FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is being a Chicago Luvabull Dancer a full time job?

No, a Luvabull must have a full time job or be a student with part time employment.

Are there any height and weight requirements?

We only require that height and weight are proportioned.

Are there any age requirements?

You must be 21 years of age at the time of auditions.

How will I know if my application was received?

You will be notified by e-mail (please make sure that we have your most current e-mail address). Or, you will receive a post card in the mail for acceptance and confirmation (if you mail the application). Please make sure that we have your most current address and phone number.

What should I wear to the auditions?

- Half-top (any style and color)
- Short shorts (any style and color)
- Sheer to the waist nude panty hose (any brand)
- Dance sneakers
- No slacks, leggings, capri's or cover-ups
- No excess jewelry
- No visible tattoos (cover with makeup)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (cont.)

What do I need to bring to the auditions?

- Drivers license for identification
- Lunch/Snacks.....plan to be there all day

What is the audition process?

Auditions:

- Saturday, August 1 2009 at the United Center, 1901 West Madison Street, Chicago.
- Doors open at 8:00am, registration must be completed by 8:45am
- Candidates will free-style dance to music that we will provide.
- Judges will interview candidates in groups of 12.
- Judges will make cuts after each group.
- Break for lunch.....30 minutes (bring lunch/snacks/drinks)
- Round 2 will begin after lunch—you will be taught a routine and will perform
- Judges will make the final selection of 30-40 dancers who will move forward to Training Camp

Training Camp:

- MANDATORY Training Camp (date TBD)

If I am not selected as a training camp candidate, may I call the Bulls or C.C. Company office to receive my judges' comments?

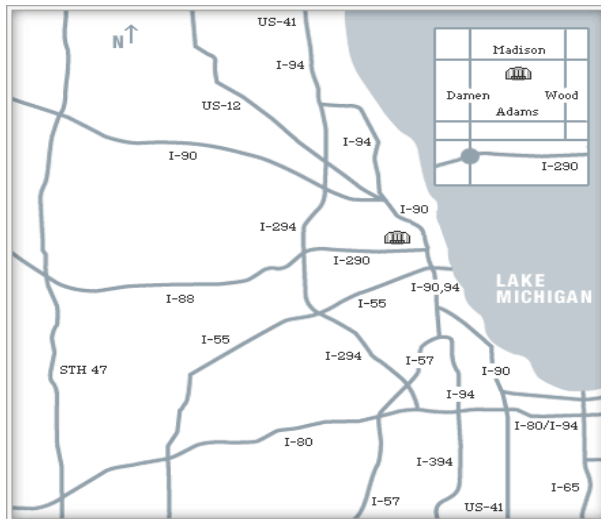
No. The judges' sheets are not kept on file and comments about your audition are not available.

LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS



1901 W. Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois 60612 (312) 455-4500

The United Center is located one mile west of Chicago's Loop and I-90/94 Kennedy Expressway, and four blocks North of I-290 Eisenhower Expressway at Damen Ave. (Exit 28A).

DIRECTIONS

From the North:

Take I-90 East to the Madison St. exit and make a right onto Madison St. The building will then be on your left.

From the South:

Take I-55 North to the Damen/Ashland exit and make a left, going northbound for approximately 7 minutes. The building will then be on your right.

From the East:

Take Madison St. West from the Loop.

From the West:

Take I-290 East to the Damen exit. Take Damen Ave. northbound to Madison St. Make a right onto Madison and the building will be on your right.

Public Transportation

Take the Orange, Green, Purple, or Brown lines to Madison. Take Bus 20 west. For Bulls and Blackhawks games only, Bus 19 takes you there as well.

WHEN: Saturday, August 1 2009
8:00 am registration

WHERE: United Center, 1901 West Madison Street, Chicago
Park in Lot H (at Wood Street between Madison & Monroe)
Enter the Building at Gate 4

You will learn any required dance combinations at the auditions. You will not have to perform your own routine at any time.

TRAINING CAMP: A group of 30-40 dancers will be selected to move forward to Training Camp. The dates for the training camp are to be determined. Attendance at Training camp is MANDATORY.

ATTIRE: Half-top (any style and color)
Short shorts (any style and color)
Sheer to the waist nude panty hose (any brand)
Dance sneakers
No slacks, leggings, capri's or cover-ups
No excess jewelry
No visible tattoos (cover with makeup)

REQUIREMENTS: Must be at least 21 years of age as of August 1 2009, a high school graduate or have a GED, employed full time or a student with part time employment, a resident of the Chicagoland area with a reliable means of transportation, the ability to attend Training Camp and all rehearsals. There are no minimum or maximum height or weight requirements

JUDGING: Judges will focus on dance ability, energy, enthusiasm, figure, personal appearance, personality, poise and showmanship.

REHEARSALS: Rehearsals are mandatory.
