



The Dallas Mavericks, the Jason Terry Foundation and Century 21 Mike Bowman, Inc. are pleased to present the second annual Dallas Mavericks Scholarship to Metroplex high school seniors, who are in financial need.

Eligibility

Currently enrolled high school seniors within a 75-mile radius of American Airlines Center and are eligible to attend a two- or four-year college or university may apply. Applicants must be legal U.S. residents, be less than 21 years, have a minimum 3.0 GPA and participate in extracurricular activities.

Relatives or immediate family members of the Dallas Mavericks employees or Century 21 Mike Bowman, Inc. are not eligible to apply for the scholarships.

Requirements

- Eligible students must submit a complete application (typed or clearly printed) and staple (**no paper or binder clips**) all of the required documentation or their application will not be reviewed.
- Applications must be postmarked by **February 24, 2012**

Terms & Conditions

Six scholarships will be awarded: two \$5,000, two \$2,500 and two \$1,800.

Scholarship recipients must enroll in and attend a two- or four-year accredited college or university in the academic year following their selection. Verification of enrollment is required. Scholarship funds will be paid via check directly to the accredited institution in which the student enrolls. Scholarship funds will not be paid directly, nor reimbursed, to an award recipient. Recipients will be responsible for getting the appropriate paperwork from college of choice.

Scholarship funds will be applied toward tuition, fees and/or other appropriate educational expenses, as determined by the Dallas Mavericks.

Supporting Documents (REQUIRED) - Must send all items together and in following order:

- Application (see below) – typed or written legibly
- Applicants must submit an essay two pages or less on: **“What is the most important lesson you have learned up to this point and how will you apply that lesson moving forward?”** OR **“What does attending college mean to you?”**
- Three (3) letters of recommendation referencing academic and community status – two (2) must come from teachers and/or administrators
- A current (2010 or 2011) copy of the IRS Form 1040 filed by his or her parent(s) or guardian(s) used to document total income.
- A certified high school transcript that contains student’s class rank and test scores
- College acceptance letter(s) (if already accepted)

Certification & Release

All applicants and, where appropriate, their parent or guardian, must sign the attached application, certifying that all information provided is true and complete to the best of their knowledge. Upon submission of the completed application, applicants grant the Dallas Mavericks the right to use any information contained in the application for the purpose of promoting and publicizing the Program, or as legally required or permitted by law.
