HAWKS STORYLINES

■ Atlanta enters the 2024 NBA Play-In Tournament as the No. 10 seed and will face off against the No. 9 seed Chicago Bulls on Wednesday, 4/17, at the United Center ... The Hawks own a 3-0 all-time Play-In Tournament record, advancing to the Eastern Conference Playoffs in 2022 and 2023.

■ In his most recent outing on 4/14 at Indiana, 25-year-old guard Trae Young (3,868) passed Doc Rivers (3,866) for the most assists all-time in Hawks franchise history ... Young broke Rivers' franchise record in 161 fewer games (Rivers: 568 games, Young: 407 games) ... The sixth-year guard has handed out at least five assists in 161 consecutive outings, the third-longest such streak in NBA history ... Despite missing 28 games this season, Young finished with the eighth-most assists in the league (583).

■ The Oklahoma product netted his 10,000th career point against the San Antonio Spurs on 1/15, becoming the 10th-youngest player in NBA history to reach the 10,000-point plateau (25 years, 118 days) ... He also became the fastest player in NBA history (in terms of games played) to 10,000 points, 3,500 assists and 1,000 three-pointers (390 games), doing so 123 games faster than the next closest player (Stephen Curry: 513 games).

■ Young finished the season averaging 25.7 points, a career-high 10.8 assists, 2.8 rebounds and a career-best 1.33 steals in 36.0 minutes (.430 FG%, .373 3FG%, .855 FT%) ... The 6-1 guard, who averaged 26.2 points and 10.2 assists in 2022-23, is just the third player in NBA history to average at least 25.0 points and 10.0 assists in back-to-back seasons, joining Russell Westbrook (2016-18) and Oscar Robertson (1963-67).

■ Dejounte Murray finished the 2023-24 regular season averaging a career-best 22.5 points (25th in the NBA), in addition to 6.4 assists (second-highest in a single season in his career), 5.3 rebounds and 1.42 steals in 35.7 minutes (.459 FG%, .363 3FG%, .794 FT%) ... He is the only player in the East, and one of only two players in the NBA this season, to finish with at least 1,500 points (1,753), 500 assists (502) and 100 steals (111), joining Denver's Nikola Jokic ... Murray has recorded 100-or-more steals in each of his past five seasons, the only player in the NBA to do so.

■ Murray connected on a career-best 201 three-pointers during the 2023-24 regular season, the seventh-most in a single season in franchise history and tied for the 22nd-most in the league this season ... He owns 334 three-pointers in his Hawks career, the 15th-most in club history.

■ Bogdan Bogdanovic also buried a career-high from beyond the arc this season, knocking down 240 triples, the sixth-most in the NBA and the most in a single season in franchise history ... In his 405th career game on 1/12, Bogi buried his 1,000th career triple, doing so the ninth-fastest (in terms of games played) in NBA history ... Fellow teammate Trae Young also hit his 1,000th career three-pointer that game (third-youngest, seventh-fastest), becoming the first pair of teammates in NBA history to both record their 1,000th career triple in the same game.

■ Clint Capela pulled down a career-best 335 offensive rebounds this season, the most in the NBA and tied for the fifth-most in franchise history (Kevin Willis, 2x) ... Capela averaged a double-double of 11.5 points and 10.6 boards this season, his seventh-straight campaign averaging a double-double ... The Hawks big man is one of only three players in the NBA to average a double-double in each of the past seven seasons, joining Rudy Gobert (8) and Giannis Antetokounmpo (7).






VAMOS, TRAE!

In Atlanta's 120-119 win over the Orlando Magic in Mexico City on 11/9, **TRAE YOUNG** recorded a game-high 41 points and eight assists, in addition to four rebounds and a team-high tying three steals in 34 minutes of play...

- His 41 points tied the **MOST POINTS EVER SCORED IN A MEXICO GAME** (Luka Doncic, 2019)



- On October 21, 2021, the Hawks honored the legacy of former Atlanta Journal-Constitution Hawks beat writer Sekou Smith, who passed away on January 26, 2021, at the age of 48, by naming the redesigned media workroom at State Farm Arena to honor him. The Sekou Smith Press Room was unveiled to a group of Sekou's family and friends prior to the Hawks season opener on October 21, 2021. During the summer of 2021, the team also launched an annual Hawks-NBA Summer League internship in Smith's name. Each summer, a journalism, or multi-media student from a Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) school will be selected to serve as the Hawks' beat writer for NBA Summer League. Quin Snyder was named the 15th full-time head coach of the Atlanta Hawks on February 26, 2023.

Snyder served as head coach of the Utah Jazz from the 2014-15 to 2021-22 seasons, accumulating a 372-264 record (.585) and leading the Jazz to the playoffs in six of his eight seasons. Over his final six seasons (2016-17 to 2021-22), the Jazz compiled a 294-178 record, the third-highest winning percentage (.623) in the NBA and best in the Western Conference over that span. Utah started the 2020-21 season with a 23-5 record, earning Snyder the honor of being named the head coach of the 2021 Western Conference All-Star team, and finished the regular season with the best record in the NBA (52-20; .722) and the fifth-highest single-season winning percentage in franchise history. His 372 wins are the second-most in Jazz history behind only Jerry Sloan.

Snyder finished sixth in NBA Coach of the Year voting in 2017, second in 2018, eighth in 2019 and third in 2021. He is a four-time Western Conference Coach of the Month. He ranks in the Top Ten among active NBA head coaches in wins (382) and winning percentage (.581). The Jazz reached the playoffs in six consecutive seasons, advancing to the Western Conference Semifinals on three occasions (2017, 2018 and 2021).

Before his hiring by the Jazz in 2014-15, Snyder was an assistant coach with the Hawks during the 2013-14 season on Mike Budenholzer's staff.

Prior to joining the Hawks in 2013-14, Snyder worked as an assistant coach for CKSA Moscow (2012-13), the Los Angeles Lakers (2011-12) and Philadelphia 76ers (2010-11).

From 2007-10, Snyder was head coach of the Austin Toros (the NBA G League affiliate of the San Antonio Spurs), recording a 94-56 (.627) mark, while leading the Toros to three straight playoff appearances and the 2008 National Basketball Development League championship game. He was the 2008-09 D-League Coach of the Year.

Snyder began his head coaching career at the University of Missouri in 1999, where in seven seasons, he led the Tigers to a 128-96 (.571) record, and four NCAA Tournaments including an Elite Eight appearance. Prior to starting with Missouri, he served as a with assistant with the Los Angeles Clippers (1992-93) and at Duke (1995-99) under Mike Krzyzewski.

Snyder was named a McDonald's All-American at Mercer Island High School. He played in 136 games over four years (1985-89) at Duke University, reaching three Final Fours and earning Academic All-American honors in his senior season.

Snyder earned undergraduate degrees in philosophy and political science from Duke, later earning a Juris Doctor and M.B.A. from Duke as well. He is a native of Mercer Island, WA.
