DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH: Take Interstate 93 south through Boston to exit 15 (JFK Library/South Boston/Dorchester) and follow the UMass signs along Columbia Road and Morrissey Blvd. to the campus.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take Interstate 93 north to exit 14 (JFK Library/Morrissey Blvd.) and follow Morrissey Blvd. northward to the campus.

FROM THE WEST: Take the Mass Turnpike (Interstate 90) east to Interstate 93 south. Follow for one mile to exit 15 (JFK Library/South Boston/Dorchester) and follow the UMass signs along Columbia Road and Morrissey Blvd. to the campus.

PARKING: A parking garage is located next to the Clark Athletic Center. Fees: \$5.00 per single use; Five uses for \$24, ten for \$46.
