BUCK SHOTS

- Over the last six contests, Mo Williams is averaging 15.3 points and 9.8 assists per game ... the Bucks are 5-1 in those games.
- On Tuesday, Jake Voskuhl scored a season-high 9 points in just under 7 minutes ... Jake was perfect from the field (2-2) and 5-6 from the charity stripe.
- Bucks guard Ramon Sessions, assigned to the Tulsa 66ers of the D-League, is the first D-League Performer of the week (announced November 26, 2007) after leading Tulsa to a 2-0 record with averages of 20.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists.
- Michael Redd has dropped in at least one three-pointer in each Bucks win this season and is second on the Bucks in 3FG% shooting (.354) this season.
- The Bucks are tied for fourth in the league with 5.5 blocks per game (66). Andrew Bogut leads the way with 2.1, which is 10th in the NBA. It took 27 games last season for the Bucks to reach 66 blocks and through 12 games that season they averaged 2.8.
- Dan Gadzuric needs just three blocks to pass Terry Cummings (347) for 10th in franchise Bucks history.
- Yi Jianlian is among the top-5 rookie leaders in points (10.1, T-2nd), rebounds (6.1, 2nd), free throw percentage (.778, 2nd), steals (0.6, T-3rd), blocks (1.3, 3rd) and minutes (25.9, 3rd).
- Milwaukee has reached the seven-win mark in November for the 8th time in the last 11 seasons (they went 5-9 during the 06-07 season and 7-6 during the 05-06 season).

ALL-TIME SERIES:

Bucks lead 93-85

- Bobby Simmons was not with the team due to personal reasons Tuesday night against Philadelphia, but is expected to rejoin the team for Wednesday's game against Atlanta
- The Bucks are 9-3 in their last 12 matchups against the Hawks. Out of the last nine season series, Milwaukee has won seven and tied two.
- The Hawks are second in the league with 6.3 blocks per game. League-leader, Josh Smith, gets more than half of that total with 3.7 each game.
- In their last seven contests, including a 105-96 loss to the Bucks on November 17, Atlanta has gone 3-4. Joe Johnson has averaged 25.0 points, 3.6 rebounds and 6.0 assists in that span and the team has averaged 96.1 points to 98.7 for their opponents.

NEWS & NOTES ...

MOVING UP THE CHARTS – Michael Redd tallied 17 points against Philadelphia Tuesday night to give him 9,250 for his career. Redd is closing in on Terry Cummings for ninth place on the Bucks all-time scoring list. He trails Cummings' 9,290 by just 40 points. Cummings played six seasons (480 games) with Milwaukee and Redd has played in 457.

Other spots the former Buckeye is closing in on include: 10th place in field goals made (he has 3,262 and needs 53 to tie Jon McGlocklin) and 7th place in free throws attempted (has 2,266 and needs three to tie Terry Cummings).

CHARITY STRIPING – For the fourth time in five games the Bucks out-shot their opponents from the charity stripe. Milwaukee shot a season-high 91.3% (21-23) on Tuesday ... six Bucks players were perfect from the line. Over those five games the Bucks are getting to the line 29.2 times per game, while their opponents are averaging 25.2 attempts per contest.

RECENT GAMES:

November 27, 2007 Atlanta

L, 99-114 – Milwaukee finally ended their six game home winning streak (and their five game overall win streak) on Tuesday against Philly. The Bucks never really got it going in this one, shooting 49.3% from the field and 19.0% from downtown. Philly out-rebounded the Bucks 39 to 35 and passing for 11 more assists than Milwaukee (31 to 20). The Sixers Andre Iguodala posted the games lone double-double with 20 points and 11 assists, while Samuel Dalembert added 22 points and Kyle Korver posted 20 points (shooting 4 of 5 from downtown). Michael Redd led the Bucks in scoring for the 10th time this season with 17 points and 8 boards, while Charlie Villanueva came off the bench to put up 16 points.

November 24, 2007 Dallas

W, 97-95 – Milwaukee rallied from a four point deficit entering the fourth quarter to defeat Dallas 97-95 and extend their unbeaten mark at home to six and their overall winning streak to five. Michael Redd had 27 points on 7-11 shooting and Mo Williams (19 points and 10 assists) and Andrew Bogut (16 points and 14 boards) added double-doubles to the cause. Milwaukee tallied 35 points in the fourth quarter (tying a high for that quarter) to make the comeback.

November 21, 2007 Los Angeles

W, 110-103 – The Bucks won their fourth consecutive game and improved to 5-0 at home with a 110-103 victory over the Lakers. Milwaukee outscored Los Angeles 35-23 in the final quarter to come away with the win. The team rallied from another slow start, down 24-17 after one quarter and down 80-75 headed into the fourth quarter. Michael Redd tallied 26 points with eight boards and seven assists and Mo Williams had 18 points and nine assists in the winning cause. Kobe Bryant had 27 points for L.A.

BIG SMOOTH – Big Smooth has been nothing but smooth as of late ... coming off the bench Charlie Villanueva is averaging 13.0 points, 4.7 boards and shooting 54.4% from the field in reaching double-figures in five of the last six games. In those six contests CV is also shooting 43.8% (7 for 16) from downtown and 90.0% (9 of 10) from the free throw line.

PAINTING THE LANE – Over the last five games Milwaukee has been a beast in the paint, outscoring their each of their last five opponents in points in the paint. The Bucks are averaging 49.2 points down low, while their opponents are averaging 43.6 points per game. In that span Milwaukee is averaging a total of 104.4 points per contest ... 47.1% of those points are coming in between the lane.

Bucks trail 84-86

- On Friday, the Bucks will complete their short two-game road trip by visiting the Big Apple to take on the New York Knicks. Last season, New York took 3-of-4 from Milwaukee ... winning the last contest on 4/7/07 (in Milwaukee) 118-113 in OT.
- The Knicks have won two straight beating both the Bulls and the Jazz. Prior to their two wins, New York had been on an 8-game losing skid. In those two wins, New York is averaging 99.0 points, 46.7% from the field, 34.5% from the behind arc and grabbing 42.0 boards per game.
- Eddy Curry ranks 5th in the NBA in FG% shooting 58.4% from the field ... on the season Curry is second on the team with 17.9 points and 6.3 boards per game.
- On the season, the Knicks rank tied for 4th in offensive boards per game (13.5), 6th in rebounds (44.5) and 4th in defensive rebounds allowed (41.4).
