**LAST GAME:** Utah battled back and forth with Minnesota in the teams' second matchup in three days, but was unable to keep pace late—falling 114-104 on Monday at Delta Center. **Collin Sexton** came off the bench for the second consecutive game and scored a team-high 24 points, while **Lauri Markkanen** returned after missing six straight games due to injury and recorded his 19th double-double of the season with 22 points and 12 rebounds.

**GEORGE SURGING ON OFFENSIVE END:** **Keyonte George** has produced at a high level recently on the offensive end—averaging 19.4 points and 5.3 assists over his last 12 games (includes March 4 vs. WAS; left due to injury after five minutes). Over his last 13 games, George has been especially on target from beyond the arc—making 41 of 95 (.432) 3-point attempts dating to Feb. 14.

**SEXTON SCORING AT ELITE RATE:** Among all NBA players this season averaging less than 30 minutes per game, **Collin Sexton** ranks third in scoring—averaging 18.4 points per game in 25.8 minutes per game (trailing only **Victor Wembanyama** and **Kristaps Porzingis**).

**THE MATCHUP:** Wednesday marks this season's fourth and final regular season meeting between the Jazz and Thunder. Utah snapped a five-game losing streak to Oklahoma City on Feb. 6 in Salt Lake City.

## CLARKSON ENDS JAZZ TRIPLE-DOUBLE DROUGHT

- With his 20-point, 11-assist, 10-rebound triple-double during the win over Dallas on Jan. 1, **Jordan Clarkson** ended a nearly 16-year span between triple-doubles in Jazz history, which was also the longest active drought in the NBA.
- Clarkson's triple-double was the first by a Jazz player since **Carlos Boozer** on Feb. 13, 2008—a span of 1,256 Jazz regular season games and 5,801 total days.
- Overall, Clarkson's triple-double was the 25th in Jazz history and only third by a player who came off the bench.

## THIS WEEK IN JAZZ HISTORY

- The 2023-24 season marks the 50th season of Jazz basketball. A look back at some of the franchise's notable moments that occurred this week on the calendar over the past half century:
- **March 18, 2001:** **Jerry Sloan** of the Utah Jazz coached his 1,000th game as the team's head coach, becoming only the sixth coach in NBA history to coach 1,000 games with the same team. Sloan joined Hall of Famers **Red Auerbach** and **Red Holzman** as well as **Gene Shue**, **John MacLeod** and **Al Attles**.
- **March 19, 1997:** **John Stockton** recorded his 2,500th career steal in a win over the Celtics—becoming the first player in NBA history to record 2,500 career steals.
- **March 19, 2002:** **Karl Malone** became the third player in NBA history to log 50,000 career minutes, surpassing **Elvin Hayes** (50,000), and trailing only **Kareem Abdul-Jabbar** (57,446).
- **March 20, 1998:** **Karl Malone** moved past **Elvin Hayes** (27,313) for fifth place on the NBA's all-time scoring list.

## 2023-24 COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

### COMMUNITY OBSESSED

We embrace our role as stewards within the community and are committed to providing impactful, world-class experiences that engender loyalty to the Utah Jazz.

### MAIN SEASON INITIATIVES

This season the Utah Jazz will highlight six major season initiatives. Each initiative will have unique programming in the community and at the arena. Those six initiatives are: Hispanic Heritage, Civic Engagement, MLK Jr. Day, Black History Month, Women's History Month, and Pride. Details will be released ahead of each initiative's launch.

### 50TH ANNIVERSARY COMMUNITY ACTIVATIONS

In a nod to their shared commitment to community, the Jazz and Delta are reconstructing and updating the 20-year-old basketball court at Liberty Park, which is located less than three miles southeast of Delta Center. Opened in late October, the basketball court will be a year-round resource for youth, families, community members, and visitors featuring a new perimeter fence, seating area, and gathering space.

The Jazz and Delta will also host 10 free-to-attend basketball clinics for youth from historically underserved communities. About 50 youth aged seven to 15 will be invited to participate in each clinic, which will take place at either Zions Bank Basketball Campus, the training facility of the Utah Jazz, or at the training facility of the Salt Lake City Stars, the NBA G League affiliate of the Jazz.

The Utah Jazz will also organize several acts of service to give back to the community. For instance, in November, the Jazz cleared classroom wish lists for teachers at high-need schools in Utah. In the following months, the Jazz will focus these acts on military families and holiday giving.

## JAZZ+ MAKES ITS DEBUT THIS SEASON

- **Scott Morrison**, head coach of the Stars last season, is now on staff with the Jazz as an assistant coach. The Stars finished last season fourth in the G League's Western Conference with a 20-12 record.

# WILL HARDY



## Will Hardy, Utah Jazz Head Coach

Will Hardy enters his second season as head coach of the Utah Jazz. Hardy joined the Jazz prior to the 2022-23 season after one season as assistant coach with the Boston Celtics, where he helped lead the team to its first NBA Finals appearance since 2010. Prior to his time in Boston, Hardy spent a total of 11 seasons with the San Antonio Spurs, including five as an assistant coach from 2015-21. He served as the team's video coordinator from 2013-15 and as the head coach of the Spurs' summer league team in Utah from 2015-18 and in Las Vegas in 2017 and 2018.

The Williams College graduate began his career in San Antonio as a basketball operations intern in 2010 before being promoted to assistant video coordinator in 2011. He was an assistant coach for Team USA's gold medal victory over France at the 2020 Summer Olympics and served on the coaching staff for Team USA at the 2019 FIBA World Cup.

While at Williams College, Hardy was a member of the Ephs basketball squad that finished 30-2 and ranked No. 2 nationally in 2010. Hardy—originally from Richmond, Virginia—and his wife, Spencer, have two daughters, Elliott and Pierce.

## COLLEGIATE TIES

Hardy competed collegiately at Williams College (2006-10)—a small Division III liberal arts school located in Williamstown, Massachusetts. His relationship with the former Williams Athletic Director, Curtis Long, helped him land an internship with Gregg Popovich and the San Antonio Spurs.

During his time at Williams, Hardy's affinity towards coaching and natural ability was easily recognizable. Long saw his potential, and when Popovich—Long's friend and former Pomona-Pitzer College teammate—reached out, Long immediately recommended Hardy to join his staff.
