Averaged 8.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.6 assists ... 2008-09 Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year ... 2008-09 Conference USA All-Defensive Team ... 2008-09 All-Conference USA second team ... 2008-09 NABC All-District 11 second team ... 2008 Conference USA Tournament MVP ... 2007-08 Conference USA All-Defensive Team ... 2006-07 collegeinsider.com All-America Defensive Team ... 2006-07 Conference USA All-Defensive Team ... 2007 Conference USA All-Tournament Team.

Senior (2006-07): Started all 37 games in his final year ... Led team in minutes played (1,269) and assists (166) ... Fourth on the team in scoring (10.2 ppg) and rebounding (4.8 rpg) and second in steals (53) ... Had career shooting percentages from the field (45.0) and free throw line (73.3) as a senior ... His scoring (10.2 ppg), rebounding (4.8 rpg), assists (166) and steals (53) were also career bests ... Averaged only 0.07 turnovers per minute (85 TO/1269 minutes) ... Ranked among Conference USA leaders in assists (6th), steals (10th) and assist-to-turnover ratio (6th) ... Had 23 games with four or more assists at his off-guard/wing position ... Started all six postseason games ... Averaged 9.2 points, 3.8 rebounds and 6.2 assists ... Had an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.2:1 ... Shot 55.6 percent from the field in the postseason ... Had seven steals ... In NCAA Tournament play (three games), averaged 11.0 points, 3.3 rebounds and 8.3 assists

Junior (2007-08): Started a school-record 40 games ... Led team in minutes played (1180) and tied for team lead in steals (49) ... Second on squad in assists (136) and three-pointers made (51) ... The 1,180 minutes played are fifth-most by a Tiger in a single season ... Averaged 8.6 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.4 assists ... Shot 40.8 percent from the field and 33.3 percent from the arc ... Averaged only 0.04 turnovers per minute (52 TO/1180 minutes) ... Led Conference USA and team in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.62:1 ... Also ranked among Conference USA leaders in assists (11th) and steals (11th) ... Dished out four or more assists in 21 games ... Started all nine postseason games ... Averaged 10.6 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.4 assists ... Had an assist-to-turnover ratio of 5.2:1 in nine postseason games ... Shot 44.9 percent from the field and 42.5 percent from the arc ... In six NCAA Tournament games, averaged 10.2 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.5 assists

Sophomore (2006-07): Saw game action in 36 contests ... Only game missed was the Feb. 10 Tulane contest with a low right ankle sprain ... Started 35 contests, with his only non-start coming on Senior Day (Jared Sandridge started in his place) ... Team's fifth-leading scorer at 8.0 ppg and third-leading rebounder at 4.1 rpg ... Led squad with 130 assists and 59 steals ... Ranked among Conference USA leaders in assists (8th) and steals (4th) ... Started all seven postseason games ... Averaged 9.4 points, 4.1 rebounds and 4.0 assists ... Had an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.8:1 in seven postseason games.

Freshman (2005-06): Played in all 37 games, starting 21 ... Averaged 7.2 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.8 assists ... Shot 42.1 percent from the field, 36.5 percent from the arc and 63.3 percent from the foul line ... Third on the team with 105 assists ... The 56 swipes are the fifth-most by a freshman in a season ... Played in all seven Tiger postseason games ... Averaged 6.9 points, 2.9 rebounds and 2.3 assists in the postseason ... Shot 47.4 percent from the floor and 43.5 from the three-point line ... Had four blocks and seven steals ... In NCAA Tournament (four games), averaged 8.3 points, 2.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists ... Shot 59.1 percent from the field and 50 percent from the arc ... Had eight points and five rebounds vs. Bradley in the NCAA Tournament/Oakland Regional semifinal.
