Monty Williams was named head coach of the Detroit Pistons on June 2, 2023.

The 2021-22 NBA Coach of the Year joined Detroit after serving as head coach of the Phoenix Suns for four years, leading the club to its first NBA Finals berth since 1993, a franchise-record 64 wins during the 2021-22 season and a Western Conference title, two Pacific Division titles and three playoff appearances in four seasons.

Over nine seasons as an NBA head coach with Phoenix and the New Orleans Hornets/Pelicans, Williams holds a .522 regular season winning percentage (367-336) including a .518 playoff winning percentage (29-27). In addition to nine seasons as an NBA head coach, he has totaled seven seasons as an assistant coach, two seasons in a front office role, one season as a coaching intern and nine seasons as a player, giving him 28 years of NBA experience since being drafted in 1994.

Williams took over the Suns in 2019-20, one year after the team had the second-worst record (19-53) in the NBA. In his first two seasons he led the team to consecutive increases of at least 15 wins despite fewer games being played in both the 2019-20 and 2020-21 shortened seasons. By accomplishing this, the Suns became just the fifth team in NBA history to increase its win total by 15-plus games in successive seasons. Over the last 45 years, the Suns became just the third team to improve from a bottom two record to a top two record in two seasons or less.

In his first season as Suns head coach, Williams helped transform the team's culture and oversaw a 15-win improvement from the season before his arrival despite playing nine fewer games, tied for the largest improvement in the NBA in 2019-20. He was named the NBA Head Coach of the Seeding Games after guiding the Suns to an 8-0 record in the NBA Bubble.

Williams led the Suns to another 15+-win improvement in 2020-21 (51-31), as Phoenix captured their first Pacific Division title since 2007. The Suns led the NBA in assists (27.2 per game) with the 10th-best scoring offense. The high-powered offense sent Phoenix to their first NBA Finals appearance since 1993 by defeating the L.A. Lakers (4-2), Denver Nuggets (4-0) and Los Angeles Clippers (4-2) to secure the Western Conference Title. The Suns fell to the Milwaukee Bucks (2-4) in the Finals despite Devin Booker's 28.2 points per game.

Williams guided the Suns to the best Western Conference record in the first half of the 2021-22 season, earning a berth as head coach of Team LeBron in the 2022 NBA All-Star Game in Cleveland. He led the Suns to the NBA's best record and second consecutive Pacific Division title in 2021-22 and set the franchise record for wins (64) and road wins in a season (32).

For his success, Williams was named the recipient of the Red Auerbach Trophy as the 2021-22 NBA Coach of the Year. He joined Cotton Fitzsimmons (1988-89) and Mike D'Antoni (2004-05) as the only Suns coaches to win the award. Recognized by his peers in an honor voted on by all 30 NBA head coaches, Williams won the Michael H. Goldberg NBCA Coach of the Year Award in back-to-back seasons in 2020-21 and 2021-22. During his tenure in Phoenix, Williams earned four Western Conference Coach of the Month Awards to join Alvin Gentry and Mike D'Antoni as the only Suns coaches to win the award at least four times while with Phoenix.

Prior to his time in Phoenix, Williams spent five seasons as head coach of the New Orleans Hornets/Pelicans from 2010-2015, leading the team to two playoff appearances. In his first season, the Hornets won 46 games and he was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for January, 2011 and led New Orleans' return to the playoffs after missing the season prior.

Following the departure of All-NBA guard Chris Paul prior to the 2011-12 season, Williams oversaw the growth and development of one of the league's youngest rosters, increasing the team's win total in three straight seasons culminating in 45 wins in 2014-15. Williams earned his start in coaching as a coaching intern with the San Antonio Spurs for the 2004-05 season when the team won an NBA Championship. Before returning to the bench in 2018-19 as an assistant with Philadelphia, he spent two seasons in the Spurs' front office as vice president of basketball operations from 2016-2018.

Williams also served as one of three assistant coaches for the USA Basketball Men's National Team from 2013-2016. As a member of Mike Krzyzewski's staff, he assisted the USA to perfect overall record of 26-0 and a gold medal at the 2014 FIBA World Cup in Spain and the 2016 Olympics in Brazil.

Drafted 24th overall in the 1994 NBA Draft by the Knicks out of the University of Notre Dame, Williams played nine seasons in the NBA and averaged 6.3 points in 456 games with New York, San Antonio, Denver, Orlando and Philadelphia. Of the seven head coaches he played for throughout his NBA career, six won the NBA Coach of the Year Award at least once at some point in their careers (Pat Riley, Don Nelson, Gregg Popovich, Mike D'Antoni, Doc Rivers, Larry Brown) and four have been enshrined in the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame (Riley, Nelson, Brown, Popovich).

Williams was born in Fredericksburg, Virginia and attended Potomac High School in Oxon Hill, Maryland. Recognized as a revered friend and role model to many in the basketball community and beyond, Williams was also named the recipient of the inaugural Sager Strong Award at the 2017 NBA Awards. The award honors the late, iconic Turner Sports sideline reporter, Craig Sager, and presented annually to an individual who has been a trailblazer while exemplifying courage, faith, compassion and grace.

TEAM NOTES 2023-24

CHARITABLE DONATION: In a win against the Kings on Feb. 7, Detroit shot a perfect 22-of-22 from the free throw line. It was their second time this season going perfect from the stripe, joining a 9-of-9 eff ort against the Grizzlies on Dec. 12. It was their fi fth-most makes from the line without missing a shot in franchise history and the most since they went 24-of-24 against Milwaukee on Jan. 12, 2012. It was the fi fth-most free throws made without a miss by any team this season.

The Pistons have shot .886 FT% (124-of-140) over their past six games, the highest free throw percentage across six games in franchise history. They lead the NBA in free throw percentage in this span and are 5th in the NBA with a .818 FT% since the All-Star break.

BOARD DOMINANT: Detroit has outrebounded their opponent by double-fi gures in each of their last three games: +22 against Brooklyn (50-to-28), +20 against Dallas (56-26) and +11 vs Charlotte (51-40). **Their** +53 combined rebound advantage is the seventh-highest over three games in franchise history and the most since the 1989-90 championship season (+55). Detroit's current streak of three consecutive games with 50+ rebounds is tied for their longest of the season. *See tables to right*.

COMEBACK CITY: After trailing by 23 points (92-69) with 4:59 left in the third quarter against Portland on Feb. 8, the Pistons stormed back to earn a 128-122 victory in overtime. It was tied as the team's largest comeback win since 1997-98, joining Jan. 8, 2021 against Phoenix. It was three points behind their franchise-record 26-point comeback on Feb. 8, 1974, also against Phoenix. Jalen Duren scored 27 points with a career-high 22 rebounds in the win, Jaden Ivey had 26 points on 7-of-7 3FG and Cade Cunningham scored 23, the first time the trio has each scored 20+ points in the same game.

RUNITUP: Detroit scored 148 points against Utah on Jan. 3, 2024. It was their most points of the season and the most in franchise history since their NBA-record 186 against Denver in a triple overtime contest on Dec. 13, 1983. The Pistons have scored at least 140 points 32 times in franchise history and four times since 2000. They scored 141 in an overtime win against Charlotte last season (12/14/22).

DIME CITY: The Pistons dished out 30+ assists in fi ve consecutive games from Jan. 10-20, the second-longest streak in franchise history (6, April 4-12, 1985) and tied as the fourth-longest streak in the NBA this season.

SECOND UNIT SCORERS: Led in bench scoring by Simone Fontecchio (16.0 PPG), Detroit's second unit ranks 7th in the NBA with 39.8 points per game and 11th with a .360 3PT% this season.

On Jan. 20 against Milwaukee, the Pistons tied their franchise record with 85 bench points, the most by any bench unit in the NBA this season. The bench scored 60+ points in three of four games from Jan. 15 - 22.

START 'EM YOUNG: Detroit's starting lineup is comprised of five lottery picks under 23 years old, with an average age of 21.6 years old. When all five of **Cade Cunningham, Jaden Ivey, Ausar Thompson, Isaiah Stewart** and **Jalen Duren** started together for the first time on November 27, 2023 against Washington, it was just the 11th time in franchise history that all five Pistons starters were younger than 22 years, 190 days old. It was the third such unique lineup, joining Cunningham, Thompson, Stewart, Duren and Killian Hayes (eight times, 10/25 to 11/10/23) and Ivey, Hayes, Duren, R.J. Hampton and James Wiseman (twice, 4/7 to 4/9/23).

HITTING THE LOTTERY: The Pistons have had 10 players formerly drafted in the lottery (first round, picks 1-14) suit up for them this season, the most in the NBA (Indiana, Sacramento, Toronto, nine). It is tied as the 22nd-most lottery picks to play for a team in NBA history and it is the eighth instance in the last 10 seasons (since 2013-14). See below the list of lottery picks that have donned a Pistons jersey this season:

HITTINGTHE COURT: As of March 6, 2024, the Detroit Pistons have had 27 players appear in a game, tied with 2021-22 for the most in a single season in franchise history and the 10th-most in NBA history. The addition of **Taj Gibson** will be their 28th different player if he appears in a game, setting the franchise record and tied for the fourth-most in NBA history. The all-time NBA record is 30 unique players on Houston in 2020-21, and Milwaukee and Washington both had 29 in 2021-22. Gibson will be the 54th player to take the court as a Piston over the past three seasons.



30-BURGERS: Detroit's leading scorer, Cunningham scored 30+ points in five of six games from December 26 to January 5. He averaged 28.3 points, 4.8 rebounds, 8.7 assists, 1.0 steals and 0.8 blocks while shooting .525 FG% in 37.0 minutes per game in that span.

Cunningham has reached 30 points four times in 10 games since the All-Star break, averaging 25.4 points, 7.9 assists, 5.1 rebounds and 0.5 steals on .481 FG%, .438 3PT% and .913 FT%. Jalen Duren ranks **5th** in the NBA with 11,7 rebounds per game and **9th** with \$ offensive boards

No Piston has ever averaged at least 14.0 PTS, 12.0 REB and 2.0 AST on .600 FG% or better in a season.

FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: Duren scored 22 points and with 21 rebounds and a careerhigh nine offensive boards against Oklahoma City on Jan. 28 for his first career 20-20 game. It was the first 20-20 performance by a Piston since Andre Drummond (Jan. 31, 2020) and the fourth-youngest overall in NBA history (20 years, 71 days old). Adding his six assists, it was the ninth 22-21-6 line in Pistons franchise history and the first since Drummond (Nov. 27, 2017).

He later grabbed a career-high 22 boards with 27 points and three blocks in an OT win vs. POR (2/8) for his second career 20-20 game. He became the youngest player in NBA history (19 years, 82 days) with at least 27 PTS and 22 REB in a game.

HISTORICALLY PERFECT: On Jan. 15 in Washington, Duren scored 20 points and tied his then career-high of 19 rebounds (set career-high 17 defensive boards) on a perfect 8-of-8 from the floor. It was the first time in franchise history that a player had a 20-19 game on 100% shooting and was just the 11th instance in NBA history, joining Clint Capela (once), Dikembe Mutombo (once) and Wilt Chamberlain (eight times). It was his sixth career 20-point double-double and 10th game with 15+ rebounds.

WALKING DOUBLE-DOUBLE: A near automatic double-double, Duren been off to one of the best starts in franchise history in the two-pronged statistic. He ranks among franchise leaders in most double-doubles through his number of games played in the season (see table to right). He leads the team and ranks T-9th in the NBA with 35 doubledoubles this season.

NUMBER 1,000: Duren grabbed his 1,000th career rebound in a double-double against Sacramento on Feb. 7, becoming the sixth-fastest player (102 games) to reach 1K career boards in franchise history. At 20 years, 81 days old, Duren became the second-youngest player to reach 1000 career boards in NBA history (Howard, 19 years, 356 days).



Duren received his second NBA Rising Stars selection this season as one of 10 outstanding sophomores. He competed alongside Jaden Ivey on Team Tamika in this year's challenge.

FITTING RIGHT IN: After being acquired from the Utah Jazz on Feb. 7 for Kevin Knox, the rights to Gabriele Procida and a 2024 second-round pick, Fontecchio came out firing in his first game as a Piston, scoring 20 points with a T-career-high nine rebounds, one assist and one steal against the L.A. Clippers (2/10). It was the eighth-most points by a player in their Pistons debut in the past 25 seasons (since 1998-99), and joined Blake Griffin (Feb. 1, 2018) as the only player to add at least nine rebounds as well. Fontecchio attempted 19 field goals in 32 minutes played, including 10 shots in his first 10 minutes, tied with Marcus Morris (Oct. 27, 2015) as the most attempted field goals in a Pistons debut since Rip Hamilton (Oct. 30, 2002). Fontecchio has scored 198 points as a Piston, his most points over any career 13-game span (15.2 PPG).

It was his most points in any professional competition since scoring 30 for Team Italy agaisnt Serbia in the 2023 FIBA World Cup on Sept. 1, 2023.

IT'S IN HIS BLOOD: Fontecchio's mother, Malì Pomilio, played basketball for the Italian National Team from 1983-89 and won two European titles for AS Vicenza...His grandfather, Vittorio Pomilio, played for the Italian National Team from 1957-60...Fontecchio's father, Daniele, was a professional Italian hurdler who won silver in the 60 meter hurdles at the 1986 European Indoor Championships and in the 110 meter hurdles at the 1985 European Cup, along with 10 national championships at the Italian individual senior level.

INTERNATIONALLY KNOWN: One of four active NBA players born in Italy (Danilo Gallinari, Nico Mannion, Reggie Jackson) and just one of 11 Italian-born players in NBA history, Fontecchio is an active member of the Italian National Basketball team. In the 2023 FIBA World Cup, he led the team with 18.0 points and 28.9 minutes across seven games to go with 5.6 rebounds and 1.4 assists en route to a quarterfinals appearance. He led the Italians in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics as well with 19.3 points and 30.3 minutes with 3.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 steals across four games in another quarterfinals appearance.

OLYMPIC MEDALIST: Fournier starred on the French National Team in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, where he led the team with 18.7 points per game with 3.2 rebounds and 2.5 assists on .378 3PT% in 28.3 minutes across six games. The French went 5-1 overall in the tournament and fell to the United States, 87-82, in a tightly contested gold medal game. He led the team again in scoring at the 2023 FIBA World Cup with 13.8 points per game as the French came in 18th. In total, Fournier has seven international basketball medals: he won bronze in the FIBA World Cup in both 2019 and 2014, earned silver at the 2022 FIBA EuroBasket and bronze in the same event in 2015, bronze on the French U-20 Team at the 2011 European Championship and silver in the 2009 European U-18 Championship. He ranks 15th in French National Team history with 1,239 points.

In his international career, Fournier played in 59 games with Union Poitiers Basket 86 of the French League...In 2011-12, averaged 14.0 ppg., 3.2 rpg., 2.2 apg. and 1.50 stlpg. in 26.0 minpg....At 19 years old, became the youngest player in French League history to score at least 20 points in a game with 21 on Feb. 5, 2011 against SLUC Nancy...Earned the French League Rising Star Award as the league's most improved player in both 2011 and 2012...Participated in the Nike Hoop Summit in 2011.

HAVE A NIGHT: Ivey scored 32 points on Jan. 17 against Minnesota with four rebounds, six assists and one steal on 4-of-6 3FG. It capped a run of six games where he averaged 21.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, 6.2 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks, joining Cade Cunningham (once) and Grant Hill (three times) as the only first-or-second year players in franchise history to average at least 21-5-5-1-1 over any six game stretch.

He recorded the best offensive night of his career on Feb. 7 in Sacramento, where he scored a career-high 37 points with five 3-pointers to go with six rebounds and seven assists. It was his fifth career 30-point game and second of the season.

SCORING MACHINE: In eight games from Dec. 21 to Jan. 5, Ivey averaged 16.5 points with 5.0 rebounds and 4.3 assists on .485 (16-of-33) 3PT%. It was the highest 3-point shooting percentage over any eight-game span in his career. The stretch included back-to-back games with 20 points from Dec. 21-23. He later shot .484 3PT% (15-of-31) over seven games from Jan. 17-31.

He showed off his smooth stroke on Feb. 8 against Portland, where he made a career-high seven 3-pointers on a perfect 7-of-7 from behind the line. It was tied for the 16th-most 3-pointers in a game in franchise history and the second-most without a miss, trailing only Ben Gordon's 9-of-9 night from 3-point territory on March 21, 2012 against Denver.



COMING OUT PARTY: Sasser erupted for a career-high 26 points (11-17 FG, 3-7 3FG, 1-1 FT) on November 8 against Milwaukee and set a career-high in scoring in three of four games; he dropped 22 points on 4-6 3FG on November 5 against Phoenix after scoring 19 points (5-8 3PT) the game prior against New Orleans (11/1). He has scored 10+ in six straight games two other times: Oct. 25 - Nov. 2, 2023 and Feb. 8-24, 2022. He averaged 13.3 points per in this span, the highest 11-game scoring average in his career.

He joins Giannis Antetokounmpo, Anthony Davis, Nikola Jokic and Scottie Barnes as the only NBA players with such minimums this season.

SWIPER: Thompson recorded a steal in 12 consecutive games from Jan. 24 to Feb. 22 (1.6) steals per game), the longest streak by a rookie this season the third-longest by a rookie in franchise history. He collected a career-high five steals against Cleveland on March 1, the most by a Piston this season and the sixth-most by a rookie in franchise history.

ATTACK THE GLASS: Thompson has been an undersized force crashing the boards this season. He leads NBA players 6'7" or shorter with 129 offensive rebounds (2.2 per game), 36 more than the next-highest player (Zion Williamson), and is second with 402 total boards (6.4 per game). He ranks third among guards this season in offensive rebounds, behind Saddiq Bey (167) and Scottie Barnes (141), and sixth overall in guard rebounds.

ROOKIE RANKINGS: Among Pistons rookies in the past 50 seasons through their first 63 career games, Thompson ranks 6th in total rebounds (402), 6th in offensive rebounds (129), **8th** in blocks (59) and **6th** in steals (68). See below where he ranks among this year's rookie class:



SEASON HIGH: Wiseman scored a season-high 20 points with 10 rebounds against Philadelphia (12/15). It was his second career 20-10 game, both with the Pistons. It was his seventh career 20-point game and first since March 19, 2023 and his first game with 10+ rebounds since April 9, 2023. He followed the performance with 17 points against Milwaukee (12/16), and his 37 points were his most in any two-game span as a Piston.
