Highlights: Was a key player for Tennessee over last two seasons, being a major contributor in the Vols 2010 NCAA Tournament run... Named SEC Sixth Man of the Year as a sophomore.

2009-10 (Senior): Appeared in 37 games (31 starts), averaged 9.9 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game... Ranked second on team in assists (3.1 apg) and field-goal percentage (.530), first in steals (1.5 spg) and fourth in scoring (9.9 ppg)... Played in all 37 of the team's games, starting 31 of them... Scored in double figures 20 times, including a season-high 22 points on 9-for-10 shooting against Vanderbilt... Scored 20 points on 6-for-10 shooting against Kentucky... Scored 14 points to go along with six assists in an NCAA Tournament win over Ohio State.

Junior (2008-09): Appeared in 31 games (23 starts), averaged 9.9 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game... Ranked first on team in steals (1.5 spg) and field-goal percentage (.572), while ranking third in points (9.9 ppg) and assists (3.1 apg)... Started 23 of 31 games played, scoring in double figures 18 times, including seven games in a row to start the season... Scored a season-high 20 points to go along with nine rebounds against South Carolina... Grabbed a season-high 10 rebounds to go along with 14 points against Alabama.

Redshirt Sophomore (2007-08): Appeared in 27 games (2 starts), averaged 8.0 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 1.8 assists per game... Scored in double figures eight times, including a season-high 23 points on 9-for-14 shooting against Xavier... Scored 13 points to go along with eight rebounds against Memphis... Dished a season-high seven assists against UNC Asheville.

Sophomore (2006-07): Arizona Played just three games for Arizona before transferring to Tennessee, where he spent the second half of the season sitting out.

Freshman (2005-06) Arizona: Appeared in 28 games (no starts), averaged 2.2 points, 1.9 rebounds, and 1.8 assists per game ... Scored a season-high eight points to go along with five rebounds and four assists against Sam Houston State.
