November 9, 2018 at Wells Fargo Center – The Hornets and Sixers would need more than 48 minutes Friday night to decide the game, after the teams were knotted at 119-119 after four quarters. The Hornets would rally from a 15-point halftime deficit behind 19 second half points from Kemba Walker to force overtime. But the second half surge would not be enough as the Sixers held on to beat the Hornets 133-132 behind a game-high 42 points and 18 rebounds from Joel Embiid. Ben Simmons also collected a double-double for the Sixers, combining for 22 points and 13 assists. JJ Redick chipped in 17 points off the bench for the Sixers. The Hornets were led by Kemba Walker who finished the game with a team-high 30 points and nine assists, while bringing down seven rebounds. Michael Kidd-Gilchrist combined for a double-double off the bench with 12 points and 12 rebounds for the Hornets. The victory gave the Sixers eight consecutive victories over Charlotte.

PAR(KER) LES VOUS FRANCAIS

The Charlotte Hornets signed six-time all-star, four-time NBA Champion and 2007 NBA Finals MVP Tony Parker as a free agent on July 23, 2018. The 17-year NBA veteran holds career averages of 15.8 points, 5.7 assists and 2.8 rebounds per game in 1,198 regular-season contests. The French native joins the Hornets as one of only four players in NBA history to total 4,000 or more points and 1,000 or more assists in the postseason (Michael Jordan, Kobe Bryant and LeBron James). Parker has played in the 2012 and 2016 Olympics for Team France and won a 2013 FIBA Eurobasket Gold Medal alongside fellow Charlotte teammate Nicolas Batum.

THE EXTRA MILES

The Hornets acquired the draft rights to the 12th overall pick in the 2018 NBA Draft, Miles Bridges in a draft night trade. The 6-7 forward from Michigan State was a unanimous 2017-18 All-Big Ten First Team selection and he also earned 2017-18 consensus Second Team All-American honors. Bridges led Michigan State in scoring in scoring (17.0 ppg), ranked second in rebounding (7.0 rpg) and third in assists (2.7 apg) during the 2017-18 campaign.

BIS-BACK BIYOMBO

Charlotte acquired Bismack Biyombo from Orlando on July 8, 2018 as part of a three-team trade. Biyombo played in all 82 regular-season games with Orlando last season (25 starts), averaging 5.7 points, 5.7 rebounds and a team-high 1.2 blocks in 18.2 minutes per contest. With 95 blocked shots in 2017-18, he ranked 19th in the NBA. The seventh-year center began his NBA career in Charlotte after being selected by Sacramento in the 2011 NBA draft and sent to Charlotte in a draft night trade. Biyombo spent four years in Charlotte and remains fifth in Hornets history in career blocks (443) and blocks per game (1.6), and ranks seventh in career offensive rebounds (571).

S'MORE GRAHAM?

The Hornets acquired Devonte' Graham, the 34th overall pick in the 2018 NBA Draft, from the Atlanta Hawks on draft night. The four-year Kansas player earned Big 12 Player of the Year and consensus First Team All-American honors after averaging 17.3 points, 7.2 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals in 37.8 minutes in 39 games played in the 2017-18 season. Graham He led the Big 12 and ranked ninth nationally in minutes played, ranked second in the Big 12 and sixth nationally in assists, ranked second in the Big 12 in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.6) and ranked third in the Big 12 in scoring. The Raleigh native set school single-season records for total assists (282) and minutes played (1,474), and was a finalist for the Naismith Trophy, Wooden Award and Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award after a season in which he was the only player in NCAA Division I to average at least 17.0 points, 7.0 assists and 1.6 steals with fewer than 3.0 turnovers per game.

THE BUZZ

STICKY FINGERS

The Hornets recorded 12 steals at Cleveland on 11/13, the most steals by the Hornets since they had 14 vs. Memphis on 3/2/18. Through 14 games the Hornets have forced 15.6 turnovers per game, good for the tenth in the NBA. The Hornets currently rank fifth in the NBA with 290 points scored off turnovers through 14 games.

J-LAMBO

In Charlotte's loss to Cleveland on 11/13 Jeremy Lamb combined for a season-high 22 points, six rebounds and three steals. Through 14 games Lamb is shooting 39.2% from three, which marks the highest percentage of his career. Lamb is currently averaging the most steals (1.4) and rebounds (4.6) of his career, while his 12.9 points per game is tied for the highest of his career (2017-18) and is the second highest on the team behind Kemba Walker.

TWENTY-POINT TONY PARKER

In the Hornets win over Detroit on 11/11, Tony Parker scored 24 points on 11-18 shooting, including going 2-2 from beyond the arc. Parker brought down three rebounds and dished four assists in the win. This is the second time in 12 appearances Parker has scored 20-or-more points this season, the most 20-point games he has had through his first 12 appearances since 2014-15. Parker has recorded six games with 10-or-more points this season, after having 21 such games in 55 contests in the 2017-18 season.

GRAHAM IN GREENSBORO

Rookie guard Devonte' Graham has played three games while assigned to the Greensboro Swarm, Charlotte's G League affiliate. Leading the Swarm to a 3-0 start this season Graham averaged 28.3 points, 6.0 rebounds and 6.3 assists in 34.7 minutes per game, including a career-high 38-point performance in the win over Grand Rapids on 11/10. The Kansas product is shooting 50% from the field and 42.9% from deep in the G League.

SPACE AND PACE

Through 14 games the Hornets are averaging 24.9 assists per game, good for eighth most in the league. Charlotte finished the 2017-18 season ranked 24th averaged 21.6 assists per game. The Hornets have totaled 349 assists through 14 games, good for 11th most in the league this season. Charlotte has an assist to turnover ratio of 1.98, which ranks first in the NBA. The Hornets are averaging 114.6 points per game, good for eighth most in the league this season.

FAB FIVE

Kemba Walker recorded 24 points on 9-17 shooting, including 2-5 from deep in the win over Detroit on 11/11. Walker has 52 three-point baskets this season, trailing only Golden State's Stephen Curry. Since the start of the 2015-16 season Walker has tallied 705 three-point field goals; only Stephen Curry, Klay Thompson, James Harden and Damian Lillard have more in that span.

TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK

In Charlotte's loss at Philadelphia on 11/9 the Hornets had only seven turnovers compared to 17 by the 76ers. Charlotte is averaging just 12.6 turnovers this season, second fewest per game in the league (12.1, San Antonio). Charlotte has finished in the top three teams with fewest turnovers every season since 2013-14.

"PUT ME IN COACH"

The Charlotte Hornets' reserves combined for 63 points, 32 rebounds, 12 assists and four blocks in the loss to Philadelphia on 11/9. The Hornets' bench has scored 682 points through 14 games, good for third most in the NBA. Charlotte's second unit is currently averaging 48.7 points per game compared to 38.9 points per game in 2017-18, and good for third most in the league. The Hornets bench is first in the NBA in blocks (3.3) and is tied for first in assists (10.6) per game.

HIVE HUSTLE

According to NBA.com Hornets players rank in the top 20 for the following hustle stats:

- Kemba Walker has drawn seven charges through 14 games played this season which is tied for second (Lowry, 9) in the NBA.
- Walker has recovered 26 loose balls in 2018-19, tied for fifth most in the league.
- Cody Zeller is averaging 4.2 screen assists per game, tied for ninth most in the league this year.
- Walker has taken 57 contested three-point shots, tied for tenth most in the association.
- Jeremy Lamb has taken 54 contested three-point shots, 17th most in the league.

NETTING OUT

The Hornets currently have a net rating of +5.0, which ranks sixth in the league after 14 games. Charlotte has an offensive rating of 112.9, good for fifth best in the NBA. Charlotte finished the 2017-18 season with an offensive rating of 108.9 and ranked ninth in the league. Charlotte has a defensive rating of 107.9 and is 14th in the league, after finishing the 2017-18 season ranked 17th with a 108.9 defensive rating.

THE BUZZ

UPTOWN MONK

In the loss to the 76ers on 11/9 Malik Monk scored 12 points along with three rebounds and four assists. Monk has scored 10-or-more points in 10 of 14 outings this season, compared to scoring as many points in 16 of 63 games played in 2017-18. This follows a 20-point performance from Monk on 10/30 in the win against MIA and a 21-point performance against Oklahoma City on 11/1. This marked only the second time in his career that he has scored 20-or-more points in consecutive games (3, 4/3/18 – 4/8/18).

THE KIDD IS ALRIGHT

In the Hornets' loss at Philadelphia on 11/9 Michael Kidd-Gilchrist scored 12 points and brought down 12 rebounds along with two assists. This is Kidd-Gilchrist's first double-double since he recorded 15 points and ten rebounds against NYK on 12/18/17.

NIC-KEL AND DIMING

In the win over Cleveland on 11/3 Nic Batum combined for nine points, eight rebounds and eight assists, bringing his Charlotte career assist total to 1,249, passing D.J. Augustin (1,248) for the ninth most assist in franchise history. Through 14 games Batum has dished out 53 assists, which is good for 14th most among NBA forwards.

MARVELOUS MARVIN

In the Hornets' win over Atlanta on 11/6 Marvin Williams connected on three of six three-point field goals, bringing his Charlotte career total to 508. Williams is now tied with Glen Rice for the third-most three-pointers in franchise history behind only Dell Curry (929) and Kemba Walker (1075). In Charlotte's win over CLE on 11/3 Williams collected seven points and three rebounds, bringing his career total to 5,001; making Williams one of only nine active players in the NBA with 5,000 rebounds and 850 three-pointers.

SEEING DOUBLE

In Charlotte's defeat of Miami on 10/30, Tony Parker recorded 24 points and 11 rebounds, good for his first double-double since March 17, 2016. Parker is the first Hornets player to record a points-assists double-double off the bench since Mo Williams (3/27/15 at WAS) and only the fourth player in franchise history to have a 20-point and 10-assist game off the bench.

INTERNATIONAL INCIDENT

Tony Parker had a season-high 24 points, 11 assists and one rebound off the bench in the Hornets' win over Miami on 10/30. Parker's 24 points brought his career points total to 19,009. He is only the seventh international-born player to reach this milestone in NBA history (Dirk Nowitzki, Hakeem Olajuwon, Dominique Wilkins, Tim Duncan, Patrick Ewing, Pau Gasol)

KILLER THR33S

Charlotte connected on 104 three-point field goals through the first eight games of the season, which ties for the second most three-point baskets through eight games in NBA history (prev: 107, Golden State, 2017-18; 104, Golden State, 2018-19). The Hornets have totaled 173 three-point field goals through 14 games, eighth most in the NBA this season.

SECOND STING

Hornets' guard Tony Parker collected 12 points and four rebounds off the bench in the victory over Cleveland on 11/3. This marked the fifth straight game in which Parker recorded 10-or-more points. This is the longest streak of such games he has had since a string of six games from 12/25/16 – 1/5/17. Parker leads the second unit for the Hornets which currently is tied for first in the NBA with 10.6 assists per game (LA Clippers). Parker's 4.2 assists per game is his highest assists per game average since 2016-17.

10K. WALKER

In Charlotte's win over Miami on 10/20 Kemba Walker scored his 10,000th career point, becoming the franchise's first player to reach this milestone and the second player in his 2011 draft class to reach the benchmark. Golden State's Klay Thompson has 10,653 career points while Boston's Kyrie Irving has the third-highest career points total in this draft class with 9,967. Walker is one of only eight active players to have more than 10,000 career points with the team that drafted him.

K3MBA WALK3R

Kemba Walker scored 39 points on 14-31 shooting, including 7-15 from beyond the arc in the win over Miami on 10/20. Walker joins Dell Curry as the only two players in franchise history to make five-or-more three pointers in three consecutive games. Walker connected on 21 threes through four games, tying the NBA record for most three-point baskets through four games (GSW, Curry, 15-16) and setting a new franchise record for as many threes through four games (prev: 14, D. Curry, 94-95). After 14 games in 2018-19 season Walker has totaled the second-most three-point baskets in the league.

THE BUZZ

MARVIN THE MARKSMAN

In the Hornets' win over Orlando on 10/19 Marvin Williams made two three-point field goals, bringing his Charlotte career total to 500. Williams becomes just the fourth player to reach 500 three-pointers made in franchise history, joining Kemba Walker, Dell Curry and Glen Rice. Williams has made 514 such baskets in his 4+ seasons in Charlotte, despite making just 353 baskets from deep in his previous 10 seasons in the league.

STARTIN' OFF STRONG

In Charlotte's season-opening loss to Milwaukee on 10/17, Kemba Walker scored 41 points on 15-29 shooting, including 7-13 from beyond the arc. Walker joins Golden State's Stephen Curry as the only player in NBA history to score 40-or-more points and make 5-or-more three-point baskets in a season opener – Curry posted 40 points on 5-12 shooting from deep on 10/27/15. Walker's 41 points set a new franchise record for most points scored in a season-opening game, passing Dell Curry's previous record of 38 (11/2/96).

KEMBA'S 20-POINT PUSH

Hornets guard Kemba Walker had 50 games in 2017-18 of 20+ points through his 80 games played. Walker is the first player in franchise history to reach 200 career games with 20-or-more points. Walker scored at least twenty points in each of his first seven outings in the 2018-19 season, the first player in franchise history to do so.

MAGIC TOUCH

With the 120-88 win over Orlando on 10/19, Charlotte extended its win streak over the Magic to twelve straight games dating back to January 22, 2016. This is a new franchise record for longest winning streak over one opponent. Previously, the Hornets won 11-straight games over Detroit from 4/16/93 – 11/7/95.

KEMBA WALKER: KING OF THE QUEEN CITY

ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER

After tallying 21 points against the Cavaliers on 3/28, Kemba Walker became the franchise's all-time leading scorer with 9,841 career points, passing Dell Curry's 9,839 points. Curry held the record for 9,491 days.

CAREER THREE-POINTERS

With 2 made three-pointers against the Phoenix Suns on 2/4, Kemba Walker became the franchise's all-time leader for three-point field goals made with 930, passing Dell Curry who had 929 in his ten-years in Charlotte. Walker currently sits at 1,075 three-point field goals. This came days after Walker set a franchise record for three-pointers made in a game when he recorded 9 on 13 attempts at Atlanta on 1/31

CAREER FREE THROWS

On 3/28, Kemba Walker recorded five made free throws on five attempts, bringing his career total to 2,003, setting a new franchise record for career free throws. His first made free throw of the night brought him to 1,999 breaking Gerald Wallace's record of 1,998. Walker's record currently sits at 2,069 career free throws.

SINGLE GAME THREE-POINTERS

In the Hornets win over Memphis on 3/22, Kemba Walker recorded 46 points on 13-18 shooting from the field, including 10 three-point field goals on 14 attempts. Walker's 10 made three-pointers set a new franchise record for most three-point field goals in a single game, breaking his own previous record of 9 (at ATL, 1/31/18). Walker joined Golden State's Curry as the only players in the league to record 10 three-point field goals in a single game last season.

30-POINT GAMES

With his 46 points against Memphis on 3/22, Kemba Walker recorded his 55th career game with 30-or-more points, the most ever recorded by a Charlotte player, breaking Glen Rice's record of 54 such games. Walker currently has 60 such games in his eight-year career. Walker has recorded five games this season in which he scored 30-or-more points, which is the fifth most in the NBA. He has logged at least ten such games in each of the last three seasons, compared to recording five or fewer such games in each of his first four seasons.

20-POINT GAMES

In Charlotte's defeat of Milwaukee on 11/1/17, Kemba Walker scored 26 points on 8-12 shooting, including 3-4 from three-point range and a perfect 7-7 from the free-throw line. This was Walker's sixth 20-plus point outing of the season and the 193rd of his career, setting a new franchise record of 20-point games. He passed Larry Johnson, who held the record with 192. Walker currently has 248 career games with 20-or-more points and 11 this season. Walker has had 50-or more such games in each of the last two seasons.

FREE-THROW STREAK

Kemba Walker entered the 3/28 game against Cleveland riding a streak of 43-consecutive free throws. Walker had previously made 43-straight free throws in 2016-17, as well as Dell Curry (done twice) and D.J. Augustin for the franchise's longest free-throw streak. With his first made free throw of the night, Walker became the only player in Charlotte history to make 44 straight, and extended his streak to 48 by the night's end. The seventh year pro connected on 53-straight free throw from 3/10 at Phoenix – 4/1 vs. Philadelphia before missing a shot from the line. Walker's streak was the fifth-most consecutive free throws made in the league this season.

40-POINT GAMES

Kemba Walker recorded his 10th career game with 40-or-more points on 10/17/18, when he scored 41 against the Milwaukee Bucks, tying Glen Rice for the most 40-plus point games in a Charlotte uniform.

OPENING NIGHT

In Charlotte's season-opening loss to Milwaukee on 10/17, Kemba Walker scored 41 points on 15-29 shooting, including 7-13 from beyond the arc. Walker's 41 points set a new franchise record for most points scored in a season-opening game, passing Dell Curry's previous record of 38 (11/2/96).
