Highlights: Played in all 136 games during his four-year career at Notre Dame... Ranks first in Fighting Irish history in games played... His 122 starts place him third in Notre Dame history in that category... Averaged 9.1 points per game and 5.1 assists per game during his career... Boasted a 3.9 rebounds per game average... His 694 career assists rank second in Irish history, while his assist average ranks fourth in program history... Second in school history with 211 steals... 1,231 career points... Only second player (Chris Thomas the other) in Irish history to score over 1,000 points and dish off more than 600 assists.

2009-10 (Senior): Appeared in 35 games (35 starts), averaging 9.6 points, 2.7 rebounds and 5.3 assists... Logged a team-high 1,312 minutes on the floor... Reached double-figures in points on 14 occasions... Had six-plus assists in 16 contests... His 185 assists led all Fighting Irish players... Finished the campaign ranked 12th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.68)... Notched a team-best 51 steals (1.5 per game) and hauled in 95 rebounds along with blocking four shots.

2008-09 (Junior): Appeared in 36 games (34 starts), averaging 10.6 points, 4.4 rebounds and 4.9 assists... Averaged a career-best points per game... Reached double figures 20 times... Led the team in scoring on four occasions... Notched a team-best 177 assists... Dished off six-plus assists in 14 contests... Scored six points and dished out eight assists in season-opening win over USC Upstate... Finished with 16 points, seven rebounds and four steals at Loyola Marymount... Matched his career-high with 21 points versus Indiana in first game of the EA Sports Maui Invitational.

2007-08 (Sophomore): Appeared in 33 games (33 starts), averaging 8.0 points, 5.1 rebounds and 5.9 assists... Led the BIG EAST in assists for the second straight year in overall games and conference contests... Notched second straight double-double and third of his career against Pittsburgh as he finished with 16 points and a career-high 13 rebound ... Also dished off five assists and made three steals while not committing a turnover in 37 minutes.

2006-07 (Freshman): Appeared in 32 games (20 starts), averaging 7.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists... Netted double figures in 10 outings... Scored in double figures six of the last nine games... Finished with a career-high 21 points, grabbed seven rebounds and dished off seven assists while playing all 40 minutes in win over Marquette.
