2003.2004 SEASON REVIEW

FRONT OFFICE

June 26, 2003

At NBA Draft 2003, the Bulls drafted Kirk Hinrich (7th overall) Mario Austin (36th overall), Matt Bonner (45th overall) and Tommy Smith (53rd overall). The Bulls then conveyed Bonner's draft rights to Toronto for a future second-round pick.

July 15, 2003

The Bulls named Johnny Bach Assistant Coach.

NBA

July 16, 2003

The Bulls named Ron Adams Assistant Coach.

Signed free agent guard/forward Scottie Pippen.

July 31, 2003

Re-signed forward/center Corie Blount.

Aug. 20, 2003

Signed free agent guard Kendall Gill.

RECORDS

Oct. 31, 2003 - CHICAGO BULLS 100, Atlanta Hawks 94

Tyson Chandler grabbed a career-high-tying 22 rebounds and tossed in 13 points, while fellow big man Eddy Curry tabbed a team-high 22 points and four boards to lead the Bulls to their first win of the 2003-04 campaign, a 100-94 triumph over the visiting Atlanta Hawks.

PLAYOFF RECORDS

Nov. 5, 2003 - CHICAGO BULLS 106, Orlando Magic 100

The Bulls snapped their 12-game road-losing streak at Orlando with a 106-100 defeat of the Orlando Magic. The win also snapped Chicago's nine-game losing skid at the TD Waterhouse Centre. Jamal Crawford led the Bulls with a game-high 29 points, eight assists and six rebounds.

HISTORICAL

Nov. 8, 2003 - CHICAGO BULLS 109, N.O. Hornets 106

Head Coach Bill Cartwright shuffled the deck and it worked. Cartwright went with his fourth starting lineup in seven games and the Bulls responded with their second consecutive road win for the first time since the 2001-02 season. Jalen Rose contributed a season-high 34 points off the bench to lead the Bulls. Chicago shot a season-high .594 (41-69 FG) from the field, including .538 (7-13 3FG) from 3-point range.

COMMUNITY

Nov. 24, 2003

The Bulls relieved Bill Cartwright of his head coaching duties.

MEDIA

Nov. 28, 2003

The Bulls named Scott Skiles the 15th head coach in franchise history.

Dec. 1, 2003

The Bulls traded forward Lonny Baxter, forward Donyell Marshall and guard/forward Jalen Rose to the Toronto Raptors in exchange for forward/center Antonio Davis, forward Chris Jefferies and forward Jerome Williams.

Dec. 13, 2003 - CHICAGO BULLS 86, Indiana Pacers 75

Jamal Crawford and the Chicago Bulls used a balanced attack to snap a four-game losing streak. Crawford and rookie Kirk Hinrich each scored 18 points to lead five players in double figures as the Bulls cruised to an 86-75 victory over the Eastern Conference-leading Indiana Pacers. Chicago also received a strong effort from its frontcourt as three players contributed double-doubles. Reserve forward Marcus Fizer contributed 15 points and 15 rebounds, Jerome Williams had 10 and 15 and former Pacer Antonio Davis contributed 10 and 10.

Dec. 16, 2003

Chicago acquired guard Rick Brunson from the Toronto Raptors in exchange for guard Roger Mason, Jr.

Dec. 16, 2003 - CHICAGO BULLS 102, Orlando Magic 88

The Chicago Bulls posted their first back-to-back victories of the season with a 102-88 defeat of the Orlando Magic at the United Center. Kendall Gill provided a ton of offense off the bench, scoring 27 of his game-high 29 points in the second half, including 17 in the third quarter on 7-of-7 FG shooting. Kirk Hinrich recorded his first career double-double with a then season-high 21 points and 10 assists. Marcus Fizer registered his second-consecutive double-double with 10 points and 11 boards off the bench.

Dec. 27, 2003 - CHICAGO BULLS 100, Washington Wizards 86

Jamal Crawford scored a then career-high 42 points to power the Bulls to a 100-86 victory over the Washington Wizards, avenging a loss in their season opener.

Jan. 10, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 89, N.O. Hornets 84

Jamal Crawford led the Bulls with 20 points and Eddy Curry added 19 off the bench, helping Chicago hold off New Orleans for an 89-84 win at the United Center. The Bulls scored a season-high 58 first half points, helped by 38 points in the second quarter on .560 shooting.

Jan. 25, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 96, Toronto Raptors 89

Jamal Crawford scored a game-high 27 points to help the Bulls snap a six-game losing streak with a 96-89 win over the visiting Toronto Raptors. Rookie Kirk Hinrich added 15 points and seven assists for the Bulls, who defeated the Raptors for the third time in a row after dropping the previous 16. Toronto's bench was held without a single field goal and was outscored 17-2.

Feb. 4, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 95, Utah Jazz 79

Eddy Curry tallied game-highs of 23 points and 12 rebounds to lead the Bulls to a 95-79 win over the Utah Jazz in front of a sold out Delta Center. The win snapped Chicago's 26 game road-losing streak versus Western Conference foes.

Feb. 12, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 107, Boston Celtics 87

The Bulls' starting backcourt of Jamal Crawford and Kirk Hinrich led the way, making 10-18 3FG, as they combined to score 50 points. Crawford scored a game-high 27 points (10-19 FG) and added seven assists, four boards and two steals in 37 minutes of action, while Hinrich played a game-high 39 minutes, tied his then season-high with 23 points (6-8 3FG) and handed out a season-best 14 assists. The Bulls posted their largest lead of the year at 33 points, when they led 100-67 with 7:24 to play in the 4th Quarter.

Feb. 28, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 87, G.S. Warriors 81 OT

Jamal Crawford scored 27 points, Eddy Curry added 26 and Kirk Hinrich recorded the season's only triple-double by a rookie as the Bulls captured an 87-81 overtime victory over the cold-shooting Warriors. Golden State shot just 27.3 percent (27-of-99 FG), narrowly avoiding its team-record low of 26.7 percent on 12/15/64 against Boston. Hinrich collected 11 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists.

March 19, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 96, Toronto Raptors 91

Chicago snapped its season-high seven-game losing streak by beating the Raptors for the third straight time on the year and won the season series versus Toronto for the first time since the 1997-98 season. It was the Bulls' first win in Toronto since 02/28/99, halting a nine-game skid at the Air Canada Centre. Eddy Curry led the Bulls with 28 points (11-18FG), while Antonio Davis posted his team-leading 16th double-double of the year with 18 points (tied season high) and a game-high 14 boards. Kirk Hinrich also tallied a double-double with his 12th of the year (first among NBA rookies), as he scored 21 points (8-14 FG) and dished out a game-high 13 assists.

March 20, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 87, New York Knicks 81

Jamal Crawford had a late prayer answered on his birthday. Crawford scored 25 points, including a tough fadeaway jumper in the final seconds, as the Bulls held on for an 87-81 victory over the New York Knicks.

March 26, 2004 - MILWAUKEE BUCKS 115, Chicago Bulls 105

Jannero Pargo, playing with his third team of the season, set career highs with 34 points and nine assists. The 6-1 guard also tied Michael Jordan and Jalen Rose for Chicago's franchise record of seven 3-pointers in a game and tied United Center records with five three-pointers in a half and four three-pointers in the second quarter.

April 2, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 114, Los Angeles Clippers 110 OT

Eddy Curry scored 27 points, including a jump hook with 23 seconds remaining in overtime that lifted the Chicago Bulls to a 114-110 victory over the Los Angeles Clippers. Four Bulls players scored 20+ points for the first time since 11/16/85. The Bulls snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Clippers dating to the 1999-2000 season.

April 11, 2004 - CHICAGO BULLS 114, Toronto Raptors 108 OT

Led by Jamal Crawford's 50 points (18-34 FG, 6-11 3FG), Chicago swept the four-game season series from Toronto for the first time since the 1997-98 campaign. Crawford scored 24 points (8-13 FG) of the Bulls' season-high 37 fourth-quarter points, as the Bulls pushed the game into overtime tied at 101-101. Crawford became the first Bull to score 50-plus points since Michael Jordan's 55 points against Washington on 04/27/97. Crawford's six three-pointers made broke Scottie Pippen's franchise record for three-point field goals made in a season, set during the 1996-97 season when he made 156 from downtown.

NOTE: The Bulls finished 3rd in the NBA in attendance (averaged 19,736) and hosted 11 sellouts at the United Center.

On the year, the United Center hosted the seven largest crowds in the NBA.
