## SEASON NOTES

**TONIGHT:** Here are some notes about tonight's game and other matters that just didn't fit in anywhere else:

- Since starting the season 1-5 (worst start since going 1-5 in 2010-11), Houston is 6-2 over its past eight games and 7-7 overall this season... the Rockets picked up their seventh loss in Game #32 last season (25-7 mark)... Houston is 6-2 with its preferred starting lineup of Capela, Ennis, Harden, Paul, and Tucker.
- Houston has won a season-high tying three straight after losing two in a row prior... the Rockets lost four straight from 10/21-10/30... Houston only lost more than two in a row once last season, five games from 12/20-12/29... Houston is 3-4 in the first game following a loss this season (10-6 in 2017-18).
- Tonight is the second of three straight at home for the Rockets... after this homestand, Houston will play seven of nine on the road from 11/23-12/8.
- Houston has won its past two home games after losing the first four games at Toyota Center... the Rockets were 4-3 over their first seven games home games last season but finished 34-7... the last time Houston lost its first four home games was a six-game stretch to start 1999-00... the Rockets have won 30+ home games in four of the past five seasons after doing so four times the 22 seasons prior.
- The Rockets snapped a two-game road losing streak with their win at Denver on 11/13... Houston is 5-3 on the road this season after winning a franchise-high 31 road games in 2017-18 (tied for sixth-most in NBA history).
- Houston is 6-3 when Clint Capela, James Harden and Chris Paul play together this season after going 42-3 in 2017-18 (all three losses coming by six or fewer points)... the Rockets outscored opponents by an average of 11.5 ppg in the 45 games Capela, Paul and Harden played together in 2017-18.
- The Rockets have won their past three games by double-digits after not having a win by more than nine points prior this season... Houston won a franchise record 38 games by 10+ points in 2017-18... the Rockets have lost by 10+ points five times this season (8 times in 2017-18)... Houston has three losses by 19+ points this season after not losing by more than 18 points in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 1-1 in games decided by five or fewer points this season (12-4 in 2017-18)... Houston is 5-0 in games it has led by double-digits this season (53-5 in 2017-18)... the Rockets are 1-7 in games in which they have trailed by 10+ points this season (11-13 in 2017-18).
- Houston is being outscored by an average of 1.8 points this season... the Rockets led the league in scoring differential (+8.5 ppg) last season.
- The Rockets are 2-1 in the second game of back-to-backs this season after going 10-3 in 2017-18... Houston has nine back-to-backs remaining this season with the next coming at Detroit on 11/23 and at Cleveland on 11/24.
- Houston is 6-0 when leading after three quarters of play this season and 1-7 when trailing... the Rockets were 56-3 when leading after three quarters of play last season and 9-14 when tied or trailing.
- The Rockets are 4-0 vs. the Eastern Conference this season and 3-7 against the West... Houston was 24-6 against the East last season and 41-11 vs. the West.

**THAT'S MORE LIKE IT:** Since starting the season 1-5, the Rockets have gone 6-2. Here are some statistical observations from the first six games compared to the past eight:

**IT'S A STEAL:** Chris Paul ranks first in the NBA with 2.58 steals per game this season while James Harden is third with 2.27 spg. The last time teammates averaged at least 2.50 spg in a single season was Michael Jordan (2.77 spg) and Scottie Pippen (2.57 spg) for Chicago in 1989-90. Dating back to 2000-01, only five different players have averaged at least 2.50 spg in a single season (Larry Hughes, Allen Iverson 3x, Chris Paul 3x, Gerald Wallace, Metta World Peace). Paul is tied for the sixth-most seasons averaging at least 2.50 spg in NBA history with three. Only 11 players have done so more than twice. Harden ranked seventh in the NBA with 1.75 spg last season while Paul ranked 11th with 1.66 spg.

**LAW OF AVERAGES STRIKES AGAIN:** The Rockets have bucked some statistical trends that were almost sure-fire indications of wins in 2017-18:

- The Rockets are 3-3 when scoring 110+ points this season... Houston was 43-5 when scoring 110+ points last season.
- Houston is 4-2 when holding opponents below 100 points this season after going 32-3 when doing so in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 3-3 when holding opponents below 45.0% shooting this season after going 28-2 when doing so in 2017-18.
- Houston is 5-3 when having 15+ 3FGM this season... the Rockets were 42-4 when having 15+ 3FGM last season.
- The Rockets are 3-4 when holding opponents below 20 assists this season... Houston was 26-3 when opponents had fewer than 20 assists in 17-18.
- Houston is 3-3 when having as many or more assists as opponents this season after going 37-4 when doing so in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 2-4 when having 12 or fewer turnovers this season after going 28-2 when doing so last season.
- Houston is 1-3 when having 10+ steals this season... the Rockets were 27-4 when having 10+ steals in 2017-18.
- Houston is 1-3 when having 7+ blocks this season... Houston was 17-0 when having 7+ blocks in 2017-18.

**65!:** The Rockets finished last season with a 65-17 mark, breaking the previous franchise record of 58 wins in a single season set in 1993-94. It also marked the first time Houston finished a season with the league's best record. The 65 wins were tied for the 18th-most in NBA history.

**YOU'RE THE BEST AROUND:** During the second annual NBA Awards show back in June, James Harden became the third player in franchise history to be named MVP joining Moses Malone (twice) and Hakeem Olajuwon. Harden is the only player to be a unanimous All-NBA First Team selection in each of the past two seasons. He led the league in scoring (career-high 30.3 ppg), while ranking third in assists (8.8 apg). Harden joined Michael Jordan (1987-88) as the only players to have averaged at least 30.0 ppg, 8.0 apg, 5.0 rpg and 1.70 spg in a single season.

**PAUL BALL:** On 7/8, the Rockets re-signed free agent Chris Paul. Last season the Rockets were 50-8 in games in which he played and 15-9 in games that he missed. The Rockets were also 23-2 when Paul scored 20+ points. Paul averaged at least 18.0 points, 7.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds in fewer than 32.0 minutes per game in each of the past two seasons. No other player in league history has done so once. Paul entered this season as the only player in NBA history with career averages of at least 18.0 ppg, 9.0 apg, 4.0 rpg and 2.00 spg.

**IN LIKE CLINT:** On 7/27, the Rockets re-signed restricted free agent Clint Capela. He was runner-up for the NBA's Most Improved Player award after averaging career-highs of 13.9 points, 10.8 rebounds and 1.85 blocks. Capela was the first player in league history to average at least 12.0 ppg, 11.0 rpg and 2.00 bpg in fewer than 31.0 mpg in a single season. He led the league in field goal percentage (.652) while ranking eighth in rebounding and second in blocks. Capela had 42 double-doubles in 74 games played last season after having 25 in 154 games played across his first three seasons.

**CHAMP 2 CHAMP:** The Rockets feature two players, Carmelo Anthony (2012-13) and James Harden (2017-18), who have led the league in scoring. Recent pairings of past scoring champions haven't been as rare as they once were. Stephen Curry and Kevin Durant are in their third season together with Golden State. LeBron James spent a season with Shaquille O'Neal in 2009-10 and four and a half seasons with Dwyane Wade (Miami from 2010-11 through 2013-14; Cleveland in 2017-18). Over a span of 23 seasons from 1986-87 through 2008-09, the only time a team had two players who had already won a scoring title was San Antonio with David Robinson and Dominique Wilkins in 1996-97.

**SCHEDULE NOTES:** Here are some noteworthy items from the Rockets 2018-19 regular season schedule:

- Four of the Rockets first six games were at home... from 11/2-11/10, Houston played a season-high five straight on the road before having four of five at home from 11/11-11/21.
- After playing seven of nine on the road from 11/23-12/8, the Rockets close out the calendar year by playing eight of 11 at home, including Christmas Day vs. Oklahoma City (third Christmas game over the past four seasons).
- Following back-to-back road games to start the New Year, Houston closes out January by playing nine of 12 at home.
- The Rockets open February with seven of nine on the road before playing seven of 11 at home from 2/25-3/17... seven of Houston's final 12 games will be on the road.
- Half of Houston's 12 back-to-backs come before Christmas with four sets falling post All-Star break... Rockets close out March by playing 13 games without more than a day off between.
- The Rockets will face every NBA team at least once at home and once on the road, including Western conference opponents twice both home and away, except for the following: L.A. Clippers (1 home, 2 road), Minnesota (1 home, 2 road), Phoenix (2 home, 1 road), Portland (2 home, 1 road).

**AROUND THE BEND:** Here are some notable milestones within reach this season for several Rockets:

- James Harden needs 70 points to surpass Rudy Tomjanovich (13,383) for the third-most in franchise history.
- Chris Paul is 105 points shy of 17,000 for his career and needs 202 assists to reach 9,000... he is looking to become the fifth player with career totals of at least 17,000 points, 9,000 assists, and 4,000 rebounds... Jason Kidd, Magic Johnson, Oscar Robertson, and John Stockton are the only players to have reached those career milestones.
- Chris Paul ranks ninth in NBA history with 8,798 assists... he is on pace to pass both #8 Gary Payton (8,966) and #7 Isiah Thomas (9,061) this season... Paul also ranks 12th in NBA history with 2,039 career steals and can pass #11 Mookie Blaylock (2,075), #10 Karl Malone (2,085) and #9 Alvin Robertson (2,112) this season.

### HEAD COACH MIKE D'ANTONI

Mike D'Antoni [dan-TONE-ee] is in his third season as head coach of the Houston Rockets. He has over a quarter of a century of coaching experience, including 14 seasons as a head coach in the NBA with a career mark of 582-477 (.550) in the regular season and 43-44 (.494) in the playoffs. Last season, D'Antoni led the Rockets to a franchise record 65 wins after picking up NBA Coach of the Year honors in his first season with Houston in 2016-17. He became the eighth coach in league history to win multiple Coach of the Year awards and joins Gregg Popovich as the only ones who are active. D'Antoni's first Coach of the Year award came after leading Phoenix to a franchise-high tying 62 wins in 2004-05. Over a four-season span from 2004-05 through 2007-08, the Suns compiled a 232-96 (.707) mark, including back-to-back trips to the Western Conference Finals in 2005 and 2006. In addition, D'Antoni served a pair of three-year assignments for USA Basketball as an assistant coach on Mike Krzyzewski's staff, highlighted with gold medal performances in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics. USA Basketball National Teams posted a 49-1 mark with D'Antoni on staff. A dual citizen of the U.S. and Italy, D'Antoni enjoyed tremendous success as both a player and a coach in the Italian League, capturing numerous titles in both endeavors. Prior to embarking on his international career, D'Antoni spent parts of four seasons playing in the NBA and ABA during the mid-70's.
