College Highlights: Finished collegiate career as Miami's sixth all-time leader in assists (330). Started 77 of 106 career games.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 10.2 points and a team-high 3.4 assists. Started 29 of 32 games. Scored in double figures 16 times. Posted career-high 33 points on 13-for-19 shooting, 4-for-6 from beyond three-point range at Massachusetts. Registered 21 points and five assists at Georgia Tech. Matched career high with ten assists vs. Alcorn State. Tallied 12 points, a season-high six rebounds, and five assists at Evansville. Scored 18 points at North Carolina. Recorded 15 points at Maryland. Shared team lead with 18 points vs. North Carolina State.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 9.5 points and a team-high 3.1 assists. Started 20 of 27 games, missing the first seven games of the season due to a hairline fracture in his right foot. Scored in double figures 13 times, posting a season-high 22 points vs. Maryland. Distributed a season-high six assists and added 17 points and five rebounds at North Carolina. Scored 16 points vs. Florida. Tallied 16 points and five assists vs. Wake Forest. Registered 13 points and a season-high seven rebounds at Florida State.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 12.4 points, 2.5 rebounds, and a team-high 4.6 assists (ranked fifth in the ACC). Started 28 of 29 games. Scored 20 or more points four times. Registered a season-high 28 points and added nine assists at Wake Forest. Scored 25 points at Florida International. Tallied 23 points at Florida. Scored 21 points and grabbed a season-high six rebounds at Virginia. Dished out a career-high ten assists vs. Florida Atlantic. Posted 14 points at South Carolina in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 1.4 points, 0.3 rebounds, and 0.2 assists in 4.1 minutes a contest. Recorded season-high nine points in ten minutes vs. West Virginia. Grabbed season-high three rebounds vs. Savannah State.
