College Highlights: Finished collegiate career as Bucknell's second all-time leader in steals (217) and fifth in assists (375). Ranks fifth in Patriot League history in steals and tenth in assists. Also ranks tied for second in school history in games played (123) with 105 games started. Named Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year as a sophomore. Was a member of the Nigerian national team that participated in the 2005 FIBA Africa Cup and the 2006 World Championships.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 7.5 points, 2.7 rebounds, 3.1 assists, and 1.5 steals. Started all 31 games. Scored in double figures ten times. Recorded season highs of 16 points and seven assists vs. Wake Forest. Scored 11 points vs. Northern Iowa. Registered 11 points, four assists, and three steals vs. Army and scored 15 points in the rematch. Dished out five assists at Xavier. Scored 13 points at Lehigh.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 6.6 points, 3.4 rebounds, 3.9 assists (ranked second in the Patriot League), and 2.0 steals (fourth). Started 31 of 32 games. Scored in double figures eight times, registering a career-high 17 points vs. Lehigh. Distributed out a season-high eight assists vs. Colgate and Navy. Tallied nine points, seven rebounds, five assists, and three steals at DePaul. Dished out seven assists, grabbed three steals, and hit the game-clinching free throws vs. Arkansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 5.3 points, 3.1 rebounds, 3.5 assists (ranked fourth in the Patriot League), and 1.9 steals (third). Started 27 of 31 games. Scored in double figures four times. Registered season-high 15 points vs. Lehigh. Tallied eight assists and six rebounds at St. Joseph's. Scored 13 points vs. Lafayette in the Patriot League Tournament. Dished out a career-high 11 assists against zero turnovers and held opposing point guard Aaron Miles without a field goal vs. Kansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 3.9 points, 1.6 assists, and 1.6 steals (ranked sixth in the Patriot League) in 21.2 minutes a contest. Started 16 of 29 games. Scored in double figures twice. Registered a season-high 13 points, a career-high nine rebounds, and four steals at Army. Scored 12 points vs. Lafayette. Dished out a season-high eight assists vs. Navy.
