Detroit picked up its fourth-straight win with a 121-112 win over the Washington Wizards at Little Caesars Arena on 2/11...Detroit scored 61 points in the first half, marking the fifth-straight game the Pistons have scored 60-plus through the first two quarters...That is the longest such streak since Detroit scored 60-plus first-half points in six-straight from 11/15/1985 - 11/27/1985...The Pistons finished 44-of-85 (.518) from the floor, marking their third-best shooting percentage in a game this season...Detroit dominated in the paint, outscoring the Wizards, 56-40... **Blake Griffin** (31) and **Andre Drummond** (32) both eclipsed 30 points in the same game for the first time while playing together...**Drummond** became the first Piston to ever record at least 32 points, 17 rebounds and four steals in the same game since steals became an official stat in 1973-74...**Griffin** totaled 31 points, nine rebounds and nine assists in a team-high 40 minutes of action...**Reggie Jackson** (16) and **Luke Kennard** (15) both made four 3-pointers en route to double-digit points...**Kennard** had one triple in every quarter while **Jackson** made all four of his in the second half...The Pistons dominated in the first frame, outscoring the Wizards, 36-27, behind 14-of-25 (.560) shooting with eight assists...**Drummond** tallied 11 points and grabbed five boards as the Pistons outrebounded the visitors, 15-9...**Griffin** added 12 points in the second frame as Detroit held on for a 61-59 lead at the intermission...**Griffin** tallied 20 points in the first half along with five boards and five assists, while **Drummond** totaled 17 points and 10 boards...The Pistons regained control in the third, outscoring the Wizards, 29-20, behind .688 (11-16 FG) shooting...Detroit extended its lead to 15 (107-92) midway through the fourth quarter...Washington cut the lead to single digits with 16 points from Bobby Portis in the frame, but the Pistons never let it get any closer than eight as they earned the playoff tiebreaker over the Wizards by going 2-1 in the three-game series in 2018-19.

Detroit picked up its third-straight win with a 120-103 win over the New York Knicks at Little Caesars Arena on Feb. 8...The Pistons are now 16-13 at home on the year, including 11-7 against Eastern Conference opponents...Detroit's biggest lead of the game was 23, and the Pistons never trailed after taking a 2-1 lead with 10:56 remaining in the opening quarter...Detroit made 13 triples tonight against the Knicks, marking its fourth-straight game with double-digit 3-pointers...**Andre Drummond** recorded a season-high 29 points (12-15 FG) to go along with 20 rebounds, two assists, one steal and a team-high three blocks...**Drummond** finished with a +39 plus/minus rating tonight, marking the highest plus/minus for a Piston in a game since April 17, 2012...**Blake Griffin** totaled 26 points, six rebounds and four assists...**Reggie Jackson** scored 20 points (8-14 FG, 4-5 3FG) to go along with a team-high six assists...**Luke Kennard** (12) and **Ish Smith** (11) led the Pistons reserves in scoring...Detroit flew out of the gate with 41 points in the first quarter, setting its season high for scoring in first frame and taking a 41-22 lead after 12 minutes of action...The Pistons shot .600 (15-25 FG) in the quarter and had nine assists...Dennis Smith Jr. scored nine of his game-high 31 points in the second quarter as the Knicks fought their way back into the contest, outscoring Detroit, 31-22, in the quarter to cut the deficit to nine (63-54) at half...New York managed to tie the game twice late in the third quarter, but 13 points from **Griffin** in the period kept Detroit on top, 89-84, going into the fourth...**Drummond** controlled the pace of play with 10 rebounds in the fourth quarter alone, **Jackson** went 3-of-3 from the floor for six points and **Glenn Robinson III** made both of his field goal attempts for five points as the Pistons used a 10-2 run to open the fourth and take a double-digit lead throughout the remainder of the game.

Detroit picked up its second-straight win with a 105-92 win over the New York Knicks at Madison Square Garden on 2/5...The Pistons won their fifth-straight game against the Knicks...Detroit never trailed in the game as after the score was tied at 2-2, the Pistons took the lead for the remainder of the contest...**Blake Griffin** set the tone with 20 first-half points, finishing the game with 29 points, six rebounds and a team-high eight assists...**Andre Drummond** tallied his NBA-leading 21<sup>st</sup> game with at least 15 points and 15 rebounds...**Drummond** also tied a season high with five swats...**Reggie Jackson** finished with 19 points, two rebounds and seven assists with just one turnover...The Pistons took the early lead with 36 points in the opening quarter, led by 14 points from **Griffin**...Detroit went 13-of-22 from the field and 6-of-12 from distance in the first frame...The Pistons led by double-digits for the majority of the frame, but New York cut the deficit to eight (36-28) after 12 minutes of play...The Knicks opened the second on a 14-7 run, making it a one-point contest (42-43) with 8:07 remaining in the half...Detroit extended the lead back to nine (63-54) at the half...Both teams went cold in the third frame, combining for just 32 points as Detroit held a 78-71 advantage after three quarters...The Pistons shut the door in the fourth quarter, holding New York to just 21 points while knocking down some clutch free throws late and getting a big 3-pointer from **Griffin**...**Jackson** went 4-of-4 from the charity stripe in the fourth quarter to preserve the win for Detroit.

- > Detroit went 1-2 against the Boston Celtics last season.

- > Detroit holds a 108-204 all-time record against the Celtics with a 63-86 record at home and a 41-95 road record.

**GRIFFIN THE ALL-STAR:** Blake Griffin was named an NBA All-Star for the sixth time in his career after being selected as reserve for the 2019 All-Star Game in Charlotte on Feb. 17. Griffin was an All-Star in five-straight seasons from 2010 to 2015, and it is his first selection as a member of the Detroit Pistons. He is averaging a career-best 26.2 points per game and leads the Pistons in assists (5.4 app) with a career-best 124 makes from 3-point range.

**GRIFFIN OWNS JANUARY AND NEW RECORD:** Blake Griffin scored 24 points against Dallas on Jan. 31, giving him a total of 445 points for the entire month of January. His 445 points set the Pistons all-time record for most points in a single month. Below are the top scoring outputs in a month by any Piston:

**THERE'S A NEW NO. 1:** Andre Drummond recorded the 2,430<sup>th</sup> offensive rebound of his career in the third quarter versus Dallas on Jan. 31, passing Bill Laimbeer (2,429) for the most offensive rebounds all-time in Pistons history. Drummond leads the NBA in offensive boards since entering the NBA in 2012-13.

**PROMINENT PISTONS ELIGIBLE FOR NBA HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 2019:** Detroit has several former players announced in this year's eligible candidates list for the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Former Detroit stars that are up for election include Mark Aguirre (with Pistons from 1988-93), Chauncey Billups (2002-2009, 2013-14), Richard Hamilton (2002-2011) and Ben Wallace (2000-2006, 2009-12). Aguirre won two NBA titles with Detroit in 1989 and 1990, while Billups, Hamilton and Wallace were all part of the 2004 NBA Championship squad.

**STREAKING LIKE STACK:** Griffin has continued to put together streaks and tally records that haven't been reached in Detroit history since Jerry Stackhouse in the early 2000's. Some of these include:

- Griffin's 26.2 points per game is highest average for any Piston since Stackhouse (29.8 ppg) in 2000-01.
- Griffin is the first Piston since Stackhouse to record multiple streaks of at least three games with 30-plus points in a single season.
- First since Stackhouse to have multiple streaks in a season of at least five games with 25-plus points.
- Griffin's 19 games with 30 or more points are the most in a single season since Stackhouse in 2000-01.
- Griffin's 22 games with at least 20 points/five rebounds/five assists passed Stackhouse's 19 such games in 2001-02 – his most ever as Piston.
- Griffin is the first Piston since Stackhouse with multiple 40+ point games in a season.

**DOING IT ALL:** Blake Griffin has led the Pistons in scoring, passing and rebounding in the same game five times this year, with the most recent at Washington (1/21). Griffin has scored 20-plus points in 41 of 53 games this season, leading the Pistons in scoring in 38 games on the year, and he has led the team in rebounding in nine games and passing in 28 games.

**DROPPING 40-BOMBS:** Blake Griffin became the first Piston to record multiple 40-plus scoring efforts in the same season since Jerry Stackhouse had eight such games in 2000-01. Griffin scored a career-high 50 points vs. Philadelphia on Nov. 3 and tallied 44 points at L.A. Clippers on Jan. 12. Griffin also is the first Pistons player to record a 50-point game and a 40-point game in the same season since Stackhouse in 2000-01.

**GRIFFIN GETTING BUCKETS:** Blake Griffin became the first Piston to record 20-plus points in nine consecutive games (11/27-12/15) since Richard Hamilton ripped off nine-straight games with at least 20 points in 2008-09. Griffin currently ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the NBA in scoring at 26.2 points per game, which ranks as the sixth-highest single-season average in team history.

**VERSATILITY AT ITS FINEST:** Blake Griffin is currently the first Eastern Conference player since Antoine Walker in 2001-02 to tally averages of at least 8.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 2.0 3-pointers made. He is also just one of three players in the NBA this season to post averages of at least 25.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists (L. James, G. Antetokounmpo).

**CANT STOP THE RAIN:** The Pistons set a franchise record with 11-straight games making at least 10 triples (1/9-1/29). Detroit had set the previous team record earlier this season after making 10-plus 3-pointers in seven-straight games (11/5-11/21).

**SETTING RECORDS FROM DEEP:** Detroit has made 637 3-pointers through 55 games this season, marking the highest total of any team in franchise history through as many contests. The Pistons have the most 3-point attempts (1,882) for any season through 55 games in team history as well. Detroit is 8-2 when making at least 15 triples this season and 22-17 when making at least 10 threes.

**MOST 3S IN A GAME:** The Detroit Pistons connected on 20 3-pointers at Minnesota on 12/19 and at Atlanta on 11/9, setting the second-highest total in franchise history, as well as recorded the third-highest total with 18 triples at Chicago on 10/20. **DEFENSIVE SPECIALIST:** Andre Drummond is currently one of two players in the NBA (Anthony Davis) to average at least 1.5 steals per game and 1.5 blocks per game. Drummond is the first Piston to post such averages since Ben Wallace in 2005-06 (1.8 spg, 2.2 bpg), and is currently one of eight players since 2008-09 to do so (min. 10 games).

**DEFENSIVE HISTORY:** Detroit recorded 12-plus steals in three-straight games (1/10-1/14) for the first time since Jan. 11-15, 1998. The Pistons tallied a season-high 13 steals in two of those three games.

**DEFENSIVE IDENTITY:** The Pistons have only allowed nine opponents to shoot .400 or better from 3-point range this season. The Pistons rank first in the NBA in opponent 3-point percentage (.330) and ninth in the league in opponent scoring (107.9 ppg).

**OWNING THE OFFENSIVE GLASS:** Detroit owns the best offensive rebounding margin in the NBA, currently at +140 offensive rebounds compared to that of their opponent. Detroit grabbed 10 offensive rebounds vs. Washington on 2/11, marking their 37<sup>th</sup> game with 10-plus offensive rebounds this season.

**EXTENDING THE RANGE:** Blake Griffin now has 14 games with four-plus 3-pointers on the season, easily setting the most games he has had in a season with as many threes in his career (had four total games with four or more threes from 2010-18). He has hit at least two treys 38 times through 53 games this season, after totaling 51 games with two or more 3-pointers through 529 career games prior to 2018-19. Griffin has made at least three triples in 24 games this season. Griffin set a career best for a three-game span with 14 triples from 10/20-25, and set a career high with six triples at Houston (11/21).

**CERTIFIED SHOOTER:** Blake Griffin finished with three triples at Utah on 1/14, marking his seventh-straight game with multiple 3-pointers (1/2-1/14). Griffin was one game shy of his career-long streak of eight consecutive games with two-plus 3-pointers (11/11/17 to 11/27/17). His previous season-long streak in 2018-19 with multiple threes was five-straight games (11/14/18 to 11/25/18).

**DRUMMOND'S DOMINATION:** Andre Drummond is among the NBA leaders in a number of categories this season. Some of those include ranking first in rebounds (15.0 rpg), offensive rebounds per game (5.2) and second-chance scoring per game (5.6). Drummond is also fifth in the NBA in defensive rebounds per game (9.8), fourth in points in the paint (14.2 ppg), third in total double-doubles (44) and 11<sup>th</sup> in blocks per game (1.8).

**FIRST TO DO IT IN A MINUTE:** Andre Drummond and Blake Griffin have been dominant throughout the season, as both Drummond (20) and Griffin (16) rank among the leaders in team history for games with 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds through 55 games. Drummond is all-time leader through 55 games with his 20 such games. The franchise record for a season for games with 20/10 since 1982-83 is 28 by Bill Laimbeer in 1984-85.

**25/7/5 CREW:** Since 2010-11, Griffin has recorded 81 career games with at least 25 points, seven rebounds and five assists, which is the fifth-most games among all players in the NBA in that time period. He has 13 such games in 2018-19, which is tied for the fourth-most in the NBA this season (Giannis Antetokounmpo-21, James Harden-20, Kevin Durant-17, Anthony Davis/LeBron James-13).

**MESSIN' AROUND:** Blake Griffin recorded his first triple-double this season with 19 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists vs. Milwaukee on 12/17. It was his second triple-double as a Piston and his ninth career triple-double. He is the only Piston to have a triple-double since Reggie Jackson (2014-15).

**KING OF THE BOARDS:** Andre Drummond ranked first or tied for first in every rebounding per game category in the NBA last season. Here's a look at how Drummond ranks this season in rebounds per game, defensive rebounds per game and offensive rebounds per game:

**ANDRE 500:** Andre Drummond played in his 500th career game against Utah (1/5). Drummond totaled 6,746 rebounds in as many games, which is the second-highest total for any NBA player through 500 career games since the ABA-NBA merger in 1976-77 (Moses Malone – 7,507). His rebounding total is also the highest for any Pistons player in team history through their first 500 games.

**LEAGUE OF HIS OWN:** Andre Drummond had 16 points, 14 rebounds, three blocks and three steals in the first half against the Rockets (11/23), becoming the only active player to ever record those numbers in any half. Drummond then went on to total 27 points, 12 rebounds, three assists and three blocks in just 26 minutes vs. Denver (2/4), becoming the first NBA player to post such a line in 26 minutes or less since Greg Kelson for Seattle in 1983. He also became the only Piston to ever post a stat line of at least 32 points, 17 rebounds and four steals vs. Washington (2/11).

**3-POINT ERUPTION:** Detroit tied the second-highest total in franchise history with 20 3-pointers against Minnesota on 12/19. The Pistons tied a season high with the makes, and also set a season high for 3-point attempts (48). The Pistons went 9-of-13 from distance in the fourth quarter alone, marking the most triples in a fourth frame since at least 1996-97 and the second-most threes in any quarter during that time period. Blake Griffin led the charge with four 3-pointers in the fourth, while Reggie Jackson made two.

**MAKING HISTORY FROM THE LINE:** Blake Griffin finished 17-of-24 (.708) from the free-throw line on 12/7 vs. Philadelphia. His 24 free throw attempts tied the second-highest single-game total in team history (Drummond – 36, 2015-16). Drummond also made history at the line that night, finishing 7-of-7 (1.000) from the charity stripe, which marks his most makes in a game while staying perfect at the foul line in his career.

**HIGHEST-SCORING HALF IN YEARS:** The Pistons scored 74 points in the first half against the Hawks on 11/9, marking the most points scored in a first half since Dec. 6, 1986 vs. Denver (74). The last time Detroit scored as many points in any half was in the second half at Toronto on March 5, 1996 (74). Five Pistons reached double-digit scoring by half at Atlanta, led by Drummond and Robinson with 12 apiece.



**MONSTER HALVES:** Andre Drummond has recorded 31 halves with at least 10 rebounds this season, the most in the NBA. Drummond has 206 halves with 10-plus rebounds in his career, the most for any player since entering the league in 2012-13. He also has 41 first-half double-doubles over the last seven seasons, the most in the NBA in that time span. Below is a list of the top-five totals for 10-plus rebounds in a half since 2012-13:

**NIGHT TO REMEMBER:** Blake Griffin had a career night with 50 points, 14 rebounds and six assists against Philadelphia on 10/23. Here are some of the records and notes from Griffin's performance:

- Set career highs for points (50), field goals (25) and field goal attempts (35) and tied his career best for 3-pointers made (five) and attempted (10).
- Became the first Piston to record three-straight games of 25-plus points, eight-plus rebounds and five-plus assists to open a season.
- Scored the most points for any Piston with at least 10 rebounds and five assists in a game.
- Became just the second Piston to record a double-double with 50-plus points (George Yardley – 52 points, 20 rebounds on Feb. 4, 1958).
- Became the ninth Piston in team history to record a double-double with at least 40 points.
- His 50 points are the seventh-highest point total in Detroit history, and he became the sixth player in franchise history to ever score at least 50 points.
- Griffin's 28 points in the first half tied the second-highest total in a first half in team history and was one off his own personal record for a half.

## DWANE CASEY

Dwane Casey was named head coach of the Detroit Pistons on June 11, 2018 after seven years at the helm with the Toronto Raptors. Casey comes to Detroit after being named 2018 Coach of the Year by the National Basketball Coaches Association (NBCA) and being honored as the 2018 NBA Coach of the Year as voted upon by national media covering the NBA.

While with the Raptors, Casey led the Raptors to four Atlantic Division Championships and a franchise record five consecutive postseason appearances from 2014-18. Under his leadership, Toronto recorded the franchise's first 50-win season in 2015-16 and proceeded to amass three consecutive 50-win seasons, including a franchise record 59 wins in 2017-18. He was also selected as the Eastern Conference head coach at the 2018 NBA All-Star Game in Los Angeles, CA and led Team LeBron to a win over Team Stephen. Casey left the Raptors as both the franchise's all-time winningest coach with a 320-238 regular season record and their longest tenured coach.

The Raptors posted their second 50-win season in 2016-17, despite missing All-Star point guard Kyle Lowry for 21 games. Casey earned his fourth Eastern Conference Coach of the Month honor in December when the Raptors averaged a conference-best 112.1 points with a +11.1-point differential. Toronto also finished the month ranked second defensively, holding opponents to 101.1 points per game. He became the only coach in franchise history to earn the Coach of the Month award multiple times (December 2017, December 2016, January 2016, November 2014 and December 2013).

In 2015-16, Casey directed the Raptors to their fourth Atlantic Division championship and set a then team record with 56 victories. It marked the first time in franchise history the Raptors had topped 50 wins in a season and Toronto finished second in the Eastern Conference, the highest position in franchise history. Casey showed an ability to adapt and still be successful as he was missing two-fifths of his starting lineup for more than 60 games and started a rookie for 20 games following the NBA All-Star break. He guided the Raptors to a 12-2 mark, setting a team record for wins in January and the best winning percentage (.857) in a month with 10 or more games. The Raptors won a franchise-best 11 consecutive games (January 6-30) and swept a seven-game home stand for the first time in team history.

The Casey-led Raptors picked up a second consecutive Atlantic Division championship and 49 victories in 2014-15. His club had sole possession of first place in the Eastern Conference for the first time in team history and remained there from November 4 – January 1. The defensive-minded Casey showcased an up-tempo offense that set a franchise best with 726 made 3-pointers and was the second-highest scoring unit in team history. They also finished in the top 10 in the league for fewest turnovers for a third straight season.

Toronto recorded 48 wins in 2013-14, won an Atlantic Division championship and locked up the third overall seed in the Eastern Conference. Casey's squad also set a franchise record with 22 road wins and matched an all-time high with 16 victories against Western Conference opponents. Casey continued his emphasis on the defensive end of the court as Toronto ranked in the top 10 in points allowed (98.0, 6<sup>th</sup>) and opponent field goal percentage (.450, 10<sup>th</sup>).

During the 2012-13 campaign, Casey and his coaching staff oversaw the development of a youthful core of players including DeMar DeRozan, Amir Johnson, Jonas Valanciunas and Terrence Ross. DeRozan established career highs in points, rebounds, assists and minutes, Johnson posted career bests in points, rebounds, assists, steals, blocks and minutes and Valanciunas earned NBA Eastern Conference Rookie of the Month honors.

In his first season with the Raptors (2011-12), Casey took a Raptors team that ranked near the bottom of the NBA in every defensive category and transformed the identity producing desirable results. The Raptors finished the season as the league's leader for greatest improvement in opponent field goal percentage and opponent scoring. Toronto ranked in the top 10 in fewest points allowed (9<sup>th</sup>), opponent field goal percentage (8<sup>th</sup>) and 3-point field goal percentage (5<sup>th</sup>). The team finished in the bottom third of the league in all three categories in the previous season.

Casey, 61, has served as a head coach, associate head coach and assistant coach in the NBA for 23 seasons. He has coached in two NBA Finals (1996 and 2011) and three NBA All-Star Games (1996, 1998 and 2018).

Casey spent three seasons (2008-11) as an assistant coach with the Dallas Mavericks. The Mavericks posted a 162-84 (.659) mark during that span, winning 50 or more games in each of Casey's three seasons with the team. Casey was in charge of a defensive unit that held its opponents to 96.0 points per game (6<sup>th</sup> in the NBA) and 45.0% shooting from the field (8<sup>th</sup> in the NBA) in the 2010-11 regular season. In the 2011 postseason, Casey's defense posted series victories over offensive powers the likes of Kobe Bryant, Kevin Durant, Russell Westbrook, LeBron James and Dwyane Wade. Dallas held its playoff opponents to 92.5 points per game and defeated the Miami Heat 4-2 in the Finals to capture the 2011 NBA Championship.

Casey's first NBA head coaching job came with the Minnesota Timberwolves where he served from 2005-07. After going 33-49 in his first season, Casey had the club in playoff contention with a 20-20 record when he was replaced on January 25, 2007.

Casey began his NBA coaching career in 1994 as an assistant with the Seattle SuperSonics. He spent 11 seasons with the Sonics where he served under longtime NBA head coaches George Karl, Paul Westphal and Nate McMillan. He was promoted to associate head coach in November 2000. Nine of his teams in Seattle finished above .500 with five winning 50 or more games. The 1996 Sonics squad won the Western Conference Championship after finishing the regular season with a franchise record 64 victories.

In 14 seasons as an NBA assistant, Casey's teams have registered a 689-427 mark (.617) with eight campaigns of 50 or more wins. His teams have qualified for the playoffs in 11 of those 14 seasons.

Prior to joining the Sonics, Casey spent five years as a head coach in Japan. He also coached Japan's National Team with basketball legend Pete Newell. In the summer of 1998, Casey coached the team to its first World Championship appearance in 31 years.

From 1985-89, Casey was an assistant under legendary collegiate coach Eddie Sutton at the University of Kentucky. The Wildcats posted a 90-40 mark during that span. He also served as an assistant under Clem Haskins at Western Kentucky University from 1980-85.

Casey began his coaching career at Kentucky in 1979 as a graduate assistant under Joe B. Hall. While at Kentucky, he recruited and coached eventual NBA players Winston Bennett, Sam Bowie, Rex Chapman, LeRon Ellis, Shawn Kemp, Chris Mills, Dirk Minnifield, Irving Thomas and Melvin Turpin.

Casey played collegiately at Kentucky and helped the Wildcats register a 30-2 record in his junior season and capture the 1978 NCAA Championship. A four-year letterman, Casey was named team captain his senior year and won Kentucky's all-academic award.

A native of Morganfield, Kentucky, Casey earned a degree in business administration from Kentucky in 1979. He and his wife, Brenda, have a daughter, Justine, and son, Zachary.

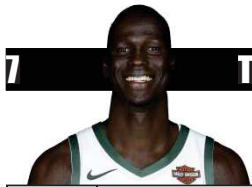
