Pro Career Highlights: Averaged 15.7 points and 3.2 rebounds in 21 games with Eroni Star Kiryat Ata in the Israeli premier league last season.

Senior (2007-08): Averaged 17.6 points and 3.4 rebounds...named All-BIG EAST Second Team.

Junior (2006-07): Finished the season tied for 14th on DePaul's single-season 3pt. field goal list (46) and tied for 17th in 3pt. field goal attempts (124)...honorable mention All-BIG EAST Conference selection...team's leading scorer in BIG EAST play (13.1 ppg)...named to the BIG EAST Conference Weekly Honor Roll on February 5 after averaging 26 points and six rebounds in two contests.

Sophomore (2005-06): Finished ninth in the BIG EAST Conference in free throw percentage...season-high 24 points (10-10 FTs) vs. Rutgers and became the 14th player in DePaul history to be perfect from the free throw line with at least 10 attempts in a game...in first start of the season scored 22 points with five rebounds and four assists in win at Wake Forest...first career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 rebounds at Cincinnati...career-high five steals at Providence, became the first DePaul player to have five steals in a game since Delonte Holland in 2002.

Freshman (2004-05): Made first collegiate start and scored five points at Tulane...season-best 12 points in win over USF...10 points, three rebounds and two assists vs. Tulane in C-USA Tournament...nine points with two steals at Cincinnati...eight points vs. TCU...four rebounds and three points in a season-high 25 minutes vs. Houston.

High School: Ranked as the 104th-best player in the nation by Prep Stars...averaged 20.1 points, 5.5 assists and 5.5 rebounds per game as a senior at Laurinburg...member of Laurinburg team that was ranked No. 1 in the nation during the 2003-04 season...second team all-state in Wisconsin after averaging 17.1 points, 4.5 assists, 3.8 rebounds and 2.4 steals per game as a junior at Milwaukee Custer...was the leading scorer at the Las Vegas Invitational AAU Tournament in the summer prior to his senior year.
