College Highlights: As a senior named all-West Coast Conference and winner of the Father William Dunne Award as USF team MVP... played in 121 games earning 86 starts ... averaged 9.1 points 5.2 rebounds in 24.5 minutes per game.

Senior (2006-07): Finished 22nd on the USF career scoring list with 1,103 points and pulled 629 career rebounds...Wiggins averaged a career best 14.3 points 7.2 rebounds shots .522 percent from the floor, nailed .737 percent of his free-throws, and blocked 1.48 shots ... 11 points, eight rebounds and four assists in WCC tournament loss to San Diego...eight double doubles (first WCC)...eight double-doubles as a junior... led team with 46 blocks.

Junior (2005-06): USF's second leading scorer. 14.1 ppg, top rebounder 8.3 rpg...named honorable mention all-WCC and USF co-MVP and top defender...led the WCC in blocked shots with 2.1 per game and was third in field goal percent .527.. USF's leading scorer nine times ...scored in double figures 22 times in 28 games...21 points and six blocks at Stanford Nov. 23...20 points on 7-9 shooting in win over Texas Tech.

Sophomore (2004-05): Significantly stepped up his game averaging 5.8 points and 4.0 rebounds in 29 starts...In USF's regular season sweep of Santa Clara, scored 11 points, including the game-winning shot in USF's 62-60 win on the road and scored 16 points (and 10 boards) in home win...started 29 of 31 games...34 blocks led the team...he also led the team in field goal percentage in both overall (.500) and league (.558) play.

Freshman (2003-04): Had a solid freshman season...named the team's Most Improved Player...appeared in all 31 games...averaged 2.8 points and 1.6 rebounds per contest ...shot a solid 48.2% from the floor...11 blocks on year...season high 10 points vs. SMS in Guardians Classic game.

Personal: Alan is the son of the late former San Diego Padres and Baltimore Orioles second baseman Alan Wiggins, who played in the 1984 World Series.
