Game Recap

The Denver Nuggets were simply too determined, too experienced, too proud and too talented to let their flop in the first two games define this series against the surging Minnesota Timberwolves. This is what defending NBA champions do — quiet a raucous crowd, embrace the boos and take the momentum right back. Jamal Murray rebounded from a rough start to the Western Conference semifinals with 24 points to lead the Nuggets on a 117-90 romp Friday night in Game 3 that made the Timberwolves the last team in the NBA to lose this postseason. "It honestly just kind of makes you better because you have to respond," said Murray, who was roundly booed each time he touched the ball. "It just makes you have to lock in and be there for your teammates." Nikola Jokic, the three-time league MVP, had 24 points, 14 rebounds and nine assists, Michael Porter Jr. scored 21 points and the Nuggets sliced Minnesota's series lead to 2-1 on the strength of their 14-for-29 shooting from 3-point range. Anthony Edwards had a quiet 19 points to lead the Wolves, who went just 10 for 32 from deep even with a 4-for-5 effort from Karl-Anthony Towns. They failed to get Towns (14 points) enough shots and played slower than they did in the first two games in Denver while falling behind by as many as 34 points. "I'll take the blame for this loss. I came out with no energy at all. I can't afford to do that for my team. I let my team down, coaches down, fans down," Edwards said. "I'll be ready Sunday." The Nuggets became the 30th team in the history of the NBA playoffs to lose the first two games at home in a best-of-seven series. Five have rallied to win. "You're always testing and finding out about human nature and what guys are made of," Nuggets coach Mike Malone said. This was the step forward Denver badly needed, breaking the 100-point barrier for the first time in three games against Minnesota's NBA-best defense. "Everything was sharp. Everything was fast," Jokic said. Murray, who totaled just 25 points on 9-for-32 shooting with a minus-38 rating over the first two games, drew a \$100,000 fine from the NBA for chucking a heat pack onto the floor from the bench. The stone-faced point guard thrived on a mix of spot-up jumpers and fadeaways set up by dribble-handoffs, clearly with more spring in his step after three days to rest the strained left calf muscle that has hampered him over the last few weeks. Jokic and Aaron Gordon helped initiate the offense, alleviating the ball-handling load on Murray. "His teammates freed him up, but he was aggressive and saw the ball go in early," Malone said. "I think he does kind of relish those moments where he's the bad guy." The defending champions not only brought the energy they promised would return after their no-show at home, but they hit enough of their shots to help keep the Wolves and their active rotations honest. The whistles tightened and Wolves defensive ace Jaden McDaniels was limited by foul trouble. After sweeping Phoenix and dominating Denver in the first two games, the Wolves received their first reality check after their head-turning Game 2 dominance in Denver. The "Wolves in 4!" chant that erupted right before the opening tip was quickly ditched. The Nuggets controlled the noise by creeping to a 28-20 edge after the first quarter, their largest lead of the series to date, and they didn't stop there. They were up by 20 points late in the second quarter. The Wolves got NBA Defensive Player of the Year Rudy Gobert back after he missed Game 2 for the birth of his son, but the Nuggets zipped the ball around so well outside of the paint so well that his long arms were largely a nonfactor. Gordon swished back-to-back 3-pointers and Porter hit one on the next possession midway through the third quarter to make it 72-50 and thwart another mini-Wolves rally. -Associated Press

<u>Game Recap</u>

The Minnesota Timberwolves, led by Anthony Edwards and Karl-Anthony Towns, overpowered the Denver Nuggets on Monday night in a stunningly efficient 106-80 thrashing of the reigning but reeling NBA champions. "We've had some really good defensive efforts this year," Wolves coach Chris Finch said after his team took a surprising 2-0 lead in the Western Conference semifinals. "That has to be right up there with the best of them." The Wolves held Denver to an ugly 29-of-83 shooting night, and the most impressive thing about that was the absence of their best defender, 7-foot-1 center Rudy Gobert, who was back in Minneapolis for the birth of his son. Towns and Edwards both scored 27 points as the Wolves improved to 6-0 in the playoffs and gave themselves a chance to close out the fuming Nuggets with wins Friday night and Sunday in Minneapolis. So flustered were the Nuggets by the second quarter that coach Michael Malone threw a fit at an official and scuffling point guard Jamal Murray threw a heat pack onto the court in frustration as Towns was about to score on a layup. Malone said he had no idea it was Murray who tossed the heat pack, saying, "I knew a heating pack was on the floor, but it was not in my field of vision." Nor did the officials see him throw it, added crew chief Marc Davis. "We weren't aware it had come from the bench If we would have been aware it came from the bench, we could have reviewed it under the hostile act trigger. The penalty would have been a technical foul," Davis told a pool reporter. Finch said he knew only that the heat pack had come from the Nuggets' bench. "We tried to impress upon (the officials) that there's probably not many fans in the building that have a heat pack. So, it probably had to come from the bench, which they found logical," Finch said. "But yeah, it's inexcusable and dangerous." Murray, who has shot 9 for 32 in this series, left Ball Arena without comment for the second straight game. He is likely to be fined by the NBA for his actions. Aaron Gordon led Denver with 20 points, Nikola Jokic had 16 points and 16 rebounds but their third-leading scorer was sub Justin Holliday with 13 points. Murray scored eight points on 3-of-18 shooting. Kyle Anderson replaced Gobert in the starting lineup and had eight assists and nine rebounds and reserves Naz Reid and Nickeil Alexander-Walker both scored 14. During a 43-18 first-half flourish by the Timberwolves — Edwards was on the bench for much of it, no less — the Nuggets grew so frustrated that Malone ran way out onto the court and got in Davis' face for an extended blowup during a timeout but avoided a technical. Davis explained. Frustrated by their slow starts — the Nuggets have trailed by double digits in six of their seven playoff games and by nine in the other — Malone challenged his team to get off to a strong start for once. Only Gordon heeded his coach's call, scoring 13 quick points, including a 3-pointer that brought the Nuggets to 18-17 late in the first quarter. Things unraveled for Denver after that. Trailing 61-35 at the break, the Nuggets' 26-point halftime deficit was Denver's largest in a home playoff game in franchise history. Now the Nuggets, who lost consecutive games just once during the season, find themselves needing to beat Edwards four times in five tries to advance to the Western Conference finals again, a seemingly impossibility given both teams' level of play at the moment. "The message we want to send is that we're extremely honored and blessed that we have this opportunity to go home up 2-0," Towns said. 2024 POSTSEASON TEAM NOTES

2-0 IN FAVOR OF THE CHALLENGER

With their Game 2 win in Denver, The Timberwolves took a 2-0 series lead have now won six consecutive playoff games, the longest streak in team history. The Timberwolves previous record for most consecutive playoff wins was two. The Wolves have also tied the NBA Playoff record for most consecutive wins to start a playoff run for a three-seed, tying the 2004 San Antonio Spurs and the 2020 Boston Celtics.

10+ BLOCKS/10+ STEALS

Minnesota finished Game 2 in Denver with 11 steals, marking the 13th time in franchise playoff history the Wolves collected 10+ steals. The Timberwolves also finished the night with 12 blocks, marking a franchise playoff-high and the third time the team rejected 10+ shots in a playoff game. Tonight marked just the second time in franchise history that the Wolves tallied 10+ steals and 10+ blocks in a playoff game.

THREE-SEED STREAKING

The Wolves six straight wins to start the playoffs are tied for the most consecutive wins to start a playoff run by a three seed in NBA history, tying the 2004 San Antonio Spurs and 2020 Boston Celtics.

BUILDING A LEAD A MILE HIGH

The Wolves led by as many as 32 points in Game 2 at Denver, the biggest lead in franchise playoff history.

The Timberwolves led 61-35 at halftime of Game 2, marking the largest halftime lead on the road against a defending champion since the Cleveland Cavaliers led the Chicago Bulls 59-33 in the Eastern Conference Finals on May 21, 1992.

GAME WON - ROUND TWO

With their Game 1 win in Denver on May 4, the Timberwolves have won a franchise-best five consecutive playoff games following their first-round sweep of the Phoenix Suns. The May 4 win also marked the second time in franchise history the team won a Game 1 on the road (April 16, 2022, at Memphis).

DOWN LOW DAWGZ

Minnesota outscored Denver 52-42 in the paint in their Game 1 victory in Denver. The Nuggets outscored the Timberwolves in all four of the team's regular season matchups (186-216). The Wolves have now outscored their opponents down low in four of their five playoff games this season.

THAT'S A SWEEP!

With their Game 4 win in Phoenix on April 28, the Timberwolves swept the Suns, the first time in franchise history completing a four-game sweep and the first time winning a playoff series since 2004. It is the first four-game sweep in a best-of-seven series in Minneapolis sport's history.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

After trailing 61-56 at the half of Game 4 in Phoenix, the Timberwolves came back to win, marking the first time in franchise history they have come back to win a playoff game on the road after trailing at halftime (1-21).

DEFENSIVE DOGS

In holding the Nuggets to just 80 points in Game 2, the Timberwolves held Denver to their fewest points scored this season in either the regular or postseason. It marked the second consecutive time holding the Nuggets under 100 points and the fourth time doing so this season including regular season and playoffs. No other team held Denver under 100 points more than once.

Denver's 80 points are tied for the fourth-lowest point total for an opponent in franchise playoff history and the lowest playoff opponent point total since holding the Lakers to 71 points on May 23, 2004.

COMFORTABLE AWAY FROM HOME

With their Game 2 win in Denver, Minnesota became the 34th team in NBA history to win both Game 1 and Game 2 of a best-of-seven playoff series on the road. Of the previous 33 teams that did so. 28 went on to win the series.

Additionally, the Wolves are now the sixth Western Conference team since 2000 to win their first four road playoff games. Of the previous five teams to do so, four went on to win the NBA Finals.

DID YA'LL FORGET ABOUT OUR D?

In holding the Nuggets to 99 points, Game 1 in Denver marked the first time during the 2024 NBA Playoffs the Nuggets failed to reach 100 points. Including the regular season, the Timberwolves have now held the Nuggets under 100 points in all three of their wins against Denver this year. The Nuggets were held under 100 just eight times during the 2023-24 regular season, the Wolves were the only team to do so twice. Minnesota has held their opponents under 100 points three times during this year's playoffs.

MINNESOTA'S OFFENSE WAS FELLING HOT! HOT! HOT!

After their 122-116 win in Game 4 vs. the Suns, the Timberwolves scored 120+ points for the third time in the first round series, marking the first time in franchise history they scored 120+ points three times in a playoff series. Their 118.3 points per game average vs. the Suns are the most in any playoff series in franchise history.

The Wolves 122 points in their Game 4 win were the most in any Game 4 in franchise history and the third most in any playoff game in franchise history.

The Wolves held the Suns to just 103.3 points per game durin their first round playoff series. Minnesota's +15 point differential vs. the Suns is the best mark in franchise playoff history.

DID SOME ONE SAY SECOND HALF HOT DOGS?

The Wolves shot 71.1% (27-of-38) in the second half of Game 1 at Denver, the best field goal percentage in a half of a road playoff game since the San Antonio Spurs shot 75.8% (25-of-33) in the first half at the Miami Heat in Game 3 of the 2014 NBA Finals.

SURRENDER NO LEAD

The Wolves never trailed in their Game 3 victory over the Suns, marking just the third wire-to-wire playoff win in franchise history.



2024 POSTSEASON TEAM NOTES

3-OH!

With their Game 3 win on April 26 in Phoenix, the Timberwolves took a 3-0 lead in a playoff series for the first time in franchise history. It also marked the first time the Wolves have won three consecutive playoff games.

BOARDROOM 50

Led by Rudy Gobert's 14 boards, Minnesota tallied 50 rebounds, setting the franchise record for most rebounds in a Game 3 of a playoff series. Game 3 was the second game of the series in which the Wolves collected 50+ boards after pulling down 52 rebounds in Game 1.

SIX FOR OVER TEN

With six Timberwolves scoring 10+ points in Game 3, Minnesota tied the franchise playoff record for most players with 10+ points in a single playoff game. It marked the eighth time the Wolves have accomplished the feat and the second time consecutive time doing so in this series (Game 2).

WOLVES FEAST OFF PHOENIX TURNOVERS IN GM2

Minnesota forced Phoenix into 20 turnovers in Game 2 on April 23, which resulted in 31 points for the Wolves. The Wolves stifling defense set a franchise record for forced turnovers and points off turnovers.

With the Wolves outscoring the Suns in points off turnovers 31-2, the +29 differential tied the largest margin by any NBA team in a playoff game since 1997-98. Denver was +29 (41-12) at New Orleans on April 27, 2009.

WOLVES TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE FREEBIES

The Timberwolves went 20-of-22 (.909) from the free throw line in Game 1, their fourth highest percentage from the foul line in a Playoff game in franchise history and the fifth time in franchise history they shot 90.0%+ from the foul line in a Playoff game.

In Game 2, the Wolves finished the night going 26-of-30 (86.7%) from the free throw line, the ninth time in franchise history making 25+ free throws in a Playoff game and the ninth time in franchise history shooting 30+ free throws in a Playoff game.

BULLIES ON THE BOARDS

Minnesota outrebounded Phoenix 52-28 in Game 1, tied for the third-most rebounds in any Playoff game in franchise history. The Wolves' +24 advantage on the boards marked the largest rebounding differential in franchise Playoff history (previous: +19, 58-39 on April 21, 2002 at Dallas Mavericks).

Phoenix' 28 rebounds in Game 1 tied an opponent low in Timberwolves Playoff history (28 vs. Portland on April 30, 2000) and the Suns' three offensive rebounds marked an opponent low for a Playoff game (previous low: four 2x; MR: at Dallas on April 21, 2002).

WE OWN THE PAINT

The Wolves dominated the Suns down low in Game 1, outscoring the Suns in the paint 52-34. Minnesota's +18 paint points advantage is the largest such margin in franchise Playoff history.

WIDE MARGIN WINS

Per STATS Perform, through the first two games of the series, the Wolves have outscored the Suns by 37 points. Since the 2020 Playoffs, the only other team to be ± 37 or better through two playoff games was the eventual NBA Champion Denver Nuggets last season at ± 38 .

With the Wolves winning by double-figures in each of the first two games of the 2024 NBA playoffs, it marks just the second time (April 18-21, 2004 vs. Denver) that Minnesota has won consecutive Playoff games by double-figures.

DOUBLE THE DOUBLE-DOUBLES

With Gobert and Towns each tallying a point/rebound double-double in Game 3, it marked the fifth time in franchise playoff history two players recorded such a double-double in the same playoff game.

10+ STEALS IN A PLAYOFF GAME

Led by Edwards and Gobert, who each had three steals, the Timberwolves tallied 11 steals in the Game 2 victory against the Suns, marking the 12th time in franchise history they have collected 10+ steals in a Playoff game and first time doing so since April 21, 2022, vs. Memphis. Minnesota's Playoff franchise record for steals in a game is 12 (3X; MR: April 29, 2022, vs. Memphis).

ALL HANDS ON DECK

With all Timberwolves' starters scoring 10+ points in Game 2 vs. the Suns, it marked the seventh Playoff game in franchise history that all five starters scored 10+ points and the first such Playoff game with all five starters also tallying at least one steal.

COOLING OFF PHOENIX'S OFFENSE

With Minnesota holding Phoenix to 95 total points in Game 1, it marked the first time the Timberwolves have held an opponent to 100 points or under in the Playoffs since the L.A. Lakers score 96 points on May 31, 2004.

Game 1 marked the 33rd time in Timberwolves franchise history they held a Playoff opponent to 100 points or fewer and the 25th time holding a Playoff opponent to 95 points or less.

During the regular season, the Timberwolves held their oppoent to 100 points or fewer 27 times, going 24-3 when doing so. Their 27 games and 24 wins both led the league.

Phoenix was held to 100 points or fewer just six times during the regular season, going 1-5 in those games.

TOURCHING THE SUNS D

The Timberwolves scored 120 points in their Game 1 win, marking the second-most points scored in a Game 1 in franchise history (130 at Memphis on April 16, 2022) and tied for the third-most points in any Playoff game in franchise history.

Minnesota's 120 points in Game 1 vs. Phoenix on Saturday were the most points scored by any team in Game 1 of the First Round of the 2024 NBA Playoffs.

GAME WON

The Wolves April 20 win marked the third time in franchise history the Timberwolves have won Game 1 of a Playoff series.

IRON MAN NICKEIL

Nickeil Alexander-Walker started 20 games this season and appeared in all 82 games, averaging 8.0 points on 43.9% shooting, including 39.1% from deep, 2.0 rebounds and a career-high 2.5 assists per contest. Alexander-Walker also made a career-high 131 threes this season.

Alexander-Walker is one of 17 players in the NBA to play in all 82 games this season and became the 37th player in franchise history to do so. Taj Gibson and Tyus Jones were the last Timberwolves to do so in the 2017-18 season.

THE DEFENSIVE ANCHOR - RUDY GOBERT

Rudy Gobert played in and started in 76 games this season, the fourth-most appearances in his career and the most games played since he appeared in 81 games in the 2018-19 season.

Gobert averaged 14.0 points, 12.9 rebounds and 2.13 blocks per contest. His 2.13 blocks were his most blocks per game since 2020-21 (2.68 BPG) and he attempted 614 shots, the second most shot attempts of his career (2016-17: 625 FGA). Gobert averaged 34.1 minutes per game, the second time in his career he played 34+ minutes per night (2019-20: 34.3 MPG).

Gobert finished the 2023-24 campaign with 54 point/rebound double-doubles, the 15th time in franchise history a player finished with 54+ point/rebound double doubles. Gobert joins Kevin Garnett, Kevin Love, Al Jefferson, and Karl-Anthony Towns as the only players in franchise history to do so. Gobert also tallied 38 double-doubles with at least two blocks this season, the second most such games in franchise history in a single season, trailing only Kevin Garnett's 2003-04 season (47 games).

MINNESOTA MIKE AGES LIKE DICK CLARK

Mike Conley finished the season averaging 11.4 points on 45.7% shooting, including a career-high 44.2% from deep, 2.9 rebounds, 5.9 assists, 1.16 steals and a career-low 1.3 turnovers per game. His 45.7% field goal percentage was the second-highest in a single season in his career (2016-17: 46.0%).

Conley tallied 15 games this season with 15+ points on 4+ made-threes, becoming just the 12th player in NBA history aged 36 or older to tally 15+ games with 15+ points and 4+ made threes. His 15 such games are the most in franchise history.

Conley is just the eigth player in NBA history (since 1967-68) aged 36 or older to shoot 44.0%+ from beyond the three-point line in a single season (min. 100 3PA). Conley's 179 made threes this season are the third most such made threes by a player 36 years or older in NBA history (since 1967-68).

HISTORIC WOLVES DEFENSE IS A PROBLEM FOR THE ASSOCIATION

On April 3 vs. Toronto, Minnesota's defense held the Raptors to just 36.7% (33-of-90) from the field. It marked the Wolves 23rd game this season holding their opponents to 40.0% shooting or worse, the most by any team in the NBA this season with the next closet team being Oklahoma City (16 games). Minnesota went 20-3 when holding teams to 40.0% shooting or below.

Following their 133-85 win vs. Toronto on April 3, the Timberwolves have shot 50% or better from the field while holding opponents to 40% or worse from the field in 13 games this season. The Wolves went 12-0 this year when doing so.

In their April 3 matchup against the Raptors, they held Toronto to 36.7%% (33-of-90) shooting, Minnesota had 18 games on the season allowing 100 points or fewer on 40.0% shooting or worse, the most such games in the NBA this season; Boston (11 games) and Oklahoma City (10 games) were the only other teams to have 10+ such games.

THE UNDER 30.0% THREE-POINT CLUB

The Hawks shot just 30.0% (9-of-30) from deep on April 12, marking the 25th time the season the Wolves held their opponents to 30.0% or worse from three, tied for the **most** such games in the NBA this season. Minnesota was 24-1 when doing so, with their 24 such wins being the most in the NBA.

THAT'S HOME COOKIN'

Minnesota's April 12 win over Atlanta marked the Wolves 30th at Target Center this season, marking the fifth time in franchise history Minnesota has won 30+ games at home and the first time doing so since 2017-18 (30-11).

ANOTHER 20-POINT COMEBACK

After trailing by 21 points at the 1:04 mark in the first quarter against the Wizards on April 9, the Timberwolves stormed back to win. It marked their second 20+ point comeback win of the season, marking the first time in franchise history the Wolves have had multiple 20+ point comebacks in the same season. It was Minnesota's 14th 20+ point comeback victory in franchise history.

THESE WOLVES BOUNCE BACK

Following the Timberwolves 116-107 loss on the road against the Nuggets on April 10 and the Wolves 109-106 victory over the Hawks on April 12, Minnesota is an NBA-best 21-4 (.840) in games immediately following a loss this season, the best mark in franchise history, besting the 2003-04 team. (19-5, .792).

The Wolves never lost three consecutive games the entire 2023-24 campaign. This marks just the second time in franchise history Minnesota avoided a three-game slide throughout an entire season (2003-04).

SHUTTING THE DOOR IN THE SECOND HALF

The Timberwolves were stingy on the defensive end this season, only allowing teams to average **51.5** points per game in the second half, while allowing opponents just **.437** shooting percentage from the floor, both were **tops in the NBA**.

HOLDING OPPONENTS TO 90 OR BELOW

In holding the Raptors to 85 points on April 3, it marked the **eighth** time this season Minnesota held their foes to 90 points or below this season, the **most such games** in the NBA this season.

WE'RE GOING BACK-TO-BACK

This season, the Timberwolves will play in a total of 13 back-to-back sets: three home-home, five away-away, one home-away and four away-home. To this point in the season, Minnesota is 10-4 in back-to-back sets, 5-2 in both the first and second games. The Wolves swept their third consecutive back-to-back set with a 121-100 win in Los Angeles against the Clippers on Feb. 12 and a 121-109 win in Portland on Feb. 13. The Wolves join the Knicks as the only other team in the NBA season to have swept three consecutive back-to-back sets and it marks just the fourth time in franchise history the Timberwolves have done so. On Feb. 27 and Feb. 28 Minnesota beat San Antonio and Memphis in back-to-back games, their fourth back-to-back set sweep of the season. To this point, The Timberwolves are 6-2 (.750) this season when playing on the second day of a back-to-back, which is second best in the NBA (Boston, 8-2). For an entire season, Minnesota's best record on no rest is 13-7 (.650) in 2003-04.

Minnesota finished their season going 18-8 in back-to-back games, 10-3 on the first night and 8-5 in the second night. The Wolves won 10+ games on the front end of the back-to-backs for the first time since 2013-14 and just the eighth time doing so in team history. The .769 winning percentage this season on the front end of back-to-backs is the best in team history.

Chris Finch was named Head Coach of the Minnesota Timberwolves on February 22, 2021, becoming the team's 16th Head Coach. On April 11, 2022, the Timberwolves announced a multi-year contract extension for Finch along with his coaching staff.

His 160 total wins over the last four seasons rank second in team history and his .558 winning percentage passes Flip Saunders' franchise-best mark (.521). After the Timberwolves' 99-96 win over the Golden State Warriors on Mar. 26, Finch recorded his 100th career win, joining Saunders as the only two coaches in Wolves history with 100 or more victories.

On Dec. 4, 2024, the NBA named Finch Western Conference Coach of the Month for October and November after guiding the Wolves to a 14-4 record to begin the 2023-24 season. It was the first monthly honor of his coaching career, he became the third Timberwolves head coach to win the award, joining Kevin McHale (January 2009) and Flip Saunders (April 2004, February 2003, January 2001 and January 2000). Following the Wolves' Feb. 4 (including tiebreaker scenarios).

This marked the first time in Finch's career being named an All-Star Head Coach and the second time in Timberwolves history a head coach has been named to the All-Star Game. Flip Saunders coached the Western Conference All-Stars to a 136-132 victory at the 2004 NBA All-Star Game in Los Angeles.

The Timberwolves finished the 2023-24 campaign 56-26, the second-highest win total in franchise history. Minnesota secured the No. 3 seed in the Western Conference, marking the third consecutive year making the NBA Playoffs, the most consecutive seasons making the playoffs since eight straight appearances from 1997-2004.

During the 2022-23 season, Finch led the Timberwolves to a 42-40 record, eclipsing 40 wins on the season in back-to-back seasons (46 in 2021-22) for the first time since the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. After defeating the Oklahoma City Thunder on Apr. 14 in the final NBA Play-In Tournament game, the Wolves clinched a spot in the NBA Playoffs for the second consecutive season. This marked the first time clinching back-to-back playoff appearances since a string of eight straight from 1997-2004. The team's second place finish in the Northwest Division was the highest since winning the division in 2003-04. With the team's 151-131 win over the San Antonio Spurs on Apr. 8, the Timberwolves clinched a .500 or better record this for the third time since 2004-05. The team has now done so in back-to-back seasons (.561 in 2021-22) for the first time since the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. After the team's 29 wins against Western Conference foes this season and 32 such wins last season, Minnesota has won 25+ games against the West in back-to-back years for the first time since 2003-04 and 2004-05. The 11 wins in January of 2023 were the most by a Wolves team in the month of January since winning 12 games in January of 2004.

During the 2021-22 season, Finch led the Timberwolves to a 46-36 record, the seventh-best record in club history, including a trip to the Playoffs for just the second time in the last 18 years. He helped guide the Wolves to a 26-15 record at Target Center and a 32-20 record against the Western Conference, the second time since 2004-05 with 30+ wins against the West. With the 136-130 victory over the Denver Nuggets on April 1, the Wolves finished the season 12-4 against Northwest Division foes, the most division wins by the team since the division was formed in 2004 and just the third time since 2004 winning 10+ division games. Additionally, Minnesota finished the season winning 10 straight games against Northwest division opponents, the most since 2004. The team finished the 2021-22 campaign with 20 road wins for the first time since the 2004-05 season and just the fifth time winning 20+ road games.

Finch took the helm mid-season in the 2020-2021 season, leading the Timberwolves to win half of their last 22 games, finishing 16-25 overall. After the All-Star break, Finch was able to unlock another level of talent in young players such as 2020-21 NBA All-Rookie First Team honoree Anthony Edwards, as well as Jaden McDaniels. Under Finch's guidance, Edwards was named the Western Conference Rookie of the Month three times last season (March, April and May), becoming the third player in Wolves history to earn the honor multiple times (Karl-Anthony Towns in 2015-16 and Andrew Wiggins in 2014-15).

Since arriving in Minnesota, Finch has jumped into helping the Twin Cities community. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of Second Harvest Heartland where he assists the organization, playing a critical role in helping Second Harvest Heartland fulfill its mission of ending hunger.

Finch, 54, has over 25 years of NBA and G League experience, serving most recently as an assistant coach under Nick Nurse and the Toronto Raptors this season. Prior to that, he made coaching stops with the New Orleans Pelicans as associate head coach from 2017-20, the Denver Nuggets as an assistant coach from 2016-17 and the Houston Rockets as an assistant coach from 2011-16. Finch was named the head coach of the Rio Grande Valley Vipers, the Rocket's G League affiliate in 2009. He led the Vipers to back-to-back G League Finals appearances, compiling a 67-33 (.670) record in his two seasons.

After leading Rio Grande Valley to the 2010 G League Championship, Finch received the Dennis Johnson Trophy as the league's best head coach.

The Reading, Pennsylvania native played overseas in the British Basketball League (BBL) for the Sheffield Sharks from 1993-97 before coaching the same team from 1997-2003. Finch was named the BBL Coach of the Year in 1998-99. He continued to coach overseas for 12 years including in Germany and Belgium.

Finch also served as the head coach of Great Britain's National Team from 2006-13, where he led the national team in the 2012 Summer Olympics in London. He also led them to a European Championship berth in 2009 and 2011, the team's first appearances since 1981.

A Franklin & Marshall College graduate in 1992, Finch was as a two-time All-American, and was inducted into the F&M Sports Hall of Fame in 2002. He started the final 115 games of his collegiate career and compiled a 102-13 record (.887), which stood as the most career wins as a starter in NCAA Division III history.

- Kyle Anderson started Game 2 in Denver on May 6, finishing with six points, nine rebounds, including seven offensive rebounds, eight assists and two steals. Anderson's seven offensive rebounds were the most in franchise playoff history since Mark Madsen pulled down eight offensive boards vs. Sacramento on May 14, 2004.
- Anderson stuffed the stat sheet on April 2 vs. Houston, finishing with 13 points on 6-of-8 shooting, including 1-of-2 from deep, six rebounds, nine assists, two steals and two blocks in 30:09 minutes off the bench. It marked his first game of the season with 10+ points/5+ rebounds/5+ assists/2+ steals/2+ blocks, his fifth such game of his career and the first time doing so as a reserve.

- Anderson scored nine of his 14 points in the third quarter against Detroit, marking a season-high for points in any quarter.
- Anderson added 10 points, six rebounds and five assists against the Warriors on March 24, marking his fourth consecutive 10+ point game and 14th of the season (179th career) as well as his fifth such game in his last six outings.
