Pro Career Highlights: Has played professionally both in the United States and abroad. In 2007-08, spent time in Germany, the PBL in the United States, and Italy. Appeared in two ULEB Cup games with Frankfurt in Germany, scoring five points before returning home to play for the Dallas Defenders in the PBL (statistics unavailable). Finished the year with Indesit Fabriano in the Italian Legadue, averaging 11.1 points and 5.4 rebounds in 13 games. In 2006-07, started the year in Israel with Gilboa/Afula/Migdal Haemek, averaging 8.1 points and 3.7 rebounds in seven games. Finished the year in the NBA Developmental League with the Sioux Falls Skyforce, averaging 8.6 points and 6.2 rebounds in ten games. In 2005-06, participated in NBA training camp with the Charlotte Bobcats before moving on to play with Frankfurt in Germany, averaging 12.6 points and 4.9 rebounds in nine regular season games and 12.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in six ULEB Cup games. In 2004-05, started the year in the NBA D-League with the Asheville Altitude before joining Hemofarm of Serbia, averaging 9.8 points and 4.0 rebounds in five ULEB Cup games, 8.7 points and 2.6 rebounds in ten Adriatic League games, and 6.6 points and 3.3 rebounds in ten YUBA league games. Spent the summer of 2004 with the Pennsylvania Valley Dawgs in the USBL, averaging 7.8 points and 5.1 rebounds in 20 games. In 2003-04, participated in NBA

training camp with the Milwaukee Bucks before moving on to the NBA D-League with the Altitude, averaging 11.2 points and 5.4 rebounds in 46 games.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-WAC honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career as the eleventh all-time leading scorer in Louisiana Tech history with 1,541 career points. Also ranks tenth all-time in rebounds (813) and fifth in blocked shots (61). Started 107 of 117 career games.

Senior (2002-03): Led team in scoring (17.9 ppg, ranked third in the WAC) and 7.3 rebounds (sixth). Started all 27 games. Paced team in scoring 18 times, including a career-high 34 points to go with 15 rebounds vs. Nevada. Posted 27 points vs. Hawaii. Registered a double-double of 20 points and 12 rebounds in the season opener at Florida.

Junior (2001-02): Averaged 11.2 points and a team-high 6.8 rebounds (sixth in the WAC). Started 27 of 29 games. Posted six double-doubles. Led team with season-high 19 points and grabbed season-high 13 rebounds at Nevada. Posted a double-double of 13 points and 12 rebounds vs. Led team with 19 points vs. Vanderbilt in the second round of the NIT.

Sophomore (2000-01): Averaged 14.0 points and a team-high 7.6 rebounds. Ranked second in the WAC in field goal percentage (.553). Started all 29 games. Scored in double figures 23 times. Registered seven double-doubles. Posted season-high 24 points vs. Tennessee State. Named to John Thompson All-Tournament Team after averaging 21.0 points and 9.5 rebounds in two contests.

Freshman (1999-00): Averaged 11.2 points and 6.9 rebounds. Started 21 of 29 games. Ranked fourth in the conference in field goal percentage (.509). Posted double figures in points 18 times and registered five double-doubles. Scored season-high 21 points vs. Denver. Grabbed season-high 16 rebounds at North Texas.
