• **CLIPPERS PR X ACCOUNT:** Follow Clippers PR on X (@ClippersPR) for all official team updates. This protected X account for media members only will regularly practice/shootaround times, injury reports, game attendance, starting lineups, active/inactive lists, game updates and various team updates, in addition to team stats, league stats, game notes and coach and player quotes.

• **TRIPLE DOUBLES:** On 3/9 vs. Chicago, James Harden recorded his second triple-double of the season with 14 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. Harden became the sixth player in franchise history to record multiple triple-doubles in a single season.

• **MOVING UP THE LEADERBOARD:** On 2/12 vs. Minnesota, with his 739th career three-pointer as a Clipper, Paul George surpassed Eric Piatkowski for sole possession of first place on the Clippers' all-time three-point field goal list. On 1/16 vs. Oklahoma City, George surpassed Paul Pierce for sole possession of 12th place on the NBA's all-time three-point field goal list. On 3/1 vs. Washington, James Harden surpassed Alex English for sole possession of 21st place on the NBA's all-time points list. On 2/7 vs. New Orleans, Harden surpassed Maurice Cheeks for sole possession of 15th place on the NBA's all-time assists list. On 1/1 vs. Miami, Russell Westbrook surpasses Patrick Ewing for sole possession of 25th place on the NBA's all-time points list.

• **GRAMMY TRIP:** The Clippers finished their 2023-24 Grammy Trip with a 6-1 (.857) record. It's the most wins and the best record they've had on this yearly trip since it began in 1999. During the span of the road trip, the Clippers ranked second in the NBA in offensive rating (124.2), third in plus/minus differential (9.9) and fourth in net rating (9.6) and in points (123.3).

• **PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Kawhi Leonard was named Western Conference Player of the Week for games played from Monday, January 29, through Sunday, February 4. This is Leonard's ninth Player of the Week Award, and his third time winning with the Clippers. During the week, Leonard led the Clippers to a 3-1 record, behind averages of 29.8 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals, while shooting 56.6% from the field, 48.0% from the three-point range and 100% from the free-throw line. It's the first time in Leonard's career he has averaged at least 29.0 points and 8.0 rebounds while shooting 100% from the free-throw line over a four-game span. It's also the first time any player in franchise history has hit those three marks over a four-game span.

• **MR. 25,000 x 2:** On 12/14 vs. Golden State, James Harden eclipsed 25,000 career points. Harden became the 24th player in NBA history to achieve the milestone. The 2017-18 MVP finished with a stat line of 28 points, 15 assists, seven rebounds and four blocked shots. Harden joined LeBron James (2/18/10 vs. Denver) as the only players in NBA history to achieve that stat line or better in a single game. On 2/2 at Detroit, Russell Westbrook also eclipsed 25,000 points, becoming the 25th player in NBA history to achieve the feat. Westbrook joined LeBron James as the only players in NBA history to have at least 25,000 points, 9,000 assists and 8,000 rebounds. Westbrook and Harden are the first teammates in NBA history to reach the 25,000 point milestone in the same season.

• **ALL-STARs:** Kawhi Leonard and Paul George were selected as reserves for the 2024 NBA All-Star Game in Indianapolis. Leonard will make his sixth career All-Star appearance (2021, 2020, 2019, 2017, 2016) and his third selection with the Clippers. George will make his ninth career All-Star appearance (2023, 2021, 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016, 2014, 2013), also his third selection with the Clippers. Leonard and George are among six players in franchise history to make at least three All-Star appearances as Clippers. This is the eighth time in franchise history that the team has had multiple All-Stars in a single season.

• **BACK TO BACK:** Tyronn Lue was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for January 2024. This is Lue's second consecutive Coach of the Month award, making him the first coach in franchise history to win the award in consecutive months. For the month of January, the Clippers had the best record in the Western Conference, while ranking first in the NBA in offensive rating (124.6), 3P% (42.3) and FT% (82.8), second in FG% (51.1) and third in plus/minus differential (10.3).

• **RECENT STRETCH:** Since November 17, the Clippers have the second-best record in the NBA at 38-14 (.731). During the span, LAC ranks second in offensive rating (120.1) and in 3P% (39.1), fifth in FG% (49.4) and sixth in plus/minus differential (5.4).

• **SIX MAN:** Norman Powell has been on a tear off the bench this season, averaging 13.5 points while shooting 49.1% from the field and 44.2% from three. Powell ranks first in the NBA in games with at least 10 points off the bench (47), and is the only player in the NBA to be shooting at least 49% from the field, 44% from three and 82% from the free-throw line off the bench (min. 20 GP).

• **STRONG START AT HOME:** The Clippers are 22-8 (.733) at home this season, the sixth-best winning percentage on home court in the NBA. LAC is tied for fifth in the NBA at home in 3P% (38.6) and in FG% (50.0), and seventh in plus/minus differential (6.3).

• **COACH OF THE MONTH:** Tyronn Lue was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for December 2023. This is Lue's second Coach of the Month award and first with the Clippers. For the month of December, the Clippers had the best record and offensive rating (122.6) in the Western Conference, while ranking tied for sixth in the NBA in points (121.6).

• **MONTH OF DECEMBER:** The Clippers finished the month of December with a 11-2 (.846) record and were on a nine-game win streak from December 2-20, the longest for the Clippers since the 2015-16 season. During their nine-game win streak, the Clippers ranked second in net rating (9.4), in plus/minus differential (12.4) and in offensive rating (126.6), and tied for sixth in turnovers (12.2).

• **COMEBACK:** On 12/2 vs. Golden State, the Clippers overcame a 22-point deficit to defeat the Warriors 113-112. LAC became the 12th team in 2023-24 to win a game when trailing by at least 20 points. Paul George hit the game-winning three-pointer with 8.9 seconds remaining to secure the victory. It was the Clippers second game-winning three-pointer this season (last: James Harden on 11/17 vs. Houston). At the time, LAC was one of three teams in 2023-24 to have multiple game-winning shots.

• **STEAL LEADERS:** On 11/20 at San Antonio, the Clippers had 30 assists and 15 steals in their 124-99 win over the Spurs. It was just the fifth time in the last 10 years that the Clippers had at least 30 assists and 15 steals in a single game (last: 10/25/21 vs. Portland). LAC is sixth in the NBA in steals per game this season (7.9).

• **LOS ANGELES TIES:** The Clippers now have four All-Stars from the Los Angeles Area. James Harden, Lakewood (Artesia High School), Kawhi Leonard, Riverside (Martin Luther King High School), Paul George, Palmdale (Knight High School) and Russell Westbrook, Lawndale (Luzinger High School and UCLA).

• **CONTINUING TO BUILD:** LA at 626-384 (.620) have the NBA's second-best regular season record since the start of the 2011-12 season. On 4/5 vs. Lakers, the Clippers extended a franchise record of securing a record above .500 to 12 consecutive seasons which is the longest active streak in the NBA and tied for the seventh-longest streak in NBA history.

- Bucks head coach Doc Rivers was the head coach for the Clippers for seven seasons (2013-20), accumulating a record of 356-208 (.631).
- Clippers assistant coach Larry Drew was the head coach for the Milwaukee Bucks during the 2013-14 season.
- Clippers President of Basketball Operations Lawrence Frank coached Bucks forward Khris Middleton for the 2012-13 season as head coach of the Detroit Pistons.
- Clipper center Ivica Zubac and Bucks center Brook Lopez were teammates for the 2017-18 season on the Los Angeles Lakers.
- Bucks forward Danilo Gallinari spent two seasons (2017-19) on the Clippers, appearing in 89 games and averaging 18.7 points.
- Bucks guard Patrick Beverley spent four seasons (2017-21) on the Clippers, appearing in 177 games and averaging 8.0 points.
- Clippers forward P.J. Tucker spent part of the 2020-21 season with the Bucks, winning the 2021 NBA Championship with the franchise.
