Pro Career Highlights: Appeared in 49 games for the Utah Flash of the NBA Development League, starting in 20. Scored in double figures 23 times, including a career-high 26 points on Jan. 20 when the Flash defeated the Los Angeles D-Fenders. Spent the 2007-08 season in the NBA D-League with the Utah Flash, averaging 6.1 points and 1.7 rebounds in 15.1 minutes a contest. Ranked third in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.448). Appeared in 50 games, starting twice. Scored in double figures 14 times. Exploded for a career-high 33 points on 13-for-16 shooting, including 6-for-8 from three-point range vs. Anaheim. Scored 21 points on 9-for-14 shooting in the regular season finale vs. Iowa. Selected by the Flash in the seventh round (94th pick overall) of the 2007 NBA D-League Draft.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-Patriot League honors his sophomore and senior years. Named to the conference Second Team as a junior. Finished collegiate career as American's fifth all-time leading scorer with 1,655 points. Started 117 of 118 career games played. Led team in scoring all four years.

Senior (2006-07): Ranked fifth in the Patriot League in scoring (15.2 ppg), second in three-point field goal percentage (.424) and second in three-point field goals made per game (2.6). Scored 20 or more points eight times. Registered season-high 25 points vs. Lafayette. Scored 24 points and dished out a career-high matching six assists vs. Morgan State. Tallied 21 points and a season-high nine rebounds at Howard. Recorded 23 points on 9-for-14 shooting vs. Bucknell. Led team with 20 points in Patriot League Tournament semifinals vs. Holy Cross.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 12.0 points and 4.7 rebounds. Scored 20 or more points three times. Hit seven three-pointers in scoring a season-high 26 points at Lafayette. Registered 24 points in the season opener at Washington. Recorded a 13-point, ten-rebound double-double at St. Francis. Tallied 14 points, nine rebounds, and a season-high five assists vs. Lafayette.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 15.3 points (ranked second in the Patriot League) and 4.3 rebounds. Exploded for a career-high 38 points on 12-for-18 shooting, including 6-for-7 from three-point range at Virginia Commonwealth. Recorded 37 points at Lafayette. Tallied 22 points and a season-high eight rebounds vs. Holy Cross. Distributed a career-high six assists at Niagara.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 13.6 points (ranked fifth in the Patriot League) and 4.0 rebounds. Posted five 20-point games. Scored season-high 30 points at Lafayette. Registered two double-doubles, including a 15-point, ten-rebound effort vs. Colgate. Sank a career-high eight threes in scoring 27 points at Navy. Notched 23 points at Notre Dame. Tallied 16 points and five rebounds at Maryland in his collegiate debut. Named to the Patriot League All-Freshman Team and was named conference Freshman of the Year.
