**Game 5, Road Game 3 (11/09/06) CLEVELAND CAVALIERS 113, CHICAGO 94 (Quicken Loans Arena – 19,947 sellout)** LeBron James scored 19 points and had a season-high 12 assists to lead Cleveland past the Bulls 113-94. Drew Gooden added 20 points in three quarters, Anderson Varejao had a career-high 15 and Sasha Pavlovic 16 points in a season-high 25 minutes for the Cavaliers, whose bench went 21-of-30 from the field and helped Cleveland get the win. Kirk Hinrich had 20 points and 11 assists and Andrés Nocioni 15 for Chicago. Cleveland opened the final period with an 11-2 run and pushed its lead to 20 when Pavlovic drained a 3-pointer with 7:17 left. Pavlovic later fed Varejao underneath for a dunk and the forward's free throw put the Cavs ahead 103-79 before cruising to the victory. The Bulls only had eight turnovers, but allowed the Cavs to shoot .570 from the field in the game, including .571 from three-point range, and were out rebounded 47-30.

**Game 31, Home Game 16 (12/30/06) CHICAGO BULLS 103, CLEVELAND CAVALIERS 96 (United Center – 22,965 sellout)** Behind a then career-high 32 points from Luol Deng, the Bulls went on a 24-point run in the second half of a 103-96 victory over the Cavaliers. After a jumper by Larry Hughes made it 67-60 with 7:17 left in the third quarter, Chicago went on a tear with 24 unanswered-points to open its largest lead of the game, 84-67. The Cavaliers came within 96-92 with 1:21 left after a three-pointer by LeBron James, who finished with a game-high 33 points. After a lay-up by Ben Gordon, Hughes scored on a drive, but missed the free throw and allowed the Bulls to increase their lead in the closing seconds. Chris Duhon made one of two foul shots to bump the lead to five with 33 seconds to play. James then missed a runner and Drew Gooden missed the follow up. Deng then grabbed the board, as the Bulls closed out the month of December with a 14-3 record, including 11-1 at the United Center. Gordon went 8-of-18 from the floor on his way to 21 points – his eighth straight game with 20 or more points, while P.J. Brown added 13 points and 10 rebounds, and Malik Allen scored 10 points. Kirk Hinrich missed his first game of the year with a left groin strain.

**Game 56, Road Game 28 (02/22/07) CHICAGO BULLS 84, CLEVELAND CAVALIERS 78 (Quicken Loans Arena – 20,562 sellout)** Ben Wallace scored 14 points with 19 rebounds, a season-high seven blocks and two huge free throws in the final minutes to lead the Bulls to an 84-78 win over the Cavaliers. Wallace, playing one of his best all-around games since signing as a free agent with the Bulls, dominated inside as Chicago snapped a six-game losing streak in Cleveland and improved to 8-2 in the Central. Luol Deng scored 18 points, Ben Gordon 16 and Kirk Hinrich 11 for the Bulls, who overcame foul trouble and 24 turnovers. Trailing by three with less than seven minutes left, Chicago put away the Cavaliers with a 14-5 burst. LeBron James scored 29 points and Larry Hughes had 20 for Cleveland, but the Cavaliers were just 8-of-16 from the line. Chicago, meanwhile, was 12-of-12 from the stripe. But the Cavaliers' biggest problem was that they couldn't handle Wallace. He didn't have to contend with Zydrunas Ilgauskas, and by being active on the boards, Wallace was able to foul out Anderson Varejao. After a fadeaway jumper by Deng in the foul lane gave the Bulls a 78-73 lead, Wallace, a 41 percent free throw shooter, stepped up to the line and swished his only two attempts of the game. Deng scored again to make it 82-73 before James hit a 3-pointer and scored on a follow to pull the Cavaliers within 82-78. However, Gordon made two more free throws with 13.7 seconds left to seal it. The Cavaliers played their fourth-straight game without Ilgauskas, who was attending to personal family health matters. Cleveland was also missing guard Sasha Pavlovic (flu) and guard Damon Jones (strep throat).

**Game 74, Home Game 38 (03/31/07) CLEVELAND CAVALIERS 112, CHICAGO BULLS 108 OT (United Center – 22,960 sellout)** LeBron James scored 39 points, including seven in overtime, and Larry Hughes added 21 points to lead the Cavaliers to a 112-108 overtime victory. Trailing 108-104 with a minute left in overtime, James drove toward the basket. He banked in the jumper, was fouled and converted the three-point play to make it 108-107 with 42.3 seconds left. Then Ben Gordon drove to the lane and missed with a wild shot. James got the rebound and put Cleveland ahead for good with a jumper in the lane that made it 109-108 lead with 20.7 seconds left. After James' short jumper, the Bulls didn't get a shot off on the ensuing possession when Gordon was trapped and threw the ball away. The Bulls then fouled Hughes, who hit one of two free throws to make it 110-108. Gordon missed a 3 with 1.9 seconds left. Hughes rebounded and was immediately fouled, making both free throws. Gordon knocked down a 22-footer to put the Bulls up 106-104 with 1:26 left in overtime. Then James missed a 3, and Ben Wallace picked up the loose ball and was fouled. Wallace hit both free throws, putting Chicago ahead 108-104 with 1:01 left. Gordon finished with 37 points and Tyrus Thomas had a career-high 27 points with eight rebounds. Sasha Pavlovic scored 21 points. James gave Cleveland a 98-91 lead on a pair of free throws with 5:07 left in the fourth quarter. The Bulls came back when Gordon made two free throws and a nice pass to Thomas for an easy dunk to get to 98-95 with 4:03 left. Thomas cut the Cavs' lead to 100-99 on another dunk off Wallace's pass. Then Thomas came up big on the defensive end. James tried to drive to the basket, but Thomas cut off his angle, James lost control of the ball and Thomas stole it. Gordon tied the game at 100 with 39.7 seconds left. The Bulls had chances to take the lead in the final seconds of regulation, but Gordon missed a jumper and later committed a turnover. Cleveland got the ball back with 3 seconds in regulation, but Pavlovic missed on a drive to the basket under tight defense by Luol Deng and Ben Wallace. Hinrich had 22 points and 11 assists and Deng finished with 12. Cleveland built a 10-point lead to start the fourth quarter. Zydrunas Ilgauskas' basket and Pavlovic's 3 gave Cleveland a 77-72 lead and James ended the quarter with back-to-back baskets to make it 83-73.

**Game 34, Home Game 18 (01/06/07) CHICAGO BULLS 106, DETROIT PISTONS 89 (United Center– 22,865 sellout)** Having lost 12 straight home games to Detroit, the Bulls looked to put an end to the Pistons' recent success at the United Center. Luol Deng led all players with 30 points, while Ben Wallace finished with 12 points, 14 rebounds and a season-high six blocks in his first game against his former team. Ben Gordon continued his solid play off the bench and added 23 points and Andrés Nocioni chipped in 21 points. Deng poured in 12 points in the first quarter and had 20 by halftime as Chicago went into the break up 55-46. Richard Hamilton led Detroit with 27 points and Nazr Mohammed scored 15. But Detroit was just 31-of-89 from the field and trailed by as many as 23 in the second half. Chicago led most of the first half, and led the entire second half, outscoring the Pistons 10-5 over the first 3:10 of the third quarter, to up its lead to 65-41. Chicago limited the Pistons to an opponent season-low .348 shooting from the field, also a Pistons' season-low.

**Game 58, Road Game 29 (02/25/07) DETROIT PISTONS 95, CHICAGO BULLS 93 (Palace of Auburn Hills – 22,076 sellout)** Chris Webber made a putback with 2.2 seconds left and matched a season high with 21 points to lift the Pistons to a 95-93 win over the Bulls. Richard Hamilton scored 22, while Chauncey Billups had 15 points and nine assists and Tayshaun Prince added 14 points and nine rebounds for the Pistons. Ben Gordon scored 21, P.J. Brown matched a season high with 19 points, Luol Deng scored 18 and Chris Duhon added 12 for the Bulls. The Bulls went on a 23-3 run before and after halftime to take a 16-point lead midway through the third quarter. The Pistons got back in the game by scoring the last 12 points of the third quarter, pulling within two. Detroit reserve Jason Maxiell provided a spark, grabbing five rebounds, blocking two shots and scoring two points in the pivotal third after Rasheed Wallace was sidelined with an ankle injury. With just under two minutes left, the Pistons led 93-86. Gordon responded with a 3-pointer and another basket to pull the Bulls within two, then Prince missed two free throws with 18.7 seconds left to give Chicago a chance. Gordon made two free throws to tie it with 15 seconds to go. On Detroit's final possession, Billups dribbled the ball up the court and allowed time to tick off the clock before missing a jump shot from the left wing. Webber got the rebound and put back the shot. Gordon had a good look at what would have been a game-winning 3-pointer just before the final buzzer, but just missed the attempt from the left corner.

**Game 73, Home Game 37 (03/29/07) CHICAGO BULLS 83, DETROIT PISTONS 81 (United Center – 22,243 sellout)** Kirk Hinrich hit two of three free throws with 2.8 seconds left, and the Bulls clinched their third-straight playoff berth, pulling out an 83-81 victory over the Pistons after blowing a 12-point lead in the fourth quarter. After Tayshaun Prince tied it with a put-back with 9.8 seconds left, Hinrich caught a pass at the top of the key and got fouled by Carlos Delfino on a 3-point attempt. After a 20-second timeout, Prince caught the inbounds pass and launched a short pull-up jumper over Luol Deng as time expired. Ben Wallace did his part, grabbing 19 rebounds as Chicago had a 51-37 edge on the boards. Ben Gordon led Chicago with 25 points. Prince scored 26 points for Detroit. With a 77-65 lead and about five minutes remaining, the Bulls appeared to be in control. But the Pistons were within 81-79 with 48 seconds left after Chauncey Billups drove by Hinrich. Rasheed Wallace then stole the ball from Tyrus Thomas with 35 seconds left, and Prince put back Delfino's missed jumper to tie it at 81. Thomas had arguably his best game, finishing with 13 points and 10 rebounds. The Pistons were without starters Richard Hamilton and Chris Webber, who were back home with the flu.

**Game 76, Home Game 38 (04/04/07) CHICAGO BULLS 106, DETROIT PISTONS 88 (Palace of Auburn Hills – 22,076 sellout)** Kirk Hinrich scored 29 points and Luol Deng added 22 as the Bulls beat the Pistons 106-88. Ben Wallace missed the game against his former team after going to the hospital with sinus inflammation. Chicago took control of the game with a 16-4 run - with Hinrich scoring half of its points - to end the third quarter for a 84-69 lead. Until that burst, it was a tightly contested game with 15 lead changes and eight ties. Chauncey Billups scored 17, Rasheed Wallace had 16 points and Chris Webber added 10 points and eight rebounds for the Pistons. Thabo Sefolosha, who entered the starting lineup late with Wallace out, had 11 points and 10 rebounds. P.J. Brown, who moved to center in Wallace's place, scored 11 points and grabbed seven rebounds. Tyrus Thomas added 13 points and eight rebounds in just 10 minutes. The Bulls trailed 53-52 at halftime, but used a 32-16 third quarter to put the Pistons in a hole, then buried them 22-19 in the fourth. Chicago limited Richard Hamilton to just three points on 1-of-4 shooting. The Bulls outrebounded the Pistons 48-32 and had 17 second chance points to Detroit's two.

**Game 1, Road Game 1 (10/31/06) CHICAGO BULLS 108, MIAMI 66 (AmericanAirlines Arena – 20,229 sellout)** Minutes after the Miami Heat received their championship rings, Kirk Hinrich and the Bulls reminded them that their new hardware was for last season's efforts. Hinrich scored 15 of his 26 points in an overwhelming first half as the Bulls trumped the Heat, 108-66, in the opening game of the 2006-07 NBA season. Hot-shooting Chris Duhon added 20 points in just 16 minutes for the Bulls to help generate a 37-point second quarter that broke open the game and abruptly ended Miami's celebration. It was the worst season-opening loss by a defending champion, surpassing the 132-117 setback suffered by the Los Angeles Lakers vs. Golden State in 1982. Miami spent the first quarter running around in circles. They committed nine fouls -- two each by superstars Shaquille O'Neal and Dwyane Wade -- and seven turnovers, digging a 22-16 hole. It got worse in the second period, when the Bulls turned up their interior defense and started making shots. Consecutive dunks by Tyrus Thomas and Luol Deng capped a 12-2 spurt that made it 38-21 with 7:39 left. Hinrich had a driving three-point play and made a beautiful tip pass to Gordon for a fast-break layup and a 47-25 bulge. Duhon drained consecutive 3-pointers for a 57-28 advantage in the final minute. In the first half, Miami had 10 baskets and 13 turnovers. Meanwhile, Chicago shot 51 percent (20-of-39) from the field and held a 26-15 rebounding advantage. The Heat got no closer than 22 points in the second half. Duhon made 7-of-8 shots, including all three of his 3-pointers. Deng scored 12 points, Sefolosha added 11 without missing a shot and Wallace and Andrés Nocioni grabbed 11 rebounds apiece for Chicago. Wade scored 25 points, but was the only player in double figures for Miami, which was beaten on the boards, 49-29. O'Neal scored seven points on 3-of-10 shooting as he was defended well by Wallace.

**Game 29, Home Game 15 (12/27/06) CHICAGO BULLS 109, MIAMI HEAT 103 (United Center – 22,946 sellout)** Ben Gordon scored a then career-high 40 points off the bench to lead Chicago to a 109-103 victory over the short-handed Miami Heat, who lost Dwyane Wade to a sprained wrist in the first quarter. Andrés Nocioni added 16 for Chicago, which recovered after blowing a 20-point lead. Chicago took a 97-96 lead when Ben Wallace hit a free throw with 2:49 left. After Wallace missed two foul shots, he stole a pass and found Gordon for a lay-up to make it 99-96. Udonis Haslem came back for Miami with a tip, and Jason Williams hit a jumper to give the Heat a 100-99 lead with 1:26 left. Then, Gordon and the Bulls finally took control. Gordon, off balance and hit hard in the lane, converted a three-point play for a 102-100 lead. Jason Kaponu missed a long 3-pointer and Tyrus Thomas was fouled on the other end. He made two free throws to make it 104-100 with 24.5 seconds left. Williams scored 28 points for Miami after draining 7-of-10 from three-point land, and Kaponu had 18. Dorell Wright added a season-high 17 and 14 rebounds, and Haslem finished with 14 and 10. Hinrich had 14 points and five assists for Chicago, while Wallace added nine points and 11 rebounds. The Heat came all the way back from a 20-point deficit and took an 87-85 lead on Williams' 3-pointer with 7:54 left.

**Game 45, Home Game 26 (01/27/07) CHICAGO BULLS 100, MIAMI HEAT 97 (United Center – 22,951 sellout)** With Shaquille O'Neal sitting and Kirk Hinrich slowing down Dwyane Wade once again, the Bulls beat the defending champs for the third time this season. Ben Gordon had 34 points and seven assists, and Hinrich scored 26 points in the Bulls' 100-97 victory over the Heat. Reserve Andrés Nocioni added 19 points for Chicago, which lost center Ben Wallace to a left knee sprain with 5:01 remaining. He finished with 15 rebounds. After giving up a 17-point lead, the Bulls finally pulled away when a jumper by Gordon with 1:58 left broke an 89-all tie and started an 8-2 run. Hinrich made a jumper in the lane and followed with two free throws, putting Chicago up 97-91 with 1:09 left. Wade led the Heat with 24 points, eight rebounds and eight assists. James Posey had 17.

**Game 63, Road Game 31 (03/07/07) MIAMI HEAT 103, CHICAGO BULLS 70 (AmericanAirlines Arena – 19,600 sellout)** Hoping to sweep the season series from the Heat for the first time since 1991-92, Chicago allowed Miami to jump out to a 30-18 lead after one quarter and never recovered. The Heat led by as many as 19 points in the opening frame and 17 in the second quarter, but the Bulls kept chipping away and trailed 52-43 at the break. Chicago was able to trim the Miami lead to just three points, 56-53, with 5:29 to go in the third, before the Heat ran off a 38-9 run and upped its lead to 94-62 with 3:41 left in regulation. Shaquille O'Neal led the way for Miami with 24 points, nine rebounds and a season-high eight assists and Eddie Jones added a season-high 23 points (6-8 3FGM). The Bulls went 0-for-10 from the field in the final 5-plus minutes of the third quarter and 3-for-20 from the floor over the remainder of the game. Ben Gordon led Chicago with 14 points, while Chris Duhon added 12 points and Kirk Hinrich had 11 points.

**Game 33, Road Game 16 (01/05/07) NEW JERSEY NETS 91, CHICAGO BULLS 86 (Continental Airlines Arena – 18,569 sellout)** Jason Kidd and Vince Carter combined to score 10-straight points down the stretch, and New Jersey rallied to beat the Bulls 91-86. Carter finished with 21 points, while Kidd had 17 points and 10 rebounds. Richard Jefferson scored 18 points and Bostjan Nachbar, making his first start as a Net, had 16. Luol Deng scored 22 points to lead Chicago. Andrés Nocioni had 19, Ben Gordon 15 and Kirk Hinrich 13. With the Bulls leading 84-81, Carter started the decisive run with a dunk with 2:49 remaining. He followed with a pair of free throws and another basket as the Nets took the lead for good with 1:05 left. On the Bulls' next possession, Kidd stole Gordon's pass for a fast-break layup. After Deng missed two free throws, Kidd closed the stretch with a spectacular shot. With his back to the basket, Kidd flipped the ball over Ben Wallace off the glass to put New Jersey up 89-84. Carter left the door open for the Bulls when he missed two free throws with 11 seconds remaining and the Nets holding an 89-86 lead. Wallace appeared to pull the Bulls within one, but he was called for offensive interference and the basket was waved off. The Bulls threatened to blow away the Nets at the start, scoring the first 18 points as they shot 7-for-10 from the field. The Nets missed their first nine shots from the field while committing four turnovers. New Jersey finally got on the scoreboard when Jefferson made a free throw with 5:26 left. The Bulls helped the Nets back into the game by committing 20 turnovers and 35 personal fouls.

**Game 37, Home Game 20 (01/11/07) NEW JERSEY NETS 86, CHICAGO BULLS 83 (United Center – 21,931 sellout)** Jason Kidd recorded his 82<sup>nd</sup> career triple-double, and the Nets erased an 18-point deficit against Chicago to down the Bulls 86-83. Kirk Hinrich made a runner in the lane for Chicago to make it 74-67, but the Nets came back and scored 14-consecutive points. Richard Jefferson had a reverse dunk, Vince Carter made two free throws and then Kidd followed with a three-pointer to give the Nets a 76-74 lead with 5:41 left in the game. Kidd extended the Nets' lead with a basket with 2:20 left, making it 81-74. Chicago got within 81-78 with 51 seconds left, but Jefferson followed with two free throws. Andrés Nocioni's three-pointer cut the Nets' lead to 83-81 with 16 seconds remaining. Kidd followed by hitting 1-of-2 free throws on the other end, making it 84-81. After Hinrich made two free throws, Kidd came back and made both free throws to make it 86-83. Then Kidd forced Hinrich to lose control of the ball and Hinrich's forced three-point attempt was blocked by Bostjan Nachbar as time expired. Carter added 18 points for the Nets. Nocioni finished with 28 points for Chicago and Gordon had 23 -- only three after halftime while being defended by Kidd.

**Game 77, Home Game 39 (04/06/07) CHICAGO BULLS 105, NEW JERSEY NETS 74 (United Center – 22,612 sellout)** Ben Gordon scored 27 points and Luol Deng added 24 points and 12 rebounds to lead the Bulls to a 105-74 victory over the visiting Nets. The Bulls coasted despite being short-handed against the Nets. Ben Wallace missed his second straight game with sinusitis and the Bulls also played without reserve forwards Tyrus Thomas, Andrés Nocioni and Adrian Griffin. Kirk Hinrich added 20 points for the Bulls. Chicago opened the contest outscoring New Jersey 31-20 after one quarter and cruised to victory. The Bulls limited the Nets to just .342 shooting from the floor, while hitting .460 of their field goals.

**Game 82, Road Game 41 (04/18/07) NEW JERSEY NETS 106, CHICAGO BULLS 97 (Continental Airlines Arena – 15,108)** Vince Carter had 24 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists, and the Nets beat Chicago 106-97 in the season finale for both teams. Mikki Moore had 22 points and Jason Kidd added 11 assists and 11 rebounds for the Nets. Bostjan Nachbar hit three big 3-pointers in the fourth quarter and scored 10 of his 15 points. Josh Boone converted a go-ahead three-point play late in the third quarter to give New Jersey the lead for good at 71-68, and the rookie added seven of his 15 in the fourth quarter. Richard Jefferson added 21 points on 5-of-18 shooting. Kirk Hinrich had 20 points and Andrés Nocioni added 19 to lead the Bulls, who never overcame an early 15-point deficit. Gordon and Luol Deng had 15 points apiece for the Bulls. Down by 12 at the half, the Bulls came out in the third quarter and made a run at the Nets, tying the game at 68 on a 3-pointer by Nocioni with 40 seconds to go. Nachbar then found Boone alone inside for a dunk and he completed the three-point play for a 71-68 edge. A layup by Gordon got Chicago within a point entering the fourth quarter. The Bulls stayed close for first four minutes, the last time at 79-77 on a layup by Nocioni with eight minutes to play. New Jersey responded with a 15-4 spurt that featured consecutive 3-pointers by Nachbar and a run-ending 3-pointer by Kidd. Chicago struggled from the field, hitting 35-of-83, or 42 percent. The Nets were 36-of-79 (46 percent).

**Game 2, Road Game 2 (11/01/06) ORLANDO MAGIC 109, CHICAGO BULLS 94 (TD Waterhouse Centre – 17,451 sellout)** Dwight Howard had 27 points and 11 rebounds and Jameer Nelson scored 21 points as the Magic downed the Bulls 109-94. The Bulls beat the Heat by 42 points the night before, but couldn't find their stroke in Orlando. Ben Gordon flashed a dazzling array of reverse layups, drives and fadeaway jumpers on his way to 24 points, while Kirk Hinrich had 14 points and four assists and Luol Deng scored 12 for the Bulls. Grant Hill had 19 points on 5-of-7 shooting and Hedo Turkoglu had 11 points, seven rebounds and six assists. Orlando trailed only once - by a point - in the game's opening minute. They won despite committing 23 turnovers to Chicago's 15, outshooting the Bulls 59 percent to 45 percent from the field. Nelson keyed a 13-2 Magic run in the third quarter with a jumper, layup and 3-pointer, scoring seven points on consecutive trips in 1:17. The spurt gave Orlando an 80-55 lead before Malik Allen turned in a three-point play with 4:31 left in the quarter. The Magic used a 17-6 second-quarter run over four minutes to take a 63-45 lead at halftime. Six different players scored in the span, including an alley-oop dunk and three-point play from Howard.

**Game 59, Home Game 30 (02/26/07) ORLANDO MAGIC 94, CHICAGO BULLS 87 (United Center – 22,031 sellout)** Dwight Howard scored 21 points and grabbed 16 rebounds - to go with 11 turnovers - as the Magic beat the Bulls 94-87. Orlando overcame 27 turnovers with the punishing inside play of Howard and Darko Milicic, who added 14 points, five blocks and matched Howard with 16 rebounds - a career high. The Magic dominated the boards 49-31 with 19 offensive rebounds. Jameer Nelson scored 18 points and made three straight free throws after he was fouled twice in a span of four seconds by Kirk Hinrich. Those free throws gave the Magic a five-point lead with less than two minutes left and they increased it to six on a Nelson jumper. Ben Gordon, who had 32 points, hit a 3-pointer to cut the lead to 90-87 with 36.9 seconds to play. With the shot clocking running out, Turkoglu put a jumper that missed. But Howard tapped the ball and so did Nelson and it went through the hands of the Bulls, right back to Turkoglu, who was fouled by Hinrich and made both free throws with 12.3 seconds left. Howard closed out the win with two more free throws.

**Game 64, Road Game 32 (03/08/07) CHICAGO BULLS 100, ORLANDO MAGIC 76 (Amway Arena – 17,451 sellout)** Looking to avoid being swept in the season series against the Magic for the first time since the 2001-02 season, the Bulls came out running and opened a 26-17 lead after one quarter. Kirk Hinrich scored 10 of his 17 points in the opening period and the Bulls outrebounded the Magic 17-7 in the first quarter to keep Orlando in check. The Bulls then limited the Magic to just 12 second-quarter points, as they posted a 49-29 lead at the half. For the quarter, Chicago went 8-16 from the floor, and held Orlando to just 5-19 from the floor. Orlando's 29 first-half points were a season low for the squad and just two more than the Bulls' opponent season low for a first half. Orlando trimmed the Bulls lead to 14 in the third quarter, 61-47, with 2:42 to play in the third, before Chicago closed the game out on a 39-29 run. Ben Gordon led all players with 25 points (4-5 3FGM), while Luol Deng posted his 13<sup>th</sup> double-double of the year with 15 points and a season-high 14 rebounds. Dwight Howard led the Magic with 17 points and 14 boards. Orlando shot .394 for the game, as the Bulls improved to 11-6 when they hold their opponent to less than .400 shooting from the field.

**Game 19, Home Game 8 (12/08/06) CHICAGO BULLS 93, TORONTO RAPTORS 90 (United Center – 21,797 sellout)** Luol Deng scored 25 points and the Bulls hung on to beat the Raptors 93-90. Toronto's Morris Peterson and T.J. Ford missed potential tying 3-pointers in the final 13 seconds, and the Bulls improved to 10-9 on the season while extending their win streak over Toronto to 14. Andrés Nocioni scored 13 of his 17 points in the third quarter, and grabbed 14 rebounds. Kirk Hinrich did most of his scoring in the first five minutes of the fourth quarter, when he had nine of his 13 points. Hinrich hit a jumper and 3-pointer from the corner to make it 83-74 with 7:13. But the Raptors were within one after Anthony Parker's 3 from the corner with 1:14 left. After a timeout, Ben Gordon (13 points) scored from the top of the key to make it a three-point game. The Raptors called time with 24 seconds left, and Peterson drove along the right side for a layup that pulled the Raptors within 91-90. Chicago's Chris Duhon hit two free throws with 13 seconds left, but after a 20-second timeout, Peterson missed from the wing and Ford from the corner. Jorge Garbajosa led the Raptors with 17 points.

**Game 30, Road Game 15 (12/29/06) CHICAGO BULLS 107, TORONTO RAPTORS 97 (Air Canada Centre – 19,800 sellout)** Luol Deng shook off a sprained wrist to help the Bulls continue their dominance over the Raptors in their 107-97 victory in Canada. Deng scored 25 points and Ben Gordon added 22 to lead the Bulls to their 15<sup>th</sup>-straight victory over the Raptors. Deng had 19 points in the second half for the Bulls, who shot a season-high 59.7 percent. Deng also had six rebounds and finished 11-for-16 from the field. A Chris Duhon three-pointer capped a 16-6 run to start the fourth quarter for the Bulls, giving Chicago a 17-point lead - its biggest of the game – 98-81. Deng then knocked down a jumper to make it 101-89 with 4:21 left, but Morris Peterson capped a 7-0 run with a three-pointer to cut the lead to six, 101-95, with 2:38 left. Ben Wallace followed with a layup, P.J. Brown made two free throws and Gordon made a jumper to give Chicago a 10-point lead with 1:36 left. Kirk Hinrich scored 12 of his 16 points in the first half, including two three-pointers in the final two minutes of the half. T.J. Ford had 20 points for the Raptors and Andrea Bargnani had 16 points, including four 3-pointers. He went 1-for-4 from behind the arc in the second half.

**Game 53, Home Game 27 (02/13/07) TORONTO RAPTORS 112, CHICAGO BULLS 111 (United Center – 21,776 sellout)** Chris Bosh hit two free throws with 2.1 seconds left after he was fouled on an offensive rebound as the Raptors recovered after blowing a 12-point, fourth-quarter lead to beat the Bulls 112-111. Bosh finished with 25 points and 14 rebounds, to help his team end a 15-game losing streak against the Bulls stretching back to Dec. 6, 2002. Andrea Bargnani added 22 points for Toronto. In the closing seconds, Tyrus Thomas blocked a layup attempt by T.J. Ford but Bosh rebounded and was fouled by Thomas before hitting both free throws. Ben Gordon, whose three-point play with 12.8 seconds left had given the Bulls a 111-110 lead and capped a 13-0 run, put up a jumper that was short at the buzzer. Gordon hit the floor but no foul was called on Ford who was guarding him. The Raptors went ahead by eight points early in the fourth quarter when Jose Calderon converted a three-point play and moments later fed Bosh for a basket that made it 94-86. Finding holes in the Chicago defense, Calderon made three straight Toronto baskets to increase the margin to 12 with about 6 minutes remaining. The Bulls got 30 points from Luol Deng and 26 from Gordon. Chris Duhon's 3-pointer with 1:27 to go closed the deficit to five and after two Toronto misses. Duhon connected again from the corner, another 3-pointer that made it 110-108 with 35 seconds remaining. Bosh's pass went off Anthony Parker's hands and out of bounds with 21.1 seconds to go and the Bulls had a final chance. Gordon drove the lane and hit a bank shot as he was fouled, tying the game with 12.8 seconds left. His free throw gave the Bulls a short-lived lead. Trailing by five points at the half, the Bulls caught up as Deng scored 12 points in the third with his jumper putting the Bulls up 73-70. But Jorge Garbajosa's third 3-pointer of the period and layup and then 3-pointer from Parker restored the Raptors' lead to five and they held on for an 87-82 advantage headed into the fourth. Bargnani was 6-for-7, including three 3-pointers, and also had a roaring dunk to score 17 first-half points -- 12 in the second quarter -- as Toronto took a 56-51 lead. The Raptors shot 60 percent in the first two quarters.

**Game 78, Road Game 39 (04/08/07) TORONTO RAPTORS 103, CHICAGO BULLS 89 (Air Canada Centre – 22,612 sellout)** Anthony Parker scored a career-high 27 points and Chris Bosh had 22 points and 11 rebounds, leading the Raptors to a 103-89 victory over the Bulls. Ben Gordon had 27 points for the Bulls, who lost for the second time in eight games. Andrés Nocioni returned to Chicago's lineup after missing 28 games with plantar fasciitis. He had three points in eight minutes. The Bulls led by four at halftime, but Toronto came out gunning in the third and outscored the Bulls 31-17 in that frame to take control of the game. The Raptors outscored the Bulls 36-22 in the last 13:56. Bosh was limited to just 5-for-14 from the field, but managed 12-for-14 from the foul line. Toronto went 9-for-19 from beyond the 3-point arc, including 6-for-10 from Parker alone.

**Game 16, Home Game 5 (12/02/06) CHICAGO BULLS 112, WASHINGTON WIZARDS 94 (United Center – 22,180 sellout)** Ben Gordon scored 28 points and Andrés Nocioni added 24 to lead Chicago to a 112-94 victory over Washington. Gordon and Nocioni led the charge as the Bulls outscored the Wizards 33-19 in the second quarter. Gordon hit 10-of-21 shots off the bench, including 5-of-9 3-pointers. Luol Deng added 18 points and nine rebounds. Kirk Hinrich had 10 points and nine assists, while Ben Wallace finished with 10 points and nine rebounds. Caron Butler had 21 points and 10 rebounds for the Wizards and Gilbert Arenas was 3-of-11 from the floor for just 10 points. Nocioni and Gordon set the tone, scoring 13 and 12 in the second quarter as Chicago turned a four-point edge into a 62-44 halftime advantage. After seeing a 15-point, fourth-quarter lead dwindle to two the previous night, the Bulls never were challenged in the second half. They led by as much as 30 in the third quarter. They were aggressive on defense and active on the glass, where they held a 49-36 rebounding edge, and they were 41-of-81 from the field while committing just 12 turnovers.

**Game 36, Road Game 17 (01/10/07) WASHINGTON WIZARDS 113, CHICAGO BULLS 103 (Verizon Center – 20,173 sellout)** Chicago dropped a 113-103 decision at Washington, despite three players with 20+ points, including a season-high 33 points from Kirk Hinrich. The Bulls jumped out to an 11-2 lead in the early going, but the Wizards stormed right back and held a 27-18 advantage after one quarter and a slim 46-43 lead at the half. Hinrich scored 24 of his 33 in the second half as Chicago closed the gap to just two points three times early in the fourth quarter. But Washington went on a 12-0 run in the middle of the final frame, then held its lead down the stretch for the win. Caron Butler's 26 points led six Wizards in double figures. Butler also added 10 rebounds and seven assists. The Bulls committed 20 turnovers that led to 32 points for the Wizards, while forcing Washington into just 11 for 15 points.

**Game 57, Home Game 29 (02/23/07) CHICAGO BULLS 105, WASHINGTON WIZARDS 90 (United Center – 22,618 sellout)** Luol Deng tied his then career-high 32 points on 13-of-22 shooting and added 11 rebounds as he helped the Bulls win their third straight after the All-Star break. Kirk Hinrich had 20 points, 12 assists and eight rebounds, offsetting a 36-point effort from Gilbert Arenas. Arenas, who made 11 of 20 shots, had 18 straight points for Washington at one stretch of the second half. His three-point play got Washington within four in the final quarter, but then the Bulls took off. Thabo Sefolosha got free for a layup, Deng scored on a jumper and Hinrich made a steal and a layup in a quick 9-0 run that put the Bulls ahead 90-77. Moments later, Hinrich came up with a loose ball and fed an alley oop to Deng for a dunk, clinching the victory.

**Game 81, Road Game 40 (04/15/07) CHICAGO BULLS 101, WASHINGTON WIZARDS 68 (Verizon Center – 20,173 sellout)** Ben Gordon scored 30 points and Chicago held Washington to .338 shooting as the Bulls beat the Wizards 101-68. The Bulls jumped out to 12-0 advantage and their lead was never threatened thereafter. Chicago led 49-27 at halftime, holding Washington to a season low for a half as it shot 11-for-36 (31 percent), including 0-for-7 on 3-pointers. The Bulls registered assists on 28 of their 38 field goals and also outrebounded the Wizards 57-42. The injury plagued Wizards were without All-Stars Gilbert Arenas and Caron Butler and Antonio Daniels also missed the game because of injury. It was just the second win at Washington for Chicago in its last 15 trips.
