### BUCK SHOTS

- Giannis Antetokounmpo scored a career-high 44 points and made a career-high 17 shots on 23 attempts in Milwaukee's win over Portland on Saturday. Antetokounmpo's 44 points are the most by a Buck since Brandon Jennings scored 55 points on 11/14/09.
- Through his first three games of the 2017-18 season, Antetokounmpo has scored 115 points, tallying 30+ points in each contest. His 115 points through the first three games of the season are the second-most in Bucks history (117 – K. Abdul-Jabbar, 1972-73), and tied for the ninth-most in NBA history.
- Antetokounmpo has scored 37, 34 and 44 points in his three games this season and is currently leading the NBA in points per game, averaging 38.3 points a contest. He has scored 30+ points in five consecutive games dating back to last year's playoffs. His 67.2 field goal percentage so far this season also ranks seventh in the NBA.
- As a team, Milwaukee is shooting 49.6 percent on the season, which is tops in the NBA. The Bucks have shot 50.0 percent or better in both of their wins so far this season.
- Malcolm Brogdon swiped a career-high-tying four steals in Saturday's win over the Trail Blazers. Prior to that, Brogdon made a career-high-tying four 3-pointers in Friday's game against Cleveland and scored 19 points, the third most of his career, in the Bucks' season opener against the Celtics on Wednesday.
- John Henson hauled in a team-high nine rebounds on Saturday and blocked a team-high three shots. Henson is averaging 2.3 blocks per game, which is tied for fifth in the NBA so far this season.

- The Bucks won the 2016-17 season series over the Hornets, 2-1.
- Giannis Antetokounmpo recorded one of his triple-doubles last season against Charlotte, as he scored 10 points with 11 rebounds and 10 assists in Milwaukee on 4/10/17.
- Tony Snell scored a career-high 26 points against the Hornets on 3/28/17 in Charlotte. Snell went 10-for-14 overall and 4-for-8 from beyond the arc in Milwaukee's 118-108 win.
- Hornets guard Michael Carter-Williams and forward Johnny O'Bryant III are both former Bucks. Carter-Williams played in 79 games with Milwaukee over two seasons (2015-16) and averaged 12.4 points, 5.3 assists and 4.7 rebounds per game. O'Bryant was a Second Round pick by the Bucks in the 2014 NBA draft and appeared in 100 games in two seasons in Milwaukee, averaging 3.0 points and 2.4 rebounds per game.
- Hornets forward/center Frank Kaminsky played four years of collegiate basketball at the University of Wisconsin, averaging 10.1 points, 4.6 rebounds and 1.3 assists in 144 games and leading the Badgers to the 2015 NCAA National Championship game

### Recent Games

Oct. 21, 2017 vs. Portland

**W, 113-100** – A career night from Giannis Antetokounmpo sent the Bucks to their second win of the season. Antetokounmpo scored a career-high 44 points and scored the go-ahead points with 11.4 seconds in the game. With the Bucks down by one with 30.3 seconds left in the game, Antetokounmpo poked the ball from Portland's C.J. McCollum before Malcolm Brogdon grabbed it, threw it ahead to Antetokounmpo, who then dunked it to put the Bucks up by one with 11.4 seconds remaining. The Trail Blazers then had the chance to regain the lead, but Antetokounmpo swatted away a Jusuf Nurkic layup and Khriston Middleton sealed the game with two free throws to send the Bucks to victory. Antetokounmpo scored 17 of his 44 points in the fourth quarter and added eight rebounds, four assists, two steals and a block to his stat line for the night. Middleton scored 18 points for Milwaukee, which also got 17 points from Tony Snell. Portland was led by Damian Lillard and McCollum who each scored a team-high 26 points.

Oct. 20, 2017 vs. Cleveland

**L, 97-116** – The Bucks were outscored by the Cavaliers in the second half, 61-48, as Milwaukee fell for the first time this season, 116-97, to the defending Eastern Conference Champions. The Bucks were down by only six points, 55-49, at halftime, and found themselves down by only one, 64-63, with 6:57 remaining in the third quarter after a Thon Maker 3-pointer. But the Cavs pushed their lead back to eight on a quick 7-0 run, and then again led by 12 points, 80-68, with 2:44 left in the quarter. In the fourth quarter, the Cavs led by double-digits throughout and kept the Bucks from mounting a comeback by shooting 64.7 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from three before winning by 19. Giannis Antetokounmpo led all scorers with 34 points to go along with eight rebounds and eight assists while Malcolm Brogdon chipped in 16 points. LeBron James paced the Cavs with 24 points.

## NEWS & NOTES

**KEEPING THE HERD INTACT** – The Bucks begin the 2017-18 season with 13 players on their 16-man roster who played on Milwaukee's 2016-17 squad that went 42-40 and earned the Sixth Seed in the Eastern Conference playoffs. The Bucks' 42-40 mark last season was the team's best record since the 2009-10 season (46-36), and the third time in the last five seasons Milwaukee's made the playoffs.

**BRINGING HOME THE HARDWARE** – Entering the 2017-18 season, the Milwaukee Bucks return two NBA award winners to their team in Giannis Antetokounmpo and Malcolm Brogdon. After a stellar fourth season, Antetokounmpo won the NBA's Most Improved Player Award and was named to the All-NBA Second Team and All-Defensive Second Team. Brogdon became just the second player in franchise history (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, 1969-70) to win the NBA's Rookie of the Year Award after he earned the honor following his rookie season in which he ranked second among rookies in points (10.2) and minutes per game (26.4), and first in assists (4.2) and steals (1.1) per game.

**THE ELITE GREEK FREAK PART 1** – In 2016-17, Giannis Antetokounmpo became the first player in league history to rank inside the NBA's top 20 for total points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks. Since 1973-74 (the first year steals and blocks were recorded as official stats) only three other times has a player ranked inside the top 25 in all five of those categories. **THE ELITE GREEK FREAK PART 2** – Giannis Antetokounmpo also became one of five players in NBA history to lead his team in points (22.9), rebounds (8.8), assists (5.4), blocks (1.9) and steals (1.6) per game, as he averaged team-highs in each of those categories in 2016-17. The only other players in league history (since 1946-47) to lead their teams in all of these categories for a full season are Dave Cowens (1977-78), Kevin Garnett (2002-03), LeBron James (2008-09) and Scottie Pippen (1994-95).

**RETURN OF THE ROY** – Bucks guard Malcolm Brogdon had a historic first season in the NBA. The second round draft pick out of Virginia and NBA Rookie of the Year finished the 2016-17 season in some exclusive company and ranked toward the top in most statistical categories among rookies in 2016-17. View the charts below to see the rookies in NBA history to shoot 40.0 percent or better from 3-point range (min. 100 attempts) while averaging 4.0 assists per game, and to see where Brogdon stacked up against his fellow rookies last season:

**STILL FUEL IN THIS JET** – Bucks guard Jason Terry begins his 19<sup>th</sup> season in the NBA and second straight season with Milwaukee. After shooting 42.7 percent from 3-point range and knocking down 73 threes over 74 games last season, "The Jet" now ranks third all-time in career 3-pointers with 2,242. - The Bucks knocked off the Celtics in the first game of the 2016-17 season series between the two teams on 10/18 in Boston, 108-100. Giannis Antetokounmpo recorded a double-double with a game-high 37 points and 13 rebounds. Jaylen Brown led the Celtics with 18 points while Kyrie Irving added 17 points.
- Bucks guard Malcolm is averaging 14.3 points per game against the Celtics in four career games against them, which is his second-highest scoring average against any team. Brogdon has scored in double figures each game against Boston in his career.
- Bucks guard Jason Terry spent one season with the Boston Celtics in 2012-13. Terry played in 79 games (24 starts) and averaged 10.1 points, 2.5 assists and 2.0 rebounds in 26.9 minutes per game with the Celtics that season.

## COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY

**FOURTH ANNUAL FAN FEST** – In a city known for its festivals, it's only fitting that the Bucks would host their own. For the fifth year, the team held a Fan Fest after their annual open practice at the BMO Harris Bradley Center on Oct. 8. The free event included opportunities for autographs and photos with current players, coaches and broadcasters, the chance to shoot a free throw on the Bucks court, appearances by Bucks game night entertainment crews, the opportunity to purchase Bucks gear and memorabilia, and "Bango's Backyard" with interactive games. This year's event will also featured video game stations where fans had the chance to challenge Bucks players at the popular NBA 2K18 video game.

**BUCKS STATEWIDE TOUR** – For the fourth straight year, the Milwaukee Bucks sent a contingent of entertainment groups – mascot Bango, Milwaukee Bucks Dancers, Hoop Troop and Rim Rockers – plus players Rashad Vaughn and D.J. Wilson to cities in Wisconsin outside of Milwaukee. The Bus Tour made stops in Adams, Eau Claire, Fall Creek, Madison, Wisconsin Dells, Janesville, Kenosha, West Bend, Appleton, Neenah, Chilton, Oshkosh, Green Bay, Crivitz, Sturgeon Bay, Luxemburg, Manitowoc and Cedarburg over two weekends at the end of September, and hosted basketball clinics in addition to taking in the local sites, to show that the Bucks belong to the entire state of Wisconsin.
