Senior (2008-09) All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention ... played in 33 games, making 32 starts ... averaged team-best 16.2 points to go along with 3.3 rebounds per game ... led team with 71 three-pointers and made 38.8 percent from long distance ... 142-182 from the foul line, good for a team-high .780 percent ... reached the 20-point plateau 10 times ... registered 30 games of double-figure scoring ... led team in scoring on 15 different occasions ... during three games of CBI competition, averaged 15.7 points per game.

Junior (2007-08) All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention ... started 30 games ... third on team in scoring at 10.0 points per game ... 64-185 from beyond the arc, a team best ... third on the team with 59 assists ... 53-71 from the foul line ... scored in double-figures 17 times ... led team in scoring eight times ... named MVP of the Basketball Travelers Classic ...

Sophomore (2006-07): Played in 25 games, making 24 starts ... averaged 12.8 points per game, ranking second on the squad ... also averaged 3.2 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game ... led the team in minutes per game (33.6) and three-pointers (60) ... 66-86 from the free throw line ... scored in double-figures 18 times ... pulled down at least five rebounds in a game on seven different occasions ... poured in a career-high 30 points on 11-16 shooting from the field (including seven three-pointers) in the season opener against Siena on Nov. 11 went down with a high left ankle sprain on Feb. 11 and missed the next six games ... Pac-10 Player of the Week on Jan. 15.

Freshman (2005-06): Played in 22 games ... made his only start of the year against UCLA on Mar. 4 ... averaged 2.7 points and 1.5 rebounds per contest ... averaged 10.0 minutes per game ... 11-32 from beyond the arc ... scored a season-high 12 points on 4-4 shooting (3-3 from three-point territory) against UCLA on Mar. 4 ... snagged a season-best seven rebounds at Washington State on Feb. 25 ... helped lead the Cardinal to an NIT first round victory over Virginia on Mar. 14 by chipping in seven points in 11 minutes on 3-4 shooting from the field.
