



JEREMY EVANS

Highlights: Finished his four-year career as the school's all-time field goal percentage leader at 63.9 percent... With 224 career blocked shots, Evans passed former WKU All-American Chris Marcus as the school's all-time leader... Became just the second player in WKU history with 1,000 points, 750 rebounds, and 200 blocks... Also honored with the Danny Rumph Outstanding Teammate Award.

2009-10 (Senior): Appeared in 34 games (34 starts), averaged 10.0 points, 6.9 rebounds and 1.8 blocks per game... Connected on 137-of-211 field goal attempts for a Sun Belt Conference best 64.9 percent... Scored in double figures 18 times in 2009-10 while leading the Hilltoppers in rebounds on 14 occasions... Had season-high's of 19 points and 17 rebounds, in an overtime road win at Florida Atlantic (Feb. 25).

2008-09 (Junior): Appeared in 34 games, averaged 8.8 points, 5.7 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game... Led the team in blocked shots with 68, sixth most in a single season at WKU... Connecting on 123-of-194 shots for a league-leading 63.4 percent... Posted four double doubles, all coming on the road, second most on the team... Set career-highs for points and rebounds with 22 and 12 in a win at Arkansas State (Feb. 2), going 10-of-12 from the field... Blocked a season-high-tying five shots against 10th-ranked Gonzaga in the NCAA Tournament Second Round.

2007-08 (Sophomore): Appeared in 34 games, averaged 5.9 points, 5.2 rebounds and 1.5 blocks per game... Led team and ranked third in league with 51 blocked shots... Shot 62.5 percent from the field... Named the Most Valuable Player of the Sun Belt Conference Tournament after averaging 13.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per game while shooting 78.9 percent (15-of-19) from the floor... Posted a season-best 20 points and 14 rebounds on 8-of-9 shooting in the SBC Tournament championship victory over Middle Tennessee (Mar. 11).

2006-07 (Freshman): Appeared in 32 games, averaged 7.0 points, 5.7 rebounds (team-leading) and 1.4 blocks per game... Finished with a team-high 44 blocks... Recorded a career-high 12 rebounds against Louisiana-Lafayette (Jan. 13).

Personal: Native of Crossett, Ark... Had a sketch of analyst Dan Bonner showcased on CBS' national television broadcast of the Hilltoppers NCAA Tournament Second Round Battle with #10 Gonzaga... Majored in interdisciplinary studies major with a concentration in art.
