College Highlights: Two-time team MVP (2007; 2008)...9th all-time with 1,677 career points...second all-time with 343 career three-pointers made...4th all-time with 190 career steals...128 three-pointers made in 2008 are 2nd most in a single-season in school history...634 points in 2008 are 5th most in single season history...had six games of 30 or more points in 2008 (career-high 39 vs. St. Bonaventure, 2/9/08).

Senior (2006-07): Third Team All-Atlantic 10...Atlantic 10 All-Tournament Team...played and started in 34 games for Charlotte...averaged 18.6 points, 4.4 rebounds in 33.2 minutes of action.

Junior (2005-06): Second on the team with a career-best 14.5 points while shooting a career-best .394 from three-point range...led team with 82 assists and 39 steals...hit 91 threes to lead the A-10 with 3.03 threes per game...led the A-10 with .905 free throw percent...scored in double figures 21 times, including nine games with 20 or more...career high of 30 vs. Dayton in which he scored 24 points in the final 7:58 of the first half, hitting a perfect 6-of-6 threes and 6-of-6 free throws over that stretch...preseason All A-10 (3rd Team) and Preseason All-Defensive Team.

Sophomore (2004-05): Honorable mention All-Atlantic-10 selection...starting shooting guard was the 49ers' 3rd leading scorer...averaged 13.4 points...hit 84 three-pointers, shooting .346 from long-range...emerged as one of the 49ers' top perimeter defenders, leading the team with 58 steals...had high of six steals vs. Wake Forest and five steals at George Washington...named to the A-10 All-Academic Team (3.0 GPA; Psychology).

Freshman (2004-05): Averaged 16.7 minutes as a back-up point guard...scored in double figures four times...was second on the team to NCAA leader Brendan Plavich with 40 three-pointers made...hit 6-of-7 three-pointers for season-high 22 points (7-13 FG) vs. Yale in Cable Car Classic...also led 49ers with 17 points (5-6 FG; 3-3 3FG) in win over NCAA participant UL Lafayette.

Personal: He and his wife, Lakin Fulton-Goldwire, were married July 2, 2005 and have a son Leemire LaTray Goldwire, III...they are calling him "Tray"...son of Cora Jones and Leemire Goldwire, Sr...has five brothers (Jovaris Jones; Alonzo Smith, Jamal Smith, Kenneth Anders, Jr. and Kevin Anders) and three sisters (Shaakiara Smith; Ashley Gilbert; Choya Goldwire)...majored in Psychology.
