Highlights: Named to Big Ten All-Freshman Team as a freshman ... Named to All-Big Ten Second Team as a sophomore ... Won a silver medal with the 2007 United States U19 National Team in the FIBA World Championship.

2009-10 (Senior): Appeared 36 games (33 starts), averaged 11.3 points, 6.2 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game ... Ranked second on the team in scoring, rebounding and field-goal percentage (.529) ... Played in 36 of the team's 37 games, starting 33 of them ... Scored in double figures 20 times while recording six double-doubles ... Scored a season-high 23 points on 7-for-12 shooting against Minnesota ... Grabbed a season-high 14 rebounds against Ohio State.

2008-09 (Junior): Appeared 35 games (26 starts), averaged 10.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.2 assists per game ... Ranked second on the team in scoring and rebounds ... Played in 25 of the team's 38 games, starting 26 of them ... Scored in double figures 15 times, including six games with 20 or more points. Scored a season-high 29 points on 9-for-11 shooting against Oklahoma State ... Scored 26 points on 11-for-12 shooting to go along with 10 rebounds against The Citadel.

2007-08 (Sophomore): Appeared in 36 games (all starts), averaged 14.0 points, 6.1 rebounds and 1.6 assists per game ... Led team in scoring, while ranking second in rebounds ... scored in double figures 27 times including seven games with 20 or more points. Scored a career-high 31 points against Minnesota on 11-for-17 shooting to go along with 10 rebounds ... Grabbed a season-high 14 rebounds to go along with 13 points against Louisiana-Monroe.

2006-07 (Freshman): Appeared in 28 games (25 starts), averaged 11.7 points and 5.2 rebounds per game ... Ranked second on team in scoring and third in rebounds ... Played in 28 of the team's 35 games ... Scored in double figures 22 times, including a season-high 19 points in the NCAA Tournament against North Carolina ... Scored 18 points on 8-for-14 shooting against Michigan.
