Tulsa 66ers (D-League), left in November ... signed with Merengeros de Santo Domingo in December (Dominican Rep.-Liga Americas, starting five): Liga Americas: 3 games: 14.0 ppg, 1.3 rpg, 4.0 apg, 2.3 spg ... Sameji (Dominican Rep.-SRT, starting five) ... in April signed with La Guaira BBC (Venezuela-LPB, starting five): 17 games: 11.5 ppg, 1.8 rpg, 3.7 apg, 2.6 spg, released in May.

Senior (2007-08) Dayton: He had 17 points, nine rebounds, two assists, two steals and two blocks against Richmond ... He had a career-high four steals to go with 10 points and four rebounds versus Charlotte He netted 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting, seven rebounds and a career-best four steals over Temple ... He played in all 34 games and started 23 of them while averaging 6.4 points and 2.9 rebounds. He was also second on the team in steals with 33.

Junior (2006-07) Dayton: He began the year on a downer, breaking a bone in his foot that required a titanium screw to be placed in it, he was expected to be out 4-6 weeks, but apparently didn't get the memo. He was back on the court exactly 19 days after the surgery to place the screw in the foot ... He bounced back in league action later in the year with performances like a career-high 21 points and adding six assists and six rebounds in the win over George Washington ... He was big in the Saint Louis win, coming off the bench to score 14 points and grab six rebounds ... At Rhode Island, he scored nine points, had five rebounds and four assists off the bench. At Duquesne, he scored seven points (4-4 FT) and tied his college career high with seven assists ... He had ten points in the Xavier game in Dayton.

Sophomore (2005-06) Santa Fe Community College: At Santa Fe, he played and started in 18 games, averaging 15.4 points, 3.9 assists, 3.2 rebounds and 2.1 steals.

Freshman (2004-05) Richmond: As a freshman at Richmond, he averaged 6.1 points, 3.1 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.8 rebounds in 22 games (19 starts). His 37 steals led the Spiders and was sixth in the A-10. Over the last five games of the year, he had three double-digit performances and averaged 10.2 points, 2.6 assists and 4.0 rebounds in that closing run
