### Recent Games...

Feb. 13, 2019 at Indiana

**W, 106-97** – The Bucks took down the Pacers in the final game before the All-Star break, 106-97, picking up their seventh consecutive road win. Milwaukee led for the majority of the first quarter and the entirety of the second quarter, going up by as many as 13 points before taking an eight-point lead into halftime, 55-47. The Pacers opened the third quarter with a 12-3 run to go up by one, 59-58, and ultimately took a three-point advantage into the fourth quarter at 79-76. Indiana extended its lead to as many as 10 points after a quick 7-0 run, forcing the Bucks to take a timeout with 9:35 left to play. Following the break, Milwaukee outscored Indiana by 11 points to take the lead, 91-90, with 5:56 to play. The game would see four more lead changes before a Khris Middleton three-pointer and a Pacers turnover sealed the win for the Bucks. Giannis Antetokounmpo led the way with 33 points, 19 rebounds and 11 assists, notching his fifth triple-double of the season. Bojan Bogdanovic led the Pacers with 20 points.

Feb. 11, 2019 at Chicago

**W, 112-99** – The Bucks picked up their sixth consecutive road win, knocking off the Bulls on Monday night in Chicago, 112-99. Neither team held much of an advantage in the first half of this one, as the first half ended with the Bucks slightly on top at 50-49. In the third quarter, the Bucks began to pull away from the Bulls as they opened up the second half on a 15-4 run to go up by 12 at 65-53. But Chicago responded and pulled back within one point at 71-70 before trailing by eight, 79-71, entering the fourth quarter. In the final quarter of play, the Bucks again used an early-quarter run to go up by 13 at 88-75 with 8:38 remaining. However the Bulls were able to cut the Bucks' lead down to three at 100-97 with 2:55 left. But after Chicago cut the lead down to three, Milwaukee came back with a 12-0 run that put the game out of reach for Chicago. Giannis Antetokounmpo led the Bucks with 29 points, 17 rebounds and eight assists. Lauri Markkanen led the Bulls with 20 points.

### BUCK SHOTS

- The Bucks have the best record in the NBA at 43-14 and have won 14 of their last 16 games. A win over the Celtics tonight would match Milwaukee's win total from last season.
- The Bucks' 14 wins in this 16-game stretch have come by an average of 15.0 points, with 12 of those wins coming by 10 or more points. Milwaukee has won an NBA-high 32 games by double digits so far this season and owns a league-best 9.8 points per game differential in 2018-19.
- Milwaukee's 43-14 record was the fourth-best at the All-Star break in franchise history and the best since the 1973-74 season (35-10). The Bucks' 43 wins were also the most in franchise history prior to the All-Star break.
- In the Bucks' last game before the All-Star break against the Pacers, Giannis Antetokounmpo led the way with his fifth triple-double of the season. Antetokounmpo scored 33 points, hauled in 19 rebounds and dished out 11 assists, marking his second career triple-double that consisted of at least 30 points and 15 rebounds (10/24/18 vs. PHI).
- Over his last five games, Antetokounmpo is averaging 32.8 points, 14.6 rebounds and 7.4 assists per game while shooting 67.0 percent from the field and 46.2 percent from three.
- Last Wednesday's win over Indiana was the NBA-high 43rd time this season that the Bucks have shot better than their opponent (41-2 in those games). Milwaukee is holding its opponents to an NBA-low 43.0 FG% this season, while the Bucks' 48.0 FG% is second-best in the league.

- The Bucks evened up the 2018-19 season series against the Celtics with a 120-107 win in Boston on Dec. 21. Giannis Antetokounmpo led all scorers with 30 points on 8-for-13 shooting in addition to eight rebounds, five assists and three blocks.
- A win over Boston on Feb. 21 would give Milwaukee its first season series win over the Celtics since the 2014-15 season. The Bucks and Celtics split the 2017-18 regular season series, 2-2.

### Last game vs. Boston – December 21, 2018 – TD Garden

**W, 120-107** – Leading by double figures during all but the first quarter, the Bucks knocked off the Celtics at TD Garden on Dec. 21, 120-107. Boston started the game on a 10-1 run, but Milwaukee then went on a 16-0 run of its own to go up 17-10, and finished the quarter up 13, 35-22. In the second quarter, the Bucks kept extending their lead, going up by as many as 26 at 58-32 with 4:50 left until halftime before taking a 17-point, 65-48, lead into the locker room. The Bucks shot 50.0 percent as a team in the first half and made 10 threes. Boston wouldn't go away quietly in the second half, however, as they were able to get within 11 points on two different occasions in the third quarter, and again with 7:01 remaining in the fourth quarter after two free throw pulled the Bucks' lead down to 105-94. But from there, Milwaukee kept Boston out of it with an 8-2 run that put it back up by 17, before going on to win by 13. Giannis Antetokounmpo led the Bucks scoring 30 points while Khris Middleton added 21 points and Tony Snell scored a season-high 15 points. The Celtics were led by Jaylen Brown who scored 21 points.

- Milwaukee took a 1-0 advantage in the 2018-19 season series after picking up a 125-95 victory over the Timberwolves on 10/26/18. Ersan Ilyasova scored a then season-high 16 points and recorded his third game of the season scoring in double figures.
- The Bucks have won four straight home games against the Timberwolves. The last time the Bucks lost at home to Minnesota was on 12/92/13.
- Milwaukee has won or tied its last four season-series against Minnesota dating back to the 2014-15 season.
- Giannis Antetokounmpo led the Bucks against the Timberwolves last season as he averaged 19.5 points, 12.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in two games.

### Last game vs. Minnesota – October 26, 2018 – Target Center

**W, 125-95** – The Bucks led from start to finish on Oct. 26, knocking off the Timberwolves in Minneapolis, 125-95, for the team's largest win of the season. Milwaukee started the game strong defensively, holding Minnesota without a field goal until the 7:19 mark, before leading by 11, 27-16, going into the second quarter. The Bucks then outscored the Timberwolves by 14, 36-22, in the second quarter to lead by 25 at halftime. In the second half, Minnesota couldn't get any closer as the Bucks extended their lead to 34 points, due to large part to making a franchise-high-tying 19 3-pointers, before coasting to a 30-point victory at the Target Center. Ersan Ilyasova and Khris Middleton led the Bucks, with both scoring a game-high-tying 16 points. Giannis Antetokounmpo added a double-double with 15 points and 12 rebounds for Milwaukee while John Henson hauled in 12 rebounds as well. Karl-Anthony Towns led the Timberwolves with 16 points.

**THE GREEK FREAK** – Averaging a career-high 27.2 points and career-highs in both rebounds (12.7) and assists (6.0) per game, while shooting a career-best 58.1 percent from the field, Giannis Antetokounmpo is on pace to have a historic season. Should he continue at this pace, he'd become the second player in NBA history to average at least 26.0 points, 12.0 rebounds and 6.0 assists per game, joining Oscar Robertson who achieved this in 1961-62.

**POURING IT IN** – Averaging 116.9 points per game, the Bucks are the second-highest scoring team in the NBA this season and are on pace to be one of the highest scoring teams in franchise history. **KHASHING IT IN** – Bucks All-Star forward Khris Middleton is second on the team in points (17.1) and third on the team in rebounds (5.9) per game this season, despite averaging five fewer minutes a game this season (31.1 mpg) than last season (36.4 mpg). Regardless, Middleton is having one of the best seasons of his career based on his per 36 minutes numbers. **THE PRESIDENT** – Malcolm Brogdon, the 2016-17 NBA Rookie of the Year, is having a career year in his third NBA season. Brogdon is currently averaging a career-high 15.8 points per game while shooting career bests in field goal percentage (.506) and 3-point percentage (.408). Brogdon is also shooting an NBA-high 93.8 percent from the free-throw line, making him the only player in the NBA shooting better than 50.0% from the field, 40.0% from three and 90.0% from the free-throw line. Check out the table below for the last three players in the NBA to achieve this, and the field goal percentage leaders among guards across the NBA this season.

**SPLASH MOUNTAIN** – Bucks center Brook Lopez has been one of the best 3-point-shooting big men in the NBA this season. Not only did he become the first center in NBA history, and the first player in Bucks history, to make seven threes in back-to-back games (which he achieved on 12/29 and 1/1), but he also ranks first among players 6-foot-10 or taller with 131 threes this season (12th overall in the NBA). He also broke his own record for most 3-pointers made in a season by a true center in NBA history.

Lopez only added the 3-point shot to his offensive arsenal over the last three seasons. In his first eight seasons combined, Lopez attempted just 31 threes, but this season, he's averaging career-highs in both 3-pointers made and attempted per game and is shooting a career-high 37.2 percent from beyond the arc. ## MILWAUKEE BUCKS COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY



**BUCKS AND COUSINS SUBS TEAM UP TO BLOCK OUT HUNGER** – The Milwaukee Bucks and Wisconsin-based Cousins Subs® have teamed up to ‘Block Out Hunger’ statewide for the fourth consecutive season. Once again, Cousins will donate \$50 to the Hunger Task Force for every blocked shot the Bucks record throughout the 2018-19 season. The Bucks have tallied 338 blocks so far this season, resulting in \$16,900 to Hunger Task Force.



**BUCKS AND ATC ‘TREES FOR THREES’ PROGRAM** – For the third season, the Milwaukee Bucks and American Transmission Co. (ATC) have teamed up to make schools across Wisconsin greener through the Trees for Threes program. As part of the program, ATC will donate one tree to be planted at a Wisconsin school for every 3-pointer the Bucks make at Fiserv Forum during the 2018-19 season. Currently, the Bucks have made 376 3-pointers at home this season, with plenty more on the way.



**COACH BUD'S ASSISTS FOR HUNGER PROGRAM** – Bucks head coach Mike Budenholzer has teamed up with Feeding Wisconsin to raise awareness and tackle hunger across the state. Budenholzer will donate \$15 to Feeding Wisconsin for every assist the Bucks tally during the 2018-19 season, with a minimum commitment of \$25,000. Should the donation reach \$25,000 before the season ends, Budenholzer will continue to donate \$15 until the season concludes.

## BUCKS IN THE QUEEN CITY

**GIANNIS ANTETOKOUNMPO NAMED CAPTAIN AND STARTER** – Bucks forward Giannis Antetokounmpo was selected as a starter and captain for the 2019 NBA All-Star Game. Making his third consecutive All-Star Game start, Antetokounmpo received the most player votes (269), the second-most fan votes (4,375,747) and tied for the second-most media votes (99) among all players in the NBA. By receiving the most votes in the Eastern Conference, Antetokounmpo will be a captain and select the players for “Team Giannis.” He’s the first player in franchise history to start three consecutive All-Star Games.

**KHRIS MIDDLETON EARNS FIRST ALL-STAR SELECTION** – Bucks forward Khris Middleton was named a reserve for the 2019 NBA All-Star Game. This is the first All-Star selection for Middleton who will join teammate Giannis Antetokounmpo at the All-Star Game in Charlotte. Middleton is the first NBA G League alum to be named an NBA All-Star. This is the first time since 2001 that the Bucks have two All-Stars.



**MIKE BUDENHOLZER TO COACH TEAM GIANNIS** – By virtue of having the best record in the Eastern Conference on Feb. 4, Bucks head coach Mike Budenholzer and his staff will coach Team Giannis in the 2019 NBA All-Star Game. This will be the second time in Budenholzer’s career that he’s been a head coach in the All-Star Game (2015), while becoming just the second coach in Bucks history (Larry Costello, 1971 and 1974), to represent Milwaukee as a head coach.

**MIDDLETON TO COMPETE IN 3-POINT CONTEST** – Khris Middleton will also participate in the MTN DEW 3-Point Contest during All-Star Weekend. Middleton, who also competed in the event in 2016, will become the third player in franchise history (Craig Hodges, Ray Allen) to participate in the 3-Point contest multiple times. This will be the ninth time Milwaukee has been represented in the 3-Point Contest. Middleton will seek to become just the second Buck to win the 3-Point Contest, joining Allen who won in 2001.
