## SEASON NOTES

**TONIGHT:** Here are some notes about tonight's game and other matters that just didn't fit in anywhere else:

- Houston has lost three of its past four games, including two straight, after winning three straight prior... dating back to 12/11, the Rockets have gone 22-11 after starting the season 11-14... Houston is 33-25 overall this season... the Rockets won a franchise record 65 games in 2017-18 (65-17).
- The Rockets have lost three straight games three times this season, including two four-game streaks... Houston only lost more than two in a row once last season, five games from 12/20-12/29... the Rockets are 13-11 in the first game following a loss this season (10-6 in 2017-18).
- Following tonight's game, the Rockets will play seven of 11 at home from 2/25-3/17... seven of Houston's final 12 games will be on the road.
- Since losing its first four home games, Houston has gone 20-5 at Toyota Center (20-9 mark overall)... the Rockets were 4-3 over their first seven home games in 2017-18 but finished 34-7... the Rockets have won 30+ home games in four of the past five seasons after doing so four times the 22 seasons prior.
- The Rockets have lost two straight on the road after winning four of their previous five road games... Houston is 13-16 on the road this season after winning a franchise-high 31 road games in 2017-18 (tied for sixth-most in NBA history).
- Houston is 15-9 when Clint Capela, James Harden and Chris Paul play together this season after going 42-3 in 2017-18 (all 3 losses coming by six or fewer points)... the Rockets outscored opponents by an average of 11.5 ppg in the 45 games Capela, Paul and Harden played together in 2017-18.
- The Rockets have won 16 games by double-digits this season... Houston won a franchise record 38 games by 10+ points in 2017-18... the Rockets have lost by 10+ points 11 times this season (8 times in 2017-18)... Houston has six losses by 19+ points this season after not losing by more than 18 points in 2017-18... the Rockets have won by 20+ six times this season (franchise-high tying 14 times in each of the past two seasons).
- Houston is 10-9 in games decided by five or fewer points this season after going 12-4 in 2017-18... since starting the season 20-5 in games in which they led by 10+ points, the Rockets have gone 7-6 (27-11 overall; 53-5 in 2017-18... Houston is 7-20 in games in which they have trailed by 10+ points this season (11-13 in 2017-18).
- The Rockets are outscoring opponents by an average of 2.0 points this season... Houston led the league in scoring differential (+8.5 ppg) in 2017-18.
- Houston is 5-3 in the second game of back-to-backs this season after going 10-3 in 2017-18...the Rockets have four sets of back-to-backs remaining with the next coming at Charlotte on 2/27 and vs. Miami on 2/28.
- Houston is 28-5 when leading after three quarters of play this season and 5-20 when tied or trailing... the Rockets were 56-3 when leading after three quarters of play last season and 9-14 when tied or trailing.
- The Rockets are 2-3 in overtime this season after going 5-0 over the past two seasons combined... Houston only went to overtime twice in all of 2017-18, marking its first time playing fewer than three in a season since having one in 2007-08.

**TEN TIMES TWO:** On 2/22, the Rockets signed both Terrence Jones and Chris Chiozza (chee-OH-zah) from the G League to 10-day contracts. Jones was originally the 18th overall pick by Houston in the 2012 NBA Draft following his sophomore season at Kentucky. He spent his first four season with the Rockets and played for both New Orleans and Milwaukee in 2016-17. For his career entering this season, Jones averaged 10.5 points, 5.7 rebounds and 1.2 blocks while shooting 50.1% from the floor. He was playing for the Erie BayHawks in the G League this season, averaging 23.5 ppg, 9.4 rpg, 5.8 apg and 1.5 spg. Chiozza was eligible for the 2018 NBA Draft following his senior season at Florida. He finished his collegiate career as the Gators all-time leader in assists. In 36 games for the Capital City Go-Go of the G League this season, Chiozza averaged 13.1 points, 6.8 assists, 5.0 rebounds and 1.8 steals while shooting 41.5% from 3-point range. He was recently selected to the 2019 USA World Cup Qualifying Team.

**STAT CHANGES:** The NBA is back to fiddling with statistics from recent games. Minnesota had a block removed from the game on 2/13. For the game against the L.A. Lakers on 2/21, there was a turnover by Brandon Ingram that James Harden received credit for a steal; the play has now been changed to a shot attempt by Ingram with Harden getting a block and a defensive rebound.

**MMM, WE WANNA SHUMP:** The Rockets like things in 3's, even when it comes to trades. On 2/7, Houston completed three trades. Long story short, the Rockets acquired Iman Shumpert from Sacramento and traded away Marquese Chriss, James Ennis, and Brandon Knight. Shumpert was originally the 17th overall pick by New York in the 2011 NBA Draft. He is averaging 8.6 points, 3.0 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.1 steals in 26.0 minutes per game this season. Shumpert has hit multiple 3FGM 22 times this season after not doing so more than 24 times in any of his first seven seasons. During his rookie season in 2011-12, Shumpert played for Mike D'Antoni during his rookie season. Shumpert played in three straight NBA Finals for Cleveland 2015 through 2017, winning the championship in 2016. He is shooting 38% from 3-point range in 71 career playoff games.

**NEXT MAN UP:** The Rockets have endured some key injuries this season and been creative in finding production along the way. Five different players who signed with Houston during this season have played 20+ minutes in their Rockets debut. Let's take a look:

- Danuel House Jr. signed with the Rockets from the G League prior to their game at Washington on 11/26 and played 28 minutes, including the entire overtime... he started 12 straight games for Houston from 12/22-1/14 (29.4 mpg) prior to having his NBA days expire as a two-way player.
- Austin Rivers signed with Houston on Christmas Eve and started 13 straight games from 12/31-1/25, averaging 38.1 mpg over that span.
- James Nunnally signed a 10-day contract with Houston on 1/16 (waived on 1/21) and averaged 18.8 minutes played in two games as a Rocket.
- Kenneth Faried signed with the Rockets prior to their game at Philadelphia on 1/21 and has started 11 straight games from 1/23-2/13... he's averaging 29.2 minutes played with Houston.
- Iman Shumpert was acquired by the Rockets at the trade deadline on 2/7... he is averaging 23.1 minutes played in three games as a Rocket.

**CHUTES AND LADDERS:** The Rockets are 11-10 over their past 21 games after winning 11 of their previous 12 after starting the season 11-14. Here's a statistical breakdown of those stretches:

**TROPICAL CLIMATE:** The Rockets rained 3's against Washington on 12/19, hitting an NBA single-game record 26. The previous record was 25 by Cleveland at Atlanta on 3/3/17 and the previous franchise record was 24 vs. New Orleans on 12/16/16. The Rockets have hit 20+ 3-pointers 31 times in franchise history (29 times under head coach Mike D'Antoni); no other team has more than 15 games with 20+ 3FGM. **Houston has hit 20+ 3FGM an NBA single season record 11 times in the 56 games this season after doing so 10 times in 2016-17 and 8 times in 2017-18). No other franchise has hit 20+ 3FGM more than seven times in an entire season.**

**MAMA, THERE GOES THAT MAN:** James Harden is averaging 36.5 points (1st in NBA), 7.7 assists (tied for 5th in NBA), 6.6 rebounds and 2.15 steals (3rd in NBA) this season. Michael Jordan (1988-89) is the only player to have averaged at least 30.0 ppg, 7.0 apg, 6.0 rpg and 2.00 spg in a single season. As usual, Harden has posted some impressive performances along the way:

- Averaging a league-high 36.5 ppg this season... last player to average at least 33.0 ppg in a single season was Kobe Bryant w/35.4 ppg in 2005-06... Harden is averaging 7.7 more ppg than the second-ranked player, which would be the highest differential between the league's top two scorers since Michael Jordan outscored Dominique Wilkins by 8.1 ppg in 1986-87.
- Harden has scored 30+ points in each of the past 32 games, which is the second-longest streak in NBA history... Wilt Chamberlain holds the longest streak of 65 games.
- Harden has scored 40+ points in 16 of the past 26 games and 22 times in 55 games played overall this season... that is the most 40-point games through a player's 55 games played in a season since Michael Jordan had 26 in 1986-87.
- Harden is averaging 40.6 points over the past 34 games... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the second-longest stretch of averaging 40+ points in NBA history... only Wilt Chamberlain (**515!!!!!!**) did so over a longer span.
- Harden surpassed his career-high for 3-pointers made in his 53rd game played this season and now has 276... that is tied for the fourth-highest single season total in NBA history... Stephen Curry holds the top three spots (402 in 2015-16, 324 in 2016-17, 286 in 2014-15).
- Harden has attempted at least 10 3-pointers in each of the past 30 games, which is the longest streak in NBA history... he also holds the second-longest streak of 12 games... no other player has a streak longer than nine games.
- Harden had 43 points, 12 rebounds, 6 steals and 4 blocks at Utah on 2/2... the last player with 40+ points, 12+ boards, 6+ steals and 4+ blocks in a single game was Hakeem Olajuwon (43/13/8/5) at Miami on 4/8/89.
- Harden scored at least 35 points in 11 straight games from 1/9-1/29, which was the fifth-longest streak in NBA history and the second-longest by a player not named Wilt Chamberlain (Kobe Bryant with 13 games from 1/29-2/23/03).
- Harden was the high scorer for the Rockets and their opponent in 24 straight games from 12/13-1/29... according to ESPN, that was the second-longest streak in NBA history, trailing a 40-game span by Wilt Chamberlain.
- Harden averaged 43.6 points, 8.7 rebounds, 7.6 assists, 2.07 steals and 1.21 blocks in 14 games played in January... according to ESPN, he became the fourth player in NBA history to record at least 600 points, 100 rebounds and 100 assists in a single month.
- Harden's points and assists accounted for an average of 61.9 points in the month of January, which was the highest in NBA history according to Elias... Harden's 43.6 ppg in January was the 7th-highest scoring average in a single month (10+ GP) in NBA history (top six by Wilt Chamberlain).
- Harden has scored 50+ points five times this season and 14 times in his career, which is tied for the fifth-most in NBA history.
- Harden averaged 52.2 points over a five-game span from 1/14-1/23... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, that tied for the second-longest stretch of averaging 50+ in NBA history, trailing a [cough] 116-game span by Wilt Chamberlain.
- Harden scored a total of 261 points over a five-game span from 1/14-1/23... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the second-highest five-game total over the past 50 seasons, trailing Kobe Bryant's 268 in March of 2007.
- Harden had a career-high 61 points, 15 rebounds and 5 steals at New York on 1/23... he became the first player to record at least 60 points, 15 rebounds and 5 steals in a game since steals became an official statistic in 1973-74... he is the 5th player with multiple career 60-point games.
- Harden's scoring and assists accounted for 50+ points in an NBA record 19 straight games from 12/13-1/19 according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
- Harden had 58 points vs. Brooklyn on 1/16 after scoring 57 (in 34 minutes played) vs. Memphis on 1/14... according to ESPN, he joined Wilt Chamberlain as the only players to have scored 55+ points in consecutive games.
- Harden hit at least five 3-pointers in 12 straight games from 12/19 through 1/11... no other player had a streak longer than seven games in NBA history... Harden hit 10 3-pointers in an overtime win at Golden State on 1/3, tying the franchise single game record.
- Harden had 43 points, 12 assists and 10 rebounds in 29:34 minutes of play vs. Cleveland on 1/11... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first player in NBA history to record a 40-point triple-double while playing fewer than 30 minutes in a game.
- Harden has recorded a 40-point triple-double four times this season, including consecutive games vs. Memphis on 12/31 and at Golden State on 1/3 ... he has 12 40-point triple-doubles for his career, which is the second-highest total in NBA history (Oscar Robertson with 22).
- Harden recorded at least 35 points and 5 assists in 10 straight games from 12/17-1/5, marking the longest streak in NBA history according to Elias.
- Harden scored 40+ points in five straight games from 12/25-1/3, tying for the third-longest streak dating back to 1963-64.
- Harden had 50 points, 11 assists and 10 rebounds vs. the Lakers on 12/13, becoming the first player to record four 50-point triple-doubles... he also had 54 points and 13 assists at Washington on 11/26... Harden has an NBA record five 50-point/10-assist games in his career.
- Harden had 25 points, a career-high tying 17 assists, 11 rebounds and 6 steals vs. Dallas on 11/28 joining Magic Johnson 33 points, 17 assists, 15 rebounds and 6 steals vs. Denver on 3/29/81) as the only players to post those numbers in a single game.
- Harden had 47 points, 6 rebounds, 5 assists and 5 steals vs. Utah on 12/17, marking his third career game with at least 40 points, 5 rebounds, 5 assists and 5 steals... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the third-highest total in NBA history (Michael Jordan w/10; Clyde Drexler w/4).

**SEICENTO:** Mike D'Antoni recorded the 600th win of his career vs. Memphis on 1/14, becoming the 25th coach to do so in NBA history. He is one of four active coaches with 600+ wins, joining Gregg Popovich, Doc Rivers, Rick Carlisle, and Nate McMillan. D'Antoni was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for December, marking his franchise-best fourth with the Rockets and the ninth of his career.

**BACKCOURT BALLERS:** James Harden had 54 points at Washington on 11/26 while Eric Gordon added 36. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that marked the second-highest combined point total (90) by a starting backcourt since starts were tracked in 1970-71. Kobe Bryant (81) and Smush Parker (13) combined for 94 points for the L.A. Lakers at Toronto on 1/22/06.

**CLIMBING THE CHARTS:** James Harden had 43 points vs. Detroit on 11/21. Along the way, he surpassed Rudy Tomjanovich (13,383) for the third-most points in franchise history. He now trails Calvin Murphy (17,949) by 2,930 points for second place. Harden has scored at least 2,100 points in each of the past four seasons.

**LAW OF AVERAGES STRIKES AGAIN:** The Rockets have bucked some statistical trends that were almost sure-fire indications of wins in 2017-18:

- The Rockets are 24-10 when scoring 110+ points this season... Houston was 43-5 when scoring 110+ points last season.
- Houston is 19-7 when holding opponents below 110 points this season after going 50-8 in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 17-4 when outshooting their opponent this season after going 38-2 when doing so in 2017-18.
- Houston is 22-8 when shooting 45.0% or better this season after going 43-5 when doing so in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 12-7 when holding opponents below 45.0% shooting this season after going 28-2 when doing so in 2017-18.
- Houston is 21-13 when having 15+ 3FGM this season after going 42-4 in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 12-13 when holding opponents below 10 3FGM this season (30-5 in 2017-18) and 20-10 when the opposition shoots below 33.3% from 3-point range (36-4 in 2017-18).
- The Rockets are 6-6 when holding opponents below 20 assists this season... Houston was 26-3 when opponents had fewer than 20 assists in 17-18.
- Houston is 14-7 when having as many or more assists as opponents this season after going 37-4 when doing so in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 11-14 when having 12 or fewer turnovers this season after going 28-2 when doing so last season.
- Houston is 9-6 when having 10+ steals this season... the Rockets were 27-4 when having 10+ steals in 2017-18.
- The Rockets are 11-7 when having 7+ blocks this season... Houston was 17-0 when having 7+ blocks in 2017-18.

**AROUND THE BEND:** Here are some notable milestones within reach:

- Chris Paul needs 11 assists to reach 9,000... he is looking to become the fifth player with career totals of at least 17,000 points, 9,000 assists, and 4,000 rebounds... Jason Kidd, Magic Johnson, Oscar Robertson, and John Stockton are the only players to have reached those career milestones.
- Chris Paul ranks eighth in NBA history with 8,989 assists... he is on pace to pass #7 Isiah Thomas (9,061) this season... Paul also ranks 11th in NBA history with 2,080 career steals and can pass #10 Karl Malone (2,085) and #9 Alvin Robertson (2,112) this season.

### HEAD COACH MIKE D'ANTONI

Mike D'Antoni [dan-TONE-ee] is in his third season as head coach of the Houston Rockets. He has over a quarter of a century of coaching experience, including 14 seasons as a head coach in the NBA with a career mark of 608-495 (.551) in the regular season and 43-44 (.494) in the playoffs. Last season, D'Antoni led the Rockets to a franchise record 65 wins after picking up NBA Coach of the Year honors in his first season with Houston in 2016-17. He became the eighth coach in league history to win multiple Coach of the Year awards and joins Gregg Popovich as the only ones who are active. D'Antoni's first Coach of the Year award came after leading Phoenix to a franchise-high tying 62 wins in 2004-05. Over a four-season span from 2004-05 through 2007-08, the Suns compiled a 232-96 (.707) mark, including back-to-back trips to the Western Conference Finals in 2005 and 2006. In addition, D'Antoni served a pair of three-year assignments for USA Basketball as an assistant coach on Mike Krzyzewski's staff, highlighted with gold medal performances in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics. USA Basketball National Teams posted a 49-1 mark with D'Antoni on staff. A dual citizen of the U.S. and Italy, D'Antoni enjoyed tremendous success as both a player and a coach in the Italian League, capturing numerous titles in both endeavors. Prior to embarking on his international career, D'Antoni spent parts of four seasons playing in the NBA and ABA during the mid-70's.
