College Highlights: Finished collegiate career at UT-San Antonio after starting at Houston. Did not play during the 2005-06 season; left Houston in the fall of 2005 prior to the start of basketball season and enrolled at UT-San Antonio in the spring of 2006.

Senior (2007-08): Averaged 1.9 points and 2.4 rebounds in 13.1 minutes a contest. Started 11 of 17 games, missing 13 games due to a knee injury suffered in the season opener. Recorded season-highs of five points and six rebounds vs. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Scored five points vs. Northwestern State. Pulled down six rebounds vs. UT-Arlington.

Junior (2006-07): Averaged 10.3 points and 6.7 rebounds. Started 15 of 19 games after becoming eligible to play after the fall semester. Scored in double figures ten times. Posted three double-doubles. Posted a career-high 17 points vs. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Registered 16 points and a career-high 14 rebounds at Northwestern State. Tallied 13 points, seven rebounds, and four blocked shots vs. Texas State. Notched a 12-point, 13-rebound double-double vs. Stephen F. Austin.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 1.8 points and 1.9 rebounds in 11.1 minutes a contest. Started once. Scored season-high seven points and blocked two shots at Rice. Pulled down a season-high seven rebounds vs. Ohio State. Posted six points in the first two games of the season vs. Sam Houston State and at Missouri. Tallied four points and four rebounds vs. SE Louisiana.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 7.3 points and 6.5 rebounds in four games before suffering a season-ending back injury. Set season-highs of 13 points, eight rebounds, and three assists vs. Lamar. Pulled down a season-high-matching eight rebounds at UTEP.
