SHAMROCK SHOOTOUT



RULES:

1. All 5 team members have 45 seconds each to shoot 5 basketballs from 4 racks, for a possible maximum score of 44 points
2. 4 ball racks will be placed at four designated shooting positions: (please see attached diagram)
 - Lay-ups = 1 point
 - Free Throws = 2 points
 - Foul Line Extended = 2 points (Fifth ball is “Money Ball” worth 4 points)
 - Three Pointer = 3 points (Fifth ball is “Money Ball” worth 5 points)
3. You may start at any rack, and proceed in any order, but you must shoot all 5 basketballs from each rack (with the Money Ball **last**) before moving on to another rack
4. Official Shootout Scorers will keep score on-court and display them on the scoreboards immediately after each shooter, with the team score displaying after the final shooter
5. Highest point totals for top 50% of teams advance through each round of competition
6. Highest individual point total will also be awarded a prize at conclusion of Shootout
7. In case of a tie:
 - In the first 2 rounds, highest individual shooters’ point total for that round will be compared. The higher score advances
 - If there is another tie, next highest individual shooters’ scores will be compared
 - In next two rounds, one player per team will shoot foul shots for 30 seconds. Higher score advances their team
 - If they’re still tied, two other players will continue the tie-break shooting
8. Shootout Court Judges will have final say in any discrepancy and/or debate
