IRVING IS ONE OF SIX PLAYERS AVERAGING 22 POINTS, 4 REBOUNDS AND 6 ASSISTS LEAGUE WIDE THIS SEASON...

Kyrie Irving is currently averaging 22.7 points, 4.8 rebounds and 6.4 assists on the season and is one of just seven players across the NBA this season to record at least 22 points, four rebounds and six assists per game joining James Harden, Kevin Durant, LeBron James, Damian Lillard and DeMar DeRozan.

HAYWARD NETS 35 OFF BENCH AGAINST MINNESOTA...

Gordon Hayward recorded a season-high 35 points coming off the bench against Minnesota on Jan. 2...He is the fourth player in franchise history to record that many points off the bench joining Larry Bird (twice), Todd Day and Ricky Davis.

STEVENS JOINS TOP 5 COACHES IN FRANCHISE HISTORY IN WINS...

With the Celtics 115-102 victory over the Timberwolves on Jan. 2 Celtics head coach Brad Stevens recorded his 243rd career victory which moved him past Bill Fitch and in to sole possession of fifth place in franchise history amongst coaching wins...listed below are the top 5 coaches with the most wins in Celtics franchise history...

IRVING DELIVERS ON CHRISTMAS DAY AGAINST SIXERS...

Kyrie Irving recorded 40 points and a career-high-tying 10 rebounds against the Sixers on Christmas Day in the C's 121-114 overtime win...It marked the first 40-point, 10-rebound game of his career and the first 40P-10R game by a Celtic since Paul Pierce on Dec. 2, 2005...He also is the second Celtics player to accomplish those totals in a game on Christmas joining Tommy Heinsohn in 1961.

C'S HAVE HISTORIC NIGHT IN CHICAGO...

The Celtics beat the Bulls 133-77 for a 56 point win which tied the record for the largest road win in NBA history on Dec. 8...They tied the record that the Seattle SuperSonics had when they defeated the Houston Rockets 136-80 in 1986...The 56 point victory also marked the largest margin of victory in franchise history according to the Elias Sports Bureau...The previous high was a 51 point win over Philadelphia on March 7, 1962.

HAYWARD POSTS HISTORIC GAME IN MINNESOTA...

Gordon Hayward recorded 30 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in 29:46 against Minnesota on Dec. 1...According to the Elias Sports Bureau it was the first time in franchise history that a player has recorded 30 points, nine rebounds and eight assists as a reserve...It also was the first time that a player has come off the bench and recorded 30 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in a game since Detlef Schrempf on Feb. 13, 1993.

IRVING HAS A RARE STATISTICAL NIGHT FOR HIMSELF IN PHOENIX...

Kyrie Irving netted a season-high 39 points to go along with seven rebounds, six assists and three steals in the C's come from behind 116-109 overtime win over the Suns on Nov. 8...It marked just the second time in his 452 career games that he has scored 39 or more points, grabbed five or more rebounds, handed out five or more assists and also swiping at least three steals...he also surpassed these marks on April 5, 2014.

CELTICS SET FRANCHISE RECORD FOR THREES IN WIN OVER MILWAUKEE...

The Celtics were connecting from deep against the Bucks on Nov. 1 when they shot 24-of-55 from the floor from three and created two new franchise records in the process...The 24 three's made broke their previous record of 19 makes while 55 three's attempted broke a previous record of 52 attempts.

TATUM BECOMES YOUNGEST PLAYER IN C'S HISTORY TO SCORE AT LEAST 20 POINTS IN SEASON OPENER...

Jayson Tatum netted a team-high 23 points against Philadelphia on Oct. 16 in the C's first game of the season...At the age of 20 years, 227 days became the youngest player in franchise history to record 20 or more points in the season opener...the previous record was held by Jaylen Brown who recorded 25 points in last year's season opener against Cleveland on Oct. 17, 2017...Brown was 20 years, 357 days old at the time of last year's season opener.

MORRIS BECOMES FIRST C'S BENCH PLAYER TO RECORD DOUBLE-DOUBLE IN SEASON OPENER SINCE 2011...

Marcus Morris recorded 16 points and 10 rebounds in the first game of the season against Philadelphia on Oct. 16...He became the first Celtics player to record a double-double off of the bench in the season opener since Brandon Bass on Dec. 25, 2011.

Brad Stevens begins his sixth season as Head Coach for the Boston Celtics. He was named the 17th head coach in the history of the Boston Celtics on July 3, 2013.

In his fifth season in Boston, Stevens led the Celtics to a 55-27 record and a second consecutive appearance in the Eastern Conference Finals and one game from appearing in the NBA Finals after a Game 7 loss to the Cleveland Cavaliers in the ECF. This marked the first time that the Celtics had made consecutive appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals since the 1986-87 and 1987-88 seasons.

In his fourth season in Boston, Stevens led the Celtics to an Eastern Conference-best record of 53-29 record as well as an appearance in the Eastern Conference Finals against Cleveland. Stevens earned the honor of coaching the Eastern Conference All-Star team for the 2017 NBA All-Star Game in New Orleans. He is the sixth Celtics head coach to earn the honor joining Red Auerbach, Tom Heinsohn, K.C. Jones, Doc Rivers, Bill Fitch and Chris Ford.

In his third season with the Celtics, Stevens led the team to a playoff appearance and finished with a 48-34 record. He became just the third coach in franchise history to win NBA Coach of the Month multiple times when he was named the Eastern Conference Coach of the Month for the second time during the month of February when the team posted an Eastern Conference-best 9-3 record. Stevens recorded his first career playoff victory on April 22 when they beat the Atlanta Hawks 111-103 in Boston.

In his second season with the Celtics, Stevens led the team to a playoff appearance with a furious finish to the season. After starting the season 16-30 the team finished the season 23-12 to clinch the seventh seed in the Eastern Conference. During the month of April when the team was 7-1 he was named the Eastern Conference Coach of the Month and became the fifth Celtic Head Coach to win the award joining K.C. Jones, Jimmy Rodgers, Chris Ford and Glenn "Doc" Rivers.

Stevens, 39, joined the Celtics after coaching Butler University where he boasted a 166-49 record, four league regular season championships, three league tournament titles and six trips to post-season tournament play. He has the top two single season win totals in Butler and Horizon League history, and he became the only coach in school history to lead a team to the NCAA Division I national championship game which he did twice.

Stevens owns two Horizon League Coach of the Year awards and has rewritten the NCAA record book for Best Coaching Starts by Wins. During the 2012-13 season, he moved into the top spot on the six-year list with 165 victories. He captured the five-year record (139), moving ahead of Everett Case of North Carolina State (1947-51) in 2011-12, and he owns the three-year (89) and four-year (117) records. He is second on the two-year list with 56 wins.

Stevens left a position as a marketing associate at Eli Lilly and Company in Indianapolis to pursue a career in basketball coaching. He served in a volunteer capacity in Butler's basketball office during the summer of 2000, before eventually gaining a full-time administrative position under Thad Matta. Stevens joined the Bulldogs' staff in 2000-01 as coordinator of basketball operations, handling a variety of administrative duties. He was offered a full-time assistant coaching position by Todd Lickliter in 2001-02. Stevens worked with Lickliter for six seasons spanning from 2001-07. During Stevens' tenure as an assistant coach with the Bulldogs, Butler compiled a 131-61 record, won three Horizon League regular season championships and made four trips to post-season tournament play.

In his debut season with Butler (2007-08) he guided Butler to their first 30-win season. The Bulldogs were ranked in the "Top 25" of the AP and ESPN/USA Today national polls for 19 consecutive weeks, including a record three weeks in the "Top 10". At the age of 31, he became the third-youngest Division I coach to guide his team to 30 wins and was the youngest coach to do so in more than half a century. During the 2009-10 season he was named the NABC All-District 12 Coach and was a finalist for several national coaching awards as Butler ended the season as the No. 2-ranked team in the final ESPN/USA Today national poll. The Bulldogs compiled a school record 25-game winning streak during the season which also was the longest winning streak in the nation that season. Butler switched conferences following a third-place finish in the 2011-12 season in the Horizon League with a move to the Atlantic-10 where they would finish with 26 wins and three "Top 10" victories including a win over in-state rival Indiana who were ranked No. 1 nationally at the time. Butler reached as high as No. 9 nationally in the AP and USA Today polls during the season.

- Earned his first win against Utah on November 6, 2013
- Became just the second head coach in NBA history to lose his first four (or more) games and then immediately follow that with a winning streak that brought his win-loss record back to .500. He joined Rick Adelman who in February of 1989 also lost his first four then won his next four
- Coached his 100th NBA game against Washington on December 7, 2014 and got a win over Washington 101-93
- Recorded his first winning month as coach of the Celtics during February, 2015 when the team was 7-4
- Recorded his 50th win as Celtics head coach against New Orleans on March 6, 2015
- Recorded his 100th win as Celtics head coach against Miami on February 27, 2016
- Recorded his 150th win as Celtics head coach against Philadelphia on February 15, 2017
- Recorded his 200th win as Celtics head coach against Philadelphia on January 11, 2018 in London, England
- Recorded his 243rd career win as Celtics head coach moving him in to fifth amongst coaches in C's franchise history for wins against Minnesota on January 2, 2019
