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Jerry Reinsdorf

Chairman

Jerry Reinsdorf assumed the position of Chairman of the Chicago Bulls on March 13, 1985, when he led the group that purchased controlling interest in the franchise ... Reinsdorf is also the Chairman of the 2005 World Champion Chicago White Sox ... Reinsdorf's two professional sports teams - the Chicago Bulls and the Chicago White Sox - now have delivered seven World Championship titles to the city of Chicago and its sports fans ... during his tenure as Chairman of the Bulls, the



team has captured six World Championships (1991-93, 1996-98) ... Reinsdorf spearheaded construction of two major facilities for the Bulls - the United Center, home of the Bulls and the NHL's Chicago Blackhawks which opened for the 1994-1995 season and the Sheri L. Berto Center, a state-of-the-art training facility for the Bulls, which opened in 1992 ... both Reinsdorf's sports franchises have donated millions of dollars to causes in the Chicago community through a variety of efforts, including CharitaBulls and White Sox Charities ... Reinsdorf has played a critical role in the development of the west side area surrounding the United Center ... during the 1990's CharitaBulls donated \$4.5 million to construct the James Jordan Boy's and Girls Club and Family Life Center, which was erected in memory of James Jordan, father of Bulls great Michael Jordan ... the 4,000-square-foot facility located just two blocks from the United Center features a computer center, art studio, science lab, gym, dance and game room, classrooms and more ... as part of its commitment to education, CharitaBulls donated \$3.5 million to launch the Bulls Scholars Program ... CharitaBulls has also donated over \$1 million to a variety of Chicago Park District programs ... through the new Chicago Bulls/Chicago White Sox Training Academy, which opened in 2001, Reinsdorf's franchises promote sports to thousands of youths each year while instilling a love of the game in future fans ... Reinsdorf was the 1997 recipient of the Order of Lincoln Award, and his many contributions to the community have been recognized by such organizations as Keshet, the Interfaith Organizing Project, American Academy of Achievement, Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, the Trial Lawyers Club of Chicago, the Chicago Historical Society, the Chicago Jewish Sporting Hall of Fame, the National Jewish Sporting Hall of Fame and the Chicago Sports Hall of Fame ... he was the recipient of the Chicago Park District's 1990 Chicagoan of the Year Award, 1992 PUSH Bridgebuilder Award, National Italian-American Friendship Award, Northwestern University's Award of Merit, the U.S. Air Force American Spirit Award and an honorary degree in humane letters from Illinois College ... Reinsdorf was awarded the Ellis Island Medal of Honor in 1993 and the 1997 Mayor's Medal of Honor ... in 1998, he was honored with the Guardian of Children Award from the Jewish Council of Youth Services ... as Chairman of the White Sox, he was instrumental in initiating Chicago White Sox Charities, the arm of the baseball organization that raises funds for cancer research, children's and senior programs ... Chicago Baseball Cancer Charities has twice conferred its Hallmark Award to Reinsdorf in recognition of his efforts ... in addition to his sports interests, Reinsdorf is an attorney, a certified public accountant, a specialist in real estate securities, a registered mortgage underwriter and a certified review appraiser ... in 1997 Reinsdorf completed employment as chairman of the board of a real estate investment firm he co-founded in the early 1970's and sold to American Express ... currently, he is a partner in Bojer Financial Ltd., a real estate investment company ... he is a former member of the board of directors of Shearson Lehman Brothers, Inc., the Northwestern University Law School Alumni Association, LaSalle Bank, Equity Office Properties and numerous other corporations and charities ... he is presently a Life Trustee of Northwestern University ... born in Brooklyn, N.Y. on Feb. 25, 1936 ... Reinsdorf graduated from George Washington University in Washington, D.C. and earned a law degree from Northwestern University after moving to Chicago in 1957 ... Reinsdorf and his wife, Martyl, have four children and seven grandchildren.

Robert A. Judelson is a partner of Bojer Financial Ltd, and FFB Equity-- real estate investment and consulting companies ... William W. Wirtz

1929-2007

On Sept. 26, 2007, long-time Chicago Bulls board member and partner William W. Wirtz passed away at the age of 77. Mr. Wirtz also served as President of the Chicago Blackhawks, a position he held for 41 years, and he was Chairman of the Board of Governors of the National Hockey League for 18 years. His contributions to the sport of professional hockey were enormous, so much so that he was elected to the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1976. He also served on both the 1980 and 1984 Winter Olympic Committees. Mr. Wirtz was also instrumental in the mergers between the WHA and the NHL, and the ABA and the NBA. Together with Chicago Bulls Chairman Jerry Reinsdorf, he built the privately-financed United Center - home to both the Chicago Bulls and the Chicago Blackhawks and a wide variety of other sports and entertainment events enjoyed by Chicagoans. Mr. Wirtz quietly donated millions of dollars to worthy Chicago charities over the years. His wisdom, council and kindness will be greatly missed.



Lamar Hunt

1932-2006

On Dec. 13, 2006, the Chicago Bulls lost a valued friend and member of our Bulls family, Lamar Hunt. In 1966, Mr. Hunt was one of the founding investors of the Chicago Bulls. Mr. Hunt loved all sports, basketball, soccer and tennis among them, but his true passion was reserved for the game of football. Lamar Hunt served as the driving force behind the formation of the American Football League, and was founder of the Kansas City Chiefs. He was instrumental in the AFL-NFL merger in the 1960's, and was enshrined into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 1972. Mr. Hunt was credited with putting the name "Super Bowl" on the NFL's championship game. Lamar Hunt's influence on the NFL was so profound that the AFC Championship Trophy was named the Lamar Hunt Trophy, in his honor. Humility was his hallmark, and he will be greatly missed by all members of the Chicago Bulls family.

Entering his 21st full season, Steve Schanwald oversees areas that include Ticket Sales, Sponsorship Sales, Game Entertainment, Promotions, Media Services, Community Relations, Publications, Advertising and Broadcasting ... during his first season (1987), the Bulls began a 610-game streak of consecutive sellouts which ended in November of 2000 - the third longest streak in NBA history ... the Bulls sold over 12,400,000 tickets during its streak, compared to Portland (10,370,360 tickets over 814 consecutive games), and Boston (9,857,180 tickets over 662 games) ... the Bulls have consistently

ranked among the league leaders in attendance during his tenure ... despite the worst six-year winning percentage in NBA history, from 1998-2004, the Bulls ranked first in cumulative home attendance during that period ... also during this six-year period, the Bulls' differential between its home attendance and road attendance of 4,451 fans per game ranked first in that category - over 800 fans per game ahead of the next closest team - the 55,830 fans per win that the Bulls attracted to the United Center between 1998 and 2004 were 17,500 fans per win ahead of the next closest team ... Steve is a recipient of a local Emmy Award, as well as fifteen awards for advertising excellence ... serves as Senior Vice President-Marketing for the United Center and is responsible for suite, signage, college basketball and club seat activities ... played a key role in negotiating stadium-naming rights agreement with United Airlines ... instrumental in bringing first-ever Big Ten Conference Basketball Tournament and the Great Eight College Basketball Classic to Chicago ... founded and serves as President of CharitaBulls, which has raised tens of millions of dollars for a variety of worthy causes ... serves as a member of the NBA's Team Advisory Committee, which makes recommendations on various league business initiatives ... sits on the board of the James Jordan Boys & Girls Club ... has spoken internationally on sports marketing and has been a guest lecturer at the University of Chicago Business School, Kellogg Graduate School of Business, the Notre Dame Business School and the American Marketing Association among others ... member of the Chicago Economic Club ... native of Bethpage, N.Y. ... 1977 University of Maryland graduate ... served as Director of Sports Marketing at the U.S. Air Force Academy (1978) ... served as Director of Promotions for the "We Are Family" Pittsburgh Pirates (1979-80) ... spent six years (1981-86) as Assistant Vice President-Marketing for the Chicago White Sox ... In 1983 and 1986, the White Sox received Major League Baseball's highest award for overall marketing excellence ... Steve resides in Chicago.

Entering his 36th season, Irwin Mandel has the longest tenure of anyone with the Bulls ... the senior financial executive in the NBA, and one of the most experienced in any management position in the League ... responsible for the Club's financial, legal, and corporate areas ... most important duties include player contracts, financial reports, and applying and interpreting the NBA's salary cap, free agency and other collective bargaining rules ... one of the select few NBA executives chosen to serve on the committee to advise the League regarding salary cap rule changes ... said Commissioner David Stern recently, "nobody in the NBA understands the intricacies of the salary cap better than Irwin Mandel" ... also considered one of the NBA's most knowledgeable and creative experts on player contracts and the collective bargaining rules ... helped develop NBA team financial statements and assisted the NBA Labor Relations Committee ... oversaw the instituting of a detailed budget plan for the office and negotiated the Club's switch to charter travel ... recently served as a consultant to two of the other major sports leagues regarding the benefits and workings of the NBA's salary cap and free agency systems ... received both his undergraduate degree in Accounting and his Law degree from Northwestern University ... he is a Certified Public Accountant and member of the Illinois Bar ... worked in the tax department of Arthur Andersen & Co. for four years prior to joining the Bulls ... formerly served two terms as President of the Northwestern University Club of Chicago and was a recipient of the Northwestern Alumni Service Award ... active in various charitable programs ... speaks regularly to business groups, law schools and college students regarding legal and financial management careers in professional sports ... avid tennis player and recent ardent (but ability-challenged) golfer ... native Chicagoan ... married to Sheri, with two sons, Michael and Robby, daughter-in-law, Jamie, and most recent addition, granddaughter Sadie Ann.

In his 25th season, Keith Brown is responsible for the sales and marketing of Chicago Bulls' season, group and individual game tickets, and for managing the full and part-time sales staffs ... he coordinates the team's ticket marketing and advertising campaigns, including television, radio, newspapers, billboards, bus tails, direct mail and the Internet, along with sales programs such as Tickets to Happiness, Court of Dreams and Preps With Pros ... he oversees the creation and production of the team's print materials for ticket sales, such as handbooks, brochures, flyers,

vouchers, season ticket holder correspondence, etc. ... he is responsible for management of the ticket department database which houses information for more than 800,000 fans, and for designing name generation programs such as the annual Ticket Sweepstakes ... he directs the team's e-marketing with targeted offers and programs for ticket sales ... he manages season ticket holder customer service programs such as Fan Forums and market research surveys, along with value-added programs for season ticket holders and group leaders such as mailings of promotional items and other benefits ... he is the Bulls' liaison with the NBA in creating the annual schedule for playing dates in the United Center ... he is a frequent attendee and presenter at the NBA's Team Marketing and Business Operations Workshops ... he is the recipient of four Telly Awards for advertising campaigns ... he began his career with the Bulls as an intern telemarketing season tickets, and in 1984 had the privilege of representing the team in Madison Square Garden for the drafting of Michael Jordan ... for six years he served as the Editor and principal writer of "BasketBull" magazine ... over recent history the Bulls have enjoyed a streak of 610 consecutive sellouts and have led the NBA in home attendance through championship and rebuilding seasons ... Keith graduated from Illinois State University with degrees in Communications and Political Science ... he was raised in Rolling Meadows, is an avid golfer and resides in Chicago.
