Augustin** was selected by Charlotte with the ninth overall pick in the 2008 draft, spending his first four NBA seasons there from 2008-12... Charlotte G/F **Nicolas Batum** and Magic G **Evan Fournier** both compete for the French National Team, appearing together at the 2015 EuroBasket Games and the 2014 FIBA World Cup ... Orlando Head Coach **Steve Clifford** served as Hornets head coach from 2013-18... Clifford was 196-214 in 410 games with Charlotte ... Magic assistant coaches **Mike Batiste**, **Pat Delaney**, **Steve Hetzel** and **Bruce Kreuzer** all spent time on the Hornets coaching staff... Hornets G/F **Dwayne Bacon** and Orlando F **Jonathan Isaac** were teammates at Florida State during the 2016-17 season... **Bacon** is a native of Lakeland, Fla.

**December 31, 2018 at Spectrum Center** – The Hornets extended their winning streak over the Magic to 13 games as they rang in the New Year inside Spectrum Center Monday night. The victory also gave the Hornets their seventh straight over the Magic inside Spectrum Center. Kemba Walker led the way for the Hornets with 24 points, seven assists and three rebounds. Charlotte's bench would be the difference in the game as they combined for 61 points. Malik Monk was the high-man off the bench with 21 points, four assists and three rebounds. Aaron Gordon led Orlando with 14 points, eight rebounds and five assists. The loss dropped the Magic to (16-20) under former Hornets Coach Steve Clifford. The win moved Charlotte back to .500 on the season at (18-18).

The Hornets kept within striking distance all night, however they would ultimately come up short as the Wizards held on to win 130-126. All-Star point guard Kemba Walker exploded for 47 points, four rebounds and four assists but it would not be enough for Charlotte. Marvin Williams added 17 points, seven rebounds and three assists for the Hornets. Washington was led by Trevor Ariza, who finished the game with 24 points, nine assists and seven rebounds.

### ON A ROLL

Kemba Walker followed a historic 60-point performance against Philadelphia on 11/17 by dropping 43 points in his next appearance against the Celtics on 11/19. Walker is the first player in the NBA to score a combined 100 points over a two-game span since James Harden (12/20 – 12/22/17). This is the first time in his career Walker scored 40+ points in consecutive games.

### ELITE COMPANY

Walker's 43 points against Boston (11/19) came after he scored 60 points against Philadelphia (11/17) in the game prior. Walker is just the sixth player in NBA history to follow a 60-point performance with at least 40 points in the following game. The chart to the left shows the five other players to accomplish this feat (via ESPN Stats & Info).

### 60-POINT PERFORMANCE:

Hornets guard Kemba Walker tallied 60 points (21-34 FG, 6-14 3PT, 12-12 FT), seven rebounds, four assists and four steals versus Philadelphia on November 17, 2018. Below marks a list of the historical significance of his night:

- Walker's performance topped his own and the franchise's previous highest scoring performance of 52 points (set vs. UTA on Jan. 16, 2016). Walker holds the only two performances of 50 or more points in franchise history.
- The 60-point total marked the highest scoring performance in the NBA this season (previous high: 52 points by Klay Thompson 10/29/18 vs. CHI)
- Walker is only the sixth active player to score 60-or-more points in a game, joining LeBron James, James Harden, Klay Thompson, Carmelo Anthony and Devin Booker
- Walker joined Allen Iverson as the only two players 6-1 or shorter in NBA history to total 60 or more points in a single game.
- Walker's 21 field goals set a new career and franchise high for field goals made in a game (previous: 18 done multiple times)
- Walker joined a list of the following players to ever amass 20+ FGs, 10+ FTs and 5+ 3PT FG in a single game: Kobe Bryant, Carmelo Anthony, Klay Thompson, Kyrie Irving and Tracy McGrady.
- Walker joined a list of the following players to ever total 20+ FGs, 10+ FTs and be perfect from the FT line in the process: Carmelo Anthony, Allen Iverson, Kyrie Irving, Alex English, Michael Jordan, Larry Bird, Dave Bing and Adrian Dantley.
- Walker joined the following list of players to reach the 60 point mark in the last 20 years: Kobe Bryant, Shaquille O'Neal, Tracy McGrady, Gilbert Arenas, Carmelo Anthony, LeBron James, Klay Thompson, Devin Booker and James Harden.

### WALK THIS WAY

In the win over Boston on 11/19 Kemba Walker scored 43 points along with four rebounds, five assists and a steal. This was Walker's third 40+ point game of the season, tied for the fifth most in the NBA this season. Walker is averaging 25.2 points per game, which ranks fifth in the Eastern Conference and 12<sup>th</sup> among all players in the association this season.

## THE BUZZ

### **KILLER BEE**

In the loss to Indiana on 2/11 Kemba Walker combined for 34 points, nine rebounds and one assist. Walker has now recorded 18 games this season of at-least 30 points, which is tied for ninth in the NBA. Walker has now scored 30+ points in 5-straight games for the first time in his career, tying Glen Rice (1/14-1/24, 1997) for the longest streak in franchise history. Walker's streak ties Anthony Davis, Paul George and James Harden for the second longest streak of 30-point games in the NBA this season.

### **J-LAMBO**

In the Hornets loss to the Pacers on 2/11 Jeremy Lamb combined for 21 points, seven rebounds and two assists. This marked Lamb's tenth game of at-least 20 points this season, good for second most on the team behind only Kemba Walker. Lamb has scored 20+ points a career-high ten times in 53 appearances this season after recording five such games in 80 appearances a season ago.

### **INTER-ZELLER**

Hornets center Cody Zeller combined for 18 points, nine rebounds, one assist and one block in the loss to Indiana on 2/11. Zeller has recorded double-figures in four of his last seven games and 18 times in 37 appearances this season. Zeller had seven such games in 33 appearances a season ago.

### **SCORIN' HUSKIES**

In Charlotte's loss to Indiana on 2/11 Kemba Walker led the team with 34 points while Jeremy Lamb was the second-leading scorer for the Hornets with 21 points. Through 56 games the University of Connecticut products, Walker and Lamb, are leading the team in scoring, averaging 25.2 and 15.2 points per game, respectively. The pair played together at Connecticut and were teammates on the 2011 National Championship team.

### **AMONG THE TREES**

In the Hornets loss to Indiana on 2/11 Jeremy Lamb combined for 21 points, seven rebounds and two assists. Lamb is averaging 5.6 rebounds per game this season, which marks the highest number of his career. Lamb currently ranks tied for sixth amongst NBA guards in rebounds per game and tied for second (Oladipo, IND) in the Eastern Conference behind only Ben Simmons (9.1).

### **DIGGING DEEP**

In Charlotte's win over Atlanta on 2/9 Kemba Walker combined for 37 points, seven assists and one rebound. His 37 points came on 13-27 shooting from the field, including 9-17 from deep. Walker has now connected on at-least nine three point field goals three separate times since the beginning of the 2017-18 season, which marks the second most in the NBA over that span (Stephen Curry, 7).

### **STARTING STRONG**

In the win over Atlanta on 2/9 the Hornets scored 46 points in the first quarter while shooting 75% from the field and 72.7% from three. This marked the most points the Hornets have scored in any quarter this season and tied the franchise record for most points scored in a quarter on the road (3/22/91 at LAC). The Hornets also scored 106 points through the first three quarters, which marked the highest total through three quarters on the road in franchise history.

### **MARVIN THE MARKSMAN**

In Charlotte's win over Atlanta on 2/9 Marvin Williams recorded a season-high 27 points, three rebounds and one steal. His 27 points came on 12-16 shooting, including 3-7 from deep. Williams has made 100-or-more threes in each of his last four seasons, joining Dell Curry and Kemba Walker as the only Charlotte players to have four-straight 100-plus three-point seasons. Williams is making 2.0 three pointers per game this season, good for the highest mark of his career.

### **HEAD OF THE HIVE**

In the loss to Dallas on 2/6 Kemba Walker combined for 30 points, 11 rebounds and six assists. Walker has now recorded nine games this season with at least 30 points, five rebounds and five assists. Only Harden, Antetokounmpo and Durant have more such games this season.

### **CRASH THE BOARDS**

In Charlotte's loss to Dallas on 2/6 Cody Zeller combined for 13 rebounds, nine points, one assist and one steal. This follows an 11 rebound and six-point performance vs. LAC on 2/5. This is the first time Zeller has recorded double-digit rebounds in consecutive games since January 6-9 of the 2015-16 season. Zeller is averaging a career high in rebounds per game this season with 6.6 (prev: 6.5, 2016-17).

### **TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK**

In Charlotte's loss to the Clippers on 2/5, Charlotte had only five turnovers, a season low for turnovers (prev: 7, multiple times). Charlotte is averaging just 12.6 turnovers this season, which is good for the second-fewest per game in the league (San Antonio, 12.5). Charlotte has finished in the top three teams with fewest turnovers every season since 2013-14.



## THE BUZZ

### **STAT SHEET STUFFER**

In Charlotte's win over Chicago on 2/2 Kemba Walker combined for 37 points, 10 assists, six rebounds, one steal and zero turnovers. Walker joins Western Conference All-Star Nikola Jokic as the only players this season to record a game of at-least 35 points, 10 assists and five rebounds without having a single turnover. Walker followed this game with a 32-point, nine-assist and zero-turnover performance against LAC on 2/5. This is just the sixth time Walker has had consecutive games without turning the ball over (min. 15 minutes played).

### **COMEBACK KIDS**

In Charlotte's win over the Bulls on 2/2, the Hornets overcame a 15-point deficit and completed their largest comeback win of the season. The Hornets entered halftime down by nine before putting up a season-high 74 points in the second half, as they outscored the Bulls by 16 in the final 24 minutes. Kemba Walker scored 25 points in the second half while connecting on eight of his 12 field goal attempts to lead the comeback for Charlotte.

### **HOME SWEET HOME**

The Hornets win over the Bulls on 2/2 marked the fifth consecutive victory for Charlotte inside Spectrum Center (1/17 – 2/2). This marked the first time the Hornets have won five straight home games since 2016 (12/7-12/29). At 19-9 the Hornets own the sixth-best home record in the Eastern Conference and the 13<sup>th</sup> best in the NBA.

### **UPTOWN MONK**

In Charlotte's win over Chicago on 2/2 Malik Monk scored 18 points off the bench, with 14 of his points coming in the second half. Monk has scored ten-or-more points in 26 of his 53 appearances, including five of his last ten games played. Monk recorded 16 such games in 63 appearances in 2017-18. Monk has made at-least one three pointer in 39 of his 53 appearances as a reserve this season, good for the fourth-most in the Eastern Conference and tied for the tenth-most in the NBA.

### **700(0) CLUB**

Tony Parker scored 15 points along with seven assist in the 2/1 win over the Grizzlies. This outing brought his career assist total to 7,003. Parker became just the second international player to total 7,000 career assists and the 17<sup>th</sup> player in NBA history to reach this milestone.

### **BOARDING BATUM**

In Charlotte's win over Memphis on 2/1 Hornets forward Nic Batum scored seven points along with ten rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks. Batum's ten-rebound game marked his best rebounding performance since he had ten against Philadelphia on October 27, 2018.

### **TRES MAGNIFIQUE**

In Charlotte's victory over Memphis on 2/1 Tony Parker scored 15 points along with seven assists. Parker has scored ten-or-more points in five of his last seven appearances and 22 games in 45 appearances this season. He had 21 such games in the entire 2017-18 season.

### **STARRY EYED**

On Jan. 21, 2019 Kemba Walker was selected as an Eastern Conference All-Star for the third consecutive year and his first as a starter. Walker finished third in fan voting and was selected by his peers and the media as a starter. Walker is the seventh player to represent Charlotte in the NBA All-Star game and just the second to do so three times, joining Glen Rice (1996, 1997 and 1998). This year's game will be hosted in Charlotte, giving Walker his first start in his city.



### **BENCH SWARMERS**

In the Hornets' 101-92 win over the Knicks on 1/28 the Charlotte bench combined for 53 points, 25 rebounds and 12 assists. Charlotte's second unit is currently averaging 42.9 points per game, good for the seventh-highest bench average in the league this season. The Hornets bench is ranked sixth in assists (9.2), tied for eighth in blocks (2.2) and is ranked 12<sup>th</sup> in rebounds (17.3) per game.

### **KILLER THR33S**

In the Hornet's loss the Knicks on 12/14 Charlotte connected on 20 three-point baskets, tying a franchise record (last: vs. SAC, 1/25/16). Charlotte connected on 104 three-point field goals through the first eight games of the season, which ties for the second most three-point baskets through eight games in NBA history (prev: 107, Golden State, 2017-18; 104, Golden State, 2018-19). The Hornets are averaging 11.9 three-point field goals per game, good for eighth most in the NBA this season.

### **EVEN KEEL**

The Hornets defeated the Knicks on 1/28 thanks to even scoring and ball movement. Charlotte had 25 assisted baskets in the win compared to just 19 by the Suns. Led by Jeremy Lamb and Tony Parker with 15 points each Charlotte had a total of six players score 10-or-more points. Joining Parker and Lamb were Walker (14), Bridges (11), Monk (14) and Hernangomez (11).

## THE BUZZ

### DOUBLE TROUBLE

In Charlotte's win over Phoenix on 1/19 Bismack Biyombo scored 11 points along with a season-high 13 rebounds and a season-high tying five blocks and recorded his second double double of the season. Fellow center Willy Hernangomez also grabbed 13 boards in the win. This was the first time two Hornets players recorded 10-or-more rebounds in one game since Nicolas Batum and Dwight Howard did so against Phoenix on 3/10/18.

### CARDIAC KEMBA

In Charlotte's loss at Sacramento on 1/12 Hornets captain Kemba Walker scored 31 points along with four assists. Nine of Walker's 31 points came in the fourth quarter. Walker is averaging 7.9 points in the fourth quarter this season, the highest fourth-quarter average in the Eastern Conference. The league leaders in this category are listed in the chart to the right.

### WILD WILL

In Charlotte's defeat of New York on 1/28 reserve center Willy Hernangomez scored 11 points along with 11 rebounds. This marked his third double-double of the season and his third game in six appearances with at-least ten rebounds (16 vs. SAC, 1/17 and 13 vs. PHX, 1/19).

### THREES IN FOUR

In the 12/29 loss to the Wizards, Kemba Walker's 47 points came on 18-29 shooting, including 6-9 from beyond the arc. Walker shot 9-13 from the field, going a perfect 4-4 from deep in the final quarter of the game. Through 56 games Walker has totaled an Eastern Conference-leading 54 fourth quarter three-point field goals, second in the NBA to only James Harden. League leaders are illustrated in the chart to the left. Hornets sophomore Malik Monk has also cracked the top ten in this category.

### DISCIPLINED ON 'D'

In the 1/14 victory over the San Antonio Spurs, the Hornets limited the Spurs to only 12 trips to the free throw line. Through 55 games the Hornets have been one of the most-disciplined teams in the NBA, giving up just 20.6 free throws per game. Only Indiana allows teams to get to the line at a lower rate. The Hornets have finished ranked in the top five of free throws allowed in each year dating back to 2014.

### CAPTAIN CLUTCH

In the 12/29 loss to the Wizards, Kemba Walker scored 18 of his 47 points during "clutch time." The NBA defines clutch time as the last five minutes of the fourth quarter or overtime when the game is within five points or less. Walker is averaging 5.0 points per game in clutch time this season, good for the third highest average in the NBA. The league leaders in this category are listed in the chart to the right.

### IN LIKE A LAMB

In the Hornets 135-115 defeat of the Suns on 1/19 Jeremy Lamb finished with 18 points, five rebounds and a season-high six assists. His 18 points came on 6-9 shooting, including a career-high tying 5-7 from beyond the arc. Through 53 games Lamb is averaging the most steals (1.0) and rebounds (5.6) of his career, while his 15.2 points per game is the highest of his career and the second highest on the team behind Kemba Walker.

### 40 POINT FLURRY

Including his 47-point performance at Washington on 12/29, Kemba Walker has scored 40-or-more points in four games through 56 appearances in the 2018-19 season. He is tied for sixth-most 40-point games in the league this season. Walker finished the 2017-18 season with five games in which he scored 40-or-more points, good for third most in the NBA. Walker holds the franchise record for most 40-point games with 12 (prev: 10, Rice).

### WALK THE WALK

In the Hornets' defeat of the Pistons on 12/12 Kemba Walker stuffed the stat sheet with 31 points, eight rebounds, nine assists, one steal and one block. Through 56 games played this season Walker is averaging career highs in each of the following categories:

- Points per game: 25.2 (prev: 23.2, 2016-17)
- Three-pointers made per game: 3.3 (prev: 3.0, 2016-17)
- Field goals made per game: 8.7 (prev: 8.1, 2016-17)

### KEMBA'S 20-POINT PUSH

Hornets guard Kemba Walker had 50 games in 2017-18 of 20+ points through his 80 games played. Walker is the first player in franchise history to reach 200 career games with 20-or-more points. Walker scored at least twenty points in each of his first seven outings in the 2018-19 season, the first player in franchise history to do so.

### FAB FIVE

Kemba Walker recorded 22 points on 9-17 shooting, including 4-9 from deep in the win over Detroit on 12/21. Walker has 107 three-point baskets this season, good for fourth-most in the NBA. Since the start of the 2015-16 season Walker has tallied 840 three-point field goals; only Stephen Curry, Klay Thompson, James Harden, and Paul George have more in that span.

### K3MBA WALK3R

Kemba Walker scored 39 points on 14-31 shooting, including 7-15 from beyond the arc in the win over Miami on 10/20. Walker joins Dell Curry as the only two players in franchise history to make five-or-more three pointers in three consecutive games. Walker connected on 21 threes through four games, tying the NBA record for most three-point baskets through four games (GSW, Curry, 15-16) and setting a new franchise record for as many threes through four games (prev: 14, D. Curry, 94-95). After 56 games in 2018-19 season Walker ranks first in the Eastern Conference and is fifth in the league in total three-point baskets made.

# KEMBA WALKER: KING OF THE QUEEN CITY

## **ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER**

After tallying 21 points against the Cavaliers on 3/28, Kemba Walker became the franchise's all-time leading scorer with 9,841 career points, passing Dell Curry's 9,839 points. Curry held the record for 9,491 days.

## **CAREER THREE-POINTERS**

With 2 made three-pointers against the Phoenix Suns on 2/4, Kemba Walker became the franchise's all-time leader for three-point field goals made with 930, passing Dell Curry who had 929 in his ten-years in Charlotte. Walker currently sits at 1,210 three-point field goals. This came days after Walker set a franchise record for three-pointers made in a game when he recorded 9 on 13 attempts at Atlanta on 1/31

## **CAREER FREE THROWS**

On 3/28, Kemba Walker recorded five made free throws on five attempts, bringing his career total to 2,003, setting a new franchise record for career free throws. His first made free throw of the night brought him to 1,999 breaking Gerald Wallace's record of 1,998. Walker's record currently sits at 2,269 career free throws.

## **SINGLE GAME THREE-POINTERS**

In the Hornets win over Memphis on 3/22, Kemba Walker recorded 46 points on 13-18 shooting from the field, including 10 three-point field goals on 14 attempts. Walker's 10 made three-pointers set a new franchise record for most three-point field goals in a single game, breaking his own previous record of 9 (at ATL, 1/31/18). Walker joined Golden State's Curry as the only players in the league to record 10 three-point field goals in a single game last season.

## **30-POINT GAMES**

With his 46 points against Memphis on 3/22, Kemba Walker recorded his 55<sup>th</sup> career game with 30-or-more points, the most ever recorded by a Charlotte player, breaking Glen Rice's record of 54 such games. Walker currently has 70 such games in his eight-year career. Walker has recorded 18 games this season in which he scored 30-or-more points, which is tied for eighth-most in the NBA. He has logged at least ten such games in each of the last three seasons, compared to recording five or fewer such games in each of his first four seasons.

## **20-POINT GAMES**

In Charlotte's defeat of Milwaukee on 11/1/17, Kemba Walker scored 26 points on 8-12 shooting, including 3-4 from three-point range and a perfect 7-7 from the free-throw line. This was Walker's sixth 20-plus point outing of the season and the 193<sup>rd</sup> of his career, setting a new franchise record of 20-point games. He passed Larry Johnson, who held the record with 192. Walker currently has 278 career games with 20-or-more points and 41 this season. Walker has had 50-or more such games in each of the last two seasons.

## **FREE-THROW STREAK**

Kemba Walker entered the 3/28 game against Cleveland riding a streak of 43-consecutive free throws. Walker had previously made 43-straight free throws in 2016-17, as well as Dell Curry (done twice) and D.J. Augustin for the franchise's longest free-throw streak. With his first made free throw of the night, Walker became the only player in Charlotte history to make 44 straight, and extended his streak to 48 by the night's end. The seventh year pro connected on 53-straight free throw from 3/10 at Phoenix – 4/1 vs. Philadelphia before missing a shot from the line. Walker's streak was the fifth-most consecutive free throws made in the league this season.

## **40-POINT GAMES**

Kemba Walker recorded his 11<sup>th</sup> career game with 40-or-more points on 11/17/18, when he scored 60 against the Philadelphia 76ers, surpassing Glen Rice for the most 40-plus point games in a Charlotte uniform.

## **OPENING NIGHT**

In Charlotte's season-opening loss to Milwaukee on 10/17, Kemba Walker scored 41 points on 15-29 shooting, including 7-13 from beyond the arc. Walker's 41 points set a new franchise record for most points scored in a season-opening game, passing Dell Curry's previous record of 38 (11/2/96).

## **SINGLE GAME SCORING**

Kemba Walker recorded 60 points on 21-34 shooting, including 6-14 from three and a perfect 12-12 from the line in the Hornets loss to Philadelphia on 11/17/18. Walker broke his own previous record of 52 (vs. UTA, 1/18/16) for most points scored in a single game.

## **FIELD GOALS MADE**

In the Hornets' loss to Philadelphia on 11/17/18, Walker scored 60 points on 21-34 shooting from the field, a new franchise record for field goals made in a single game.

## **FOURTH QUARTER POINTS**

In Charlotte's loss to Washington on 12/29/18, Walker scored 47 points including 24 in the fourth quarter alone. This set a new record for fourth-quarter points for the franchise. The previous high was 21 points, done multiple times by Walker, Baron Davis and David Wesley.

- During his tenure, San Diego captured the West Coast Conference Championship and earned a trip to the NCAA Tournament in the 2002-2003 season
- Began his collegiate coaching career at his alma mater, University of San Diego, as an assistant coach from 2001 to 2003
