LAST GAME: SUNDAY, MARCH 10, 2024: LOS ANGELES LAKERS 120 - MINNESOTA TIMBERWOLVES 109

Anthony Davis had 27 points, a season-high 25 rebounds and a career-high seven steals while leading the Los Angeles Lakers to a 120-109 victory over the short-handed Minnesota Timberwolves on Sunday night. Davis added five assists and three blocked shots in one of the most prolific games of his decorated career. The nine-time All-Star feasted on a Minnesota lineup missing its top two big men and four regulars due to injuries, grabbing 21 rebounds in the second half alone and leading a 21-4 rally to begin the fourth quarter while the Lakers pulled away to their 12th win in 17 games. "When we're out there having fun, everybody's confidence is high," Davis said. "When we're talking trash to the other team, we're holding each other accountable, and we're just playing the right way. We know what it takes. It's just about having the consistency of playing that way each and every night." Davis is only the eighth player since the 1982-83 season with at least 25 points, 25 rebounds and five assists in a game, according to Sportradar. Nikola Jokic did it last season, joining a short list that includes Charles Barkley and Kevin Garnett. "Ten offensive rebounds is crazy," said Austin Reaves, who scored 19 points for Los Angeles. "I did feel any time we shot and missed, he was there to give us a second-chance opportunity with offensive rebounds, get himself to the line. The steals, I don't know. The steals are crazy. Seven steals is very, very impressive." LeBron James had 29 points, nine assists and eight rebounds as the Lakers knocked off another top team following wins over Oklahoma City and Milwaukee on their six-game homestand. Los Angeles (36-30) is six games above .500 for the first time since the final day of the 2021-22 regular season. Naz Reid scored 25 points and hit five 3-pointers in his first start of the season for Minnesota, which hit 16 of its season-high 46 3-point attempts. Reid delivered his second straight outstanding performance after scoring a career-high 34 against Cleveland last Friday, but the Wolves' depleted interior defense couldn't stop Davis without Rudy Gobert or Karl-Anthony Towns. "This team is No. 2 in the West, and still a good team," Davis said. "Obviously, they're missing key parts of their team, but they still have guys who can make plays, and they still find a way to win ballgames. We just wanted to come out as a team effort and knowing that wherever we are in the standings and how important this game was, trying to close the gap in the standings." Anthony Edwards also scored 25 points for the Wolves, who have lost four of six. Minnesota missed nine consecutive shots to start the fourth quarter while Los Angeles pulled away. James returned after sitting out due to injury for the ninth time this season when the Lakers stunned Milwaukee 123-122 on Friday night behind D'Angelo Russell's 44-point performance. Davis injured his left shoulder during that game in a collision with Giannis Antetokounmpo, but it didn't visibly slow him.

Darius Garland scored 34 points, Jarrett Allen added a career-high 33 and 18 rebounds and the injury-thinned Cleveland Cavaliers handed the NBA's best road team a loss, beating the Minnesota Timberwolves 113-104 in overtime Friday night. Allen made a career-best 15 free throws, including 14 after halftime. He scored 10 points in overtime as the Cavs outscored the Timberwolves 16-7 and won their eighth straight against a Western Conference team. It was Cleveland's eecond win in four days against one of the league's elite teams. On Tuesday, the Cavs rallied from 22 points down in the final minutes to stun the East-leading Boston Celtics. "It just boosts us for when everybody else gets back," Allen said. "Contrary to belief, we're better when everybody is in the lineup." Cleveland was without starters Donovan Mitchell, Evan Mobley and Max Strus because of injuries but had enough to down the Timberwolves, who could be excused for being tired following a 113-111 win at Indiana on Thursday. With the loss, Minnesota fell a half game behind Oklahoma City for the Western Conference lead. Naz Reid scored a career-high 34 and Anthony Edwards 19 — on just 7-of-27 shooting — for Minnesota, which came in a league-best 21-11 on the road. Minnesota coach Chris Finch sat out after feeling ill shortly before tipoff. He met with reporters about 90 minutes before the game and didn't mention any issues. Assistant Micah Nori filled in for Finch. The Cavs were helped by Minnesota center Rudy Gobert, who was called for a technical foul with 27 seconds left. After being whistled for a disqualifying sixth foul — a push underneath on offense — by official Scott Foster, Gobert rubbed his fingers together and made the money sign as if implying the referee was on the take. Foster didn't see the gesture, but official Natalie Sago did and T'd up Gobert, who finished with 17 rebounds in 37 minutes. Nori was disappointed and displeased with Gobert. "A technical foul with 27 seconds in the game, to be honest, is unacceptable," Nori said. "That's who Rudy is, but you've got to be smart. He made a visual that was automatic. He was obviously frustrated — both teams were — but we have to be smarter." Gobert admitted he was wrong in making the gesture. "My reaction, which I think was the truth, but it wasn't the time to react that way," he said. "It cost my team the game. It was an immature reaction. It's not just one call. Everyone makes mistakes, but when it's over and over and over again, of course it's frustrating." Garland made the technical to tie it at 97. Minnesota had one last chance in regulation, but Edwards' baseline jumper at the horn was off. Edwards was coming off a 44-point performance in the win over Indiana, a game he sealed with a chase-down block in the final second before striking his head on the bottom of the backboard.He didn't do anything quite that sensational, though Edwards did get called for a technical after dunking on Allen — much to the delight of Minnesota's bench. -Associated Press

Anthony Edwards matched his season high with 44 points, made a tiebreaking 3-pointer with 1:11 to go and came up with a spectacular block at the buzzer to give the short-handed Minnesota Timberwolves a 113-111 victory over the Indiana Pacers on Thursday night. Edwards soared to reject a last-second layup by the Pacers' Aaron Nesmith, hitting his head on the rim as time expired. He yelled, flexed his muscles and chest-bumped Rudy Gobert in celebration. Gobert added 18 points and 14 rebounds for the Timberwolves, who played without All-Star Karl-Anthony Towns. Minnesota moved into the top spot in the Western Conference, one-half game ahead of Oklahoma City. "His shot was next level," Pacers coach Rick Carlisle said when asked about Edwards. "Even when we double-teamed him, he got away from us. Look, he's a great player and that's why every second of every minute of every game matters." Edwards was masterful in Minnesota's second straight win, accounting for the team's final eight points while making 18 of 35 from the field with three 3-pointers and six rebounds in a back-and-forth game that neither team led by more than five over the final 20 minutes. Pascal Siakam scored 24 points and Tyrese Haliburton added 23 points and 13 assists for the Pacers, who trailed by 17 points in the first half but led 104-103 on Siakam's powerful dunk with 2 minutes left. Indiana has lost three of four and is eighth in the East. Even without Towns, Minnesota managed to hold the league's highest-scoring team nearly 13 points below its average. "I thought the defensive game plan was on point," Wolves coach Chris Finch said. "I thought our players really executed in the first half, got a little loose in the second half. Of course, they made some adjustments, but we were able to turn them over a lot early." And Edwards made them pay, time after time. Despite limping off the floor 26 seconds into the game, Edwards helped stake Minnesota to a 54-37 midway through the second quarter. He finished the first half with 15 points, three rebounds and three assists. Indiana trimmed the halftime deficit to 60-49, opened the second half on a 19-4 run and finally took a 68-66 lead midway through the third quarter when Myles Turner converted a Minnesota turnover into a dunk. From there, neither team could take control — until Edwards capped his big closing flurry with the decisive block. "Edwards is a physical player and you've got to play physical players physically," Carlisle said. "It's a tough learning thing." Towns sat out with a sore left knee and Finch gave no timetable for his return. ESPN and The Athletic reported Towns has a torn meniscus. The Pacers also were short-handed. Starting guard Bennedict Mathurin was out with a shoulder injury and is expected to miss at least three more games. -Associated Press

NAZ AND ANT BRING THEIR A-GAMES TO HOLLYWOOD

Naz Reid made his first start of the season on March 10 in Los Angeles finishing with 25 points on 9-of-17 shooting, including 5-of-10 from three, five rebounds and a season-high-tying four blocks. It marked his second consecutive and fourth 25+ point game of the season (ninth career) and his second such game this season with multiple blocks (third career).

After making seven threes in his previous game against Cleveland, Reid knocked down five threes against the Lakers, joining Brook Lopez (twice) and Aron Baynes as the only centers in NBA history to record 12+ threes in a two-game span. Reid is the 11th player in franchise history to knock down 5+ threes in back-to-back games (MR: D'Angelo Russell: Feb. 1-3, 2023).

Over his last two games, Reid has totaled 59 points, a career-high for points in a two-game span. Reid's previous two-game career-high was 49 points (March $22-March\ 26,\ 2023$).

Anthony Edwards led the way for the Timberwolves against the Lakers on March 10 with 25 points, seven rebounds, seven assists, two steals and two blocks, marking his 21st 25+ point/5+ rebound/5+ assist game of the season (52nd career) and his third such game this season with 2+ steals and 2+ blocks (5th career).

Edwards is the seventh player in the NBA this season to record 3+ 25+ point/5+ rebound/5+assist/2+ steal/2+ block games and joins Luka Dončić and Shai Gilgeous-Alexander as the only guards to do so. Edwards is one of only four players in franchise history to record 5+ such games (Kevin Garnett: 25 games; Tom Gugliotta: seven games; Karl-Anthony Towns: seven games) and he is the only guard in franchise history to record multiple such games.

The March 10 game marked the eighth time Reid and Edwards have each scored 20+points in the same game in their careers and the fourth time doing so this season.

NAW DOES IT ALL IN LA LA LAND

In his 18th start of the season, Nickeil Alexander-Walker finished the night of March 10 in Los Angeles with 15 points on 6-of-11 shooting, including 3-of-4 from deep, a season-high-tying seven rebounds, five assists and two steals. It marked his second career game with 15+ points/5+ rebounds/5+ assists/2+ steals (Nov. 30, 2023, vs. Utah).

NAZ REID'S CAREER-NIGHT IN THE LAND

Naz Reid had a career-night in Cleveland on March 8, seeing 32:18 minutes of action off the bench, leading the Timberwolves with a career-high 34 points on 10-of-18 shooting, including 7-of-11 from the three-point line, five rebounds and two blocks. It marked the first time this season Reid has scored 30+ points in a game, the second time doing so in his career and his first such game coming off the bench. It was Reid's third consecutive 10+ point game off the bench and his 43rd such game of the season (136th career) which ranks fourth in the NBA this season.

Reid's seven threes were the most in franchise history for a player coming off the bench, becoming the seventh Timberwolf to do so (MR: Malik Beasley; Feb. 8, 2022). Reid is the first player in Timberwolves history to score 30+ points while making 7+ threes off the bench. It marked the second time in his career Reid has made 5+ threes, Tying his career-high of seven made-threes earlier this season (Dec. 14 at Dallas).

In blocking one shot and knocking down one three-pointer, it marked Reid's 96th career game doing so off the bench, the most such games in Timberwolves franchise history by a wide margin, with Eddie Griffin being second on the list (37 such games). His 96 career games with 1+ block and 1+ 3PM off the bench also rank second in the NBA since the 2019-20 season, trailing only Chris Boucher of Toronto (97 such games).

JMAC - HOMETOWN HERO

Jordan McLaughlin logged as season-high 21:12 minutes of action off the bench, against the Lakers on March 10, finishing with a season-high 12 points and a career-high-tying four made threes. It marked the second time this season he has scored 10+points (22nd career).

ANT DOES IT ALL IN INDY

Anthony Edwards led the way for the Timberwolves on March 7 at Indiana, finishing with a game-and-season-high-tying 44 points on 18-of-35 shooting, six rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks, marking his third 40+ point game of the season (ninth career). Edwards' three 40+ point games ties his career-high for most such games in a season (2021-22). Only Kevin Love (six games; 2013-14) and Andrew Wiggins (five games (2016-17) have had more 40+ point games in a single season in Timberwolves franchise history.

Edwards became just the seventh player in the NBA this season to record 40+ points/6+ rebounds/2+ steals/2+ blocks. Edwards is one of only two players in franchise history to record such a game (Karl-Anthony Towns; Dec. 16, 2023, vs. Indiana) and he is the only Wolves player to do so multiple times with tonight being the third time doing so.

It also marked Edwards' most points scored against Indiana, his second consecutive 35+ point game against the Pacers, his first career 40+ point game against an Eastern Conference opponent and his third consecutive 30+ point performance on the road. His three straight 30+ point games on the road mark the longest such streak of his career.

With zero turnovers against the Pacers, Edwards tied the most points in Timberwolves history in a game without committing a turnover (Garnett on Jan. 28, 2007 vs. Suns; 44 Points, 0 Turnovers).

Edwards scored 16 of his 44 points in the fourth quarter, a season-high for points in the fourth quarter and the 14th time he has scored 15+ points in the fourth.

Edwards sealed the game on an highlight reel block at the rim as time expired. He joins Kobe Bryant (January 11, 2012) as the only guards in the NBA in the last 20 years to score 40+ points and block a shot in the last three second of a game.

JADEN FILLS THE STAT SHEET IN INDIANAPOLIS

On March 7 at Indiana, Jaden McDaniels contributed 11 points on 4-of-7 shooting, eight rebounds and a season-high six assists, marking his 31st 10+ point game of the season (128th career) and his first 10+ point/5+ rebound/5+ assist game this season (fourth career).

MIN BIGS FIND RAREFIED AIR

With Gobert's 17 rebounds and Reid's seven made threes, the March 8 game in Cleveland marked just the **third time in NBA history** a team finished with one center collecting 15+ rebounds and another making 7+ threes.

THIRD QUARTER DAWGS!

On March 8 at Cleveland, the Wolves outscored the Cavs 30-25 in the third quarter. It marksed the **39th** time they have outscored their opponents in the third quarter this season, tied with Phoenix for the most such games in the NBA this season. Minnesota is allowing just **25.6** points per game in the third quarter, the **best mark in the NBA**.

PILING UP THE ROAD WINS

Following their 113-111 victory in Indiana on March 7, Minnesota had won five straight road games, the last time the team won five straight on the road was during the 2005-06 season (Nov. 26, 2005 - Dec. 7, 2005). The Timberwolves' longest road winning streak in franchise history is six games (2X: Dec. 3 - Dec. 23, 2003, and Jan. 8 - Jan. 25, 2000).

The win also gave the Minnesota their 21st road win of the season, tied for the **most road** wins in the NBA this season and the most road wins by a Timberwolves team since winning 27 road games in 2003-04. The Wolves have now won 20+ road games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in franchise history.

AT OUR BEST VS. THE BEST

The Timberwolves have been stellar against the top teams in the NBA this season. Minnesota is **third (.600)** in **winning percentage** vs. teams that are *currently* .500 or better. The Wolves rank **first (.451)** in the NBA in **opponents field goal percentage** when facing teams that are *currently* .500 or better.

The Wolves' 40 games vs. teams .500 or better are tied for the **fourth** most such games in the NBA this season.

BEST VS. THE WEST

Minnesota is 30-11 against the Western Conference. The Timberwolves' **30 wins vs. the West** are the **most in the NBA** this season along with their **.732 winning percentage** being the **highest in the NBA** against Western Conference foes.

HISTORIC WOLVES DEFENSE IS A PROBLEM FOR THE ASSOCIATION

On Mar. 3 vs. the LA Clippers, Minnesota's defense held the Clippers to just 37.6% (32-of-85) from the field. It marked the **Wolves 20th game this season holding their opponents to 40.0% shooting or worse, the most by any team in the NBA this season** with the next closet team being Oklahoma City (13 games). Minnesota is 17-3 when holding teams to 40.0% shooting or below.

Following their 128-91 win at Portland on Feb. 15, the **Timberwolves have shot 50% or** better from the field while holding opponents to 40% or worse from the field in **10 games this season**. The Wolves are 10-0 this year when doing so.

On Feb. 15 at Portland, the Wolves finished the night shooting 51.7% (46-of-89) from the field while holding the Trail Blazers to 37.3% (31-of-83) from the field and 27.6% (8-of-29) from three. The game marked the Wolves seventh game this season shooting north of the 50.0% mark from the field while holding their opponents to 40.0% or worse from the field and 30.0% or worse from three, most in the NBA with only the Oklahoma City Thunder (five games) as the only other team with at least five such games.

The Wolves seven games shooting 50.0%+ and holding opponents to 40.0% or worse from the field and 30.0% or worse from three are the third most such games in NBA history and the most such games in a season since the Cleveland Cavaliers had seven such games during the 2008-09 season. The 2003-04 San Antonio Spurs and the 1986-87 Atlanta Hawks, who each tallied nine such games, hold the record for most such games in any season in NBA history.

WE CAN SHOOT THE ROCK TOO

On March 4 vs. Portland, the Wolves finished the night shooting 50.6% (40-of-79) from the field, marking the **29th game this season in which the Wolves have shot at least 50.0% from the field**, going **26-3** when doing so, the **sixth-most** such games in the NBA this season and their 26 wins rank **fourth** in the NBA.

WINNING GAMES WHEN HOLDING OPPONENTS TO 100 OR BELOW

On March 3 vs. the LA Clippers, Minnesota held the Clippers to 89 points, marking the **20th time this season holding their opponent to 100 points or below**. The Wolves are 18-2 on the season when doing so with their 20 games being tied with the Knicks for the **most such games** in the NBA this season and their **18 wins** are the **most such wins** in the NBA this season.

Additionally, they held the Clippers to 37.6%% (32-of-85) shooting, Minnesota has **15 games** on the season allowing **100** points or fewer on **40.0%** shooting or worse, the most such games in the NBA this season.

HOLDING OPPONENTS TO 90 OR BELOW

In holding the Clippers under 90 points on March 3, Minnesota has held their foes to 90 points **or below seven times** this season, the **most such games** in the NBA this season with Orlando and New Orleans the closest teams with four games each.

THE UNDER 30.0% THREE-POINT CLUB

The Clippers shot just 29.4% (10-of-34) from deep on March 3, marking the **18th** time the season they held their opponents to 30.0% or worse from three, tied for the **second-most** most such games in the NBA this season (Boston, Cleveland and Orlando: 19).

WE MAKE THE THREES - YOU GET THE MEATS

This season, when Minnesota makes 12+ threes in a game, fans are elegible to receive a free Classic Beef 'N Cheddar from Arby's.

On March 10, the Wolves shot 16-of-46 from the three-point line aginst the Lakers, their 41st game this season in which they have made 12+ threes. The Wolves are 27-14 when making 12+ threes.

Teams have made 20+ threes in back-to-back games 46 times in NBA history. Including their Feb. 6 and Feb. 8 performances, the Timberwolves have done so twice (Nov. 18, 2021 vs. San Antonio and Nov. 20, 2021 vs. Memphis). Only the Utah Jazz have made 20+ threes in three consecutive games (Dec. 3 - Dec. 8, 2021).

The Timberwolves have made 15+ threes 11 times, going 7-4 when doing so.

The Feb. 8 game at Milwaukee marked the sixth time this season the Timberwolves have shot 50% or better from deep. Minnesota is 5-1 on the season when doing so.

TAKING WHAT'S OURS

Led by Edwards' game-and-season-high four steals, the Timberwolves finished the night of Feb. 27 vs. San Antonio with a season-high 16 steals, marking the ninth game this season the Wolves have collected 10+ steals and the first time this season finishing 15+ steals. It marked the 42nd time in franchise history Minnesota has finished a game with 15+ steals and the first time doing so since Dec. 14, 2022, vs. Oklahoma City (16 steals).

STREAKING AGAINST THE PACERS

Following the March 7 victory, the Wolves have defeated the Pacers in their last six matchups. Minnesota's six-game win streak against Indiana is the team's longest active streak against any opponent.

POSTING PLENTY OF PAINT POINTS

The Timberwolves finished the March 7 game outscoring the Pacers 66-60 in points in the paint, tying a season-high for points down low and marking their 13th game this season scoring 60+ points in the paint; Minnesota is now 11-2 when doing so.

OPPONENTS WILL BE INEFFECTIVE

The Timberwolves defense has been smoothering opponent this season. Minnesota is holding their opponets to **51.2%** effective field goal percentage, **leading the league** in the category:

WOLVES TALLY MOST BLOCKS IN ALMOST 9 YEARS

Led by Alexander-Walker's career-high four blocks, the Timberwolves finished the night of Feb. 28 vs. Memphis with a season-high 13 blocked shots. It was the fifth time this season Minnesota has recorded 10+ blocks and the first time tallying 13+ blocks since Nov. 18, 2015 at Orlando (13 blocks). The Wolves are the ninth team in the NBA this season to block 13 or more shots in a single game.

FOURTH QUARTER DOMINANCE

The Timberwolves outscored the Nets 31-20 in the fourth quarter on Feb. 24, marking the Wolves' **16th game** outscoring their opponent by 10+ points in the fourth quarter this season, **the most such games in the NBA**.

WE'RE GOING BACK-TO-BACK

This season, the Timberwolves will play in a total of 13 back-to-back sets: three home-home, five away-away, one home-away and four away-home. To this point in the season, Minnesota is 10-4 in back-to-back sets, 5-2 in both the first and second games. The Wolves swept their third consecutive back-to-back set with a 121-100 win in Los Angeles against the Clippers on Feb. 12 and a 121-109 win in Portland on Feb. 13. The Wolves join the Knicks as the only other team in the NBA season to have swept three consecutive back-to-back sets and it marks just the fourth time in franchise history the Timberwolves have done so. On Feb. 27 and Feb. 28 Minnesota beat San Antonio and Memphis in back-to-back games, their fourth back-to-back set sweep of the season. To this point, The Timberwolves are 6-2 (.750) this season when playing on the second day of a back-to-back, which is second best in the NBA (Boston, 8-2). For an entire season, Minnesota's best record on no rest is 13-7 (.650) in 2003-04.

The Timberwolves defeated the Pacers 113-111 on March 7, but came up short against the Cavaliers the next night in a 113-104 overtime loss. The Wolves next back-to-back set comes March 18 in Utah followed by a March 19 showdown with the Nuggets at Target Center.

Chris Finch was named Head Coach of the Minnesota Timberwolves on February 22, 2021, becoming the team's 16th Head Coach. On April 11, 2022, the Timberwolves announced a multi-year contract extension for Finch along with his coaching staff.

His 148 total wins over the last four seasons rank second in team history and his .550 winning percentage passes Flip Saunders' franchise-best mark (.521). After the Timberwolves' 99-96 win over the Golden State Warriors on Mar. 26, Finch recorded his 100th career win, joining Saunders as the only two coaches in Wolves history

On Dec. 4, 2024, the NBA named Finch Western Conference Coach of the Month for October and November after guiding the Wolves to a 14-4 record to begin the 2023-24 season. It was the first monthly honor of his coaching career, he became the third Timberwolves head coach to win the award, joining Kevin McHale (January 2009) and Flip Saunders (April 2004, February 2003, January 2001 and January 2000). Following the Wolves' Feb. 4 win vs. Houston, Finch was selected to represent the Western Conference at the 2024 NBA All-Star Game in Indianapolis, given to the team with the best record through Feb. 4 (including tiebreaker scendrios).

This marked the first time in Finch's career being named an All-Star Head Coach and the second time in Timbervolves history a head coach has been named to the All-Star Game. Flip Saunders coached the Western Conference All-Stars to a 136-132 victory at the 2004 NBA All-Star Game in Los Angeles.

During the 2022-23 season, Finch led the Timberwolves to a 42-40 record, eclipsing 40 wins on the season in back-to-back seasons (46 in 2021-22) for the first time since the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. After defeating the Oklahoma City Thunder on Apr. 14 in the final NBA Play-In Tournament game, the Wolves clinched a spot in the NBA Playoffs for the second consecutive season. This marked the first time clinching back-to-back playoff appearances since a string of eight straight from 1997-2004. The team's second place finish in the Northwest Division is the highest since winning the division in 2003-04. With the team's 151-131 win over the San Antonio Spurs on Apr. 8, the Timberwolves clinched a .500 or better record this for the third time since 2004-05. The team has now done so in back-to-back seasons (.561 in 2021-22) for the first time since the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. After the team's 29 wins against Western Conference foes this season and 32 such wins lost season, Minnesota has won 25+ games against the West in back-to-back years for the first time since 2003-04 and 2004-05. The 11 wins in January of 2023 were the most by a Wolves team in the month of January since winning 12 games in January of 2004.

During the 2021-22 season, Finch led the Timberwolves to a 46-36 record, the seventh-best record in club history, including a trip to the Playoffs for just the second time in the last 18 years. He helped guide the Wolves to a 26-15 record at Target Center and a 32-20 record against the Western Conference, the second time since 2004-05 with 30+ wins against the West. With the 136-130 victory over the Denver Nuggets on April 1, the Wolves finished the season 12-4 against Northwest Division foes, the most division wins by the team since the division was formed in 2004 and just the third time since 2004 winning 10+ division games. Additionally, Minnesota finished the season winning 10 straight games against Northwest division opponents, the most since 2004. The team finished the 2021-22 campaign with 20 road wins for the first time since the 2004-05 season and just the fifth time winning 20+ road games.

Finch took the helm mid-season in the 2020-2021 season, leading the Timberwolves to win half of their last 22 games, finishing 16-25 overall. After the All-Star break, Finch was able to unlock another level of talent in young players such as 2020-21 NBA All-Rookie First Team honoree Anthony Edwards, as well as Jaden McDaniels. Under Finch's guidance, Edwards was named the Western Conference Rookie of the Month three times last season (March, April and May), becoming the third player in Wolves history to earn the honor multiple times (Karl-Anthony Towns in 2015-16 and Andrew Wiggins in 2014-15).

Since arriving in Minnesota, Finch has jumped into helping the Twin Cities community. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of Second Harvest Heartland where he assists the organization, playing a critical role in helping Second Harvest Heartland fulfill its mission of ending hunger.

Finch, 54, has over 25 years of NBA and G League experience, serving most recently as an assistant coach under Nick Nurse and the Toronto Raptors this season. Prior to that, he made coaching stops with the New Orleans Pelicans as associate head coach from 2017-20, the Denver Nuggets as an assistant coach from 2016-17 and the Houston Rockets as an assistant coach from 2011-16. Finch was named the head coach of the Rio Grande Valley Vipers, the Rocket's G League affiliate in 2009. He led the Vipers to back-to-back G League Finals appearances, compiling a 67-33 (.670) record in his two seasons.

After leading Rio Grande Valley to the 2010 G League Championship, Finch received the Dennis Johnson Trophy as the league's best head coach.

The Reading, Pennsylvania native played overseas in the British Basketball League (BBL) for the Sheffield Sharks from 1993-97 before coaching the same team from 1997-2003. Finch was named the BBL Coach of the Year in 1998-99. He continued to coach overseas for 12 years including in Germany and Belgium.

Finch also served as the head coach of Great Britain's National Team from 2006-13, where he led the national team in the 2012 Summer Olympics in London. He also led them to a European Championship berth in 2009 and 2011, the team's first appearances since 1981.

A Franklin & Marshall College graduate in 1992, Finch was as a two-time All-American, and was inducted into the F&M Sports Hall of Fame in 2002. He started the final 115 games of his collegiate career and compiled a 102-13 record (.887), which stood as the most career wins as a starter in NCAA Division III history.

- Rudy Gobert finished the night of March 8 in Cleveland with seven points, 17 rebounds and two blocks. It marked Gobert's 23rd 15+ rebound game of the season (212th career), tied with Domantas Sabonis for the most such games in the NBA this season.
- On March 7 at Indiana, Gobert finished with 18 points on 7-of-11 shooting, 14 rebounds, two steals and three blocks, marking his fourth consecutive 10+ point/10+ rebound/3+ block game, and his 21st such game this season (183rd career). His four consecutive 10+ point/10+ rebound/3+ block games are tied for the second longest such streak of games in his career. Gobert has put together five consecutive such games twice (MR: Feb. 5 Feb. 13, 2021).

- Gobert was dominant against the Trail Blazers on March 4, finishing with a team-high 25 points on 9-of-10 shooting, including 7-of-7 from the free-throw line, a game-high 16 rebounds and a game-high three blocks. The game marked Gobert's first 25+ point/15+ rebound game of the season (ninth career) and his fourth such career game with 3+ blocks.
- It also marked Gobert's 22nd 15+ rebound game of the season, the most such games in the NBA (211th). Gobert became the first player in the NBA to record 25+ points on 90.0%+ shooting, 15+ rebounds/3+ blocks without a miss from the free-throw line (min. five FTA) since blocks became an officially recorded stat in 1973-74.
- Gobert scored 11 of his 25 points in the third quarter on March 4, marking the fourth time this season he has scored 10+ points in a quarter (39th career). He also grabbed seven rebounds in the third quarter, the fourth time this season recording 10+ points/5+ rebounds in a quarter (22nd career).
- On March 3 vs. the LA Clippers, Gobert finished the game with 12 points on 5-of-7 shooting, a game-high 16 rebounds and a game-high three blocks, marking his 42nd double-double of the season (428th career) and his 30th such game with multiple blocks (297th career). Since entering the league in the 2013 NBA Draft, no player in the NBA has recorded more 10+ point/10+ rebound/2+ block games than Gobert and only 12 players in NBA history have recorded more such games.
- The March 3 game marked Gobert's 18th double-double this season with at least 15 rebounds (181st career) and his seventh such game this season with 3+ blocks (122nd career). Since 2013-14, Only Anthony Davis has tallied more career games (183 games).

Recent Notables 2023-24:

- Reid had a career-night in Cleveland on March 8, seeing 32:18 minutes of action off the bench, leading the Timberwolves with a career-high 34 points on 10-of-18 shooting, including 7-of-11 from the three-point line, five rebounds and two blocks. It marked the first time this season Reid has scored 30+ points in a game, the second time doing so in his career and his first such game coming off the bench. It was Reid's third consecutive 10+ point game off the bench and his 43rd such game of the season (136th career) which ranks fourth in the NBA this season.
- Reid's seven threes were the most in franchise history for a player coming off the bench, becoming the seventh Timberwolf to do so (MR: Malik Beasley; Feb. 8, 2022). Reid is the first player in Timberwolves history to score 30+ points while making 7+ threes off the bench. It marked the second time in his career Reid has made 5+ threes, Tying his career-high of seven made-threes earlier this season (Dec. 14 at Dallas).
- In blocking one shot and knocking down one three-pointer, it marked Reid's 96th career game doing so off the bench, the most such games in Timberwolves franchise history by a wide margin, with Eddie Griffin being second on the list (37 such games). His 96 career games with 1+ block and 1+ 3PM off the bench also rank second in the NBA since the 2019-20 season, trailing only Chris Boucher of Toronto (97 such games).
- On March 7 at Indiana, Reid finished with 13 points and eight rebounds in 26:03 minutes of action off the bench. Tonight marks his 42nd 10+ point performance off the bench this season (135th career), which is tied for the fourth most such games in the NBA this season. It also marked Reid's 25th 10+ point/5+ rebound game off the bench this season (68th career), the second most such games in the NBA this season.
- Reid finished the night of March 4 vs. Portland with 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting, including 4-of-4 from deep and five rebounds in 22:59 minutes of action off the bench, marking his 41st 10+ point game of the season off the bench 134th career). Reid's 41 10+ point games off the bench are the fifth-most in the NBA this season and second-most among centers (Bobby Portis — MIL: 42 games).
- Reid has now grabbed 5+ rebounds in six straight games, tied for the longest streak in his career. He did so for six games earlier in the season from Dec. 2-16, 2023
- It marked Reid's fourth career game off the bench with 10+ points and 5+ rebounds while shooting 80.0%+ from the field and 100% from three. He is one of 11 players in franchise history to record such a stat line and one of just two players to have multiple such games (Nemanja Bjelica: two games).

- Towns returned to the lineup on Feb. 29 vs. Memphis and finished with 13 points, going 3-of-7 from deep and grabbing 11 rebounds. It marked his 22nd double-double of the season and the 362nd double-double of his career, which ranks
- second in franchise history (Kevin Garnett: 606 games).
 Towns finished the night of Feb. 24 vs. Brooklyn with 28 points on 8-of-17 shooting, including 4-of-8 from deep, a perfect 8-of-8 from the free-throw line, nine rebounds, four assists and two blocks. It marked his 19th 25+ point/5+ rebound game of the season (232nd career) and his fourth such game this season with multiple blocks (102nd career).
- Feb. 24 marked the 10th time this season Towns has finished with 25+ points/5+ rebounds with at least four made threes and the 53rd time doing so in his career. Towns' 53 career games with 25+ points/5+ rebounds with four or more made threes moves him into a tie with Antoine Walker for 20th in NBA history for such games.
- Towns ended the night of Feb. 23 vs. Milwaukee with 22 points and 14 rebounds, marking his 21st 10+ point/10+ rebound game of the season (362nd career). Towns had 12 points and 10 rebounds at halftime, marking the second time this season he tallied 10+ points and 10+ rebounds in the first half of a game (33rd career). Towns also collected a season-high eight of his 14 rebounds in the first quarter, one shy of his career-high nine rebounds in a quarter (4x; MR: Feb. 21, 2021 at New York).
- Playing in his fourth NBA All-Star Game, Towns finish the Feb. 18 All-Star Game in Indianapolis with 50 points on 23-of-35 shooting and eight rebounds, marking the most points ever scored in an All-Star Game in Timberwolves franchise history.
- On Feb. 15 at Portland, Towns ended the night with 23 points on 8-of-13 shooting, including 1-of-2 from deep and a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line and eight rebounds. It marked Towns' 34th 20+ point game of the season (380th career).


