**Consistency Through the Years:** The Oklahoma City Thunder is .500 or better against 21 of its 29 opponents in Thunder history. Oklahoma City ranks tied for the sixth highest percentage of seasons (.667) making the playoffs since 2008-09.

**Leading the Way:** Since the NBA/ABA merger in 1976 the Thunder enjoyed the most successful first 15 seasons of any expansion or relocation team. The Thunder ranks first in wins per season, winning percentage, net rating, playoff series wins, Conference Finals Appearances and tied for 1st in NBA Finals appearances, compared to the other 17 expansion or relocation teams. Additionally, the Thunder ranks first with four First Team All-NBA players (nine total First Team All-NBA selections) when compared across the same timeline to those other 17 teams.

**League Leaders:** Oklahoma City is tied with the LA Clippers for the most 40-win seasons (13) in the league since the 2009-10 season.

**Win Improvement:** Oklahoma City won 16 more games during the 2022-23 season than the 2021-22 season. The 16-win improvement was the second highest in the league behind only the Sacramento Kings.

**50% Shooting:** The Thunder has shot 50 percent or better from the field in 35 games this season, the most games in a single season in team history. Previous high was 29.

**Young and Running:** In a win at Portland on 3/6, marked the 8th game the Thunder had multiple players, both age 25 or younger, each score 30+ points this season. That is tied for the 3rd-most games in a season for any team in NBA history, trailing the 1983-84 Mavericks and 2011-12 Thunder. Gilgeous-Alexander and Williams have done this in 5 games and Gilgeous-Alexander and Chet Holmgren have done this in 3 games.

**Excellent Efficiency:** Oklahoma City ranks top-three in the league in field goal percentage (2nd, 50.0), free throw percentage (1st, 83.2), and three-point percentage (1st, 39.4). No other team ranks in the top five in all three.

**All-Star Starter:** Shai Gilgeous-Alexander was named a 2024 NBA All-Star starter, it was announced on 1/25 by the NBA. He is the fourth different Thunder player to be named an NBA All-Star starter, tied for second most by any team since 2008-09.

**Rising Stocks:** Oklahoma City ranks top-five in the league in both steals (t-2nd, 8.2) and blocks (1st, 6.7) per game. Shai Gilgeous-Alexander leads the league in total steals (135) and steals per game (2.0) while Chet Holmgren ranks fourth in blocks per game (2.5) and tied for second in total blocks (165). Holmgren has three games this season with 7+ blocks.

**Effective at Both Ends:** Oklahoma City ranks 3rd in offensive rating (119.0) and 5th in defensive rating (111.5), leading to OKC holding the second-best net rating in the league (7.6).

**SGA's Season:** Shai is currently averaging 30.9 points per game on 54.4 percent shooting from the field through his first 66 games. On top of his scoring frenzy, Gilgeous-Alexander is averaging 5.7 rebounds, 6.3 assists, and a league-leading 2.0 steals per game. SGA became only the third player ever to average 30+ points and 2.5+ steals per game through the first 25 games of a season.

- He is on pace to become only the third player in NBA history to average at least 30-plus points and two-plus steals while shooting 50% or better from the field (Stephen Curry and Michael Jordan).
- Leads the NBA in steals and is second in deflections.
- After a terrific start in Chicago, Gilgeous-Alexander posted 34 points, 11 rebounds, and five steals, becoming the 3rd player (4th instance) in Thunder history with consecutive 30-point double-doubles to begin the season.
- Had a career-best seven steals in a win over the Spurs on 11/14, **tying the highest single-game total from a player this season.**
- Scored 38 points and had five rebounds, five assists, and five steals in an OT win over Golden State on 12/8. Became the first player to average 30 points and 2.5 steals through his first 20 games of a season since Michael Jordan in 1988-89.
- Shai knocked down a game-winning shot with 0.9 seconds left to clinch a one-point victory in Denver on 12/16.
- Became the first player to record 70 steals through his first 25 games of a season since Ricky Rubio in 2013-14.
- In a win over Minnesota on 12/26, SGA had his 9th straight game with 25 Pts & multiple steals (longest streak by any player since LeBron James in 2008 - also 9 straight)
- Became the third player in NBA history to have a 10-game streak of 25+ points and 2+ steals (Allen Iverson and Michael Jordan).
- Reached his 100th career 30-point game with the Thunder on 12/29 at Denver becoming, the 3rd player to reach the mark in Thunder history, joining Russell Westbrook and Kevin Durant.
- Became the eighth player in NBA history to have 30 games of 30+ points in their first 41 games of the season. Leads the NBA in 30-point games this season (49).
- Became the first player in Thunder history to reach 35/9/8/3/3 in a win at Phoenix on 3/4.

**Holmgren's Hustle:** Holmgren is averaging 16.8 points, 7.9 rebounds, 2.7 assists, and 2.5 blocks in his rookie season.

- First player in NBA history to reach 150+ blocks, 150+ assists, and 100+ made 3-pointers in a season.
- Holmgren has eight games with three blocks and three 3-pointers this season, the most by a rookie all-time.
- Chet Holmgren set the Thunder rookie record for blocks in a game with seven in a win over the Cavaliers in Cleveland. Holmgren posted 16 points, 13 rebounds, seven blocks, and three made three-pointers, becoming the first rookie in NBA history to reach those numbers or better. Also became the third player since 1973-74 with 15 pts, 10 reb, & 5 blocks in a game within their first two career games.
- Chet Holmgren became the first player in NBA history to average 50/50/90 shooting splits and score 100+ points through his first seven career NBA games. On top of that, Holmgren and Victor Wembanyama became the only players in NBA history to have 10+ made three pointers and 10+ blocks through the first six career NBA games.
- Chet Holmgren became the first rookie with 35 points, 10 rebounds and 5 assists in a game since Luka Doncic in 2019 and the first rookie in Thunder history on 11/18 when he posted 36/10/5 in an overtime victory.
- On 12/18 in a win over Memphis, Holmgren became the first rookie to have back-to-back seven block games since Tim Duncan.
- On 12/29 Holmgren became the first rookie with 20 points and 60% shooting in 3 straight games since Deandre Ayton in 2018 and the first rookie to do that in Thunder history.
- Recorded 29 points, eight rebounds, seven assists and three blocks in a win against the Rockets on 2/25 to join Kevin Durant as the only other Thunder player to register those numbers.
- Became the first rookie in team history to eclipse 1,000 points and 500 rebounds.

## OKLAHOMA CITY THUNDER NOTES

**Dub's Dominance:** Through 60 games (all starts) Jalen Williams is averaging 19.2 points on 53.8 percent shooting to go along with 4.1 rebounds, 4.5 assists, and 1.0 steal per game.

- Dub is the only player in the NBA currently averaging 19+ points on 50%+ shooting and 45%+ shooting from deep.
- J-Dub is averaging 44.9 percent from three, 3rd best in the league.
- Tallied 28 points 12-of-15 FGs, five rebounds, and three steals on 12/8 in a win over Golden State.
- Scored a career-high 36 points on 13-of-17 shooting, 17 of those coming in the fourth quarter, in a win over the Knicks on 12/27.
- Knocked down a go-ahead jumper in the lane to help propel Oklahoma City to a hard-fought win over Boston on 1/2.
- Dub posted 19 points, a career-high 12 assists, and nine boards in a win at Miami on 1/10.
- Had 25 points on 10-18 field goals, six assists, three rebounds, and three steals against the Lakers on 1/15. The following night Dub tallied 25 points again on 10-of-14 shooting, seven assists, and three boards in a loss to the Clippers.
- Scored 33 points on 12-of-18 shooting in a win against Orlando on 2/13, marking the first time in his career to score 30 points in back-to-back contests.
- Dropped 31 points on 11-of-17 shooting to go along with four boards, three assists, and three steals in a win at Portland on 3/6.

**Rising Stars:** Oklahoma City Thunder forward/center Chet Holmgren, guard Cason Wallace and guard/forward Jalen Williams were named to the player pool for the 2024 Rising Stars teams, it was announced by the NBA on January 30th. This marks the second time in Thunder history to have three players named Rising Stars (2008-09).

**The Shai Way:** Shai Gilgeous-Alexander was named Western Conference Player of the Month for games played in December. This marked the first Player of the Month honor for Gilgeous-Alexander. He appeared in 13 games (all starts) and averaged 31.9 points on 55.3 percent shooting from the field to go along with 6.6 assists, 5.4 rebounds, and a league-leading 3.08 steals in 35.2 minutes per game, as Oklahoma City went 10-3 in December. Gilgeous-Alexander knocked down the game-winning shot with 1.4 seconds remaining on Dec. 16 against Denver and finished with 25 points, eight assists, six rebounds, two steals, and two blocks. He scored 30-plus points in 10 games during December, second most in the NBA.

**Holmgren's Honor:** Chet Holmgren was named Western Conference Rookie of the Month for games played in December. Holmgren appeared in 13 games (all starts) and averaged 17.4 points on 55.1% shooting from the field to go along with 7.7 rebounds, 3.46 blocks and 2.4 assists in 29.7 minutes per game. He led Oklahoma City in rebounding and blocks and tallied a team-leading five double-doubles, as he helped the Thunder to a 10-3 record in December. This marked the second Rookie of the Month honor for Holmgren, making him the fourth Thunder player to win multiple Rookie of the Month awards.

**Joining History:** After SGA and Holmgren took home the honors for December, it marked the 6th time in NBA history for a team to win both Rookie of the Month and Player of the Month in the same month, and the first instance since 2013.

**History for Giddey:** Josh posted a triple-double in a win over Portland on 1/11, tallying 13 points, 10 rebounds, and 12 assists in the win in just 22 minutes of action. This marked the first time in NBA history a player has had a triple-double on 100% shooting in under 25 minutes.

**Franchise First:** On 10/25 against the Chicago Bulls, eight Oklahoma City Thunder players had two or more three-point makes in the game, marking the first time that had been done in Thunder history.

**Cup of Joe:** Isaiah Joe was a perfect 7-of-7 from long distance in a win over the Golden State Warriors on 11/16/23. Joe tied a Thunder record with seven consecutive made threes without a miss (4x) in tonight's win at Golden State. The seven made three-pointers also tied his career high (4x).

**Award Tour:** Last season, Thunder guard Shai Gilgeous-Alexander was named to the All-NBA First Team for the first time in his career while guard/forward Jalen Williams was named to the All-Rookie First Team. Oklahoma City became the first team since 2008-09 (Miami) to have a player named to each the All-NBA First Team and All-Rookie First Team.

## OKLAHOMA CITY THUNDER NOTES

**Wallace From Deep:** Through the first 25 games of the season, rookie Cason Wallace led the NBA in three-point percentage at 50.0 percent (27-of-54). He joined Jayson Tatum and Klay Thompson as the third rookie to connect on 50 percent or better from long distance through his first 25 career games (min. 50 attempts).

**Dozen From Distance:** In a 36-point win over the San Antonio Spurs on 11/14, 12 Thunder players made at least one three-pointer, marking a first in Thunder history.

**First time for Everything:** In a win over the Warriors on 11/16, the Thunder bench combined for 50+ points, 15+ assists, 10+ threes made, and zero turnovers. This marked the first time in NBA history that has ever been done.

**60/60/100 Club:** On 11/19 in a win over the Portland Trail Blazers, OKC shot 60.5 percent from the field, 61.1 percent from three-point distance, and 100 percent from the free throw line. This made OKC the first team in at least the last 25 years to shoot 60% from the field, 60% on 3-pointers and 100% on free throws in a single game.

**Young Core:** Oklahoma City had the third youngest roster in the NBA on opening night of the 2023-24 season. The Thunder's roster featured four rookies, three sophomores, and four players in their third season.

**Worldwide Club:** Oklahoma City and Dallas had a league-high eight international players each on respective opening night rosters. The National Basketball Association (NBA) announced that a record 125 international players from 40 countries and territories across six continents are on opening-night rosters for the 2023-24 season, including a record number of players from Canada (26) and France (14).

**New Faces:** Oklahoma City signed 13-year NBA veteran and forward/center **Bismack Biyombo** on 2/10/24. Biyombo was originally selected seventh overall in the 2011 NBA Draft. The Thunder recently acquired forward **Gordon Hayward** from the Charlotte Hornets in exchange for forward Dāvis Bertāns and guards Tre Mann and Vasilije Micić, a 2024 second-round draft pick (Houston Rockets), a 2025 second-round draft pick (Philadelphia 76ers) and cash considerations. Hayward is in his 14th season and has seen action in over 800 career games between Utah, Boston, Charlotte, and Oklahoma City. **Adam Flagler** was signed to a two-way contract on 2/12/24 after appearing in 14 games (four starts) for the Thunder's G League affiliate, the Oklahoma City Blue, this season and averaging 12.6 points, 3.4 rebounds and 3.1 assists in 21.2 minutes per game, while shooting 42.0% from beyond the arc. The Oklahoma City Thunder selected guard **Cason Wallace** 10th overall in the 2023 NBA Draft, acquiring him from the Dallas Mavericks on draft night. He was named to the SEC All-Freshman team this past season after averaging 11.7 points, 4.3 assists, 3.7 rebounds and 1.97 steals in 32 games at the University of Kentucky. The Thunder also drafted guard/forward **Keyontae Johnson** with the 50th overall pick in the 2023 NBA Draft. Johnson spent three seasons at the University of Florida before finishing his four-year collegiate career at Kansas State University. In 108 career appearances, he averaged 13.1 points on 51.9 percent shooting, including 38.9 percent from 3-point range, 6.6 rebounds, 1.6 assists, and 1.08 steals per game.

**Canadian Honor:** Shai Gilgeous-Alexander was named the 2023 Northern Star Award as Canada's Athlete of the Year. Shai became the second basketball player ever to win the award (Steve Nash).

**Ring in the New Year:** Oklahoma City continued its New Year's Eve game night tradition versus the Brooklyn Nets. With a 124-108 win, the Thunder moved to 12-4 in New Year's Eve games.

**Season-Opening Sizzle:** The Oklahoma City Thunder kicked off the 2023-2024 season with a 20-point victory over the Chicago Bulls on the road, 124-104. The Thunder connected on 54.9 percent of its attempts from the field, including 48.7 percent from long distance, and tallied 30 assists. SGA became the fifth player over the last 50 seasons with 30 points, 5 rebounds and 5 assists in back-to-back season openers, joining LeBron James, Trae Young, Carmelo Anthony and Michael Jordan. Gilgeous-Alexander also became the second Thunder player with 30 points and 10 assists in a season opener since the franchise moved to OKC in 2008-09 (Russell Westbrook in 2015). Rookie Cason Wallace jumped into action and became the second player in the last 30 seasons to go 5-5 or better in his NBA debut (Walker Kessler 2022).

## OKLAHOMA CITY THUNDER 2022-23 SEASON REVIEW

**Play-in Clinched:** The Oklahoma City Thunder finished the regular season with a 40-42 record, securing the 10th seed and final play-in position. The Thunder defeated the 9th seeded Pelicans, 123-118, in New Orleans on April 12th. This marked the first play-in appearance for the organization. OKC eventually fell to the Timberwolves in Minnesota on April 14th.

**SGA's Spectacular Season:** In 68 appearances last season, Gilgeous-Alexander averaged 31.4 points (4th in the NBA), 5.5 assists, 4.8 rebounds, 1.6 steals (4th in the NBA), and just shy of 1.0 block. SGA was named an All-Star on February 2nd, marking the first such honor for Gilgeous-Alexander and becoming the fifth Thunder player to be named an NBA All-Star.

- Shai averaged over 30 points on 50 percent shooting from the field, four rebounds, four assists, one steal and just shy of one block. The only players to ever accomplish this stat line for an entire season includes Michael Jordan (2x), LeBron James, and Kareem Abdul-Jabbar.
- SGA scored 30 points in 45 games this season, **the most in the league**.
- SGA **led the league** in third quarter scoring, averaging a total of 10.2 points in the frame this season.
- Shai finished **first** among all guards in blocked shots per game. On 3/23 against the Clippers, SGA recorded his 18th game of the season with multiple blocks, totaling three in the loss.
- Shai ranked **4th in the league** in steals, averaging 1.6 per contest.
- SGA tied Russell Westbrook for the quickest Thunder player in **history** to score 1,000 points in a season (32 games).
- Shai made 669 free throws this season, leading the league despite being 3rd in the NBA in total free throw attempts. He finished **5th in the league** in free throw percentage at 90.5 percent.
- SGA scored a **career-high** 44 points (17-29 FGs) on 12/23/22 in a 128-125 OT loss versus the New Orleans Pelicans. 17 made FGs was also a career-best for Gilgeous-Alexander. Shai tied his career-high again on 2/10 in a win over Portland where he knocked down 13-of-16 FG attempts. Shai became the **first player in Thunder history** to score 40+ points on 80% shooting or better.

**January Jolt:** Oklahoma City started the New Year off with a 9-5 record and owned the second-best net rating in January (7.6). In the month, OKC had the fourth highest points per game (121.1) on 49.5 percent FG, the tenth highest assist rate (26.1), the third highest offensive rating (119.8), and the ninth best defensive rating (112.1).

**Making History:** Less than a minute into the win over the Spurs on 12/27/22, Josh Giddey dished out his 500th career assist. In doing so, Giddey became the **second youngest player ever** to reach 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, and 500 assists. Giddey reached this milestone in just 83 games played.

**Thunder First:** Oklahoma City scored 150 points for the first time in team history in a 150-117 victory over the Boston Celtics on 1/3/23. The Thunder connected on 59.5 percent of its attempts from the field. OKC scored 48 points in the third quarter alone, marking a franchise best for any quarter. Five Thunder players scored 20+ points, marking the second time in franchise history that has ever occurred.

**Comeback Kings:** Oklahoma City finished tied with Brooklyn for most 10+ point comeback this season with 17. The Thunder ranked fourth for the most 15+ point comeback wins this season with six (Brooklyn, Philadelphia, Sacramento all have seven).

**SGA Earns All-Star Nod:** Oklahoma City Thunder guard Shai Gilgeous-Alexander has been named a 2023 NBA All-Star, it was announced on February 2nd by the NBA. This marks the first such honor for Gilgeous-Alexander, as he becomes the fifth Thunder player to be named an NBA All-Star. Gilgeous-Alexander has appeared in 57 games (all starts) this season and averaged 31.2 points (5th in NBA), 5.6 assists, 4.8 rebounds, 1.7 steals (3rd in NBA) and 1.10 blocks in 35.6 minutes per game. His blocks lead all guards and he is shooting 50.9% from the field and 90.8% from the free throw line, which ranks fifth in the NBA.

**Rising Stars:** Oklahoma City Thunder guards Josh Giddey and Jalen Williams were selected as 2023 Rising Stars, it was announced on January 31st by the NBA. This marked the second Rising Stars honor for Giddey, as he and Williams are the 12th and 13th players in Thunder history to be named to a Rising Stars team.

Posted 72 career double-digit scoring games, including 18 games of at least 20 points. 15 of his 18 20-point games came against high-major competition, including Baylor (1/25/20) when Jerome Tang was on staff and 9 times in 2022-23. His career-high of 28 points came at K-State, against Nevada (11/22/22) and at No. 6/6 Texas (1/3/23). Scored in double figures in 34 of 36 games at K-State, including 10 games of at least 20 points. Totaled 19 career double-doubles (points/rebounds), which included 13 at Florida and 6 at K-State. Among those 19 double-doubles were eight 20-point, 10-rebound double-doubles. His first 20/10 double-double came vs. Arkansas (3/14/19) with 20 points and 12 rebounds at the SEC Tournament. Grabbed more than 700 rebounds in his college career, including better than 200 3 times. Dished out 175 assists in his college career, including 77 at K-State in 2022-23. Had 117 steals in his college career, including 38 in 2018-19 and 2019-20. Connected on better than 47 percent of his field goals in each of his four seasons of college basketball, including hitting on 64.1 percent (25-of-39) in 2020-21. Hit on 56.4 percent (435-of-772) of his 2-point field goals. Has shot better than 64 percent from the free throw line in each of his seasons in college, including better than 76 percent in 2019-20 and 2020-21. One of the few players to play for and against one of his former schools, as he had a double-double (15 points, 11 rebounds) in the Wildcats' win over Florida (1/28/23) in the Big 12/SEC Challenge. Also played against Jerome Tang while Tang was the associate head coach at Baylor, as the Bears defeated the Gators, 72-61, in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge on Jan. 25, 2020, despite a game-high 20 points from Johnson. Experienced a medical emergency on Dec. 12, 2020, during Florida's game at Florida State that sidelined him for the remainder of his junior season (2020-21).
