Last Game: Sunday, Jan. 20 – Minnesota 116, Phoenix 114

Derrick Rose scored 29 of his 31 points in the second half, including the game-winning jumper with 0.6 seconds left, as the Timberwolves escaped with a 116-114 victory over Phoenix on Sunday night at Target Center. Minnesota spotted the Suns a 24-16 start before Karl-Anthony Towns and Dario Šarić teamed up for the game's next 11 points. However, Phoenix countered with a 12-0 spurt of its own, easing ahead 38-29 on Dragan Bender's dunk early in the second quarter. Back-to-back 3-pointers from Quincy Acy and Devin Booker hiked the margin to 11 before another Towns scoring spree helped the Wolves pull to within 67-64 by halftime. Triples from Kelly Oubre and Jamal Crawford rebuilt the Suns' lead to 91-80 late in the third before Rose punctuated a 15-1 rally that put Minnesota on top by six with 9:14 to play. A four-minute drought enabled Phoenix to jump ahead 114-111 with 1:45 remaining but Taj Gibson's dunk and a Rose free throw tied it, setting the stage for Rose's last-second heroics. Towns finished with 30 points and 12 rebounds for Minnesota. T.J. Warren led the Suns with 21 points while Booker and Oubre added 18 apiece.

LaMarcus Aldridge scored 25 points and Rudy Gay added 22 to help San Antonio erase a 10-point, 3rd-quarter deficit and edge the Timberwolves, 116-113, on Friday night at Target Center. Neither team led by more than four points in the opening stanza, which ended with Minnesota on top 31-28. The Spurs crept ahead by five on Patty Mills' 3-pointer with 32 seconds left in the second period, but Andrew Wiggins' trey and two Karl-Anthony Towns free throws knotted the halftime score at 58-58. Jeff Teague and Josh Okogie keyed a 14-1 flurry that gave the Wolves their largest lead of the night at 77-67 midway through the third, but Minnesota was limited to one basket in the next four minutes while Dāvis Bertāns' triple pulled the Spurs even. Derrick Rose's last-minute jumper sent the Wolves into the fourth quarter ahead 90-88, but San Antonio took the lead for good on a Jakob Poeltl jumper at the 8:57 mark. The Spurs widened the margin to 108-101 on Derrick White's 3-pointer with 4:18 remaining and then fended off the Wolves' comeback effort. Towns and Rose collected 23 points apiece for Minnesota while Taj Gibson grabbed 11 rebounds.

The Wolves are 14-8 in the teams' past 22 since ending L.A.'s 22-game series winning streak with the 113-90 road victory on Nov. 10, 2013.

First Meeting: Jimmy Butler pumped in 32 points – including the game-clinching 3-pointer with 18.8 seconds left – and Karl-Anthony Towns had 25 points, 16 rebounds and four blocks as the Wolves fended off Los Angeles, 124-120, on Oct. 29 at a sold-out Target Center. LeBron James led the Lakers with 29 points and 10 rebounds while Brandon Ingram chipped in 24 points.

Second Meeting: LeBron James totaled 24 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists and Kyle Kuzma sparked a late 7-0 burst as Los Angeles rallied past the Wolves, 114-110, on Nov. 7 at Staples Center. Derrick Rose piled up 31 points – sinking a career-high seven 3-pointers – for Minnesota while Jimmy Butler and Andrew Wiggins added 24 and 19, respectively.

Third Meeting: Andrew Wiggins scored 25 of his 28 points in the first half and Karl-Anthony Towns racked up 28 points, 18 rebounds and four blocks as the Timberwolves breezed past Los Angeles, 108-86, on Jan. 6 at Target Center. Jeff Teague finished with 15 points and 11 assists for Minnesota while Lance Stephenson led the Lakers with 14 points and six assists.

ROSTER NOTES: On Jan. 6, Minnesota waived forward James Nunnally, reducing its roster to 16 players... On Nov. 12, the Wolves completed a five-player trade with Philadelphia, acquiring forwards Robert Covington and Dario Šarić, guard Jerryd Bayless and a 2nd-round pick in the 2022 NBA Draft in exchange for forward Jimmy Butler and center Justin Patton... Of the 16 players who finished 2017-18 with Minnesota, seven remain; nine new faces dot the Wolves' roster, including veteran free-agent signees Anthony Tolliver, Luol Deng and C.J. Williams... Three rookies are currently on the list: Josh Okogie (1st round, 20th overall), Keita Bates-Diop (2nd round, 48th overall) and Jared Terrell (undrafted); Terrell and Williams are signed to two-way contracts... Last October, the Wolves returned only seven of 15 players from their final 2016-17 roster; they kept 10 of 14 from 2015-16 to 2016-17... The updated 16-player roster averages 5.3 years of NBA experience and has an average age of 27.5 years; the 2017-18 Opening Night group was at 5.0 and 27.1 years, respectively (3.6 and 26.1 in 2016-17, 5.1 and 27.6 in 2015-16)... Gorgui Dieng remains alone atop the team's seniority list, playing in his sixth season in Minnesota, while Andrew Wiggins is in year number five and both Karl-Anthony Towns and Tyus Jones are midway through their fourth seasons in a Wolves uniform... Deng (33), Tolliver (33) and Taj Gibson (33) are the oldest players on the roster while Okogie (20), Jones (22), Bates-Diop (22), Towns (23) and Wiggins (23) are the youngest...

WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota ended its brief two-game slide by edging Phoenix, 116-114, on Sunday at Target Center, squaring a 107-99 defeat on Dec. 15 in the desert... The teams wrap up their season series tonight in the 19th time in team history the Wolves have faced the same opponent in consecutive regular season games; number 20 occurs later this week (Friday at Utah, Sunday vs. Utah)... San Antonio rallied from 10 points back to notch a 116-113 triumph on Jan. 18 at Target Center, the Wolves' seventh loss in their last eight starts with 2+ days of rest (3-8 overall in that category)... The Spurs take the season series (3-1) for the sixth consecutive year... Philadelphia breezed past Minnesota, 149-107, on Jan. 15 at the Wells Fargo Center, the Wolves' fourth loss by 20+ points this season (matching last year's total)... Minnesota picked up a 110-106 home triumph over New Orleans on Jan. 12, avenging the 123-114 New Year's Eve loss at the Smoothie King Center... Dallas halted Minnesota's three-game winning streak with the 119-115 verdict Jan. 11 at Target Center, its second four-point decision vs. the Wolves this season (140-136 on Oct. 20 at the AAC)... Minnesota eked out a 119-117 decision in Oklahoma City on Jan. 8, its second two-point victory at Chesapeake Energy Arena in 17 nights (114-112 on Dec. 23)... The Wolves rolled to a 108-86 victory over the L.A. Lakers on Jan. 6, their fourth 20+ point win of the year – surpassing their 2017-18 total of three... Minnesota erased a 19-point deficit to beat Orlando, 120-103, on Jan. 4, tying its largest comeback win of the season... The Wolves concluded a three-game road swing with the 115-102 loss at Boston on Jan. 2, their 13th straight defeat at TD Garden... Minnesota began the trip with a 113-104 victory at Miami on Dec. 30 before falling 123-114 on Dec. 31 at New Orleans... Atlanta squandered a 22-point lead but regrouped to outlast the Wolves, 123-120 in OT, on Dec. 28... Coupled with the 129-123 loss to Detroit on Dec. 19, it's the first time Minnesota has played consecutive OT home games since Jan. 3-5-7, 2007... The Wolves ended a 2-1 trip with the 119-94 Boxing Day thrashing of Chicago, their largest road win ever in the series... Minnesota earned its first road win vs. a Western rival this season (following an 0-12 start) by rallying past Oklahoma City, 114-112, on Dec. 23...

MARGINAL NOTES: Sunday's 116-114 victory over Phoenix was Minnesota's fifth game to be decided by four points or fewer in its last six (13th overall, 6-7 in those); they had 17 such games in 2017-18, going 8-9... The 42-point spread Jan. 15 at Philadelphia equals the Wolves' 2nd-largest losing margin of all-time; they suffered a 48-point loss (139-91) on Nov. 14, 2014 at New Orleans... Philadelphia hit 59.8% on Jan. 15, the top figure vs. the Wolves in 2018-19; Minnesota tumbles to 0-124 all-time when the opposition hits better than 56%... The L.A. Lakers' 86 points and 36.8% accuracy on Jan. 6 represent Minnesota's best defensive figures this year; the Wolves are 8-0 when keeping the opposition under 100 and 5-0 when holding teams below 40%... They'd limited San Antonio to 89 points on Nov. 28; that 128-89 decision ties the 3rd-largest winning margin in club history... The 125-95 loss to Milwaukee on Oct. 26 was Minnesota's sixth home defeat all-time by 30+ (first since 2011)... The Wolves are currently 20th in scoring defense (112.0 ppg), 18th in defensive FG percentage (46.3%), 30th in defensive 3-point percentage (37.3%), 20th in Defensive Rating (110.2) and 20th in Net Rating (-0.6)...

POINT PARADE: Philadelphia erupted for 149 points on Jan. 15, its highest total since 1990 and matching the 2nd-highest ever by a Wolves opponent; Phoenix poured in 152 on Mar. 16, 2010... Minnesota (80) and Sacramento (78) combined for 158 points after intermission on Dec. 12, the NBA's top-scoring half since Houston (94) and Denver (68) produced 162 in the 2nd half on Jan. 10, 1991 at McNichols Arena (a 156-133 Rockets win)... Minnesota has tallied 130+ points four times in 2018-19, its best total for any season (three each in 2013-14 and 2015-16); Golden State currently leads the NBA this season with nine 130+ efforts... Minnesota suffered a 140-136 loss on Oct. 20 in Dallas... The combined 276 points mark the highest-scoring regulation game in club history; the previous record was 272, set in a 142-130 loss at Houston on Feb. 25, 2017... Minnesota went 32-for-40 from the FT line Jan. 8 at Oklahoma City, equaling its season high for attempts; the Wolves rank 4th in FTs made (20.1 per game) and 8th in FT accuracy (79.3%)...

THE TRIPLE LINDY: Philadelphia went 21-for-43 from beyond the arc on Jan. 15, one short of the most three-pointers ever made by a Wolves opponent and the league-leading sixth game this season in which Minnesota has permitted 19+ treys... The Wolves are 13-3 this year when the opposition makes 10 or fewer threes (9-21 when allowing more than 10)... San Antonio finished 19-for-33 (57.6%) from three-point distance on Dec. 21, two nights after Detroit shot 20-for-48 (9-for-13 in the 4th quarter)... The Wolves drilled 14 three-pointers in the Dec. 23 victory at Oklahoma City, firing at a season-best 51.9% clip; it was the first time in December they'd outscored the opposition from beyond the arc... Minnesota set a franchise record by making 20 three-pointers Nov. 7 in L.A.; the previous mark of 19 occurred last Feb. 7 at Cleveland... The Wolves tied a franchise record by sinking eight threes in the 4th quarter of the Oct. 29 win over the Lakers; all of their field goals in that quarter were from long distance (8-for-11, compared with 0-for-10 from inside the arc)...

THE BOARD REPORT: Philadelphia compiled a 54-34 margin on the glass on Jan. 15, the Wolves' eighth double-figure deficit this season (sixth away from Target Center)... Minnesota outboarded Boston 34-33 on Jan. 2, just its fourth advantage in 22 road starts; the Wolves are facing a -6.8 rpg deficit (40.8-47.6) away from Target Center... Minnesota enjoyed a 58-38 edge Dec. 17 vs. Sacramento, one of six double-digit spreads on the year and largest single-game margin (+20) at home since outboarding the Lakers 49-26 on Mar. 28, 2014 (32nd edge of 20+ in club history)... Portland outboarded the Wolves 66-38 on Nov. 4, the most rebounds ever vs. Minnesota and tying the 2nd-largest single-game deficit (-28) in club history; Boston posted a 57-27 margin on Mar. 4, 2007... Milwaukee claimed 55 defensive rebounds on Oct. 26, tying the NBA's 5th-highest single-game total since the category started being tracked in 1973-74... For the year, Minnesota ranks 9th in offensive reb pct (.247), 20th in total rebound pct (.497) and 28th in defensive rebound pct (.746)...

THE ROAD GOES ON FOREVER: The 119-117 victory at Oklahoma City on Jan. 8 was Minnesota's fourth in its last seven road starts (a run that began Dec. 23 at Oklahoma City), having started the year 2-13 away from Target Center... The Wolves strung together a season-best three consecutive road victories (114-112 at Oklahoma City, Dec. 23; 119-94 at Chicago, Dec. 26; 113-104 at Miami, Dec. 30) before suffering a 123-114 defeat at New Orleans on New Year's Eve... Minnesota posted its first road victory of 2018-19 with the 112-102 verdict on Nov. 23 at Brooklyn, ending a season-opening eight-game road drought that was the longest in franchise history; the Wolves started 0-7 away from Target Center in 2009-10... Sacramento overcame a 12-point deficit to beat the Wolves, 121-110, on Nov. 9 at the Golden 1 Center, one of four times this year they've let a double-digit lead slip away...

THE BIG 80s: Memphis held Minnesota to 87 points on Nov. 18, the Wolves' second sub-90-point game this year... They enter tonight having scored 100+ in each of their last 14 starts (averaging 113.6 ppg in those 14), the longest Century streak in franchise history... Minnesota's 81 points Nov. 4 at Portland are its single-game low since a 93-71 setback at Memphis on Nov. 19, 2016; the low total in 2017-18 occurred in a 91-84 loss at Boston on Jan. 5... Minnesota finished at 31.2% Nov. 4 at Portland, its lowest percentage overall since shooting 29.3% vs. Miami on Dec. 7, 2013 – and its 3rd-lowest percentage ever in a road game (30.6% at San Antonio, Feb. 6, 1999; 30.7% at the Clippers, Nov. 10, 1996)... Minnesota shot a season-high 58.1% vs. Utah on Oct. 31, its best percentage at home since hitting 65.1% vs. New Orleans in the 2015-16 finale (Apr. 13, a 144-109 win)... The Wolves have topped 50% in eight of 24 home starts – most recently a 51.6% effort Jan. 4 vs. Orlando – (winning all eight), but just twice in 22 away from Target Center...

SCHEDULE NOTES: Sunday's win vs. Phoenix wrapped up an eight-game run for Minnesota that featured six at Target Center (dating to Jan. 4 vs. Orlando); starting tonight, six of the next nine (through Feb. 8 at New Orleans) will be on the road... The Jan. 4 win vs. Orlando completed an 11-night run (began Dec. 26 at Chicago) that saw Minnesota play six of seven vs. Eastern opponents, while the Jan. 6 victory over the Lakers kicked off a month-long stretch in which the Wolves play 13 of 14 vs. Western Conference rivals... The Jan. 12 win vs. New Orleans concluded the NBA-low fifth of 13 sets of back-to-back games for the Wolves; the next one begins Thursday at the Lakers... Minnesota opened its 30th NBA campaign with the 112-108 loss on Oct. 17 in San Antonio, the fifth straight season for the Wolves to start on the road... A year ago, they opened with a 107-99 defeat at San Antonio (Oct. 18)...

WOLF TRACKS: Minnesota finished 2017-18 with a 47-35 record, a 16-game improvement from a year ago – the 2nd-largest increase in the NBA last season behind Philadelphia's +24 (28-54 to 52-30) – and a 31-game upgrade on its 16-66 mark in 2014-15, trailing only the Sixers (+34) during that span, as well... Last year's 16-win increase is also the best full-season bump in franchise history (+14 from 1995-96 to 1996-97); the Wolves doubled their win total from the lockout-shortened 1998-99 campaign (25-25) to 1999-2000 (50-32)... The final record is the seventh time in eight seasons Minnesota has improved on its previous year's victory total... The Wolves clinched the Western Conference's final playoff berth with their 112-106 overtime win vs. Denver in the regular season finale (Apr. 11) at Target Center... It's Minnesota's first trip to the postseason since reaching the Western Conference Finals in 2003-04, ending what was the NBA's longest playoff drought at 13 seasons – Sacramento (12) now tops that list – as well as the 2nd-longest in league history behind the Clippers franchise's 15-year siesta from 1976-77 through 1990-91 while drifting from Buffalo to San Diego to Los Angeles...

SEASON EBB & FLOW: The Wolves began the year 10-5, climbing above .500 (at 4-3) with their 125-122 OT win at Miami on Oct. 30 and staying there for the final 163 days of the 2017-18 season... Minnesota enjoyed a winning record for only a combined 113 calendar days during the previous decade (2007-08 through 2016-17), topped by 48 days in 2013-14 and 39 in 2012-13... The Wolves fashioned a 12-3 record from Dec. 8 through Jan. 14 – bookended by home wins over Portland and highlighted by road victories at Denver (Dec. 20) and Indiana (Dec. 31) as well as a 5-0 homestand that featured consecutive wins vs. New Orleans, Cleveland and Oklahoma City – to climb 13 games above .500 at 29-16... It's Minnesota's most prolific in-season 15-game stretch since closing 2003-04 with 12 wins in its final 15 (capped by a nine-game winning streak)... The Wolves carried the West's #3 seed into March, when consecutive losses at Portland and Utah dropped them out of 1st place in the Northwest Division and into 6th in the conference overall...
