BUCK SHOTS

- The Bucks have opened their first 11 games of the season with a 8-3 record, their best mark after 11 games since the 2001-02 season when the club started 9-2.
- The Bucks have won seven of their last eight games, a feat they last accomplished from 12/16/06 to 12/30/06. For more on the last eight games, check out the Going Streaking stat box to the right.
- Bucks fans wanting to catch a second-showing of Brandon Jennings' 55 point effort can tune into Fox Sports Wisconsin on Thursday, December 10 (7 p.m.) to see the re-broadcast.
- Brandon Jennings leads all rookies in points (25.3), assists (5.5) and field goal percentage (.479). Jennings is also in the top five in rebounds (4.4), three point-percentage (.491), free throw percentage (.772), steals (1.0) and minutes played (34.9).
- Milwaukee has allowed just 104 second-chance points this year, averaging 9.5 per game, lowest in the NBA.
- The Bucks have been playing solid perimeter defense in their last three games, holding opponents to 19.5 percent three-point shooting (8-41).
- Six Bucks are currently averaging double-digit scoring numbers. They are: Brandon Jennings (25.3), Andrew Bogut (16.1), Michael Redd (13.0), Ersan Ilyasova (10.5), Luke Ridnour (10.2) and Hakim Warrick (10.1).
- In the last four games, the Bucks bench has outscored the opponents subs 155-104, an average of 38.8 to 26.0. On the season, Milwaukee averages 36.0 bench points while allowing 29.0 (400-314). The Bucks have won the bench battle in eight of their first 11 contests.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

Series tied 35-35

- The Bucks swept last year's season series with the Spurs, marking the fifth time in the last 10 years that Milwaukee has won the series. Over that stretch the Bucks have a 12-8 record against the Spurs.
- All five of the Spurs wins have come at home, where they are 5-2 this season.
- Tim Duncan is off to another solid season, averaging 17.1 points, 11.2 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 1.8 blocks. He is averaging 6.0 assists per game over his last three.

NEWS & NOTES ...

QUARTERLY STATEMENT – The Bucks have been making a statement coming out of the half this season. They have won the last six third quarters and have taken eight of the 11 this season, going 7-1 when winning the third. Milwaukee has outscored the opposition in the third frame by a total of 302-236, or 27.5 to 21.5 per game. The Bucks have also been good before the half, winning eight of 11 second quarters with an average advantage of 23.5 to 20.6 (258-227).

HOT HAND LUKE – Luke Ridnour has had a hot hand off the bench this year, especially in the last five contests. The point guard is averaging 13.6 points on 52.9 percent (27-51) from the field, including 8-16 (50.0 percent) from long range. Ridnour is also averaging 5.6 assists, 3.2 rebounds and 1.1 steals over that span. Ridnour is coming off of a 12-assist, zero turnover performance in Memphis on Saturday, boosting his assist-to-turnover ratio to 7.00:1 (28:4) during that stretch. Ridnour is 10th in the NBA with a 3.08:1 assist-to-turnover ratio this season (40:15). The 12 assists are the most he has dished out in a game in his Bucks career.

ILYASO-GOOD – Ersan Ilyasova has been playing great basketball as of late. In his last four games, Ilyasova is averaging 14.8 points, 9.8 rebounds, and 1.8 assists and has recorded two double-doubles. The Turkey native has gone 21-43 from the field (.448) and 9-22 from long range (.409) during that span and is 3-0 as a starter.

RECENT GAMES:

November 21, 2009 @ Memphis

W, 103-98 – Hampered by injuries, the Bucks used contributions from several different players to defeat the Grizzlies and win their seventh game in eight tries. Brandon Jennings did the scoring (26), Ersan Ilyasova and Kurt Thomas did the rebounding (12 and 10, respectively), and Luke Ridnour did the assisting (12). Charlie Bell added a season-high 19 points on five threes to go along with double-doubles by Ilyasova and Ridnour.

November 20, 2009 Charlotte

W, 95-88 – Milwaukee closed out their homestand with a victory over Charlotte to give themselves a 5-1 record on their season-high home stretch. Brandon Jennings had game-highs in points (29) and assists (7) to lead the way. The Bucks held the advantage through each of the first three quarters before holding off a Bobcats fourth quarter push for the win. Gerald Wallace and Stephen Jackson led Charlotte with 22 points each.

November 18, 2009 New Jersey

W, 99-85 – Behind a strong third quarter, the Bucks were able to top the Nets and improve to 5-1 at the Bradley Center this season. The Bucks scored the first 15 points in the quarter and ended with a 28-12 advantage, holding the Nets to 17.4 percent (4-23) shooting. Andrew Bogut tallied his fifth double-double with 21 points and 11 rebounds while Carlos Delfino recorded a season-best 21 points and Luke Ridnour tied his season-high with 17.

ON THE REBOUND – The Bucks are the top rebounding team in the NBA, grabbing 45.8 boards per game this season. They are fourth in offensive (12.9) and third in defensive (32.9) boards and are grabbing 53.7 percent of available rebounds, second best in the NBA. The Bucks have outrebounded their opponents by a total of 504-450 (45.8-40.9) and are 6-0 when rebounding more than the opposition. They have allowed only 8.9 offensive boards per game, good for second fewest in the league.

DIALING UP LONG DISTANCE – The Bucks have been running up long distance charges this season as they're currently fifth in the NBA by shooting 39.1 percent from three-point range. In addition to knocking down a high percentage of those attempts, Milwaukee is taking a lot of three pointers. They're currently fifth in the league with an average of 22.6 three-point attempts and they're making 8.8 of those attempts, good for third in the league behind only Phoenix (10.4 makes per game) and Orlando (9.7). Brandon Jennings is seventh in the league with a 49.1 percent (28-57) success rate from three and his 2.5 three-point makes per game tie him for seventh in the NBA.

Milwaukee trails 31-44

- The Hornets have taken the last eight games from the Bucks at home and have won seven in-a-row over Milwaukee overall.
- New Orleans has protected the ball so far this season, committing 13.1 turnovers per game, the fifth lowest total in the league. The Hornets have allowed only 5.5 steals, the lowest figure in the NBA.
- Chris Paul has missed the Hornets last five games with a sprained left ankle. Paul is averaging 23.8 points and 9.2 assists per game.
- After a 3-7 start, the Hornets have won three of their last five games.
