Head Coach David Fizdale

David Fizdale was named the 29th head coach in New York Knickerbockers franchise history on May 7, 2018.

Fizdale, 44, led the Memphis Grizzlies to a 50-51 (.495) regular season record as head coach over the past two seasons (2016-17 and 2017-18), which included a trip to the NBA Playoffs in 2017.

Prior to joining the Grizzlies for his first NBA head coaching assignment, Fizdale spent the previous eight seasons (2008-09 thru 2015-16) with the Miami Heat as an assistant coach, including the final two years as assistant head coach under Erik Spoelstra. During his tenure in Miami, the Heat won back-to-back NBA Championships in 2012 and 2013, and more Playoff games (70) and series (15) than any other NBA team.

With a decade-and-a-half of NBA coaching experience, the Los Angeles native was an assistant coach for one season in Golden State (2003-04) and for four seasons in Atlanta (2004-05 thru 2007-08).

Fizdale began his coaching career in the college ranks, serving as an assistant coach at his alma mater, the University of San Diego (1998-99 thru 2001-02) and at Fresno State (2002-03). His first NBA job was as a member of the Heat's video department in 1997-98.

Fizdale was a three-year starter at the University of San Diego and was named to the All-West Coast Conference team as a senior in 1995-96 when he led the Conference in assists with 7.0 APG.

Born on June 16, 1974 in Los Angeles, David earned a bachelor's degree in communications with a minor in sociology from San Diego in 1996.

New York (12/3/18) – It was a tale of two halves with the Wizards defeating the Knicks 110-107 at Madison Square Garden. New York took a nine-point (61-52) lead into the second half but was outscored 34-19 in the third quarter. Despite a furious comeback, the Knicks came up short in the end. New York, down 107-104 after a Noah Vonleh layup, was unable to make one last defensive stop as John Wall hit a clinching three-pointer with 12 seconds left. The Knicks were paced by Tim Hardaway Jr.'s team best 20 points on 7-15 shooting and two assists over 30 minutes. Damyean Dotson continued his hot play off the bench with 17 points on 6-12 shooting and nine rebounds over 24 minutes. The game marked Dotson's fourth consecutive game of at least 15-points off the bench for the Knicks. Dotson is leading the Knicks in scoring over that four-game stretch. Washington was led by its all-star backcourt duo, Bradley Beal and John Wall. Beal registered a game best 27 points on 12-25 shooting, with eight rebounds and seven assists over 38 minutes. Wall recorded 18 points and 15 assists over 37 minutes.

KEVIN KNOX ROTM DECEMBER-

New York Knicks forward Kevin Knox has been named KIA NBA Eastern Conference Rookie of the Month for December. Knox becomes the eighth rookie in franchise history to be awarded Rookie of the Month honors.

Among Eastern Conference rookies, Knox led in scoring (17.1 ppg), three-pointers (33), was second in rebounding (6.0 rpg), and led all rookies in minutes (34.9 mpg) in the month of December. He appeared in all 14 games (nine starts) for the Knicks during the month, scored in double figures in 12 games and recorded six games with 20 or more points. On December 9, Knox joined LeBron James as just the second teenager in NBA history to record at least 25 points and 15 rebounds in a game (vs. Charlotte). He is the first Knicks rookie since Patrick Ewing to post at least 25 points and 15 rebounds in a game. In December, the Tampa, FL-native became just the sixth Knicks rookie ever to post three consecutive games of at least 20 points and five rebounds and is the first since Patrick Ewing (1985-86).



On the season, Knox has appeared in 31 games (13 starts) for the Knicks averaging 12.2 points (7th among rookies) and 4.3 rebounds (8th among rookies) over 26.3 minutes (6th among rookies). He currently has 11-straight double-figure scoring performances, which is tied for the second longest streak by a Knicks rookie over the last 30 seasons (Kristaps Porzingis, 2015-16).
