## SEASON NOTES

**RUN AS ONE:** This marked the 32nd time in 51 seasons that the Rockets made the playoffs. Houston has made the postseason in six straight seasons after missing the playoffs in three straight seasons from 2009-10 through 2011-12. The current six-year streak of making the playoffs is one shy of tying for the longest in franchise history. All-time, Houston is 147-152 (.492) in the playoffs, including 93-57 (.620) at home and 54-95 (.362) on the road.

**65!:** The Rockets finished the season with a 65-17 mark, breaking the previous franchise record of 58 wins in a single season set in 1993-94. This marked the first time Houston finished a season with the league's best record. The 65 wins were tied for the 18th-most in NBA history. Here are some other statistical odds and ends from the season:

- Houston captured its sixth division title in franchise history and its second over the past four seasons after not having any the 20 seasons prior.
- The Rockets had three winning streaks of at least 11 games... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, the Rockets were the sixth team to have three winning streaks of at least 10 games in a single season... the last was San Antonio in the lockout shortened 66-game season in 2011-12.
- Houston went 38-6 over the final 44 games after going 2-7 the nine games prior from 12/20-1/6... the Rockets won 17 in a row from 1/28-3/7 (second-longest streak in franchise history).
- The Rockets were 42-3 when Clint Capela, James Harden, and Chris Paul played together (lost by two points at New Orleans on 1/26, by three at Toronto on 3/9, and by six to Oklahoma City on 4/7) and 23-14 when they didn't... Houston outscored opponents by 11.5 ppg in the 45 games that trio played together.
- Houston was 34-7 at home this season, including 20 straight wins from 1/10-4/5... that tied for the longest single season home winning streak in franchise history (first 20 home games in 1985-86)... the Rockets have won 30+ home games in four of the past five seasons after doing so four times the 22 seasons prior.
- The Rockets went 18-5 over its final 23 road games, including a season-high 10 straight wins from 2/1-3/7, after losing four of five on the road from 12/25-1/6...the 10-game road winning streak was the second-longest in franchise history (12 from 1/4-3/12/08), Houston was 31-10 on the road this season... **the 31 road wins this season are the most in franchise history and tied for the sixth-most in NBA history.**
- The Rockets won seven of their final eight games which decided by five or fewer points and were 12-4 in such games overall this season.
- Houston was 56-3 when leading after three quarters of play this season and 9-14 when tied or trailing...the Rockets led by double-digits in 58 of the 82 games this season (53-5 mark; biggest blown lead: 26 at Boston on 12/28) and trailed by 10+ points 25 times (11-14 mark; biggest deficit overcome: 22 vs. NY on 11/25)... the Rockets never trailed in 10 games this season.
- The Rockets led the league in point differential (+8.5 ppg) and won by double-digits 38 times, including by 20+ 14 times... the 38 double-digit wins were the most in franchise history, while the 14 20-point wins tied for the most... Houston lost by double-digits eight times this season.
- Houston won both of its overtime games this season (vs. LAL on 12/31; vs. DET on 3/22)... it marked the first time the Rockets had fewer than three overtime games in a single season since having one in 2007-08.

- Houston led the NBA in point differential (+8.5 per) this season... the previous largest point differential in franchise history was 5.8 ppg set in 2016-17.
- The Rockets were second in the NBA in scoring this season (112.4 ppg)...Houston averaged 115.3 ppg in 2016-17, marking its first season averaging 110+ since 1985-86... the Rockets were 43-5 when scoring 110+ points (43-5 in 2016-17) and 22-12 when failing to do so (12-22 in 2016-17)... Houston was 19-0 when scoring 120+ points this season after going 30-1 in 2016-17.
- Houston scored below 100 points eight times this season (3-5 mark) after doing so five times in 2016-17... the Rockets scored 100+ points in 25 straight games from 10/30-12/25/17... Houston scored 148 points vs. the L.A. Lakers on 12/31, tying for the fifth-highest total in franchise history and the most since scoring 149 on 2/6/93... the Rockets scored 100+ points through three quarters of play six times, but just once over the final 64 games
- The Rockets ranked tied for sixth in scoring defense this season (opponents: 103.9 ppg) after ranking 26th in 2016-17 (opponents: 109.6 ppg)... from the start of January (47 games), opponents averaged 101.7 ppg, down from 106.9 ppg the first 35 games of the season.
- Houston was 50-8 when holding opponents below 110 points this season (34-5 in 2016-17) and 15-9 when failing to do so (21-22 in 2016-17)... **the Rockets held the opposition below 100 points 35 times this season (32-3 mark) after doing so 18 times in 2016-17.**
- The Rockets averaged a league-high 30.0 first quarter points this season after ranking second with 30.4 ppg in 2016-17... Houston was actually 33-7 when scoring below 30 first quarter points this season and 32-10 when having 30+.
- Houston averaged an NBA high 58.6 first half points this season and was 34-5 when scoring 60+ (34-5 in 2016-17), including 5-0 with 70+ (9-1 in 2016-17)... the Rockets had 90 first half points at Phoenix on 11/16/17 (2nd-most in a first half in NBA history).
- The Rockets held their opponent below 50 first half points in 13 of the final 23 games and 33 times overall this season (31-2 mark) after doing so just 19 times in 2016-17.

- Houston ranked 15th in the NBA in FG% (.460) and 16th in field goal defense (opponents: .462)... the Rockets were 38-2 when outshooting their opponent this season (41-2 in 2016-17) and 27-15 when failing to do so (14-25 in 2016-17).
- The Rockets were 43-5 when shooting 45.0% or better this season (39-6 in 2016-17) and 22-12 when shooting below (16-21 in 2016-17)... Houston was 14-0 when shooting 50.0% or better this season after going 19-2 in 2016-17... the Rockets were 4-5 when shooting below 40.0% this season after going 1-7 in 2016-17.
- Houston was 28-2 when holding opponents below 45.0% shooting this season (34-1 in 2016-17) and 37-15 when failing to do so (21-26 in 2016-17)... the Rockets were 9-1 when holding the opposition below 40.0% shooting this season after going 10-0 in 2016-17.
- Eight of the Rockets 17 losses this season came when opponents shot 50.0% or better (Houston 8-8 mark)... last season, 18 of Houston's 27 losses came when the opposition shot 50.0% or better (Rockets 10-18 mark).

- Houston ranked third in the NBA with 25.1 FTA per game this season after averaging a league-high 26.5 in 2016-17... the Rockets were second in the NBA in FTA differential (+5.5) this season after finishing third in 2016-17 (+4.3 per)... this season marked just the second time Houston held the opposition below 20.0 FTA (2001-02).

## HEAD COACH MIKE D'ANTONI

Mike D'Antoni [dan-TONE-ee] finished his second season as head coach of the Houston Rockets. He has over a quarter of a century of coaching experience, including 14 seasons as a head coach in the NBA with a career mark of 575-470 (.550) in the regular season and 43-44 (.494) in the playoffs. D'Antoni picked up his 500th win at Chicago on March 10, 2017, becoming the 30th coach in NBA history to accomplish that feat. Last season, D'Antoni was named NBA Coach of the Year after guiding the Rockets to a 55-27 mark after Houston went 41-41 in 2015-16. He became the eighth coach in league history to win multiple Coach of the Year awards, and joins Gregg Popovich as the only ones who are active. D'Antoni's first Coach of the Year award came after leading Phoenix to a franchise-high tying 62 wins in 2004-05. Over a four season span from 2004-05 through 2007-08, the Suns compiled a 232-96 (.707) mark, including back-to-back trips to the Western Conference Finals in 2005 and 2006. In addition, D'Antoni served a pair of three-year assignments for USA Basketball as an assistant coach on Mike Krzyzewski's staff, highlighted with gold medal performances in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics. USA Basketball National Teams posted a 49-1 mark with D'Antoni on staff. A dual citizen of the U.S. and Italy, D'Antoni enjoyed tremendous success as both a player and a coach in the Italian League, capturing numerous titles in both endeavors. Prior to embarking on his international career, D'Antoni spent parts of four seasons playing in the NBA and ABA during the mid-70's.
