Acquired the draft rights to No. 4 pick Tyrus Thomas & Viktor Khryapa from Portland in exchange for the draft rights to No. 2 pick LaMarcus Aldridge and a future second-round pick. Also acquired the draft rights to No. 13 pick Thabo Sefolosha from Philadelphia for the draft rights to No. 16 pick Rodney Carney, New York's 2007 second-round pick and cash.

## July 13, 2006

Signed free agent Ben Wallace.

## July 14, 2006

Acquired P.J. Brown and J.R. Smith from the Hornets in exchange for Tyson Chandler.

Traded J.R. Smith to Denver in exchange for Howard Easley and a 2007 second-round draft choice.

## July 21, 2006

Requested waivers on Howard Easley.

## July 31, 2006

Signed free agent Adrian Griffin.

## August 1, 2006

Signed draft picks Thabo Sefolosha and Tyrus Thomas.

## August 18, 2006

Acquired Martynas Andriuskevicius from Cleveland in exchange for Eddie Basden.

## October 24, 2006

Picked up fourth-year options on Luol Deng, Ben Gordon and Viktor Khryapa.

## October 30, 2006

Waived Luke Schenscher.

## October 31, 2006

Signed Kirk Hinrich to a multi-year contract extension.

## October 31, 2006

The Bulls rolled past the Heat in the season opener, posting a 108-66 victory in Miami. Kirk Hinrich led the stampede with 26 points on 10-of-18 shooting, including 3-of-5 from deep. Chris Duhon added 20, while newcomer Ben Wallace and Andrés Nocioni each ripped 11 rebounds. It was the worst season-opening loss by a defending champion, surpassing the 132-117 setback suffered by the Los Angeles Lakers vs. Golden State in 1982.

## November 6, 2006

Ben Gordon torched the nets with 37 points and dished out a career-best nine assists to lead Chicago to a 110-85 home victory over the visiting Milwaukee Bucks.

## November 11, 2006

Despite being down by five at the half, Chicago topped the Indiana Pacers, 89-80, at home. Ben Wallace had eight points and 18 rebounds and Luol Deng had an outstanding performance with 21 points and 12 boards, while Kirk Hinrich chipped in with 23 points. Chicago shot only 38 percent, but Wallace, who played the entire game, gave the Bulls plenty of second chances with 10 offensive rebounds.

## November 25, 2006

Chicago closed out its seven-game road odyssey with a convincing 106-95 victory in New York. Luol Deng led the Bulls with 24 points, including 16 on 7-of-12 shooting in the first half to give the Bulls a 56-34 lead. Kirk Hinrich added 21 points and Andrés Nocioni had 19 for the Bulls, who snapped an eight-game road skid.

## December 1, 2006

Andrés Nocioni scored a career-high 31 points, including two late free throws, as the visiting Bulls held off a series of comebacks for a 111-108 victory over the New Orleans/Oklahoma City Hornets. Chicago allowed NO/Okla. City to cut a 15-point, fourth-quarter deficit to two in the waning moments, but was still able to escape with its third straight win. Luol Deng added 21 points for Chicago (6-9). Nocioni also had 13 rebounds for his third double-double of the season.

## December 8, 2006

The Bulls captured their seventh-straight victory and 14th consecutive over the Toronto Raptors with a 93-90 triumph at United Center. Luol Deng recorded a game-high 25 points to lead the Bulls and Andrés Nocioni added 17 points and 14 rebounds.

## December 11, 2006

Assigned Martynas Andriuskevicius to the D-League's Dakota Wizards.

## December 13, 2006

Chicago led by 16 at halftime and by as many as 24 in a 99-84 home win over the Seattle SuperSonics. Ben Gordon's 27 points paced five in double figures and Ben Wallace racked up 15 points, 20 rebounds and five blocked shots. Andrés Nocioni scored 20 on 9-for-16 shooting in just 28 minutes.

## December 15, 2006

Ben Wallace snared a season-high 27 rebounds and added 10 points to lead the Bulls to a 117-111 victory over the Milwaukee Bucks. The win was the 10th in 11 games for the Bulls. Chicago also finished its longest homestand in team history with a 7-1 record and improved to 9-0 against Eastern Conference teams at the United Center.

### December 27, 2006

Ben Gordon scored a then career-high 40 points off the bench to lead Chicago to a 109-103 victory over the shorthanded Miami Heat, who lost Dwyane Wade to a sprained wrist in the first quarter.

---

### December 29, 2006

Luol Deng played with a sprained right wrist and scored 25 points, and Ben Gordon added 22 to lead the Bulls to their 15th straight victory over the Raptors, 107-97, in Toronto. Deng had 19 points in the second half for the Bulls, who shot a blazing 59.7 percent.

---

### December 30, 2006

Luol Deng scored a then career-high 32 points, and the Bulls went on a 24-point run in the second half of a 103-96 victory over the Cleveland Cavaliers to spoil LeBron James' birthday. With his sprained right wrist bandaged again, Deng hit 15 of 19 shots after scoring 25 the previous night. P.J. Brown added 13 points and 10 rebounds, and Malik Allen scored 10 points after sitting out the first half. The Bulls were without guard Kirk Hinrich, who sat out with a strained groin.

### January 6, 2007

In his first appearance against his former team, Ben Wallace helped the Bulls beat the Detroit Pistons 106-89 at the United Center. Luol Deng scored 30 to lead Chicago, while Wallace finished with 12 points, 14 rebounds and a then season-high six blocks.

---

### January 15, 2007

Kirk Hinrich had 23 points and 10 rebounds and Ben Gordon added 20 points to lead the shorthanded Bulls past the San Antonio Spurs, 99-87, at the United Center. The Bulls played without Chris Duhon (suspension) and Ben Wallace (sore back). Luol Deng scored 17 for Chicago.

---

### January 25, 2007

Chicago outscored Dallas by 14 in the first quarter and never trailed as it defeated the visiting Mavericks 96-85. Ben Gordon scored 30 and dished out five assists, while Luol Deng added 21 points and nine rebounds. Ben Wallace pulled in 17 rebounds and recorded four blocks as Chicago snapped the Mavericks' eight-game winning streak in the series.

---

### January 29, 2007

The NBA announced Ben Gordon as the Eastern Conference Player of the Week after he guided Chicago to a 3-1 mark on the week with averages of 26.8 ppg, 4.8 apg and 4.3 rpg.

---

### February 11, 2007

After the Bulls were outscored by 16 in the third quarter, turning a 11-point lead into a five-point deficit, Kirk Hinrich sparked his team to a 116-103 victory in Phoenix. Hinrich scored 14 of his 29 in the fourth quarter. Luol Deng also scored 29 and grabbed 12 rebounds, while Ben Gordon pumped in 27 points. Playing the final game of a seven-game road trip, Chicago didn't look tired in the fourth quarter, dominating the Suns, 37-19, for the win.

---

### February 17, 2007

Tyrus Thomas competed in the 2007 Sprite Slam Dunk competition at All-Star Weekend in Las Vegas. Ben Gordon also participated in the All-Star festivities as he teamed with Bulls great Scottie Pippen and Candice Dupree of the WNBA's Chicago Sky in the Haier Shooting Stars Competition.

---

### February 20, 2007

Chris Duhon scored 17 points and the Bulls held the Atlanta Hawks without a field goal in the third quarter in a 106-81 home victory. Kirk Hinrich and Luol Deng added 16 points each for the Bulls, who defeated the Hawks for the 10th straight time. Hinrich and the Bulls limited Atlanta's Joe Johnson - who came in the game averaging 25.1 points - to just nine points on 2-of-12 shooting.

---

### February 22, 2007

Ben Wallace scored 14 points with 19 rebounds, a season-high seven blocks and two huge free throws in the final minutes to lead the visiting Bulls to an 84-78 win over the Cavaliers. Luol Deng scored 18 points, Ben Gordon 16 and Kirk Hinrich 11 for the Bulls, who overcame foul trouble and 24 turnovers. Trailing by three with less than seven minutes left, Chicago put away the Cavaliers with a 14-5 burst.

---

### February 23, 2007

Luol Deng matched his then career high with 32 points and led the Bulls over Gilbert Arenas and the Washington Wizards, 105-90, at the United Center. Deng's 13-of-22 shooting and 11 rebounds helped the Bulls win their third straight following the All-Star break. Kirk Hinrich had 20 points, 12 assists and eight rebounds, offsetting a 36-point effort from Arenas.

---

### February 28, 2007

Ben Gordon scored 16 of his 22 points in the first 12 minutes, Tyrus Thomas tied a then career high with 14 points, and the Bulls beat the Golden State Warriors 113-83 at the United Center. Thabo Sefolosha scored a career-high 19 points and reserve Adrian Griffin added a season-high 17 for the Bulls, who bounced back after dropping consecutive games.

---

### March 4, 2007

Ben Gordon scored a career high 48 points and led the Bulls to a 126-121 come-from-behind overtime win over the host Milwaukee Bucks. He made 18 of 32 shots, including six 3-pointers. He took over the game in the second quarter with 15 points to keep the Bulls close, and then added 20 points in the fourth quarter. The Bulls needed every one of his points as they had to overcome 52 points from Michael Redd and an 18-point fourth-quarter deficit. Luol Deng had 27 points, and Kirk Hinrich added 23 points.

---

### March 13, 2007

Tyrus Thomas posted a then career-high 23 points and nine rebounds as the Bulls recorded their eighth-straight win over the Celtics with a 95-87 home triumph. Ben Wallace scored a season-best 19 points to go along with 16 rebounds and three blocks.



## March 14, 2007

Trailing by one, Kirk Hinrich hit the game-winning jumper with 26.7 seconds remaining in the Bulls' 88-87 victory over the host 76ers. Hinrich finished with 14 points, while Luol Deng scored a game-high 20. Ben Wallace nearly recorded a triple-double, recording 10 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists.

## March 22, 2007

Tyrus Thomas tipped in Ben Gordon's missed jumper with 0.2 seconds remaining to lift Chicago over Denver, 109-108, at the United Center. Gordon posted 25 points and five assists to lead Chicago, while Luol Deng added 22 points and 14 rebounds. Thomas finished with nine points and 11 boards.

## March 25, 2007

Ben Gordon netted 31 points, including the game-winning jumper with 2.8 seconds remaining in a 92-90 road win at Indiana. Chicago won for the ninth time in its past 12 games and guaranteed itself at least a .500 season. Luol Deng finished with 14 points and 10 rebounds and Ben Wallace added 13 rebounds for the Bulls.

## March 26, 2007

Luol Deng scored a career-high 38 points, and the Bulls won their third straight, beating Portland 100-89 at the United Center. Chicago outscored Portland by 15 over the final two periods to secure the victory. Deng hit 18-of-25 shots and played a big role during the deciding run.

## March 29, 2007

Ben Gordon recorded 25 points and Kirk Hinrich sank two free throws with 2.8 seconds remaining to lift the Bulls to a thrilling 83-81 triumph over the visiting Pistons and clinch a third straight playoff berth. Tyrus Thomas posted 13 points and 10 rebounds for Chicago, which won its fourth straight.

## April 4, 2007

Kirk Hinrich scored 12 points as Chicago doubled up Detroit in the third quarter to overcome a one-point halftime deficit in a 106-88 road win. Hinrich finished with 29 points and eight assists, while Luol Deng had 22 points and nine rebounds. Ben Wallace (sinus inflammation) was a late scratch for the Bulls, who took the season series from the Pistons for the first time since 1998.

## April 13, 2007

In front of their 41st sellout of the season (44th-straight overall), the Bulls jumped ahead quickly and never trailed in a 100-81 triumph over the visiting Bobcats in their regular season home finale. Ben Gordon recorded 20 points, while Kirk Hinrich chipped in with 18 points and eight assists. Ben Wallace had 12 points and 12 rebounds. Chicago finished with a home record of 31-10 one of the best home-court records in the NBA and also the best home record by the franchise since the 1997-98 season, when the team went 37-4 at the UC.

## April 16, 2007

Ben Gordon was named Eastern Conference Player of the Week for the second time on the year after he led the Bulls to a 3-0 week. In three starts, Gordon averaged 24.3 ppg, 4.7 apg and 3.3 rpg. It was the third time Gordon has garnered the honor.

## April 21, 2007

As the 2007 Playoffs began, the Bulls met the defending champion Miami Heat for a first round rematch from the team that eliminated them in six games in 2006. In Game 1, Luol Deng led the Bulls to victory with 33 points, while Ben Gordon and Nocioni each hit two free throws in the final 19 seconds, to help the Bulls down the Heat 96-91 in Chicago.

## April 25, 2007

The Bulls got 27 from Ben Gordon and Luol Deng contributed 26 as they helped their squad to a 2-0 series lead over the Heat with a 107-89 beating of the Heat. Gordon scored 11 in the third quarter, hitting three 3-pointers, and the Bulls built a 17-point lead. Miami made a comeback before Deng scored 14 in the fourth to put the game out of reach.

## April 27, 2007

Ben Gordon scored 27 points, Luol Deng added 24 points and 11 rebounds and Chicago used a 15-2 fourth-quarter run to seize control of a 104-96 victory over the Heat in Game 3 in Miami. The Bulls led by nine points with 2:33 left and allowed the Heat to pull to within three before closing the door. Chicago's win snapped Miami's 26-game home court playoff winning streak when leading at halftime, the second longest streak in NBA history.

## April 29, 2007

With a 92-79 victory on South Beach in Game 4, the Bulls swept the defending champion Heat in their first round series and captured the franchise's first playoff series win since 1997-98. Chicago was led by Ben Gordon's 24 points and got 22 points and 11 boards from Luol Deng. Ben Wallace finished with 13 and 11 rebounds, including four free throws down the stretch.

## April 30, 2007

Kirk Hinrich and Ben Wallace were named to the NBA All-Defensive Second Team.

## May 3, 2007

Luol Deng was named recipient of the 2006-07 NBA Sportsmanship Award.

## May 5, 2007

The Bulls and Pistons rekindled their old rivalry, meeting in the second round in 2007. Game 1 in Detroit was not pretty for the Bulls, dropping a 95-69 loss at the Palace. The Bulls shot just .329 from the floor and committed 22 turnovers. Luol Deng led Chicago with 18 points and eight rebounds. Chauncey Billups and Richard Hamilton paced Detroit with 20 apiece.



---

### May 8, 2007

Chicago fell into a quick 0-2 hole against Detroit after it fell 108-87 in Game 2. For the second game in a row, the Bulls made just 23 field goals as a team, tying their franchise playoff-record low set in Game 1. Tyrus Thomas' 18 points led the Bulls, who were outrebounded 51-30. Detroit had three starters score 20+ each.

---

### May 8, 2007

The NBA announced Tyrus Thomas as a selection to the 2007 T-Mobile NBA All-Rookie Second Team.

---

### May 11, 2007

The scene shifted to Chicago for Game 3, but the momentum still sided with Detroit. The Bulls built a 19-point lead but allowed the Pistons to storm back and win 81-74 at the United Center. Luol Deng had 21 points and 14 boards for Chicago, which had three players tally double-doubles.

---

### May 13, 2007

The Bulls broke into the win column in Game 4 after holding off a late Pistons surge for a 102-87 victory on Mother's Day. Luol Deng led the charge with 25 points, while Kirk Hinrich and Ben Gordon each added 19. Chicago shot the ball much better than in its first three outings, hitting .493 from the floor, including .417 from downtown, while limiting Detroit to just .373 shooting.

---

### May 15, 2007

Chicago made the series interesting after it returned to the Palace in Game 5 and posted a decisive 108-92 win to force a Game 6 back in the Windy City. The Bulls came out red hot and shot .722 from the field in the first half to build a 59-51 lead at the intermission and never looked back. Ben Gordon had 28 points in just 35 minutes of action and Kirk Hinrich tabbed 17 and 13 assists.

---

### May 17, 2007

The Bulls bid to become the first NBA team to rally from a 3-0 deficit in a seven game series came up short in Game 6 as Chicago was eliminated following a 95-85 loss at the United Center. The Bulls led by five at the intermission but could not answer a Pistons rally in the third quarter that eventually proved the difference. P.J. Brown scored all 20 of his points in the first half to match his playoff career-high.

---

### NOTE:

The Bulls finished first in NBA attendance in 2006-07 with an average of 22,253 fans filling the United Center each home game. Chicago sold out every regular season and playoff home game on the year, extending its sellout streak to 49 in a row - a string that began with the 2006 playoffs.

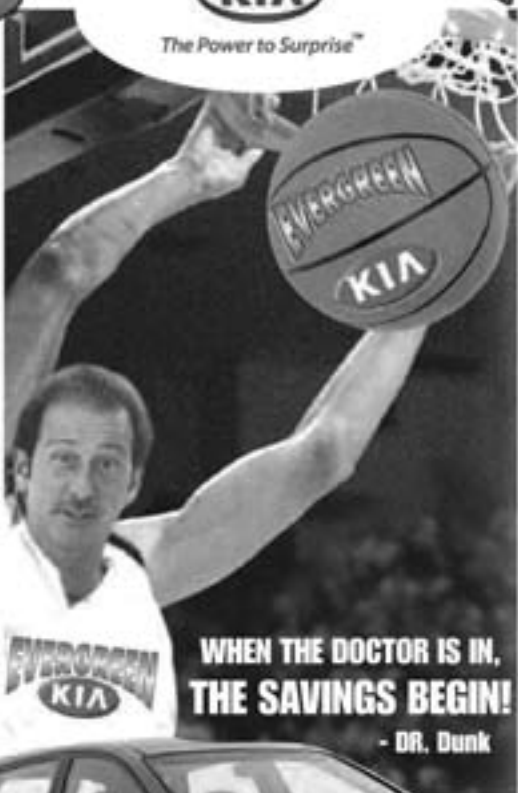
