Pro Career Highlights: Joined the Skyforce for the regular season finale last season and recorded six points and six rebounds in 13 minutes of action.

College Highlights: Fifth on UW's career blocked shots list (96).

Senior (2007-08): Played in 35 of 36 games, starting seven...averaged 11.5 minutes per game...led the team with 40 blocked shots...four double-digit scoring performances, including a career-high 14 points in the NCAA tournament against Kansas State...tied a career high with 21 minutes played, scoring 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting and adding six rebounds in his final home game.

Junior (2006-07): Played in 34 of 36 games...played a career high 21 minutes and scored a career-high 12 points off the bench at Illinois...had two or more blocked shots in 10 games and finished second on the team in that category (30)...shot a team-best .591 (13-of-22) from the field in Big Ten play.

Sophomore (2005-06): Played in 16 games, averaging 11.7 minutes per game...led the Badgers with 24 blocked shots (1.5 per game)...had career bests in blocks (5), assists (4) and steals (3) vs. Iowa...grabbed a career-high seven rebounds in 15 minutes vs. Old Dominion.

Freshman (2004-05): Played in 10 games, totaling 27 minutes...scored first career points to go with three rebounds and two blocked shots vs. Western Carolina...missed first six weeks of the season with a right foot injury.

High School: Led Randolph to Division 4 state titles as a sophomore, junior and senior...Associated Press All-State Third Team as a senior...three-time All-Conference selection.
