### SERIES NOTES

Denver has won 27 of the last 44 games overall against the Kings ... Despite losing both games in Sacramento during the 2009-10 season, the Nuggets have still gone 14-10 at Sacramento over the past 12 years, after losing the previous 20 games in Sacramento from 1997-2006 ... Denver's 33-point win (118-85) in Sacramento on 12/6/08 is the Nuggets' largest margin of victory over the Kings franchise since joining the NBA in 1976-77 ... The Nuggets won the 2017-18 season series against Sacramento (3-1), the fifth time in the last nine years Denver has won the series.

Nuggets G **Isaiah Thomas** was drafted in the second round (60<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2011 NBA Draft by the Kings, playing three seasons (2011-14) for them, averaging 15.3 points, 2.5 rebounds and 4.8 assists in 29.1 minutes ... Kings C **Kosta Koufos** spent three seasons (2010-13) with Denver, he averaged 6.9 ppg, 6.1 rpg and 1.1 bpg in 19.3 minutes a game ... Kings assistant coach **Elston Turner** played in 232 career games for the Nuggets from 1984 to 1989, Turner averaged 4.8 points 3.1 rebounds and 2.0 assists ... Nuggets head coach **Michael Malone** was the head coach in Sacramento for two seasons (2013-15) ... Nuggets assistant coach **Ryan Bowen** spent two seasons (2013-15) under coach Malone as an assistant coach with the Kings ... Nuggets G **Jamal Murray**, F **Trey Lyles**, Kings C **Willie Cauley-Stein**, F **Wenyen Gabriel** and G **De'Aaron Fox** all played at Kentucky ... Kings F's **Harry Giles** and **Marvin Bagley III** and Nuggets F/C **Mason Plumlee** all played at Duke ... **BEASLEY HELPS DENVER HALT LOSING SKID**

After sweeping a home-road back-to-back to start the month February, the Nuggets were tested in three straight road games in which they failed to register a win. The home cooking in Denver helped, as the Nuggets returned home to Pepsi Center and defeated the Miami Heat 103-87 on 2/11 to end their three-game losing streak. It also marked their first season sweep of the Heat since the 2008-09 season. The defense was key to the victory, as Denver allowed just 70 points through the first three quarters after allowing an average of 66.2 points in the first half in the first five games of February.

**Malik Beasley continued his stellar month of February, he finished with 23 points (8-13 FG, 5-7 3FG) and two assists in 28 minutes making it his 10th career game (all this season) scoring 20+ points. Overall in the month, Beasley is averaging 20.8 points, 2.0 rebounds and 1.2 assists while shooting 56.6% from the field and 52.4% from three-point range.**

**HOME SWEET HOME**

The Pepsi Center has been rocking as of late, with 18 sellouts in 28 games, including the second largest crowd in Pepsi Center history of 20,076 fans on 12/28/18 to see the Nuggets defeat the Spurs 102-99. The home crowd has helped **Denver propel their record 24-4 at home (best home record in the NBA). Denver has now won six straight games at home, which is their second largest home winning streak of the season, they had previously won 12 straight from 11/15 to 1/13. The Nuggets also own a record of 14-2 in Denver against Western Conference teams.**

**MICHAEL MALONE AND STAFF TO COACH TEAM LEBRON**

With their 107-106 win over the Minnesota Timberwolves on 2/2 the Nuggets (37-15, .712) clinched a tie with the Golden State Warriors for the best record in the Western Conference through games played on Sun., Feb. 3. According to NBA rules, the first tiebreaker to determine an All-Star Game head coach is better head-to-head record, Denver and Golden State are 1-1 against each other this season. The second tiebreaker is better record against teams in own conference, the Nuggets have a 23-10 (.697) record against Western Conference teams while the Warriors hold a 22-10 (.688) record against Western Conference teams, giving Malone the spot over Golden State head coach Steve Kerr.

**Coach Malone will be an NBA All-Star Game head coach for the first time in his career. He is the third Nuggets head coach to earn the honor, joining Larry Brown (1977) and George Karl (2010). Malone is in his fourth season as the Nuggets' head coach with a 156-144 record all-time and has led them to a 37-17 record in 2018-19 – tying them for the best start through 54 games in franchise history.**

**OWNING THE NORTHWEST**

Denver defeated the Minnesota Timberwolves 107-106 at Target Center on 2/2 in a game that went down the final shot as Minnesota missed at the buzzer and Denver escaped with the division win. **The Nuggets moved their record to 7-1 against the Northwest, ranking them first in the Western Conference for the best win percentage against a division.**

**NUGGETS GIVE HOUSTON A PROBLEM**

For the first time this season the Nuggets took down the Houston Rockets 136-122 at Pepsi Center on 2/1 snapping a nine-game losing streak to the Rockets. The first half was a track meet as the Nuggets got up and down the court, **scoring 83 points in the first two quarters, tied for the fourth most in a first half and tied for the fifth most in any half in franchise history. They scored 48 points in the second quarter which also ranks near the top, tying for third most in any quarter and second most ever in a second quarter in franchise history.**

The charge was led by career nights from Malik Beasley and Torrey Craig. Beasley had with a career-high 35 points (12-17 FG, 5-9 3FG), three assists and one steal in a career-high 41 minutes, while Craig posted career-high 22 points (8-11 FG, 2-4 3FG), four rebounds and two assists in 34 minutes off the bench. Nikola Jokic's presence was also felt the entire evening, as he went for 31 points (12-15 FG, 6-6 FT), 13 rebounds and nine assists. **Beasley and Jokic became the first Nuggets teammates since 3/7/14 vs. LAL to each score 30+ points in a game.**

**CLIMBING THE WEST**

With their 107-106 win over the Minnesota Timberwolves on the road on 2/2 the Nuggets moved their record to 37-15 on the season. **Their record now stands at 38-18, which is best record through 56 games in Nuggets NBA franchise history ... It had also been awhile since since Denver sat atop the Western Conference this late in a season, as they held the top spot in the West on 2/4/19. It is the latest the Nuggets have been in first place of the conference since March 16, 1977, when they were 43-26.**

**RED HOT JANUARY**

The Nuggets finished off the month of January by locking down two road wins against the Memphis Grizzlies on 1/28 and the New Orleans Pelicans on 1/30 to cap the first month of 2019 with a 12-4 record. Denver finished January with a 7-1 record at home and were able to finish above .500 on the road going 5-3 to stay right at the top of the Western Conference and **reach their best start in franchise history through 50 games. Their 12 wins in the month is tied for best January in franchise history and is also tied for second best month overall (12+ wins in a month accomplished six times in Nuggets history).**

**COMEBACK FOR THE AGES**

The Nuggets found themselves down 25 points (70-45) in the third quarter against the Memphis Grizzlies on the road on 1/28. The switch quickly flipped as Denver slowly started to build momentum and cut into the lead. The Nuggets still trailed by 17 entering the fourth quarter but things quickly changed, Malik Beasley scored 13 points in the fourth and the Nuggets outscored Memphis 35-15 in the final quarter, closing the game on a 23-7 run to complete the improbable comeback defeating Memphis 95-92 in regulation.

**The 17-point deficit entering the fourth quarter tied the largest comeback win in franchise history (previously done 1/13/1987 vs. Seattle Supersonics). As well, NBA teams in the 2018-19 season were previously 174-0 when leading by 25+ points at any point in the game before the Nuggets victory.**



**BALANCED ATTACK TAKES DOWN PHOENIX**

Despite missing Nikola Jokic to an NBA suspension, the Nuggets used one of their best all-around games to defeat the Phoenix Suns in blowout fashion 132-95. Denver had eight players score 10+ points for the second time this season and it was the third game in which all five starters scored 10 or more points. **The big win continued a recent trend for Denver, it was the third game in the last four that Denver has won by 20+ points and their eighth win this season by 20+ points. If you look back at last season the Nuggets had only five such games and in 2016-17 had only seven.**

**ASSISTS FOR DAYS**

In their 115-108 victory over the New York Knicks on 1/1 the Nuggets dished out a season-high 36 assists. **The Nuggets have dished out 30+ assists in a game 20 times this season and their record is 48-13 under coach Malone's tenure when accomplishing this.** Denver ranks second in the NBA averaging 27.6 assists per game and they are converting those assists at a high rate, ranking second in the league with 65.0% of their field goals coming off an assist.

**STAY HOT JAMAL**

Jamal Murray ended his recent struggles on the road in a big way against the Phoenix Suns on 12/29. The Blue Arrow was red hot from the jump as he posted 13 points in the opening quarter and rode that momentum the rest of the way. **He finished the game with his second highest point total of his career posting 46 points (16-24 FG's, 9-11 3FG's) eight assists and six rebounds in 40 minutes, becoming the first Nugget to have 45+ points, 5+ rebounds and 7+ assists on the road.**

Murray connected on nine three-point field goals, beating his previous career-high of six. **It was only the eighth time in franchise history a player has made nine or more threes in a game and the most since Ty Lawson made 10 on 4/9/11. Murray's two game stretch of scoring 77 points, (31 points on 12/28 and 46 points on 12/29), is the most points scored in two consecutive games since Carmelo Anthony combined for 79 points on 2/7/11 and 2/9/11.**

**THE CENTURY MARK**

Denver took down the Toronto Raptors 95-86 at home on 12/16 winning their sixth straight game at home. Nikola Jokic led the way for the Nuggets posting 26 points, nine rebounds, four assists and two steals in 35 minutes. Denver's defense in the fourth quarter was stellar, holding the Raptors to just 14 points in route to the win ... **Denver has held their opponent to 15 or fewer points in a quarter eight times, tying them for second in the NBA for most quarters holding an opponent to 15 points or less.**

The Nuggets now have **held their opponent to fewer than 100 points in 12 of the last 35 games. The century mark has been a great indicator for success. Denver has held their opponent to under 100 points 19 times this season, improving to 18-1 in those games. The Nuggets are tied for second (Indiana, Memphis) in the NBA in total games holding their opponents under 100 points (19).**

**MONTE IS HERE TO STAY**

Spending last season on a two-way contract, Monte Morris is now with the Nuggets fulltime and is off to a fast start this season. Morris had one of the best games of his young career at home against the Memphis Grizzlies on 12/10. The Iowa State product tied a career-high in scoring (20 points), set a career-high in field goals made (8-12 FG's), while also registering six rebounds and five assists, only turning the ball over once in 28 minutes. **Morris has a total of 20 games this season in which he has recorded at 3+ assists and zero turnovers (14-6) and has only reached three turnovers in a game one time.**

Morris averages 25.0 minutes per game **currently ranks third on the Nuggets in assists (221), while only turning the ball over only 35 times. His 6.31 assist to turnover ratio ranks him first in NBA history among players who averaged 20+ minutes per game and played at least 15 games.**

**DENVER'S DOMINANT DEFENSE**

After finishing the 2017-18 campaign near the bottom of the league in defense, the Nuggets have turned the page and have been a cohesive group on the defensive end, ranking near the top of the NBA in several categories. Denver took down the Golden State Warriors 100-98 at home on 10/21 to move to 3-0 on the young season. The win marked three straight games that they have held their opponents under 100 points and it is the **first time in Nuggets franchise history that the team started a season 3-0 and held all three opponents to under 100 points in all three games.**

Denver has continued that trend, having held opponents to under 100 points in 19 of their first 56 games and have held opponents to 15 points or fewer in eight quarters this season.

**BENCH LEADING THE WAY**

Finishing their road trip with a 1-2 record, the Nuggets returned to Pepsi Center to face the Orlando Magic on 11/23 and were able to bounce back with a win. Denver controlled most of the game mainly due to another great showing from their bench. 11 players scored in the game and the second unit outscored the Magic's 57-45 as the Nuggets cruised to a 112-87 victory. **The 25+ point win marked the third time through the first 19 games winning by 25+ points (only did so three times last season).**

Trey Lyles registered a season-high 22 points (9-15 FG), two rebounds and one assist in 18 minutes off the bench while Mason Plumlee posted a season-high 15 points (6-8 FG), a season-high 11 rebounds, four assists, two steals and two blocks in 21 minutes. It was the first time in his career he had 15+ points, 11+ rebounds and 4+ assists. As for the entire second unit, Denver's bench is **amongst the best in the Western Conference, they rank third in points (38.6), fourth in assists (9.0), third in FG% (46.8%), while having a +/- of 1.5, ranking third.**

### RISING THE RANKS

Denver defeated the Cleveland Cavaliers at Pepsi Center 124-102 on 1/19 and were once again led by Nikola Jokic as he recorded his 22<sup>nd</sup> triple-double of his career. He posted 19 points, 12 assists and 11 rebounds in 28 minutes, making him just the third player (Magic Johnson and Fat Lever) in NBA history with 19+ points, 11+ rebounds and 12+ assists in 28 minutes or less.

**Nikola now has 27 career triple-doubles which passed Kareem Abdul-Jabbar for the second most among centers in NBA history and currently ranks in 13<sup>th</sup> place all-time. When he records a triple-double the Nuggets are tough to beat, as they are 23-4 overall and 15-0 at home, they have also won 18 of their last 20 games when he does so.**

### THE JOKER IS HEADED TO CHARLOTTE

Nikola Jokic added another accolade to his young career as he was selected as a Western Conference reserve for the 2019 NBA All-Star game on Sunday, Feb. 17 at Spectrum Center in Charlotte. It marks the first All-Star selection for the Serbian big man, joining Ben Simmons, Nikola Vucevic and Khris Middleton as the only first time All-Stars in 2019. **It has been awhile since the city of Denver has been represented at the All-Star break, Jokic is the first Nuggets player since Carmelo Anthony in 2011 to be selected to play in the game.**

### JANUARY JOKIC

With one of his best months of his career in December, Nikola stepped his game up even more in the month of January, leading the Nuggets to a 12-4 record, tying them for the best record in the month of January in Nuggets history. **The big man averaged 25.1 points, 11.8 rebounds and 8.2 assists while shooting 52.5% from the field in 32.3 minutes. He recorded six of his eight triple-doubles in the month and had a double-double in 13 of 15 games.**

### FRANCHISE FIRST

Nikola Jokic came out very aggressive in the Nuggets 126-110 win over the Philadelphia 76ers on 1/26. Jokic scored 17 points on 7-12 shooting and grabbed seven rebounds in the first quarter alone to help his team put up 41 points to open the game. He finished with 32 points (12-22 FG, 2-3 3FG), 18 rebounds, 10 assists and one steal in 34 minutes for his seventh triple-double of the year and 23<sup>rd</sup> of his career. **He became the first player in Nuggets franchise history with 32+ points, 18+ rebounds and 10+ assists and is the first player in NBA history to record those numbers in 34 minutes or less**

### ACCUMULATING ASSISTS

The Joker once again was spreading the wealth in the Nuggets 135-105 win over the Chicago Bulls on 1/17. Jokic finished with 18 points, 11 assists and eight rebounds in 25 minutes, making it the third game in the last six in which he has dished out 10+ assists. **He now has 38 career games where he has recorded 10 or more dimes, amongst centers he ranks second all-time trailing only Wilt Chamberlain.**

### CENTER OF ATTENTION

Nikola Jokic finished with a season-high 40 points (15-23 FG, 4-7 3FG), 10 rebounds and eight assists in 37 minutes for his 28<sup>th</sup> double-double of the year in a 116-113 win vs. Portland on 1/13 ... It was his third career 40+ point game and his first to do it with 10+ rebounds and 8+ assists. Jokic is just the third player this season with 40/10/8 in 37 minutes or less (LeBron James and James Harden).

**Additionally, the Joker is only the fifth center in the NBA since 1985 with 40+ points, 10+ rebounds and 8+ assists. Joining David Robinson, Hakeem Olajuwon, Shaquille O'Neal and DeMarcus Cousins.**

### 20 TRIPLE-DOUBLES AT AGE 23

The Joker propelled the Nuggets to a 103-99 road win over the Miami Heat on 1/8 as he knocked down a game winning runner in the lane with 2.2 seconds left to seal the victory. Jokic finished the game with 29 points, 11 rebounds, 10 assists and one steal in a season-high 40 minutes. It was his fourth triple-double of the season and the 20<sup>th</sup> of his young career.

**At age 23, Jokic became the third youngest player in NBA history to reach 20 triple doubles. Magic Johnson and Oscar Robertson were the only two players to do so at a younger age, they were both 22 years old when they produced their 20<sup>th</sup> career triple-double.**

### NIKOLA JOINS HIS AIRNESS

The Nuggets defeated the Charlotte Hornets 123-110 at Pepsi Center on 1/5 led again by Nikola Jokic who finished the game with a season-high in points. Jokic posted 39 points (16-29 FG), 12 rebounds, six assists, three steals and one block in 34 minutes for his 23<sup>rd</sup> double-double of the year. Nikola joined elite company, becoming the only player other than Michael Jordan to record those numbers in 34 minutes or less.

The big man has dished out 10+ assists in 18 games, ranking him in third place in the NBA for most games with 10 or more. In his fourth season, **Jokic now has four games of 15+ assists in his career, no other starting center in the NBA over the last 20 seasons has recorded one game of 15+ assists.** Amongst the centers in the NBA, the Joker has a clear margin in the assist column.

## DECEMBER TO REMEMBER

Nikola Jokic has been playing some of the best basketball of his career during the month of December when the Nuggets have needed him the most. After losing Paul Millsap, another starter, to injury on 12/7, Jokic has done nothing but carry his team. Capping a road trip at the beginning of the month, Denver returned to Pepsi Center, where the Joker led the Nuggets to a perfect 4-0 homestand. Nikola posted 27 points, 12 rebounds, six assists and two steals vs. Memphis on 12/10 and followed that performance off by recording 24 points, 15 rebounds and nine assists in 36 minutes vs. Oklahoma City on 12/14. He then finished the homestand by putting up 36 points, 16 rebounds and four assists vs. Dallas on 12/18.

**During the month, Nikola posted a double-double in eight games, including a triple-double at Toronto on 12/3, he also had 24+ points and 10+ rebounds in five of the last nine games. Overall, in December, Jokic averaged near a triple-double with 20.9 points, 10.1 rebounds, 7.9 assists and 1.5 steals in 33.8 minutes per game.**

## JOKIC SEEING 20/20

Nikola Jokic came out of the gates aggressive vs. BKN on 11/9 and kept his foot on the gas pedal the entire game applying constant pressure to the Nets defense. Jokic recorded a season-high 37 points (14-22 FG, 8-10 FT), a career-high tying 21 rebounds and added three assists and two blocks in 33 minutes for his eighth double-double of the season. It was **his first career 20/20 game and he became the first player this season and just the second (DeMarcus Cousins) in the last two seasons to record 37+ points and 21+ rebounds.** He also added his name to the record books:

- First player in NBA history to record 37+ points and 21+ rebounds in 34 minutes or less.
- Joined Dikembe Mutombo (2/3/92 at MIN), becoming the second Nugget in franchise history to post 37+ points and 21+ rebounds.

## NIKOLA'S HISTORIC NIGHT

Nikola Jokic had a night for the record books in the Nuggets home opener vs. Phoenix on 10/20. Jokic dominated from the start of the game scoring 14 points in the first quarter and never looked back. **He finished with his first triple-double of the season and 17th of his career recording 35 points (11-11 FG, 3-3 3FG), 12 rebounds, 11 assists, four steals, one block and no turnovers (all season-highs) in 31 minutes.**

- **Jokic joins Wilt Chamberlain as the only two players in NBA history to post a 35+ point triple-double while shooting 100% from the field. Each doing it one time.**
- It is just the eighth time in NBA history that a player has recorded a triple-double without missing a shot. Jokic is the fifth player to do that, joining Wilt Chamberlain, Draymond Green, Bo Outlaw and Russell Westbrook.
- Only player in NBA history to record a 30+ point triple-double while attempting 11 or fewer shots.
- Became just the second Nugget in franchise history, joining Fat Lever, to finish with at least one triple-double within the first two games of the regular season.

- **The Nuggets** defeated the Miami Heat at home 103-87 **on 2/11**, going 16-37 from three-point range in the game ... The have made 16+ three-pointers in five games this season ... It was the 32nd game in franchise history with 16 made threes ... Denver is 22-10 in those games.
- **Denver** allowed just 70 points through the first three quarters **vs. MIA on 2/11** ... They allowed an average of 66.2 points in the first half in the first five games of February.
- **Malik Beasley** finished with 23 points (8-13 FG, 5-7 3FG) and two assists in 28 minutes **vs. MIA on 2/11** ... It was Beasley's 10th career game (all this season) scoring 20+ points ... - **Denver** beat the Minnesota Timberwolves 107-106 on the road **on 2/2** to move their record to 2-0 on the season against Minnesota ... The Nuggets dished out 29 assists on 42 made field goals making it their third straight game with 29+ assists ... - **Nikola Jokic** posted 13 points, 16 rebounds and 10 assists in only 29 minutes for his ninth triple-double of the season and 25<sup>th</sup> of his career **at MIN on 2/2** ... It was the fifth time in his career he has recorded 13+ points, 16+ rebounds and 10+ assists but doing so in the fewest minutes (29) ... He is the first player in the NBA since 1983-84 to record 13+ points, 16+ rebounds and 10+ assists in 29 minutes or fewer.
- **Trey Lyles** recorded 19 points (8-13 FG's, 3-6 3FG's) and six rebounds in 20 minutes **at MIN on 2/2** ... It was his ninth game scoring 15+ points off the bench with Denver going 7-2 in those games.
- **The Nuggets** shot a season-high .622 (51-82) from the field in a 136-122 win over **Houston on 2/1** ... It was their 37th straight win when shooting over .500 from the field ... Denver has won eight game when their opponent shoots .500 or better (most such wins in the NBA ... The Nuggets are 13-1 at home when shooting .500 or better from the field this season ... The 62.2% from the field is the 11th best shooting percentage in franchise history.
- **Denver** scored their second most points of the season (136), winning their last 43 games when scoring 130+ points in regulation vs. **HOU on 2/1** .... The Nuggets scored 120+ points for the 12th time this season, going 12-0 in those games.
- **Malik Beasley** finished with a career-high 35 points (12-17 FG, 5-9 3FG), two rebounds, three assists and one steal in a career-high 41 minutes **vs. HOU on 2/1**... Beasley's 12 made field goals were also a new career-high ... It was Beasley's fifth career game with 5+ three-pointers, all coming this season.
- **Torrey Craig** posted a career-high 22 points (8-11 FG, 2-4 3FG), four rebounds, two assists, one steal and one block in 34 minutes off the bench **vs. HOU on 2/1** ... This is Craig's 11th game with 2+ three-pointers this season. The Nuggets are 10-1 in those games ... Craig's eight made field goals is a new career-high.
- **The Nuggets** took down the New Orleans Pelicans 105-99 at Smoothie King Center **on 1/30** ... Denver was moving the ball, as they dished out 30 assists on 42 made field goals ... The have had 30+ assists in 17 games, going 14-3 when they accomplish that.
- **Nikola Jokic** posted 20 points, 13 rebounds and 10 assists in 37 minutes at **NOP on 1/30** for this 24<sup>th</sup> career triple-double and eighth of the 2018-19 season ... He is the one of six players to post those numbers in 37 minutes or less and is one of three players to do so multiple times this season.

The Nuggets are 21-2 overall and 15-0 at home when Jokic records a triple-double and have won 16 straight games when he does so ... - **Mason Plumlee** registered 17 points (5-5 FG, 7-10 FT), six rebounds, four assists and one block in 22 minutes off the bench **vs. PHI on 1/27**... It was Plumlee's first career game with 17+ points, 6+ rebounds and 4+ assists while shooting 100% from the field ... - **Denver** outrebounded Phoenix 57-35 **on 1/25**, their 17th game outrebounding an opponent by 10+ boards ... Denver is 14-3 in those games ... The +22 rebound margin is the biggest margin for Denver since 11/24/17 vs. MEM (+27)
- **Paul Millsap** finished with 20 points (6-8 FG, 2-2 3FG), nine rebounds, two assists and three steals in 22 minutes **vs. PHX on 1/25** ... It was Millsap's first career game with 20+ points, 9+ rebounds and 3+ steals in 22 minutes or less and his fifth 20+ point game this season.
- **Monte Morris** posted 17 points (7-11 FG, 3-5 3FG), three rebounds, one assist and zero turnovers in 26 minutes off the bench **vs. PHX on 1/25** ... - **Trey Lyles** registered 16 points (7-11 FG), six rebounds, four assists and one steal in 19 minutes off the bench **vs. CLE on 1/19** ... It was Lyles first career game with 16+ points, 6+ rebounds, 4+ assists and 1+ steal and his seventh game with 16+ points off the bench this season (5-2).
- **Denver** beat the Chicago Bulls 135-105 at home on **1/17** ... The 30-point win was their third win this season by 30+ points ... The three wins are tied for the most in a single season since 2010-11 when Denver had four such games ... It was the second time in franchise history that the Nuggets followed a 30+ point loss with a 30+ point win.

Jokic is just the second player in NBA history (Magic Johnson) with 18+ points, 8+ rebounds and 11+ assists in 26 minutes or less ... It was Jokic's 11th career game with 18/8/11 ... The Nuggets are 10-1 in those games.
- **The Nuggets** lost to the Golden State Warriors 142-111 at home on **1/15** ... 142 points was the most points Denver has allowed in a non-overtime game since 11/9/10 (144 vs. IND).

- **The Nuggets** lost on the road to the Phoenix Suns 102-93 on **1/12** ... Denver outrebounded the Suns 50-49 in the game ... It was the 15<sup>th</sup> time this season the Nuggets have pulled down at least 50 rebounds in a game and only the third time they have lost when doing so.
- **Malik Beasley** posted 21 points on 8-14 FG's and 5-9 3G's in a career-high 40 minutes at **PHX on 1/12** ... It was his fifth time eclipsing 20 points in a game this season ... He has also made five three pointers in a game three times, which ties his career-high.
- **Denver** outrebounded the Clippers 53-38 in their 121-100 win at **home on 1/10** ... It was the 14th time this season Denver has outrebounded their opponent by 10+ boards ... They are 12-2 in those games ... Denver is tied with Milwaukee for most such games in the NBA this season.

- **Mason Plumlee** registered a season-high 17 points (7-8 FG), a season-high tying 12 rebounds, five assists and one block in 20 minutes off the bench for his fifth double-double of the season vs. **LAC on 1/10** ... It was Plumlee's second career game with 17+ points, 12+ rebounds and 5+ assists ... The Nuggets are 5-0 this year when Plumlee has a double-double ... Plumlee was the first player in NBA history to post 17+ points, 12+ rebounds and 5+ assists in 20 minutes or fewer off the bench.
- **The Nuggets** defeated the Miami Heat 103-99 on **1/8** in the second game of a back-to-back ... The win moved the Nuggets record to 5-1 in back-to-back sets which is the second-best in the NBA (Toronto 7-1).
- **Denver's** win over the Heat on **1/8** marked the 10<sup>th</sup> straight game scoring over 100 points, tying a season best. They opened the season scoring at least 100 points in their first 10 games.
- **Torrey Craig** tallied 11 points, a career-high 16 rebounds (six offensive) and four assists in 39 minutes at **MIA on 1/8** ... It was his first career double-double ... Craig knocked down three 3FG's, tying a career-high for threes made (previously done three times).
- **Nikola Jokic** recorded 29 points, 11 rebounds and a game-high 10 assists in 40 minutes at **MIA on 1/8** ... It was his 20<sup>th</sup> career triple-double, trailing only Fat Lever (43 triple-doubles) for most triple-doubles in franchise history ... At age 23, Jokic became the third youngest player to reach 20 triple-doubles, Oscar Robertson and Magic Johnson were 22 years old when they recorded their 20<sup>th</sup> ... Jokic has recorded a double-double in all five games this month and has also done so in 10 of the last 14 games.

## HEAD COACH MICHAEL MALONE

**Overall Record:** 196-212 (4<sup>th</sup> season)

Michael Malone enters his fourth season as head coach of the Denver Nuggets. He was named the 16th head coach in Denver's NBA franchise history on June 15, 2015.

This past season saw Coach Malone lead the Nuggets to a 46-36 record, their best overall record since 2013, while narrowly missing the playoffs by one game. Since Malone has taken over prior to the 2015-16 season the Nuggets have improved on their win total by a total of 16 wins (+3 after first season, +7 after second and +6 after third), making Denver one of three teams to increase their win total in each of the last three seasons (Minnesota and Boston).

Malone possesses over 21 years of coaching experience, 17 coming in the NBA with six different teams – New York, Cleveland, New Orleans, Golden State, Sacramento and Denver. The teams that Malone has been a member of the coaching staff have amassed eight playoff appearances, including one NBA Finals showing and two conference finals appearances.

Before joining the Nuggets, Malone served as the head coach of the Sacramento Kings for two seasons. Before his time with the Kings, Malone was the lead assistant for the Golden State Warriors under Mark Jackson from 2011-13 where they clinched a postseason berth in 2013, their first since 2007.

Prior to Golden State, Malone worked as the lead assistant to Monty Williams in New Orleans and helped the Hornets achieve a 46-36 record and a trip to the 2011 NBA Playoffs. The Hornets were the most improved defensive team in the NBA in 2011, allowing a league-best 8.7 fewer points per game than in the previous campaign (94.0 ppg, after giving up 102.7 ppg in 2009-10).

Malone also served as an assistant coach under Mike Brown for the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons, during which the Cavs posted a 272-138 (.663) record, the third-best mark in the NBA over that span. The Cavaliers made five consecutive playoff appearances during Malone's time on the bench, reaching the NBA Finals in 2007 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2009. In 2008-09, the Cavs notched a franchise record and NBA-best 66 wins, with Malone and the rest of the team's staff earning the right to coach the Eastern Conference All-Star squad. In 2009-10, the Cavaliers again captured the league's best regular season record with 61 wins.

Malone's NBA coaching career began with a four-season stint with the New York Knicks, where he originally joined Jeff Van Gundy's staff as a coaching associate in the summer of 2001, and was promoted to assistant coach in May 2003.

Before joining the NBA, Malone coached seven years in the college ranks, with his last stop coming at Manhattan College where he was the lead assistant. During the 1998-99 season Malone worked at the University of Virginia as its director of men's basketball administration. Malone also spent three seasons (1995-96 – 1997-98) at Providence College under New York Basketball Hall of Fame coach Pete Gillen after beginning his coaching career working for Greg Kampe at Oakland University in Michigan.

Malone is a three-time participant in the NBA's "Basketball Without Borders" program, having coached at the league's global outreach camps in Africa (2017), Puerto Rico (2006) and Argentina (2005). In 2017 Malone traveled to Johannesburg, South Africa where he spent a week coaching at the BWB camps and then served as an assistant coach for Team Africa, for the NBA Africa Game 2017.

Malone also served as an assistant coach for the Canadian Men's Senior National Team for three years. He helped guide the Canadian team to a top-four finish in the 2009 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico, qualifying Canada for the 2010 World Championships.

A native of Queens, New York, Malone played college basketball at Loyola College in Maryland, where he graduated with a BA degree in 1994. He is a graduate of New Jersey's Seton Hall Prep where he played two years under Bob Farrell. Malone also played a season under Tom Blackburn at Worcester Academy (Mass.).

Michael is the son of longtime NBA coach Brendan Malone, who has coached over 28 years in the league.

He and his wife, Jocelyn, have two daughters, Caitlin and Bridget.
