## TONIGHT'S OPPONENT



**KINGS AT MINNESOTA TIMBERWOLVES (12/17 at Target Center):** Sacramento takes on the Minnesota Timberwolves in the second half of a back-to-back with both games on the road. The Kings will look to turn around their luck in Minnesota as they team has dropped the last two meetings at the Target Center.

In their most recent matchup on Dec. 12, Sacramento held strong for a good first half as they limited Minnesota to just 19 points in the second quarter and took a 13-point lead into the halftime break. Despite the lead, the Kings gave up a 16-2 run to Minnesota to start the third quarter to regain the lead at 65-66. Sacramento would end up maintaining a four-point lead in the fourth quarter and hit a 24-11 run to pull away and grab the win, 141-130. The Timberwolves scored 80 points in the second half while the Kings tallied 78 of their own, marking highs for a high by an opponent and the Kings. The Kings finished the game shooting .581 percent from the field while knocking down exactly .500 percent of their shots from three-point range for the first time all season.

Nemanja Bjelica led the Kings with 25 points on 9-of-15 while Yogi Ferrell added 17 points and six assists. Marvin Bagley III totaled his fourth career double-double as the rookie had 17 points and 10 rebounds Karl-Anthony Towns recorded a double-double this season with 19 points and 11 rebounds and Andrew Wiggins had a team-high 25 points.

**KINGS VS. OKLAHOMA CITY THUNDER (12/19 at Golden 1 Center):** The Kings make their way home for a three-game road trip beginning with the Oklahoma City Thunder as they look to pick up their third straight victory against the Thunder.

In their second meeting this season, the Kings notched the first 10 points of the ball game, including a 16-5 run before Oklahoma City would call a timeout. Sacramento would lead by as many as 19 in the first half and held a 13-point lead at the midway point of the contest. Sacramento would then go 5-for-24 from the field in the third quarter and relinquish the lead for the first time with 1:36 left in the third quarter at 81-83. Sacramento would find themselves down 84-85, but start the final quarter on a 5-0 run to regain the lead and allow OKC to tie the game one the last time at 91 all at the 07:31 mark. Another 5-0 would help the Kings pull away and grab the victory, 117-113.

Sacramento recorded season-high 59 rebounds in the game as Kings center Willie Cauley-Stein grabbed 14 rebounds and forward Marvin Bagley III finished with 15 points and 13 rebounds for a double-double. Kings guard Buddy Hield tallied a team-high 25 points. Thunder forward Paul George scored 27 points and collected nine rebounds while Russell Westbrook totaled a game-high 29 points to go with 13 boards and seven assists.

A three-game win streak would mark the longest against the Thunder/Super Sonics franchise since Sacramento won five straight against Seattle spanning from Dec. 10, 2005 to Feb. 10, 2007.

## 2018-19 KINGS NOTES

**KINGS OF THE ROAD:** The Kings beat the Dallas Mavericks on the road 120-113 in Dallas to nab their ninth win on the road as they move to 9-7 away from Sacramento this season. Nine road victories is tied for the second most by a team this season with the Boston Celtics, Indiana Pacers and Utah Jazz as the Kings hold the fourth highest road winning percentage at .563 percent. Sacramento is one of nine teams this season to play in 16 or more road games with the Jazz playing in 19 so far, the most in the NBA this season.

**A BACKCOURT DUO LIKE NO OTHER:** Sacramento Kings guards De'Aaron Fox and Buddy Hield have been a tremendous starting backcourt as the two have combined for 55+ points in a single game three times this season after each scored 28 points for a total of 56 points in their win at Dallas on Dec. 16. Since the NBA began listing positions in their lineups in the 1970-71 season, the last Kings backcourt to total 55 or more points in a single game multiple times was during the 2006-07 season when Mike Bibby and Kevin Martin notched 55-plus points together in four games that season. In franchise history, two starting backcourt duos have done this in 10 games during a single season, which includes guards Tom Van Arsdale and Nate Archibald in 1971-97 and Phil Ford and Otis Birdsong in 1970-1980 per Elias Sports Bureau.

The pair of Fox and Hield is averaging 18.5 and 19.1 points per game respectively. Fox is grabbing 3.6 rebounds and dishing out 7.5 assists per game and Hield is collecting 5.1 boards while tallying 2.5 assists per contest as they are one of three starting backcourt duos (Trail Blazers guards Damian Lillard and CJ McCollum, Wizards guards Bradley Beane and John Wall) to total 18.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game or more this season with a minimum of 10 starts together.

**THE KINGS KEEP FLYING HIGH AT THE AMERICA AIRLINES CENTER:** On Dec. 16, the Sacramento Kings defeated the Dallas Mavericks 120-113 to pick up their third consecutive win at the American Airlines Center, tying the longest winning streak at Dallas in team history. Three straight wins at Dallas has occurred two other times in franchise history, from Mar. 20, 1992 to Apr. 16, 1993 and Oct. 17, 1980 to Feb. 3, 1981. Kings guard Buddy Hield scored 28 points on career-highs as he went 12-for-23 from the field and guard De'Aaron Fox also added 28 points. Kings forward Nemanja Bjelica recorded his third double-double this season with 15 points and 10 rebounds while also recording a career-high four blocks.

The game marks just the eighth time in team history the Kings have won a game in Dallas while scoring 120 or more points with the last time coming on Dec. 7, 2016. During the 2018-19 season, this is the 11th game where Sacramento has totaled 120 or more points in a single contest. 11 games with 120 points or greater is the most in a single season by a Kings team since 1992-93, when that Kings team tallied 13 120-point performances. The Kings have won eight of the 11 games where they notched 120-plus points, which is the most by a team since the same 1992-93 squad had eight wins with 120 points or more over the entire season.

**A KEY TO SUCCESS:** The Sacramento Kings went down in a tough matchup as they lost, 125-130, to the Golden State Warriors on Dec. 14. Sacramento notched 125 points for the sixth time this season as the 1988-89 Kings were the last Sacramento team to total 125 points in six games in a single season with this year's team already doing so through just 28 games. The Kings are now 4-2 in games where they score 125 points or greater. Sacramento made 15 three-pointers for the second consecutive game as they set a new franchise record with 44 attempts from beyond the arc Sacramento has now made 13 or more three-pointers in 10 games this season, the eighth most in the NBA, as they hold a record of 7-3 when knocking down 13-plus shots from distance. The Kings also dished out 33 assists in the game marking the fourth time this season Sacramento has tallied 30-plus assists in a single-game and are now 3-1 in those instances. The last Kings team to record four games with 30 or more assists in a single outing during a lone season was during the 2012-13 season when the Sacramento squad had exactly four contests with 30 or more dimes.

In each of the four games that Sacramento has dished out 30 or more assists, the Purple and Black also managed to total at least 13 made shots from beyond the arc.

**SACRAMENTO'S SHOOTING LEADS TO FRANCHISE NIGHT:** The Sacramento Kings beat the Minnesota Timberwolves, 141-130, for their second straight home victory overall and second consecutive home win over the Timberwolves. Sacramento shot a season-best .581 percent while also knocking down .500 percent of their shots from beyond the arc, marking the first time this season the team has shot .500 or better from three-point range. The Kings notched 19 makes from beyond the arc as the team set a new franchise record for made three-pointers (previous was 18 which was done twice; 1/28/18 at San Antonio, 2/10/17 vs. Atlanta) while tying their franchise record of 38 three-point attempts, set earlier this season at Oklahoma City on Oct. 19. The 141 points in the contest marks the second time this season that the Kings have scored 140 or more points in a single outing, the most games with 140 points in a single season since the 1988-89 Sacramento Kings team that had three games with 140-plus points. Through 27 games, only two other teams in franchise history managed to score 140 points in two games, which includes the 1982-83 Kansas City Kings and the 1960-61 Cincinnati Royals.

With the victory over Minnesota, the Kings move to 9-1 when leading at the halftime break and 11-0 when holding the scoring edge headed into the fourth quarter. The 11-point win marks the seventh time this season the Kings have defeated an opponent by double-digits as Sacramento has beaten their opponents by double figures in each of their last four wins.

**DE'AARON DOES IT AGAIN:** During Sacramento's 129-110 win over the Cleveland Cavaliers, Kings guard De'Aaron Fox made a career-high 12 field goals on 16 attempts to go for 30 points while also dishing out 12 assists. Fox is just the 23rd player in NBA history to record 30 points and 12 assists or more in two games through the first 24 games of the season and only the third player in franchise history with two or more games with 30 points and 12 assists as only Oscar Robertson (1960-69) and Tiny Archibald (1972-73) have also completed the task; Fox notched 31 points and 15 assists on Nov. 1 at Atlanta. Only Houston's guard James Harden has multiple games with 30 points and 12 assists. Fox is the first player to have two or more 30 point and 12 assist performances through 24 games in the Sacramento Era and only the second player in the Sacramento Era to have multiple games with 30 points and 10 assists as Reggie Theus was the only other player to have two games with 30-10 in a Sacramento Kings uniform during the 1987-88 season.

Fox is one of five players (Harden, New Orleans guard Jrue Holiday, Los Angeles guard-forward LeBron James, Portland guard Damian Lillard) to have two or more games with 30 points and 10 assists or more and is the first to do so in a Kings uniform since Mike Bibby had three 30 and 10 outings during the 2005-06 season. Fox is the only player this season to have a game with 30 points and 12 assists or more.

**A FOXY SEASON:** Sacramento Kings guard De'Aaron Fox has been having a stellar season so far as the second-year guard out of Kentucky is averaging 18.1 points, 3.6 rebounds, 7.5 assists and 1.6 steals per game. Fox is one of five players with averages of 18.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 7.5 assists and 1.6 steals per game this season. The short list includes Rockets guards James Harden, Thunder guard Russell Westbrook, Pelicans guard Jrue Holiday and Washington guard John Wall. Amongst his fellow sophomores, Fox checks in tied with the second highest scoring and second best assists average behind Jazz guard Donovan Mitchell and Sixers guard-forward Ben Simmons respectively. Fox, Mitchell and Hawks forward John Collins (18.5 ppg) are the only second-year players averaging 18.5 or more points while playing 10 or more contests as Simmons and Fox are the only two sophomores to average 7.5 assists or better.

With 13 assists against Oklahoma City on Nov. 19 and 13 against Utah on Nov. 21, Fox is one of five players this season to have consecutive games with 13 assists with the others being Rockets guard James Harden, Nuggets center Nikola Jokic, Thunder guard Russell Westbrook, and Wizards guard John Wall. At 20 years old, Fox is the first player to dish out 12 or more assists in consecutive outings before his 21st birthday since John Wall when the Wizards guard completed the feat on Feb. 23 and Feb. 25, 2011.

**FOX JOINS THE HISTORY BOOKS:** Sacramento Kings guard De'Aaron Fox played a pivotal role in the Kings 146-115 win over the Atlanta Hawks on Nov. 1, as Fox collected 31 points, 15 assists and 10 rebounds for his first career triple-double. At 20 years and 316 days old, Fox ranks as the youngest player in NBA history to record a triple-double with 30 points, 15 assists and 10 rebounds. Magic Johnson was the previous record holder as he recorded a triple-double on Mar. 29, 1981 at 21 years and 227 days old with 33 points, 17 assists and 15 boards.

He is the last Kings player with a 30-point triple-double since Mitch Richmond on Jan. 22, 1997 when he tallied 38 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. Fox also joins Lakers forward LeBron James as the only two players in the league's history to notch a 30-point triple-double before their 21st birthday.

## 2018-19 KINGS NOTES

**RANKS AROUND THE LEAGUE:** The Sacramento Kings are currently in the top 10 in these statistical categories: fourth in points (115.8) and sixth in assists (25.8) per game while ranking third in field goal percentage (.481) and in three-point field goal percentage (.387). The Kings are also second in points off turnovers, averaging 21.1 per game as Sacramento is currently forcing 17.1 opponents' turnovers per game this season, the third most league-wide.

Individually, Kings guard De'Aaron Fox is tied for ninth in assists per game average at 7.5 and sits tied for while Kings forward Nemanja Bjelica is second in three-point field goal percentage at .485 percent this season. Kings guard Buddy Hield has the 16th best three-point field goal shooting percentage in the NBA at .425 percent.

**HISTORICAL START PAST THE QUARTER MARK:** The Sacramento Kings are now 16-13 through their first 29 games, marking the latest in the season that Sacramento has been above .500 since the 2005-06 season. The latest team to be over .500 this late into the season was the 2005-06 team who finished 44-38 and, which is the last Kings team to make a playoff appearance. 16 wins through the team's first 29 games is the most by a Sacramento team since the 2004-05 season when the the team was 20-9 through their first 29 games.

**SETTING THE PACE AND ATTACKING:** The Kings have been pushing the pace all throughout the season with the second highest pace at 105.2, which has helped them average 22.5 fastbreak points per game, the highest average this season; .195 percent of Sacramento's points per game are currently coming from fast break points, the highest in the NBA. Sacramento's ability to get down the court has also helped them become one of the better teams in the NBA in points in the paint per game as the Kings are averaging 53.5 points in the paint per game, the fourth highest average this season.

The Kings have scored 30 or more fast break points six times and are 4-2 in those games.

**THE KINGS FINISH THE ROAD TRIP STRONG IN CHI-TOWN:** The Sacramento Kings wrap up their four-game road trip from Dec. 4 to Dec. 10 winning three out of the four contests, including a come from behind win over the Chicago Bulls. Sacramento would go on to defeat the Bulls, 108-89, despite giving up 56 points in the first half to Chicago and being down by 11 at halftime. The Kings would go on to outscore the Bulls, 36-18, in the third quarter as Sacramento made seven three-pointers, the most in a single quarter by the Kings this season. Guard De'Aaron Fox scored 15 points while the team also forced seven steals, another season-high for a quarter. The third quarter spark would help Sacramento score 63 second half points to Chicago's 33, an opponent season-low for a half as the Bulls made just 12 field goals on 34 attempts, also season-lows by an opponent for a half. Sacramento finished with a season-best 16 steals as they forced 27 turnovers marking just the sixth times in the last 10 years that the Kings have collected 16-plus steals as well as just the fourth time in regulation.

The Kings allowed 33 second half points for the first time since giving up just 33 second half points to the New York Knicks in an 88-80 win at New York as the team has limited teams to 33 second half points or less just four other times over the last 10 seasons. The 30-point differential in the second half is the sixth highest in team history in a second half. Following this game, Sacramento went to 10-0 in games when leading after the third quarter.

**THE SUN WAS SHINING EARLY FOR THE KINGS:** The Sacramento Kings picked up their 12th win of the season and their first wire-to-wire victory of the year as they defeated the Phoenix Suns, 122-105. Despite only winning by 17 at the final horn, the Kings led by as many as 35 in the game as they got off to a hot start scoring 36 points and holding the Suns to just nine first quarter points. The Kings limited Phoenix to just three field goals on 17 tries as the Suns also went 0-for-9 from three-point range. The three made field goals is a season-low for a Kings opponent while nine points also marks a season-low. Nine points for a quarter is the lowest points by a Kings opponent since Feb. 16, 2001 when the Denver Nuggets totaled just seven points in the second quarter.

The Kings limiting Phoenix to just nine points in the first quarter is the lowest since at least 1954 with the previous low being 10 when the Rochester Royals allowed just 10 points to the Philadelphia Warriors on Feb. 17, 1955. The 27-point differential in a quarter is the Kings' largest in the Sacramento era (since 1985). The Cincinnati Royals are also the only other team to have a +27 point differential in a quarter as the 1964-65 Royals outscored the New York Knicks, 50-21, in a win at New York on Dec. 19, 1964.

**SACRAMENTO WINS THREE STRAIGHT ONCE MORE:** The Sacramento Kings defeated the Cleveland Cavaliers, 129-110, which marked their second three-game win streak of the season despite making a Sacramento-Era low four free throws on a season-low seven attempts, which has only been done seven other times in franchise history. Sacramento recorded a season-high 72 points in the paint and shot a season-high .571 percent as they made a season-best 56 field goals.

**SACRAMENTO SNAPS THE SKID:** The Kings defeated the Indiana Pacers on Dec. 1, 111-110, as center Willie Cauley-Stein putback a miss by Kings guard De'Aaron Fox with 16.1 seconds remaining in the game. Sacramento would stop Indiana to close out the game and snap a season-long three-game losing streak. Sacramento was victorious despite allowing Indiana to shoot over .500 percent (.524) and outshoot the Kings from the field, marking their first win of the season when an opponent shoots over .500 and their first win when being outshot from the field by an opponent. Sacramento also snapped a four-game overall losing streak to Indiana as they notched their first win against Indiana in Golden 1 Center since it's opening during the 2016-17 season. Cauley-Stein finished with his eighth double-double on the year as he recorded 17 points and grabbed 13 boards, including a career-high tying six offensive rebounds. Fox also stepped up for the Kings as he finished with a career-high and team season-high tying four steals, which included three in the second half.

**NOT YOUR TYPICAL ROOKIE:** Sacramento Kings rookie forward Marvin Bagley III recorded his second career double-double with a career-high tying 20 points and a new career-high 17 rebounds at Golden State on Nov. 24, 2018. At 19 years old, Bagley III is the only rookie under 20 years old to total a double-double with 20 points and 17 rebounds through their first 20 career contests. Wizards center Dwight Howard is the only other player to total 15 points and 17 rebounds in a single game as a teenage rookie in his first 20 career games. Bagley III is just the fourth Kings rookie to collect 20 points and 17 rebounds in a single game through his first 20 career games with the last player being Joe Kleine who totaled 20 points and 19 rebounds in a win for the Kansas City-Omaha Kings versus the Portland Trail Blazers on Nov. 29, 1972. Only two other players in NBA history have scored 20 points and grabbed 17 or more boards while under the age of 20, including Pelicans forward Anthony Davis on Mar. 9, 2013 and Bill Willoughby on Apr. 10, 1976 while playing for the Atlanta Hawks.

Bagley III is now the 20th rookie over the last 20 seasons, including this season, to notch 20 points and 17 rebounds or greater in a game and the third rookie to do so while coming off the bench. Only five other players have totaled 20 points and 17 boards or better in a game as a reserve over the last 10 seasons, including Knicks center Enes Kanter who has done it twice this season.

**THE KINGS WENT STREAKING:** The Sacramento Kings recorded five consecutive victories after defeating the Atlanta Hawks, 146-115, in Atlanta for the first time since Mar. 3, 2006 as they snapped an 11-game losing streak on the Hawks home court. The 31-point victory was a point shy of the Kings biggest victory over Atlanta as the Kings used a 46-point third quarter to break the contest open after being up, 69-64, at halftime. The 46 points in a quarter is tied for most points in the Sacramento-Era having been done several times with the most recent time coming against the Houston Rockets on Mar. 20, 2001 when the team notched 46 points in the first quarter. The huge quarter would lead the Kings to their 13th highest scoring game in franchise history and the most recent 145-point game by the team since Jan. 2, 1993 when Sacramento defeated Philadelphia, 154-98.

The team finished with 38 fast break points, the third highest in a single-game this year only behind the Golden State Warriors and Los Angeles Lakers. As a team, the Kings also dished out 38 assists, which is the most by a Kings squad since Mar. 11, 2004 when the team recorded 39 assists in a win vs. Dallas. It is only the 30th time in team history where the Kings totaled 38 or more assists in a single outing as they team record currently sits at 42 assists, which has been done three times in team history.

During the five-game span, the Kings averaged 117.8 points, 50.6 rebounds, 26.4 assists, which ranks sixth, third and fifth respectively in the NBA over that time. Sacramento forced 18.6 opponents turnovers per game over the five-game stretch and averaged 22.4 points per game off of those turnovers, and scored 23.2 fast-break points per contest. League-wide, the Kings ranked second in opponents turnovers, points off turnovers and fast break points per game during their win-streak.

## 2018-19 KINGS NOTES

**MARVELOUS NIGHT FOR MARVIN:** Sacramento Kings rookie forward Marvin Bagley III had another great night on Nov. 19 at home against the Oklahoma City Thunder as he collected his first career double-double with 15 points, 13 rebounds and three blocks. Bagley III's 13 rebounds mark a career-high as he also pulled down a new career-high six offensive boards. Only 11 other players have totaled 15 points, 13 rebounds and three blocks or greater while just five others have notched that stat line or greater with six or more offensive rebounds.

Amongst his first-year peers, only Suns center DeAndre Ayton has notched 15 points and 13 rebounds or more as Bagley III is the only rookie with 15 points, 13 rebounds and three blocks in a single game.

**SACRAMENTO'S FLORIDA MAGIC MAGIC CONTINUES:** The Kings beat the Miami Heat, 123-113 on Oct. 29, and the Orlando Magic, 107-99, on Oct. 30 to notch their four wins in-a-row, continuing their best start since the 2014-15 season when the team went 5-3 in their first eight games as well. The four-game winning streak is the longest stretch of wins for the Kings since the 2016-17 season when the team won four straight games from Feb. 8 to Feb. 14, 2017. The Kings have won both road games in Florida in consecutive seasons for the first time in team history while tying their longest winning-streak against the Magic with four straight wins. Sacramento picked up just their fifth victory ever in South Beach, marking the first season in the Sacramento-Era where they defeated the Heat on the road in consecutive seasons.

**FILLING UP THE BOXSCORE:** Kings forward-center Harry Giles III had himself a career night versus the Utah Jazz on Nov. 25, collecting 10 points and career-highs with eight rebounds, six assists and four steals. Giles III is just the fourth Kings rookie to total 10 points, eight rebounds, six assists and four steals or more in a single contest. This season, only seven other players have accumulated 10 points, eight boards, six dimes and four steals or greater in a game.

**ANOTHER BIG NIGHT IN THE BAG FOR BAGLEY III:** Kings rookie forward Marvin Bagley III had another huge night as he notched a career-high 20 points, nine rebounds and five blocks at the Denver Nuggets on Oct. 23, 2018. Bagley III is one of three Kings rookies since the 1983-84 season to post 20 points, nine boards and five blocks as Brian Grant achieved the feat twice (1/5/95, 3/14/95) and Duane Causwell recorded the numbers in a single game himself on Jan. 3, 1991. Bagley III is the first Kings rookie with five blocks in a game since Francisco Garcia recorded five blocks on Jan. 5, 2006.

Bagley III is just the 10th rookie since the 1999-00 season to tally 20 points, nine rebounds and five blocks or greater and only the third rookie in NBA history to do so while coming off the bench for his team with the other two being John Salley in 1987 and Stanley Roberts in 1992.

**SHUMP BRINGS THE THUNDER:** The Sacramento Kings picked up their first win of the season defeating the Oklahoma City Thunder, 131-120, in Oklahoma City for only the second time since the Thunder moved from Seattle to OKC. The Kings got an electric start from guard Iman Shumpert who went off for 16 points in the first quarter as he went 5-for-7 from the field and 4-for-6 from beyond the arc to go with two steals. Shumpert would go on to finish the half with 18 points and tally 26 points by the end of the contest. Shumpert broke his career-high for points in a quarter and half after having previously scored a quarter career-best 15 points in the fourth quarter and 18 in the second half at Orlando on Oct. 21, 2017. The seven-year veteran finished with 26 points, one shy of tying his career-high.

**A ROYAL ROAD DEBUT:** Sacramento Kings forward Marvin Bagley III had one of the franchise's better career road debuts as the rookie notched 19 points, eight rebounds, three assists, three steals and one block in his first career road game. Amongst the franchise's players who made their road debuts within their first or second career games, Bagley III's 19-point performance is the seventh highest scoring total while ranking sixth with DeMarcus Cousins in rebounds collected.

**T'S BEEN A WHILE:** The Kings defeated the San Antonio Spurs, 104-99, at Golden 1 Center on Nov. 12, which snaps a 14-game overall losing streak to San Antonio. The last time the Kings defeated the Spurs was on Nov. 15, 2014, which is also the last time Sacramento had eight or more wins through their first 14 contests as their current record is 8-6. The Kings were 9-5 through their first 14 games to kick off the 2014-15 season. It is just the fourth time the Kings have defeated the Spurs over the last 10 seasons, including the second win in front of their home crowd and the first against San Antonio at Golden 1 Center.
