STORYLINES

- The Hawks have swiped 11 steals in each of the first two contests ... Nine different players came up with at least one theft at Charlotte (10/20), while six posted steals on 10/18 at Dallas (including four with at least two).
- Atlanta forced Dallas into 16 turnovers (leading to 20 points) on 10/18 and Charlotte into 21 miscues (leading to 19 points) ... The Hawks are forcing opponents into 18.5 turnovers per game on the year, while averaging 19.5 points off turnovers.
- Atlanta has shot at least .800 FT% in each of the first two games, hitting .828 from the charity stripe this year.
- Seven Hawks are shooting .400 3FG%-or-better for their careers vs. the Nets – Luke Babbitt (.467), Kent Bazemore (.400), Marco Belinelli (.414), Malcolm Delaney (.500), Mike Muscala (.444), Taurean Prince (.417) and Dennis Schröder (.410).
- Atlanta is opening the 2017-18 season with a five-game road trip – at Dallas (10/18), Charlotte (10/20), Brooklyn (10/22), Miami (10/23) and Chicago (10/26) ... Previously, the longest road trip to start a season was three games (three times), most recently in 2005-06.
- Dennis Schröder scored 28 points at Dallas (10/18), becoming the third Hawks point guard to score 28-or-more points in a season opener, joining Pete Maravich and Lenny Wilkens ... He followed it up with 25 points at Charlotte (10/20), becoming the first Hawk since Joe Johnson in 2008-09 to start a season with consecutive 25-point games (Jeff Teague had back-to-back 20-point outings to start 2014-15) ... The last Hawk to start a year with three straight 25-plus scoring efforts was Johnson in 2006-07.
- Dennis Schröder is one-of-eight players since the 1977 NBA Draft class and one-of-two since the 1993 NBA Draft class (along with fellow 2013 draftee Giannis Antetokounmpo) to increase their points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks per game for three consecutive seasons following their rookie year (min. 40 games played) ... No NBA player has increased their averages in each of those categories for four straight seasons following their rookie campaign dating back to the 1972-73 season.
- Dewayne Dedmon knocked down his first career 3FG at Charlotte (10/20), finishing the night with 11 points, seven rebounds, two assists, one steal and one block in 25 minutes (5-9 FGs, 1-1 3FGs) ... It was his second career attempt from long range, with the other coming in 2014-15 with Orlando.
- Ersan Ilyasova needs six FTM for 1000 in his career ... Dewayne Dedmon needs 25 points for 1000 in his career.

Atlanta continues the season opening road swing at Brooklyn in the first-of-four games between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more in Brooklyn on 12/2 then in Atlanta on 12/4 and 1/12 ... The Hawks split the series with the Nets last season winning the first two matchups (117-97 on 1/10, 110-105 on 3/8) and losing the final two (107-92 on 3/26, 91-82 on 4/2) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 99-72, with the Nets holding a 49-37 edge in home games.

COMMON THREADS

Brooklyn Head Coach Kenny Atkinson was an Assistant on the Hawks' bench from 2013-16 ... DeMarre Carroll was a Hawk for two seasons (2013-15) ... Nets Assistant Coach Jacque Vaughn had two separate stints in a Hawks uniform, playing all 82 games in 2001-02 and 72 contests in 2003-04 ... Vaughn played for San Antonio (2006-09) and was an Assistant Coach for the Spurs (2010-12) when Hawks Head Coach Mike Budenholzer was an Assistant on the Spurs' bench ... Ersan Ilyasova and Spencer Dinwiddie were teammates in Detroit for part of 2015-16 ... Nets TV broadcaster Mike Fratello (1983-90) is a former Head Coach of the Hawks, compiling 324 wins ... Nets Assistant Coach Jordan Ott was a Video Coordinator for the Hawks from 2013-16.

HAWKS RECENT GAMES

HORNETS 109, HAWKS 91 – SPECTRUM CENTER – CHARLOTTE, NC (10/20/17)

The Hawks started strong, grabbing a 28-18 lead after the first quarter and pushing it to 40-20 thanks to a 12-2 run to open the second ... The Hornets outscored the visitors 29-16 to close the half, cutting the deficit to 56-49 at the break ... Atlanta went back up 10 early in the third but Charlotte exploded for a 24-0 run midway through the period to go on top by 15, before settling for an 84-73 advantage heading to the final stanza ... The Hawks managed to get it back down to eight in the fourth but could get no closer ... Dennis Schröder led the way with 25 points, Taurean Prince had 15, and Kent Bazemore and Dewayne Dedmon added 11 apiece ... For Charlotte, Kemba Walker had 26 point, Frank Kaminsky 21 off the bench and former Hawk Dwight Howard tallied 20 points and 15 rebounds ... Led by Howard and Dwayne Bacon (11 boards), the Hornets had a 57-38 advantage on the glass, while outscoring the Hawks 24-7 in second chance points and 48-40 in the paint ... Atlanta finished the night shooting .379 FG%, .233 3FG% (7-30) and .857 FT% (12-14), while the Hornets hit .430 from the floor, .306 from distance (11-36) and .800 from the line (24-30).

HAWKS 117, MAVERICKS 111 – AMERICAN AIRLINES CENTER – DALLAS, TX (10/18/17)

A back-and-forth affair, featuring 18 lead changes and 12 ties, came down to the wire as the Hawks opened the season with a 117-111 win at Dallas ... Dewayne Dedmon's putback with under a minute to play proved to be the game-winner before Atlanta iced it late with defensive stops and a 4-4 showing from the foul line ... The Hawks grabbed a 27-24 lead after one and a 14-2 burst to close the first half put Atlanta up 58-47 at the break ... The Mavericks rallied in the third, eventually taking the lead, before settling for an 82-82 standoff heading to the final frame ... Harrison Barnes tied things at 111 with 1:13 to go setting up Dedmon's game-winning bucket ... Dennis Schröder scored a game-high 28 points (to go with a team-best seven assists) for the visitors and Marco Belinelli had 20 (4-6 3FGs) off the bench ... Rookie John Collins had 14 points and Taurean Prince recorded his first career double-double (10 points/team-high 10 rebounds) ... Dennis Smith Jr. (16 points/10 assists) and Nerlens Noel (16 points/11 boards) had double-doubles for the home team ... Atlanta finished the night shooting .511 FG%, .500 3FG% (9-18) and .800 FT% (12-15), while the Mavs hit .442 from the floor, .378 from downtown (17-45) and .857 from the charity stripe (18-21) ... The Hawks also had advantages of 56-38 in points in the paint, 20-11 in points off turnovers, 21-14 in second chance points and 17-14 in fast break points.

NOTEWORTHY

MAKING SHOTS & GRABBING BOARDS

In the 117-111 win at Dallas (10/18), Atlanta shot .511 FG% (48-94), .500 3FG% (9-18) and .800 FT% (12-15), while pulling down 50 rebounds ... It was the first time since 1/30/93 vs. Philadelphia the Hawks shot at least .500 FG%, .500 3FG%, .800 FT% and had at least 50 rebounds in a game, and the first time since 1/30/89 at L.A. Clippers turning the trick on the road.

SEASON OPENERS:

Since moving to Atlanta prior to the 1968-69 season, the Hawks are 22-28 in the opening regular season game (either on the road or at home) ... The Hawks are 28-21 all-time in their first home game of the year, with wins in nine-of-the-last-11 (last beat Washington in 2016-17) ... Atlanta is 17-33 in their first road game of the year, including wins in seven-of-the-last-10 (two straight), after defeating Dallas 117-111 on 10/18.

ROAD TRIPPING:

Atlanta is opening the 2017-18 season with a five-game road trip – at Dallas (10/18), Charlotte (10/20), Brooklyn (10/22), Miami (10/23) and Chicago (10/26) ... Previously, the longest road trip to start a season was three games (three times), most recently in 2005-06.

YOUNGSTERS:

The Hawks have eight players on the 16-man roster (including two-way contracts) with one year or less NBA experience, while 11 players have fewer than five years experience ... Atlanta's average years of service is 3.31, making them the fourth-least experienced team in the league (according to the Elias Sports Bureau, as of 10/17).

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR:

The Hawks currently have four international players on the roster, including representatives from Italy (Marco Belinelli), Argentina (Nicolas Brussino), Turkey (Ersan Ilyasova) and Germany (Dennis Schröder) ... Additionally, rookie Tyler Dorsey holds dual citizenship the United States and Greece.

GETTING BETTER & BETTER:

Dennis Schröder is one-of-eight players since the 1977 NBA Draft class and one-of-two since the 1993 NBA Draft class (along with fellow 2013 draftee Giannis Antetokounmpo) to increase their points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks per game for three consecutive seasons following their rookie year (min. 40 games played) ... No NBA player has increased their averages in each of those categories for four straight seasons following their rookie campaign dating back to the 1972-73 season.

BELINELLI OFF THE BENCH:

Marco Belinelli finished with 20 points, three rebounds, three assists, and three steals in 26 minutes (7-14 FGs, 4-6 3FGs, 2-2 FTs) off the bench at Dallas on 10/18 ... He is the first Hawk to score 20-plus points and make at least four three-pointers as a reserve in his team debut since Larry Robinson on 10/31/00 vs. Charlotte ... The last player to score 20-plus points off the bench in his first game wearing a Hawks uniform was Lou Williams vs. Houston (11/2/12) while the last Hawk with four triples as a reserve in his team debut was DeShawn Stevenson vs. Houston (11/2/12).

STRONG START:

John Collins made his NBA debut at Dallas (10/18), finishing with 14 points, five rebounds, two steals and one assist in 22 minutes off the bench ... It was highest scoring effort by a Hawks rookie in his first game since Rumeal Robinson put up 19 points vs. Orlando on 11/2/90 ... Collins converted a three-point play on his first career FGA in the opening quarter (the last Hawk to have a three-point play on his first career attempt was Pape Sy 4/9/11 at Washington).

BUCKETS & DIMES:

Dennis Schröder owns 17 career point/assist double-doubles (five 20/10 games) and has scored 30-plus point four times (all in 2016-17) ... Atlanta is 12-5 all-time when Schröder posts a double-double and 3-1 when he goes for 30-or-more points.

POINT GUARD PRODUCTION:

Dennis Schröder scored 28 points at Dallas (10/18), becoming the third Hawks point guard to score 28-or-more points in a season opener, joining Hall of Famers Pete Maravich and Lenny Wilkens ... Schröder followed it up with 25 points at Charlotte (10/20), becoming the first Hawk since Joe Johnson in 2008-09 to start a season with consecutive 25-point games (Jeff Teague had back-to-back 20-point outings to start 2014-15) ... He's averaging 26.5 ppg on .511 FG% and .800 FT% through two games this year.

PRESEASON RECAP:

Atlanta finished the preseason with a 2-3 record (1-1 at home, 1-2 on the road) ... Dennis Schröder led the team in ppg (15.0), spg (1.3) and mpg (23.3) while playing in four contests ... Taurean Prince also averaged in double-figures, scoring at a 10.2 ppg clip and starting all five games ... Rookie John Collins was the top rebounder (7.0) and tied for the team lead in FTM (12), while averaging 7.6 ppg in five outings off the bench ... Dewayne Dedmon paced the club in FG% (.581) and bpg (1.2), chipping in 8.4 ppg and starting all five games ... Malcolm Delaney averaged 9.4 ppg and team-best 4.0 apg in five contests, and tied for the team-high with 12 FTM (12-13, .923) ... Kent Bazemore hit a team-high .556 3FG% (5-9 3FGs in four outings), with Luke Babbitt topping the club with nine 3FGM (9-21, .429) in five contests off the bench.

DOUBLE-FIGURES:

Eight different Hawks recorded at least one double-figure scoring game in the preseason – Taurean Prince (four), Dennis Schröder (three), Dewayne Dedmon (two), Malcolm Delaney (two), Kent Bazemore, (one), Marco Belinelli (one), John Collins (one) and Mike Muscala (one) ... Collins and Dedmon each had one double-digit rebounding effort as well.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE:

Atlanta hosted two preseason games (against Memphis on 10/9 and Dallas on 10/12) at Georgia Tech's McCamish Pavilion, marking the first time the Hawks have played on the school's campus since a playoff game against the Pistons in May of 1999.

SUMMER LEAGUE RECAP:

The Hawks finished the 2017 MGM Resorts NBA Summer League with a 3-2 record ... Rookie forward John Collins was named to the league's First Team after averaging 15.4 ppg, 9.2 rpg and 1.0 apg (.593 FG%, 1-1 3FGs, .667 FT%) in five games, leading Atlanta in rpg and FG% ... DeAndre' Bembry tallied 17.0 ppg, 4.5 rpg, 3.3 apg and 2.8 spg (.565 FG%, .500 3FG%, .813 FT%) playing in four contests, leading the club in scoring, assists and steals ... BIOS

HEAD COACH MIKE BUDENHOLZER

Overall NBA Coaching Record: 190-140 (.576) (5th year)

Now in his fifth season in Atlanta, Mike Budenholzer is the 12th full-time head coach in Hawks history. He was named head coach on May 28, 2013 and has led the Hawks to a 189-139 (.576) regular season mark entering the 2017-18 season.

Last season, he led Atlanta to a 43-39 regular season finish, placing fifth in the Eastern Conference, as the club reached the postseason for the fourth time in his four years. Overall, Atlanta has made 10 consecutive postseason trips, the longest stretch in Atlanta history and the longest active streak in the Eastern Conference (second in the NBA to the Spurs).

In 2015-16, the Hawks went 48-34, good for fourth in the East, and topped Boston in the first round of the NBA Playoffs (Atlanta's first series win over the Celtics in franchise history), reaching at least the Conference Semis for the second straight year. From 2014-16, the Hawks had the best two-year combined mark (108-56) in the history of the franchise.

Budenholzer led the Hawks to a number of milestones in 2014-15, including the best record in franchise history (60-22, .732), the club's first-ever trip to the Eastern Conference Finals, Atlanta's first Division title since 1993-'94 and the first time with the Eastern Conference's top seed since that same season. In addition, the Hawks put together a franchise-record 19-game win streak, tying the fifth-longest single-season streak in NBA history. Budenholzer and his staff coached the Eastern Conference All-Star team in February 2015 in New York.

He was the Eastern Conference Coach of the Month for December 2014 and January 2015, becoming the first Hawks coach to win the honor in back-to-back months. Atlanta became the first team in NBA history to finish a month 17-0 in January. He capped off 2014-15 by winning the NBA's Coach of the Year award.

In his first season in Atlanta, Budenholzer led the Hawks to their seventh consecutive postseason appearance with a 38-44 record. The team reached the playoffs playing their best basketball of the season and pushed the top-seeded Indiana Pacers to seven games in their first round series.

Budenholzer spent the previous 19 seasons with the San Antonio Spurs, winning four NBA championships along the way. As an assistant coach since the 1996-97 season, he helped lead San Antonio to a league-best 908-438 (.675) regular season record, a league-best 133-83 playoff mark (.616) and NBA titles in 1999, 2003, 2005 and 2007. Hired by the Spurs prior to the 1994-95 campaign, Budenholzer spent his first two seasons as a video coordinator before being named an assistant coach. He also served as an advance scout for Team USA for the 2004 Olympics in Athens, Greece.

Budenholzer is a 1993 graduate of Pomona College where he received a bachelor's degree in politics, philosophy and economics and was a four-year letterman in both basketball and golf. Following college, he played professionally in Denmark for the Vejle Basketball Klub, also getting his start in coaching, serving as head coach for two different teams in the Vejle system.

Budenholzer raised over \$100,000 last season for the Atlanta Community Food Bank, giving money raised from his Assists for Hunger program and a fundraiser dinner.

A native of Holbrook, AZ, he has four children: Will, Libby, Hanna and John. His father Vince spent 25 years as a high school and college basketball coach in Arizona before retiring in 1997, and was inducted into the Arizona Coaches Association Hall of Fame. The youngest of seven children, Budenholzer was born on August 6, 1969.
