SEASON NOTES

WE'RE 50! FIFTY YEARS OLD: This was the 50th season in Rockets franchise history. The San Diego Rockets were established as an expansion team for the 1967-68 season and moved to Houston prior to the 1971-72 season. Houston has gone .500 or better in each of the past 11 seasons, joining San Antonio as the only teams to have done so. Dating back to 1984-85, the Rockets have now gone .500 or better in 30 of 33 seasons. No other team has done so more than 28 seasons (San Antonio and Utah). Houston had the fourth-highest winning percentage (.570; 1514-1144) of any team dating back to 1984-85.

RUN AS ONE: This marked the 30th time in 50 seasons that the Rockets made the playoffs. Houston has made the postseason in 10 of the past 14 seasons, including five straight, after missing the playoffs in three straight seasons from 2009-10 through 2011-12. The current five-year streak of making the playoffs is the third-longest in franchise history. All-time, Houston is 136-146 (.482) in the playoffs, including 86-54 (.614) at home and 50-92 (.352) on the road. The Rockets advanced to the Western Conference Semifinals for the second time over the past three seasons after doing so once over their previous nine playoff appearances from 1997-98 through 2013-14.

ODDS AND ENDS: Here are some notes regarding the Rockets in 2016-17:

- The Rockets clinched a playoff spot on 3/14 with a record of 46-21. Houston did not secure its playoff spot in 2015-16 until the regular season finale.
- Houston played 14 of its first 20 games of the road, then played 12 of 17 at home from 12/5-1/5... from 1/6-1/29, the Rockets played 10 of 14 games on the road before having eight of their next 10 at home from 1/31-2/27... from the start of March through the end of the season, Houston had 11 home games and 10 road games.
- The Rockets won a season-high 10 in a row from 12/1-12/17 and nine straight from 12/26-1/10... the only other time Houston recorded at least two winning streaks of 9+ games in a single season was 1992-93 (15 and 11).
- Houston was 22-5 in the first game following a loss this season and only lost three straight games once (3/28-3/31).
- The Rockets were 30-11 at home this season after going 23-18 in 2015-16... Houston did not lose consecutive home games at all this season... the Rockets have won 30+ home games in three of the past four seasons after doing so three times the 19 seasons prior from 1994-95 through 2012-13.
- Houston was 25-16 on the road this season after going 18-23 in 2015-16... the 25 road wins tied for the third-most in franchise history... the Rockets played 29 of their first 51 games on the road this season... that was tied for the fifth-most road games within the first 51 games of a season in NBA history and was tied for the most in franchise history (1970-71).
- The Rockets led at the start of the fourth quarter in 58 of the 82 games this season (49-8 mark; 5-19 when tied/trailing)... Houston also led by double-digits in 61 of the 82 games (51-10 mark)... the Rockets were 10-21 in games in which they trailed by double-digits this season.
- Houston won 30 games by 10+ points overall this season (14 in 2015-16), which was one shy of tying the franchise record set twice... the Rockets had 14 wins by 20+ points, which tied for the highest single season total in franchise history (2006-07).
- The Rockets were 11-3 in games decided by four or fewer points this season after going 11-10 in 2015-16... Houston did not trail in six games this season and did not lead twice... the Rockets were also 3-0 in overtime this season (4-2 in 2015-16).
- Houston was 13-3 in the second game of back-to-backs this season after going 8-12 in 2015-16.
- The Rockets preferred starting lineup of Ryan Anderson and Trevor Ariza at forward, Clint Capela at center, and Patrick Beverley and James Harden at guard went 30-9... no other lineup was used more than 10 times and there were 15 lineups used overall, eight of which were used just once.

WERE YOU NOT ENTERTAINED?! James Harden had 2,356 points, 907 assists (franchise record for single season), and 659 rebounds this season, becoming the first player in NBA history with at least 2,000 points, 900 assists and 600 rebounds in a single season. Harden also had 2,376 points, 612 assists and 501 rebounds in 2015-16. He is just the third player in NBA history to post multiple seasons with at least 2,000 points, 600 assists and 500 rebounds (Oscar Robertson six times and John Havlicek twice). Harden averaged career-highs of 29.1 ppg, 11.2 apg and 8.1 rpg this season after averaging 29.0 ppg, 7.5 apg and 6.1 rpg in 2015-16 after averaging 27.4 ppg, 7.0 apg and 5.7 rpg in 2014-15. LeBron James (4 times) and Oscar Robertson (8 times) are the only players to have averaged at least 27.0 ppg, 7.0 apg and 5.0 rpg in at least three different seasons.

BELLISSIMO!: On 5/7, the National Basketball Coaches Association (NBCA) named Rockets head coach Mike D'Antoni and Heat head coach Erik Spoelstra the co-recipients of the inaugural Michael H. Goldberg NBCA Coach of the Year Award. It is the only award voted upon by the head coaches of the 30 NBA teams. The Michael H. Goldberg NBCA Coach of the Year Award is named after the longtime Executive Director of the NBCA. D'Antoni guided the Rockets to a 55-27 mark this past season after Houston went 41-41 in 2015-16. The 55 wins were tied for the fourth-most in franchise history. On 3/10, D'Antoni became the 30th head coach in NBA history to win 500 career games.

- Houston ranked second in the NBA in scoring this season with 115.3 ppg, which also tied for the second-highest scoring average in franchise history... from the start of December (64 GP), the Rockets averaged a league-high 117.0 ppg.
- The Rockets averaged 115.3 points this season, marking their first season averaging at least 110.0 ppg since 1985-86 (114.4)... dating back to 1995-96, 13 teams have averaged at least 110.0 ppg (four this season), four of which were coached by Mike D'Antoni.
- Houston was 43-5 when scoring 110+ points this season and 12-22 when failing to do so... the Rockets scored 120+ points 31 times this season (30-1 mark), which was the second-highest total in franchise history (38 times in 1969-70)... Houston scored 120+ points in four straight games from 12/26-12/31 for the first time since 3/23-3/28/79.
- The Rockets scored 130+ points 12 times this season, which was the second-highest total in franchise history (14 in 1969-70)... that was also the highest single season total by any team dating back to 1992-93... Houston had a season-high 142 points vs. Minnesota on 2/25, marking its second-highest total dating back to 1995-96... the Rockets scored 140+ points twice this season after doing so twice from 1995-96 through 2015-16.
- Houston scored 100+ points in a franchise-high 61 straight games from 11/23-3/30, breaking its previous mark of 47 game from 12/23/69-3/22/70... that was the longest streak by any team since a 75-game span by Denver from 12/2/86-11/20/87... the Rockets only scored below the century mark five times this season (2-3 mark)... Houston had 100+ points before the start of the fourth quarter 13 times this season.
- The Rockets were 34-5 when holding opponents below 110 points this season, including 18-0 below 100, and 21-22 when failing to do so.
- Houston scored 30+ first quarter points 49 times this season and ranked second in the NBA with 30.4 first quarter ppg... the Rockets scored 60+ first half points 38 times this season, including 70+ nine times and ranked second in the NBA with 59.1 first half ppg... Houston had 79 first half points vs. Oklahoma City on 3/26... according to ESPN Stats and Information, that tied for the second-most first half points in franchise history.
- Houston had at least six players score in double-figures 33 times this season (7+ nine times)... all five starters scored 10+ points 14 times this season.

- Houston ranked 12th in the NBA in field goal shooting this season (.462 and were 42-2 when outshooting its opponents and 13-25 when failing to do so.
- The Rockets were 39-6 when shooting 45.0% or better this season, including 19-2 shooting 50.0% or better, and 16-21 when shooting below 45.0%, including 1-7 when shooting below 40.0% (3-10 in 2015-16).
- Houston shot 66.3% in their win vs. Oklahoma City on 3/24, marking its highest percentage since shooting 63.4% at Milwaukee on 1/24/95... the Rockets defeated Cleveland on 3/12 despite being outshot 52.5% to 42.7%... the last time Houston won a game in which it shot below 43.0% while its opponent shot 52.0% or better was at Golden State on 11/23/96.
- The Rockets were 34-1 when holding opponents below 45.0% shooting, including 10-0 below 40.0%, and 21-26 when failing to do so, including 10-18 when the opposition shot 50.0% or better... 18 of the Rockets 27 losses came when opponents shot 50.0% or better.

Rockets were 19-10 when having as many or more FTM as opponents had FTA (14-10 in 2015-16) and 6-7 when opponents had as many or more FTM as the Rockets had FTA (4-7 in 2015-16).

- The Rockets averaged an NBA-high 26.5 FTA this season while opponents averaged 22.2... Houston ranked third in the NBA in FTA differential at +4.3 per game.
- Houston recorded 30+ FTA 29 times this season (21-8 mark)... opponents only had 30+ FTA four times over the final 57 games after doing so five times the first 25 games of the season... the opposition had 30+ FTA nine times overall this season, down from 19 times in 2015-16.
- Houston shot 76.6% from the line this season after shooting 69.4% in 2015-16... that marked just the third time shooting below 70.0% in franchise history ... this season marked the Rockets highest FT% since shooting 78.2% in 2011-12.
- From the start of January (47 games) the Rockets had more FTM (611; 809 FTA) than opponents had FTA (609)... Houston had more FTM than opponents had FTA 29 times this season.

HEAD COACH MIKE D'ANTONI

Mike D'Antoni [dan-TONE-ee] has over a quarter of a century of coaching experience, including 13 seasons as a head coach in the NBA with a career mark of 510-453 (.530). He was named NBA Coach of the Year in 2004-05 after leading Phoenix to a franchise-high tying 62 wins. Over a four-season span from 2004-05 through 2007-08, the Suns compiled a 232-96 mark (.707), including back-to-back trips to the Western Conference Finals in 2005 and 2006. In addition, D'Antoni served a pair of three-year assignments for USA Basketball as an assistant coach on Mike Krzyzewski's staff, highlighted with gold medal performances in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics. USA Basketball National Teams posted a 49-1 mark with D'Antoni on staff. A dual citizen of the U.S. and Italy, D'Antoni enjoyed tremendous success as both a player and a coach in the Italian League, capturing numerous titles in both endeavors. Prior to embarking on his international career, D'Antoni spent parts of four seasons playing in the NBA and ABA during the mid-70's. During his tenure as head coach in Phoenix, at the time, the Suns posted the three highest single season totals for 3FGM in NBA history from 2004-05 through 2006-07. **Prior to 2004-05, only three teams had more than 700 3FGM in a single season in NBA history. Since D'Antoni's final season with Phoenix in 2007-08, 73 teams have hit 700+ 3FGM in a single season, including 25 of the 30 teams in 2016-17.** The Rockets had an NBA single season record 1,181 3FGM in 2016-17.
