- **Kemba Walker** scored 19 points, handed out four assists, grabbed one rebound and had one steal in 34 minutes. Walker posted career highs for free throws (11) and free throw attempts (12).
- **Corey Maggette** scored 12 points, grabbed six rebounds and handed out two assists in 25 minutes.
- **Tyrus Thomas** scored 11 points on 5-6 shooting, grabbed five rebounds and handed out two assists in 18 minutes.
- **Derrick Brown** scored 10 points and grabbed three rebounds in 24 minutes.
- **Byron Mullens** scored 10 points, grabbed four rebounds, handed out two assists and blocked one shot in 20 minutes.
- The Bobcats committed a season-low six turnovers and posted season highs of 33 free throws and 43 free throw attempts.
- The Bobcats shot .351 from the field (26-74), .071 from beyond the three-point line (1-14) and .767 from the free-throw line (33-43), compared to .526 (41-78), .400 (8-20) and .875 (21-24) for the Clippers.
- Blake Griffin led the Clippers with 21 points and 10 rebounds, while Chris Paul added 18 points and 14 assists for Los Angeles.

BOBCATS NOTES

CALLING KEMBA

Kemba Walker was announced Wednesday as one of 18 players selected to play in the 2012 BBVA Rising Stars Challenge. The group of nine rookies and nine sophomores will be split into teams for the game, which will take place on Friday, Feb. 24, at NBA All-Star Weekend in Orlando. On the season, Walker is averaging 12.6 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 1.0 steal in 28.8 minutes. He ranks third among NBA rookies in scoring, third in assists, fifth in minutes played, sixth in free-throw percentage (.811), seventh in steals, ninth in three-point percentage (.349), and 12th in rebounding. He is also the lone rookie this season to post a triple-double, tallying 20 points, 11 assists and 10 rebounds on Jan. 28 against Washington.

WHAT BROWN CAN DO

Derrick Brown has scored in double figures in nine of his last 11 games, averaging 11.3 points on .539 shooting from the field (48-89) during the stretch. In the season's first 16 games, he averaged 4.9 points on .493 shooting (35-71) and scored in double figures only once. Brown, who scored a career-high 20 points on a perfect 10-10 shooting from the field on Tuesday at Boston, posted a career-long four-game double-figure scoring streak from Jan. 22-27.

ROLLING WALKER

Kemba Walker has scored in double figures in 11 of his last 16 games, averaging 14.1 points, 4.8 rebounds, 4.1 assists and 1.4 steals in 34.3 minutes played during the stretch. On Jan. 28 against Washington, Walker scored 20 points, handed out a career-high 11 assists and grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds, recording the first triple-double of his career. Walker's triple-double, which was the first in the NBA by a rookie this season, is the third in franchise history, joining former Bobcats guard Stephen Jackson (24 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists vs. Phoenix on Nov. 20, 2010) and teammate **Boris Diaw** (25 points, 11 rebounds and 11 assists vs. Philadelphia on Jan. 17, 2011).

SWAT TEAM

Tyrus Thomas and **Bismack Biyombo** are ranked ninth and 18th, respectively, in the NBA in blocked shots. Thomas, who is averaging 1.9 blocks per game, has had at least two blocks in 10 of his 20 games played this season, while Biyombo, who is averaging 1.4 per game, has blocked at least four shots four times this season, including a career-high five on Jan. 13 against Detroit. On Jan. 25 at Washington, Thomas blocked a career-high nine shots, posting the then-highest single-game total in the NBA this season, and Biyombo added four blocks as the Bobcats recorded a season-high 13. As a team, the Bobcats enter tonight's games ranked fifth in the NBA in blocked shots, averaging 5.63 per game. They trail only Oklahoma City (7.63), Washington (7.61), Utah (6.00) and Chicago (5.64).

IRON BORIS

Boris Diaw has played in 250 consecutive games since joining the Bobcats on Dec. 10, 2008, breaking the previous franchise record of 175 consecutive games played set by Emeka Okafor. Diaw started a franchise-record 235 consecutive games from December 10, 2008-Jan. 13, 2012, topping the previous high of 173 games also set by Okafor. Going back to his time in Phoenix, Diaw has played in 376 consecutive games, a streak that started on March 7, 2007, and is currently the second longest in the NBA behind only the Lakers' Derek Fisher.

REGGIE'S RETURN

In his six games played this season after missing the first 21 games due to left knee surgery, **Reggie Williams** is averaging 9.7 points, 3.2 rebounds and 2.7 assists in 27.0 minutes played. Williams scored 21 points in each of his first two starts, adding seven rebounds and six assists on Feb. 4 at Phoenix in his first start of the season and five assists and three rebounds on Tuesday at Boston. He is the third Bobcats player this season to post consecutive 20-point games, joining **D.J. Augustin** (21 points on Jan. 6 vs. Atlanta and 20 points on Jan. 7 at Indiana) and **Gerald Henderson** (22 points on both Jan. 17 at Orlando and Jan. 21 at Chicago).

BYRON'S RUN

Byron Mullens has scored in double figures in 15 of the season's 27 games after doing so just once in his 26 career NBA games played prior to this season. Mullens, who surpassed his previous career total of 39 points in the fifth game of the season, scored a career-high 23 points on Jan. 28 against Washington, marking his third 20-plus-point game of the season. He grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds on Jan. 16 against Cleveland. Mullens recorded his first career double-double with 10 points and a career-high 11 rebounds on Jan. 7 at Indiana, and followed that up two games later with 15 points and 10 rebounds on Jan. 10 against Houston. The following compares his production this season to the 26 games he played over his first two NBA seasons.

HELLO HENDERSON

Gerald Henderson has scored in double figures in eight of his last nine games played, including three games of 20 points or more, and is averaging 17.1 points on .496 shooting (59-119) during the nine-game stretch. Henderson, who recorded a season-high 26 points in the Jan. 14 win over Golden State, has scored in double figures 16 times this season, including five games of 20 points or more. Henderson also recorded 14 points and a career-high 10 rebounds on Jan. 7 at Indiana for his first career double-double. Including the final 28 games of last season, Henderson has scored in double figures in 38 of his last 49 games played, after doing so just 12 times in 83 career games played prior to that. The stretch includes a career-best 10-game double-figure-scoring streak from March 19-April 6, 2011. During the 49-game stretch, which includes all 12 of Henderson's career 20-point games, he is averaging 14.9 points on .465 shooting from the field (293-630) and .798 free-throw shooting (130-163). The following compares his production over his last 49 games played to his previous 83 career games.

THAT'S MY D.J.

D.J. Augustin has scored in double figures in nine of his last 13 games played, including four games of 20 points or more, and tallied consecutive double-doubles with 14 points and 10 assists on Jan. 4 at New York and 21 points and a season-high 12 assists on Jan. 6 against Atlanta. On the season, Augustin is averaging 13.6 points and 6.6 assists, ranking 16th in the NBA in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.63). Including the final 26 games of last season, Augustin has scored in double figures in 33 of his last 43 games played, averaging 14.3 points and 6.3 assists during the stretch.

YOUTH GONE WILD

Born on August 28, 1992, **Bismack Biyombo** is the youngest active player in the NBA.
