BUCK SHOTS:

- Ersan Ilyasova tallied 17 points and 16 rebounds on Saturday, his third career game with 15+ points and 15+ rebounds.
- Drew Gooden logged 42 minutes on Saturday, his most in a game in nearly four years (Gooden played 43 minutes for Chicago on 3/11/08).
- Carlos Delfino is shooting 11-for-16 (.688) from behind the arc over his last three games. He went 4-of-5 on Saturday vs. Orlando and hit a season-high six treys on 2/8 at Toronto.
- As a team, Milwaukee is shooting 38-of-91 (.418) from behind the arc over the last four games.
- Milwaukee has had 20 or more assists in 10 of the last 12 games.
- On Friday night in Cleveland, the Bucks set two new season-high marks for the team: 113 points and 51 total rebounds.
- The Bucks have grabbed at least 10 offensive rebounds in each of the last seven games.

- In the two teams' last meeting on Feb. 1, the Bucks rallied from an 18-point first-half deficit to become the only squad in the NBA to beat Miami two times this season.
- The last time Milwaukee swept a season series against the Heat was in 1990-91.

 - Brandon Jennings – finished with 31 points (including a season-high seven treys), eight assists, four steals and zero turnovers
 - Ersan Ilyasova – grabbed a game-high 14 rebounds off the bench
 - LeBron James – scored 40 points to lead the Heat (24 in the first quarter, a Heat franchise record)

NEWS & NOTES ...

YOU CAN'T SPELL REBOUNDERS WITHOUT ERS – Ersan Ilyasova has been a rebounding machine in recent weeks, grabbing at least one offensive board in a career-best 17 straight games and posting 10+ rebounds in four of his last six games. Those raw numbers are even more impressive when considering that Ersan has done it all in a reserve role and hasn't played more than 35 minutes in a game yet this season. Ersan already owns the top-two rebounding games by a reserve this season and ranks second in the league in double-digit rebounding efforts by a reserve:

February 11, 2012 vs. Orlando

L, 94-99 – The Bucks held a 10-point lead with 5:44 to play last night but couldn't hold off a late Magic rally, falling 99-94 to snap a two-game winning streak. Jason Richardson had a career-night for the Magic, finishing with 31 points and hitting a career-best nine three-pointers (in 11 attempts). He hit four of those threes in the final quarter, all coming during Orlando's game-changing 16-0 run that turned that 10-point Bucks lead into a six-point deficit from which the Bucks could not recover. Ersan Ilyasova hit a three with 57 seconds remaining to trim the lead deficit to three and the Magic went just 2-of-6 from the line in the closing seconds, but the Bucks were unable to get any closer. Ilyasova finished with 17 points and 16 rebounds off the bench, his third double-double of the season, with Drew Gooden adding 21 points and eight boards. Dwight Howard finished with 11 points and 14 rebounds for the Magic.

February 10, 2012 at Cleveland

W, 113-112 – A 17-2 deficit in the 1st quarter to start the game turned into a one-point OT victory for the Bucks. Tied at 102 points with 3.7 seconds left, Antawn Jamison stepped to the line for two free throws, missing both. Milwaukee could not score to win, sending the game into overtime. Drew Gooden went 2-3 with two free throws for 6 points in OT to help the Bucks to the victory. Brandon Jennings led Milwaukee in scoring with 24 points and assists with 8. Carlos Delfino grabbed a team-high 7 rebounds. For Cleveland, Antawn Jamison had a season-high 34 points, Ramon Sessions dished out a season-high 16 assists and Tristan Thompson grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds. Scott Skiles was ejected in the third quarter. Cavs rookie star Kyrie Irving did not play due to concussion-like symptoms, and Anderson Varejao left the game in the third quarter and did not return.

MILWAUKEE BUCKS GAME NOTES – FEB 13, 2012

ON THE OFFENSIVE - The Bucks poured in a season-high 113 points on Friday at Cleveland, at the time their third straight game with 100+ points and eighth such outing in the last 10 games. Despite falling below the century mark against Orlando on Saturday (94 points), the Bucks are averaging 100.0 points per game over the last 11 en route to a 6-5 mark over that span. For the season, the Bucks have cracked the century mark 13 times in 26 games, after doing so just 21 times all of last season. Overall, Milwaukee is 71-28 in the Scott Skiles era when scoring 100+ points, including 10-3 this season.

BOMBS AWAY – The Bucks had a brief two-game lull from behind the arc against Detroit (Feb. 3) and Chicago (Feb. 4), but are still shooting 38.3% as team from long range over the last eight games, including six games in that span with 8+ treys. Carlos Delfino's season-high six threes were part of a Bucks team-high 12 bombs at Toronto on Feb. 8, one of four games this season in which a Bucks player has hit 5+ threes (with Milwaukee 3-1 in those games).

BOARDING SCHOOL – The Bucks have now held a rebounding edge in each of the last three games, the first three nights the Bucks have outrebounded the opposition since losing starting center Andrew Bogut to injury. The effort on the glass in Cleveland on 2/10 was particularly unique, as the Bucks pulled down a season-high 51 boards without a single player grabbing more than seven. All 11 players who saw action grabbed at least two rebounds, and six different players had five or more boards. Further, all 11 players grabbed at least one offensive rebound.

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS – On Saturday night vs. Orlando, Milwaukee went a perfect 7-7 from the free throw line, the second game this season with 100 percent shooting from the charity stripe. The Bucks rank among the league's best at the free throw line this season, shooting 78.6 percent as a team (4th in the NBA). Individually, six Bucks players are shooting 80 percent, including one of the players on the team with the most attempts this year (Gooden: 75-89, 84.3%, T28th in NBA). Stephen Jackson (82.8%), Mike Dunleavy (81.3%), Shaun Livingston (85.4%), Luc Mbah a Moute (85.3%) and Jon Leuer (81.0%) are all cracking the 80 percent mark this season as well. As a team, the Bucks have failed to shoot at least 70 percent from the line just once in the last 15 games.

- The Hornets have won four of the last five meetings at the Bradley Center. Prior to that, the Bucks had won at least one home game against the Hornets in five straight seasons (2001-02 through 2005-06).

- New Orleans has swept the season series from Milwaukee in four of the last five seasons. Wednesday's matchup is the only times these clubs will meet in 2011-12.

A SPECIAL PRACTICE – On Feb. 6, Bucks players and coaches will participate in the team's annual Special Olympics Basketball Clinic at Homestead High School. The players and coaches, along with Bango, will join 300 Special Olympics athletes to help them prepare their teams for upcoming competition.

DISCOVERY WORLD READING EVENT – On Tuesday, Jan. 31, Bucks players headed to Discovery World at Pier Wisconsin to host an afternoon of fun and learning with 300 Milwaukee Public School children. The event, made possible through a partnership with Sam's Hope for Literacy Foundation, emphasized the importance of staying in school and reading.

MACC FUND GAME – The Bucks' preseason matchup with the Wolves on Dec. 21 served as the 35th Annual MACC Fund Game. The event is the cornerstone of the Bucks long-time commitment to Midwest Athletes Against Childhood Cancer. Since the inaugural event in 1977, the annual MACC Fund Game has raised more than \$1.3 million dollars for children's cancer research at the Midwest Children's Cancer Center in Milwaukee.
